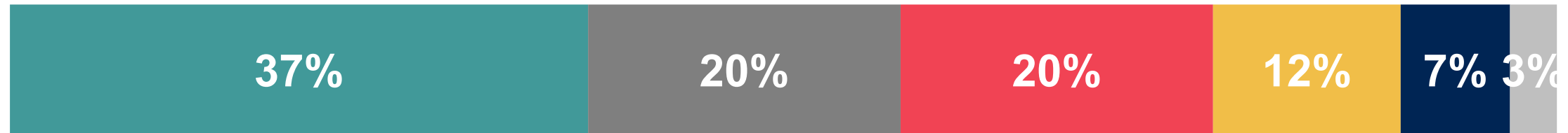

Almost two in five remain more proud of what the Monarchy represents than embarrassed, relatively unchanged from before the Coronation

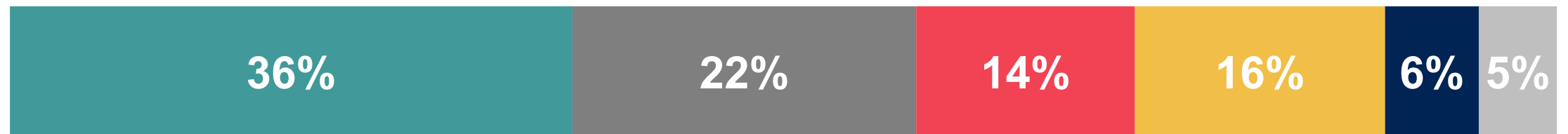
Thinking of the monarchy in Britain, would you say you're more proud of what the monarchy represents, more embarrassed that a monarchy is still in place, or neither?



May 2023 – after the Coronation



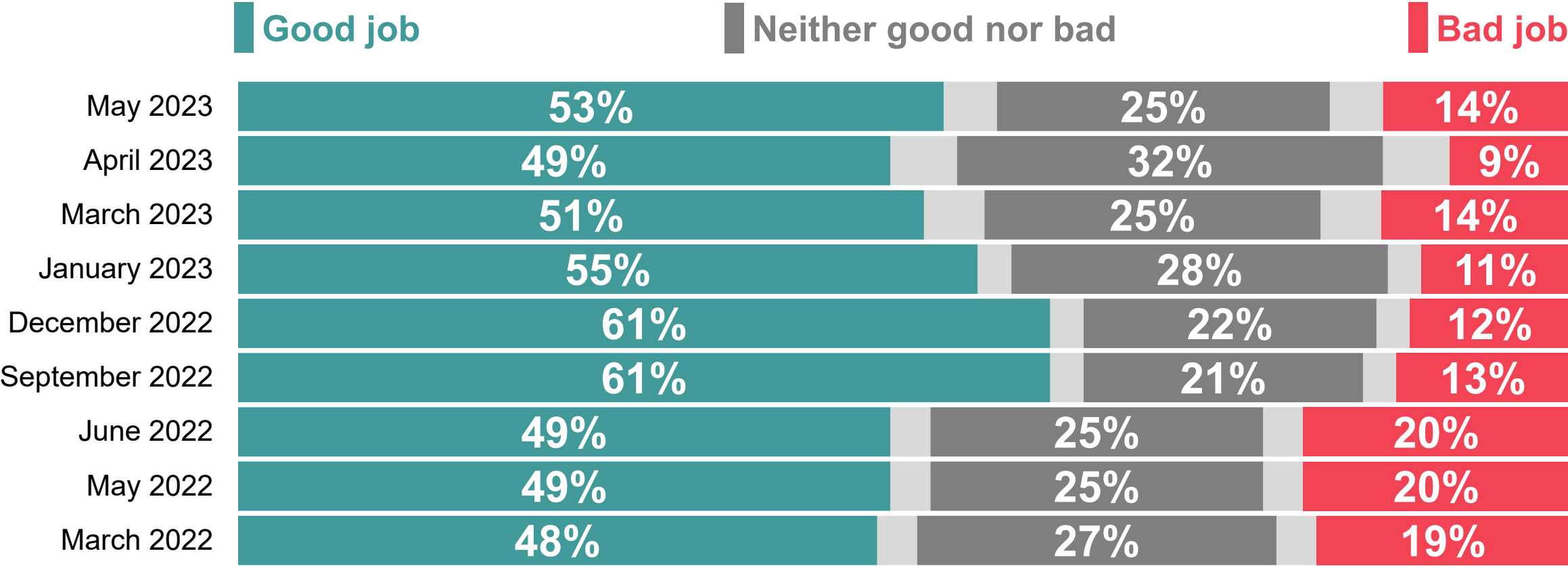
April 2023 – before the Coronation

Over half believe King Charles is doing a good job as King, up slightly from before the Coronation

Half now think that too much money was spent on the Coronation of King Charles, up from what they thought before the Coronation took place

From what you know or have heard, do you think too much, too little, or about the right amount of money was spent on the coronation of King Charles?

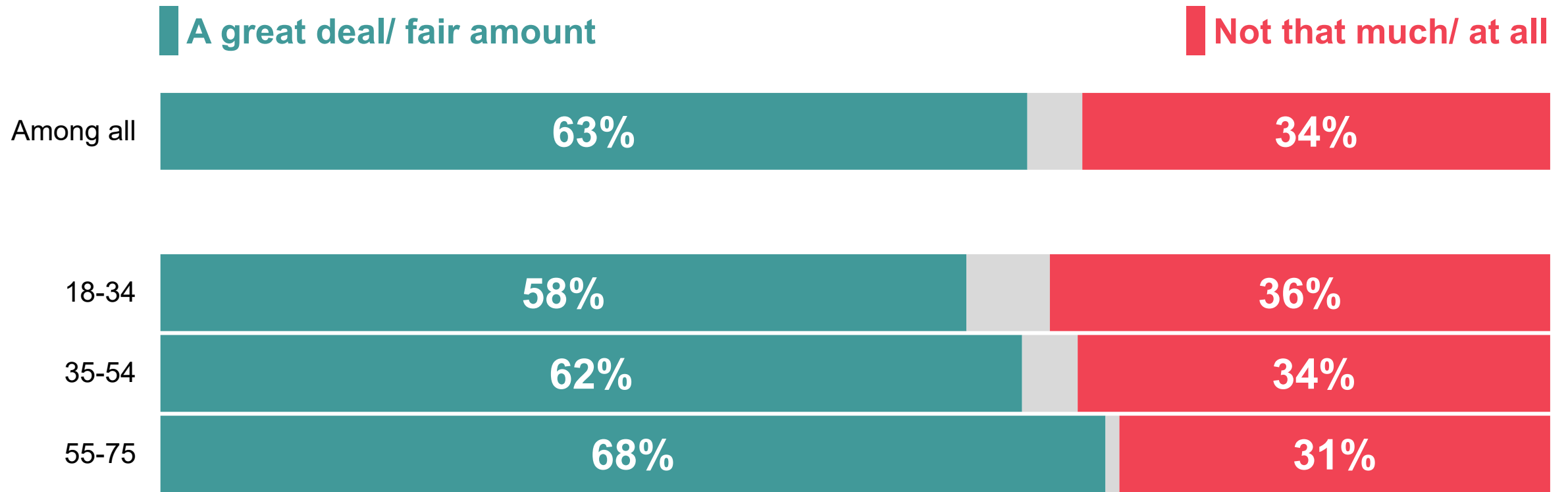

Almost two thirds have seen or heard about the arrests of anti-monarchy protestors at the Coronation

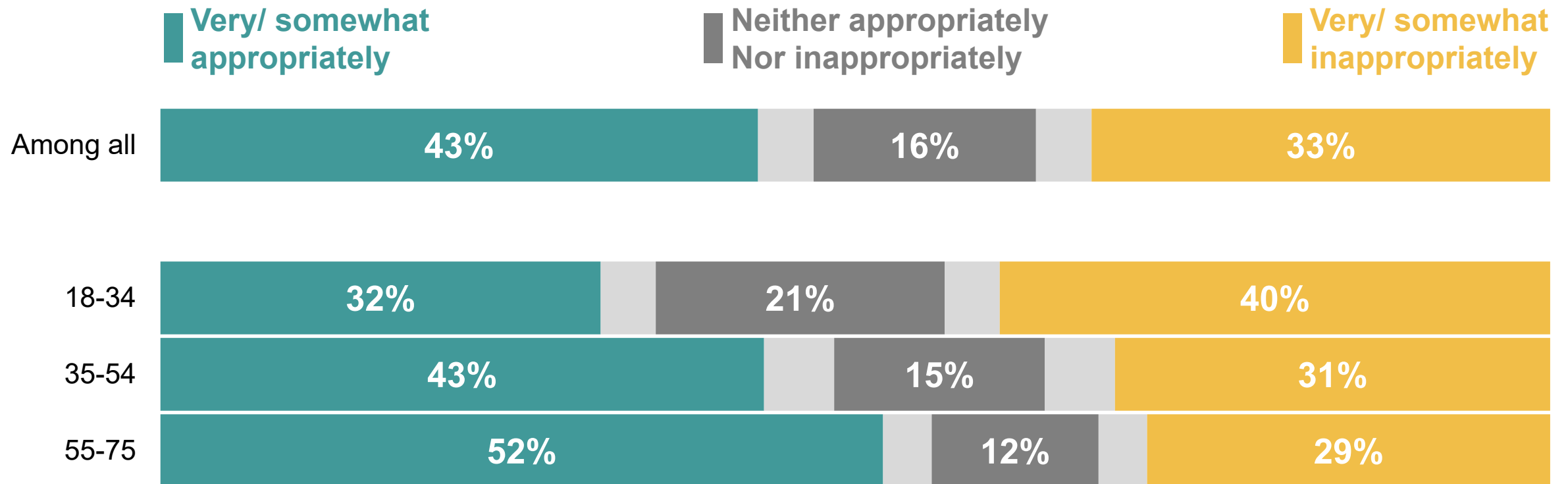
How much, if at all, have you seen or heard about the arrests of anti-monarchy protestors at the Coronation of King Charles III?

Of those that have seen or heard about the arrests of anti-monarchy protestors, two in five think the Metropolitan Police acted appropriately. Younger Britons are more divided

Based on what you've seen or heard, do you think the Metropolitan Police acted appropriately or inappropriately in making these arrests, or are you unsure?
