



Voting Intention: February 2023

How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?









Base: 1,004 British adults 18+, 22 February – 1 March 2023; Headline Voting Intention: all 9/10 certain to vote, always/usually/it depends vote in General Elections = 642. Margin of error is displayed at +/- 4% All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points. This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.

How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?



How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?



Base: 1,004 British adults 18+, 22 February - 1 March 2023. Swing is calculated as the average of change in % "satisfied" and % "dissatisfied"




Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way Rishi Sunak is doing his job as Prime Minister?




Rishi Sunak: Satisfaction amongst Conservative supporters








Net satisfaction with Prime Ministers (1979-2023)









Keir Starmer: Satisfaction amongst Labour supporters















Economic Optimism Index

Do you think that the general economic condition of the country will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?



Do you think that the general economic condition of the country will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?






















Impact of Government policies: Britain's economy

July 1980 – February 2023





"In the long term, this government's policies will improve the state of Britain's public services"



Which party do you think has the best policies on ... the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats, or some other party?






Which party do you think has the best policies on managing the economy, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?






Best party on pensions: 1993-2023

Which party do you think has the best policies on taxation, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?





Which party do you think has the best policies on unemployment, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?





Which party do you think has the best policies on poverty and inequality, the Conservatives, Labour, Liberal Democrats or some other party?


