# **Ipsos Veracity Index** 2023

Trust in professions survey

# **Technical note**

*This year's Veracity Index has been conducted using a telephone survey*. *Typically the index uses face-to-face fieldwork but since 2020 data has been collected over the phone.* 

Mode effects should be kept in mind when comparing the results with previous years' data, especially when differences are close to the margin of error.


This year's survey was carried out over two waves of a telephone omnibus survey: one with 1,020 British adults aged 16+ between 8 and 14 November 2023 and the second with 1,015 British adults aged 16+ between 15 and 21 November 2023.

Data are weighted to the population profile. Where percentages do not sum to 100 this may be due to computer rounding.




















# Trust in politicians by subgroup






#### Trust in the police: long term trend








