


In the past 12 months, has the amount of crime or violence in your neighborhood increased, decreased, or stayed about the same as the previous year?

(%)







Base: 23,039 online adults under the age of 75 across 29 countries, interviewed March 24, 2023, to April 7, 2023.



View on Crime and Law Enforcement

The majority of Malaysians believe that crime rates have remained steady compared to last year, with 25% of respondents reporting an increase in crime in their neighborhoods.

This indicates that Malaysia, like Japan, South Korea, and Singapore, is benefiting from the measures taken by national law enforcement agencies to combat crime.

Despite acknowledging that vehicle theft, burglary, and vandalism are common crimes in their communities, Malaysians are confident in law enforcement's ability to combat violent and non-violent crimes.

With this confidence in law enforcement and initiatives announced through Budget 2023 to enhance the quality of service provided by the PDRM, Malaysians emphasize economic growth and job creation as the government's top priority.
