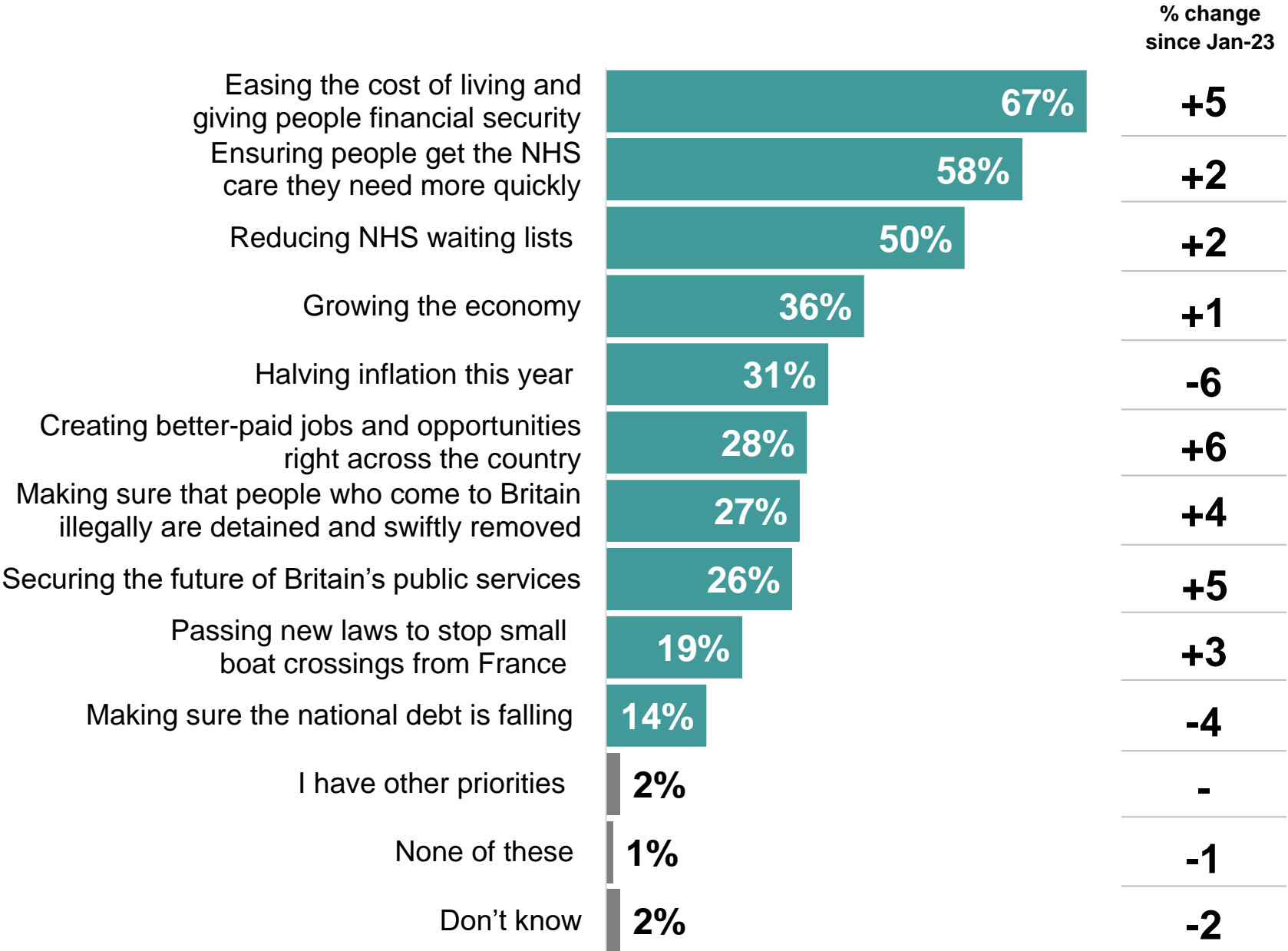

Which of the below, if any, are the most important priorities for you? Please choose up to 4.

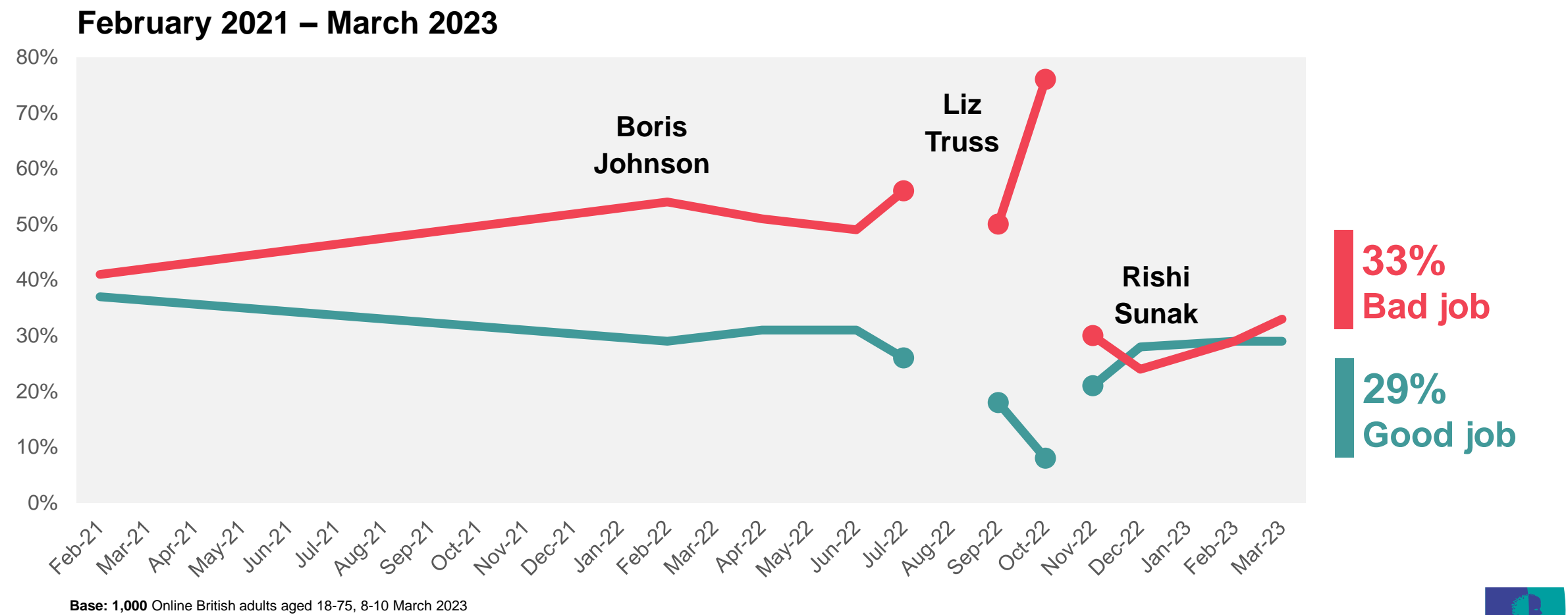

# Job performance: Prime Minister

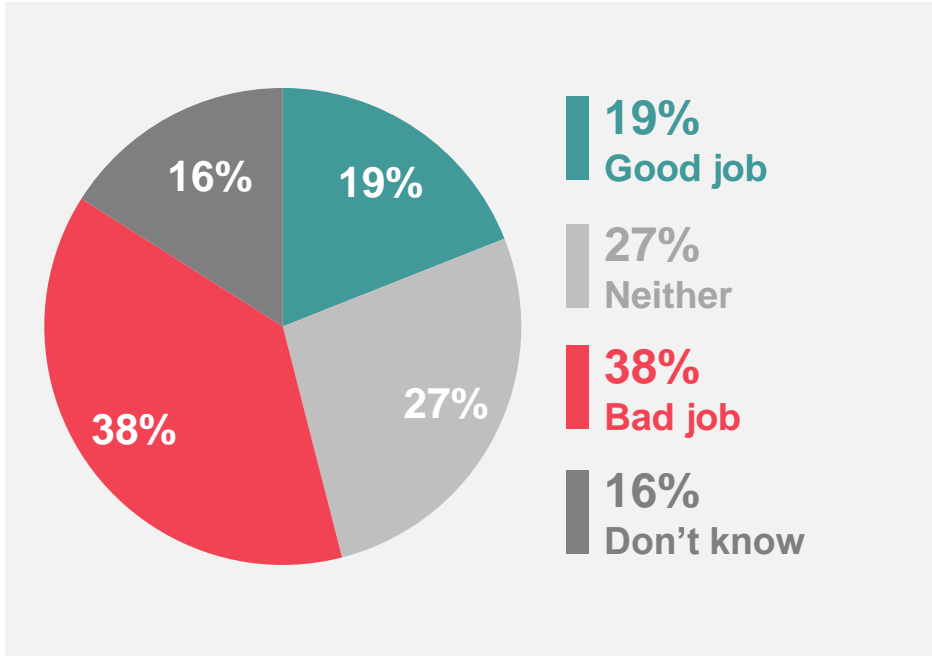
To what extent, would you say Rishi Sunak has been doing a good job or bad job as Prime Minister, or neither?



# Job performance: Suella Braverman

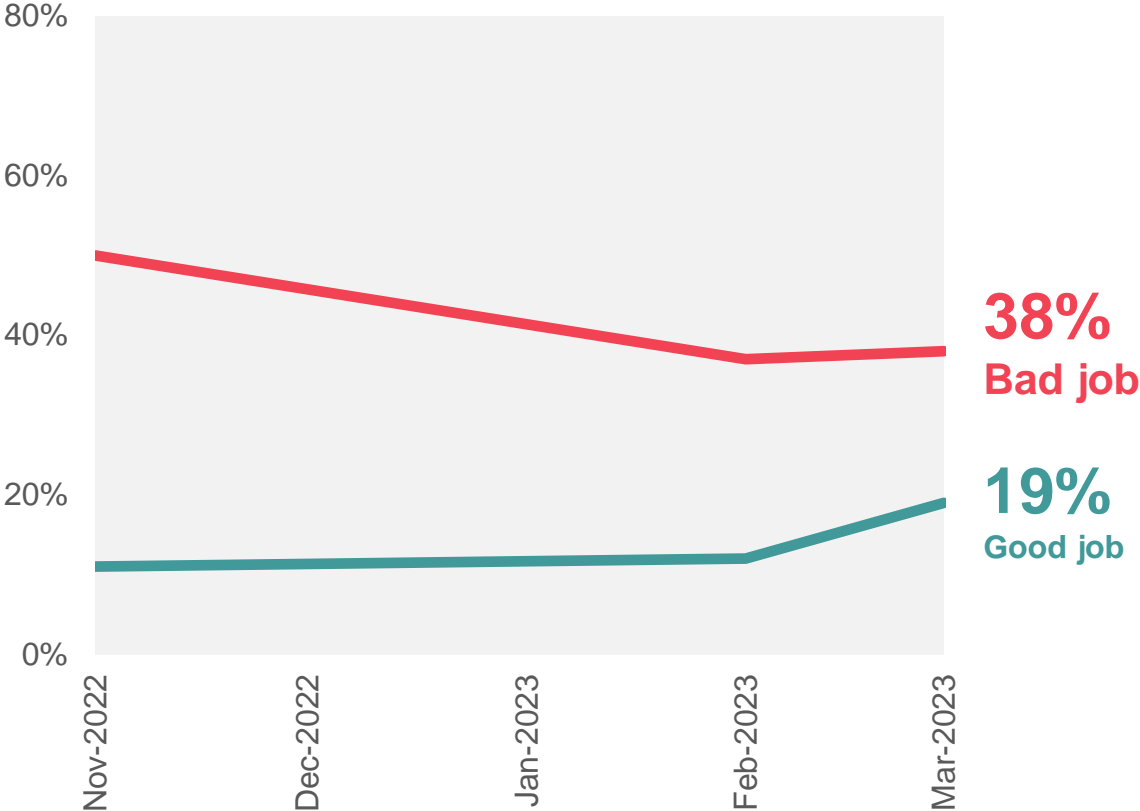
To what extent, would you say Suella Braverman has been doing a good job or bad job as Home Secretary, or neither?

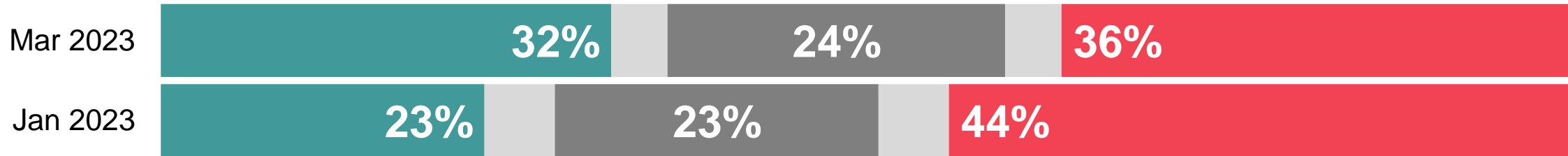


# Expectations for Rishi Sunak's govt. handling illegal immigration

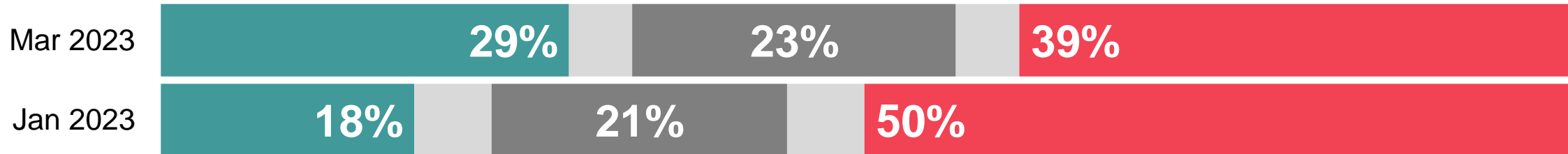
In your opinion, do you think a Conservative government led by Rishi Sunak will do a good job or a bad job, if either, at delivering in the following areas?

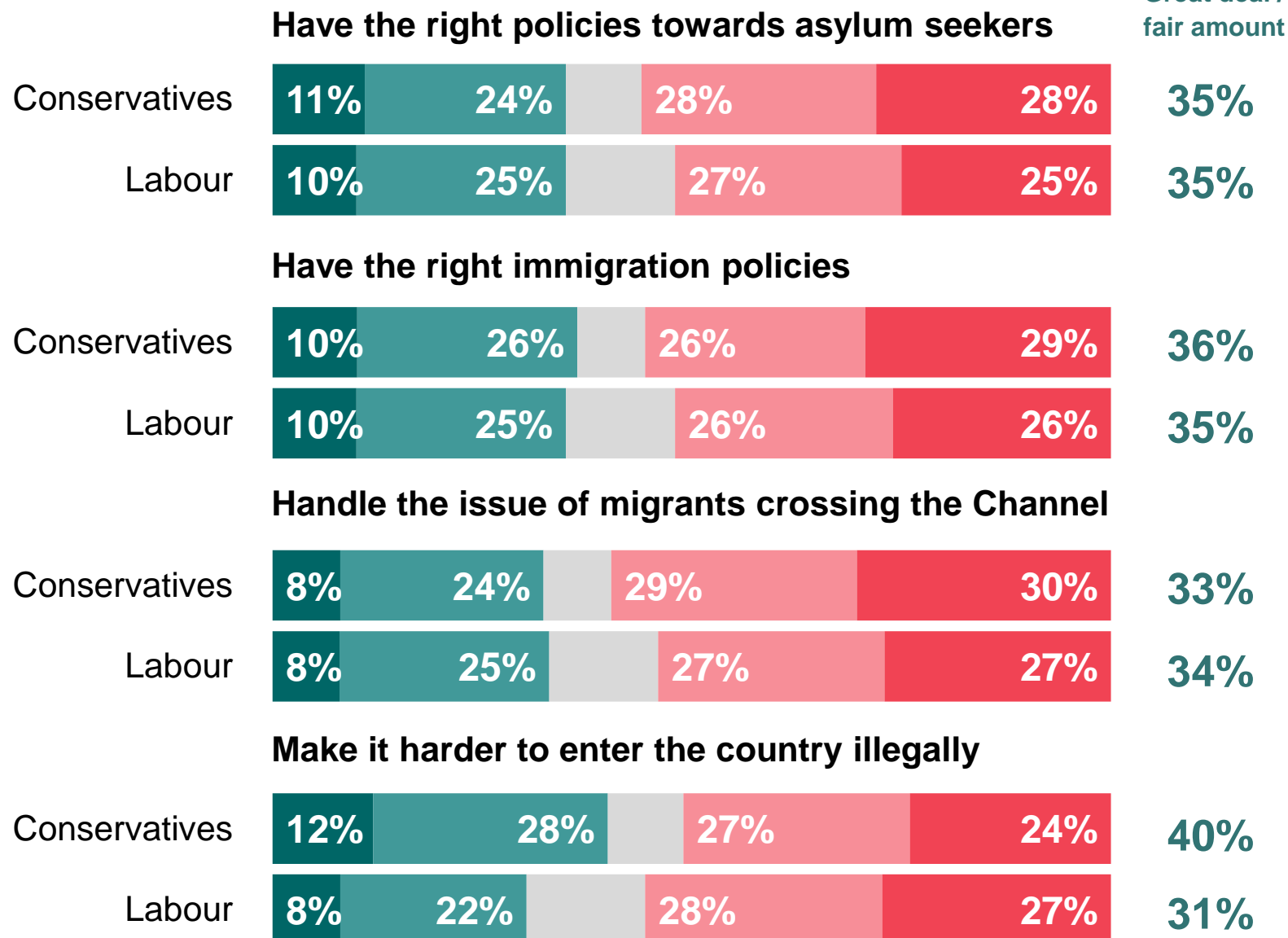
## Making sure that people who come to Britain illegally are detained and swiftly removed

To what extent, if at all, do you trust each of the following political parties to...?

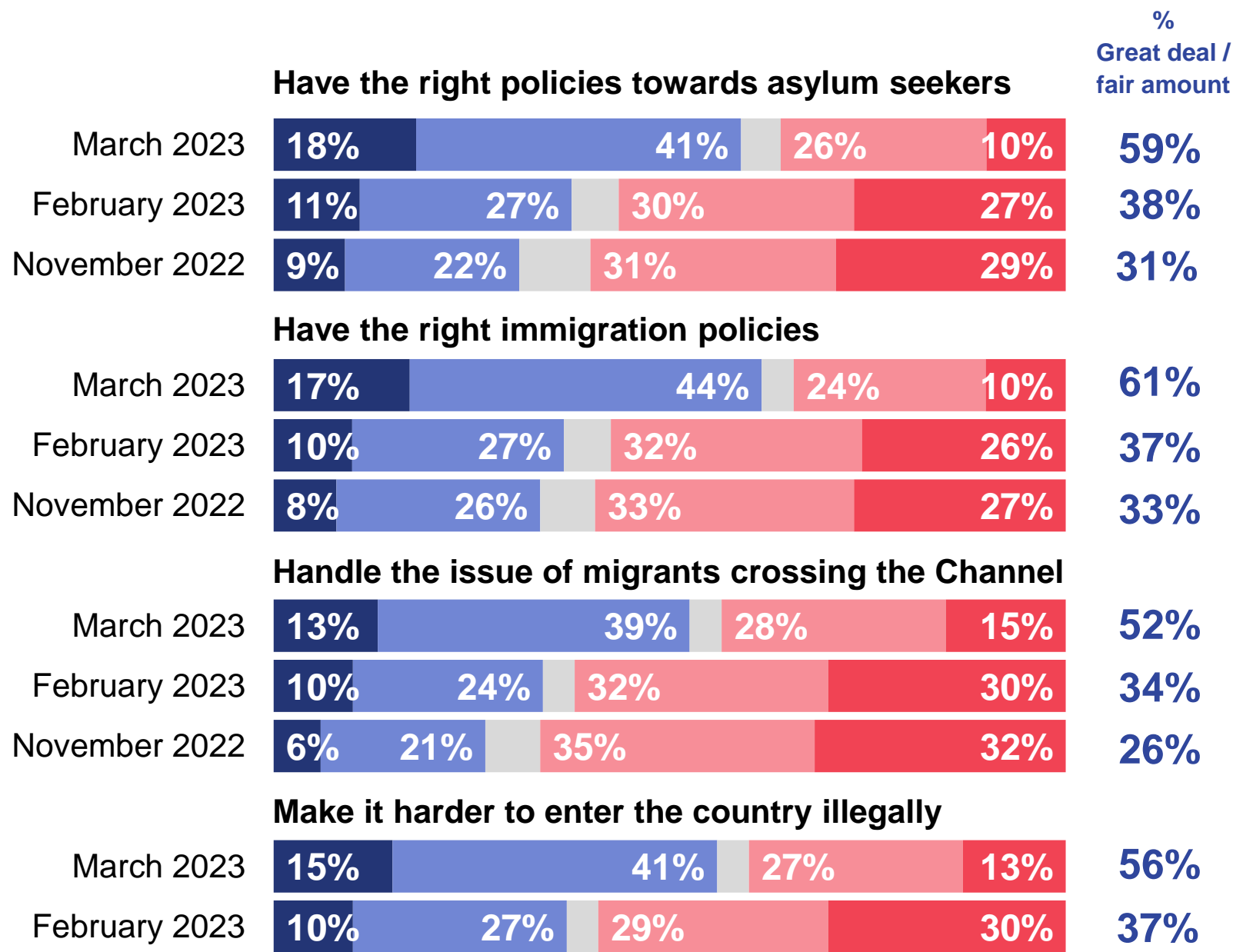

Among 2019 Conservative voters

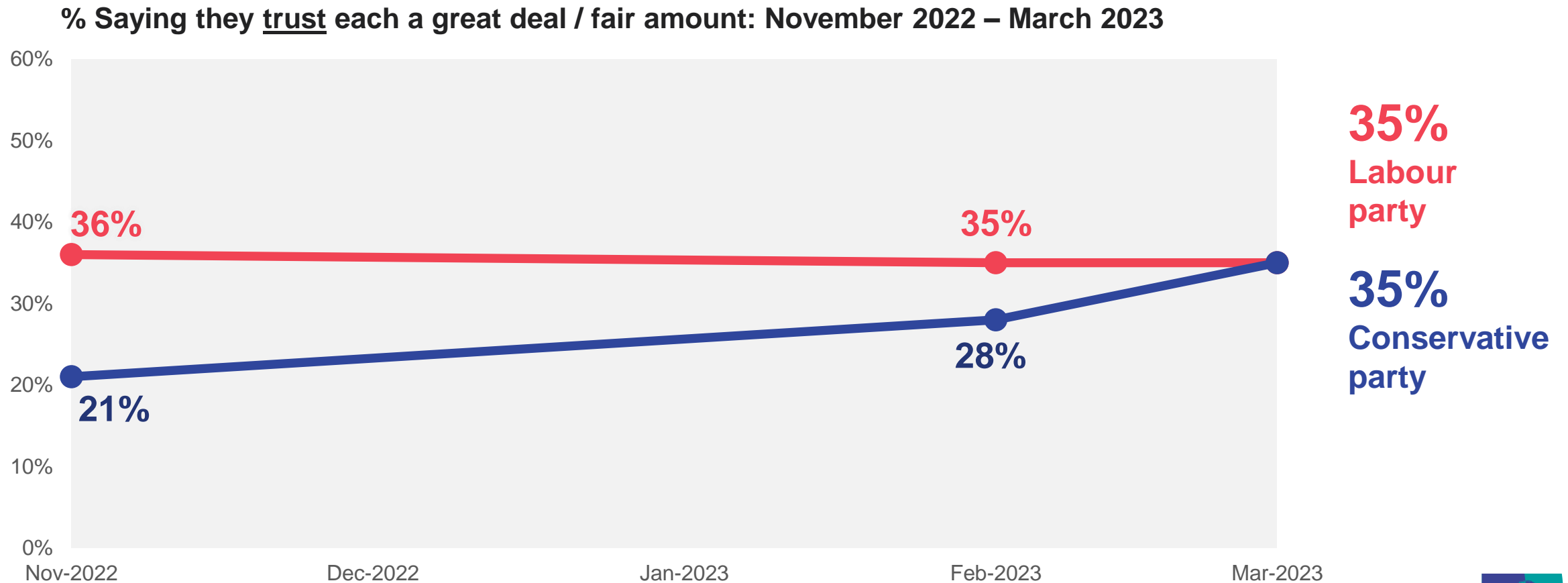

To what extent, if at all, do you trust each of the following political parties to have the right policies towards asylum seekers?

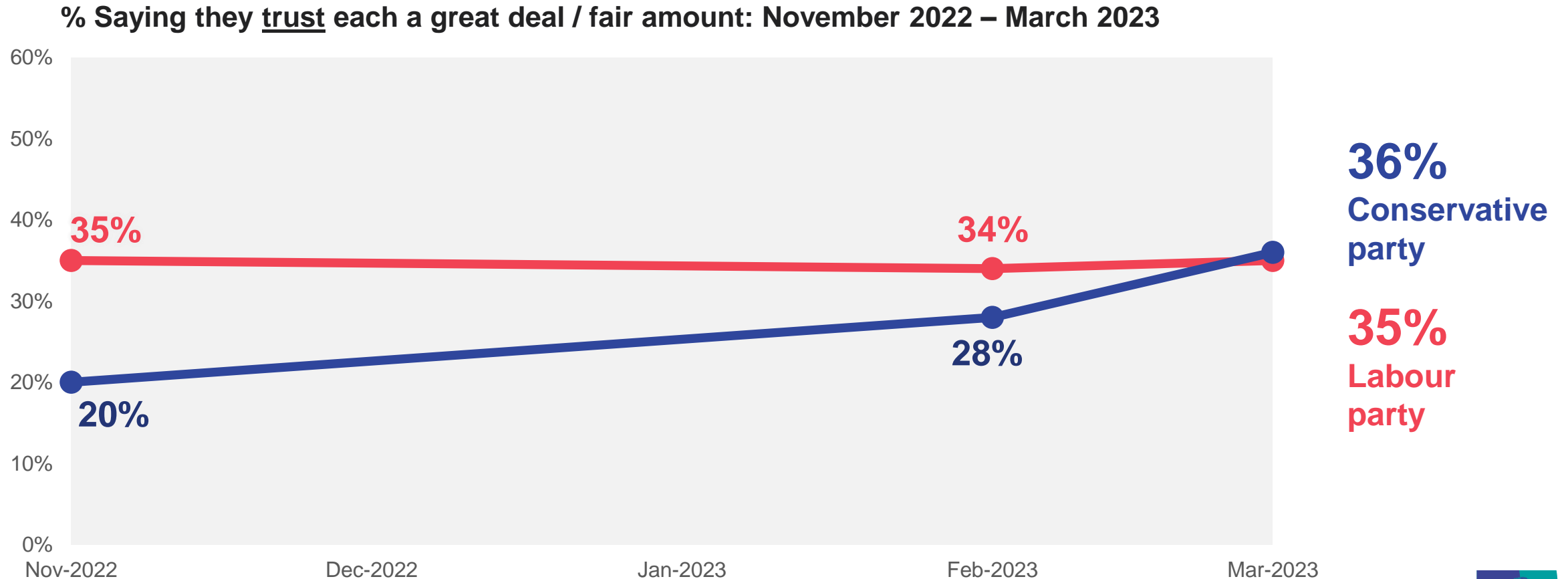

# Trust in parties to have the right immigration policies

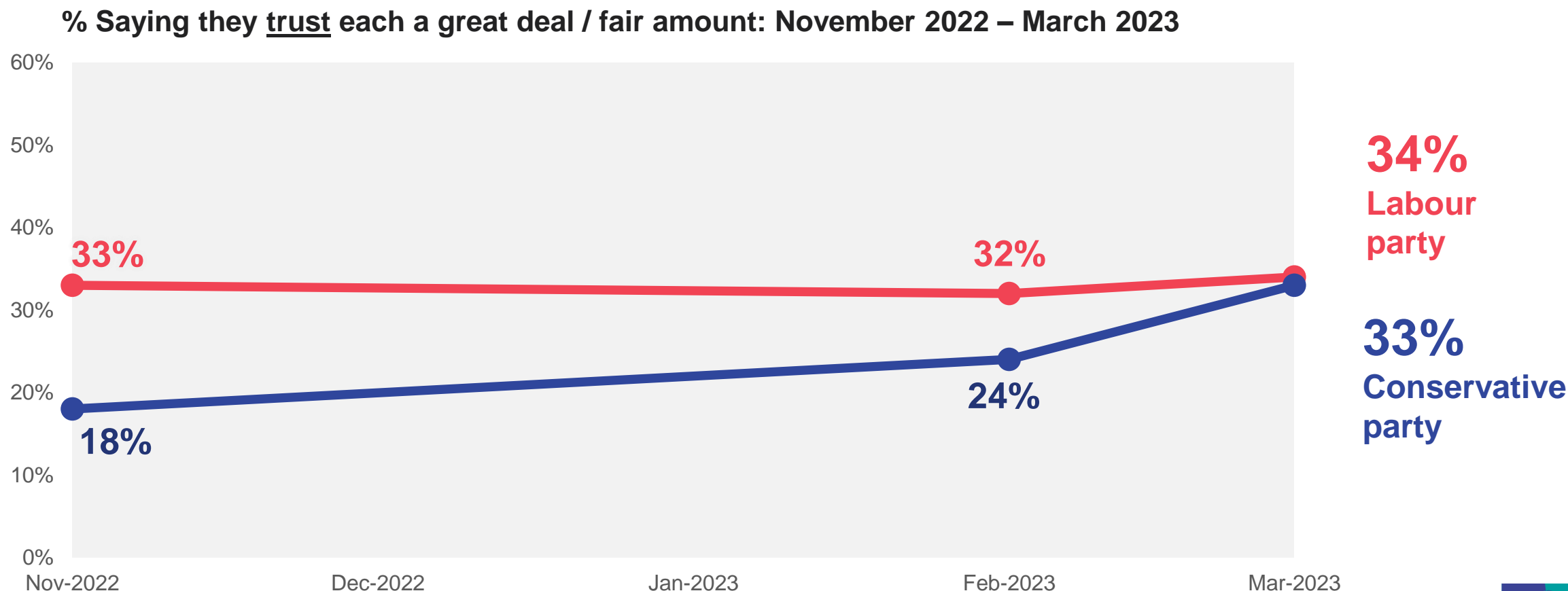
To what extent, if at all, do you trust each of the following political parties to have the right immigration policies?

# Trust in parties to handle issue of migrants crossing the Channel

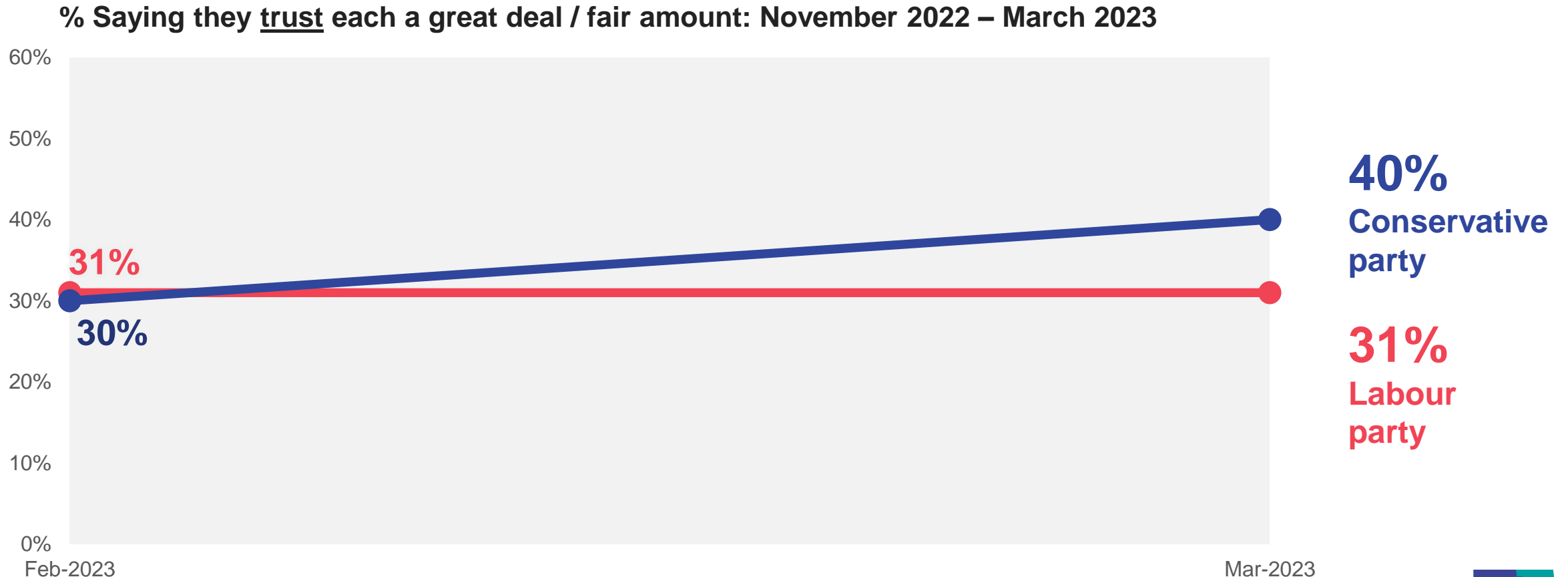
To what extent, if at all, do you trust each of the following political parties to handle the issue of migrants crossing the English Channel?
