






Westminster Voting Intention: May 2023

How would you vote if there were a General Election tomorrow?











Holyrood Constituency Voting Intention: May 2023


If there were elections to the Scottish Parliament tomorrow, how would you use this constituency vote?














Holyrood Regional List Voting Intention: May 2023

If there were elections to the Scottish Parliament tomorrow, how would you use your regional list vote?









How would you vote if there were a General Election tomorrow?





What do you see as the most important issue/issues facing Scotland today?






Top five concerns for May 2023: trend data












Satisfaction with Nicola Sturgeon

Satisfaction ratings over time: Feb 2014 – Mar 2023















Support for Scottish independence: May 2023

All likely to vote and expressing a voting intention










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Technical note

lpsos interviewed a representative sample of 1,100 adults aged 16+ across Scotland. Interviews were conducted by telephone: 15 May – 21 May 2023. Data are weighted by age, sex, region, social grade, tenure, working status, work sector, education and country of birth to match the profile of the population.

Where percentages do not sum to 100 this may be due to computer rounding, the exclusion of "don't know" categories, or multiple answers. An asterisk (*) denotes any value of less than half a per cent.
