


What will the outcome of next election be?

As you probably know, a general election may result in a clear majority for one party that can make decisions without consulting, or it may result in a Hung Parliament where no party has an overall majority so parties must compromise and reach agreement to make decisions.

One party forms a minority government and needs the support of other parties to pass legislation






One in three say they are likely to vote tactically at the next election – with the majority of these wanting to keep the Conservatives out
