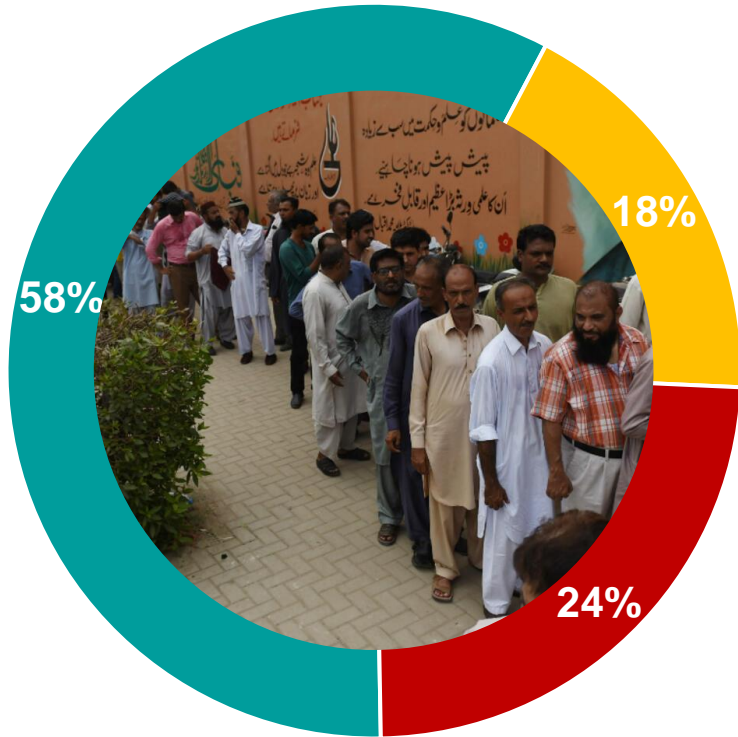

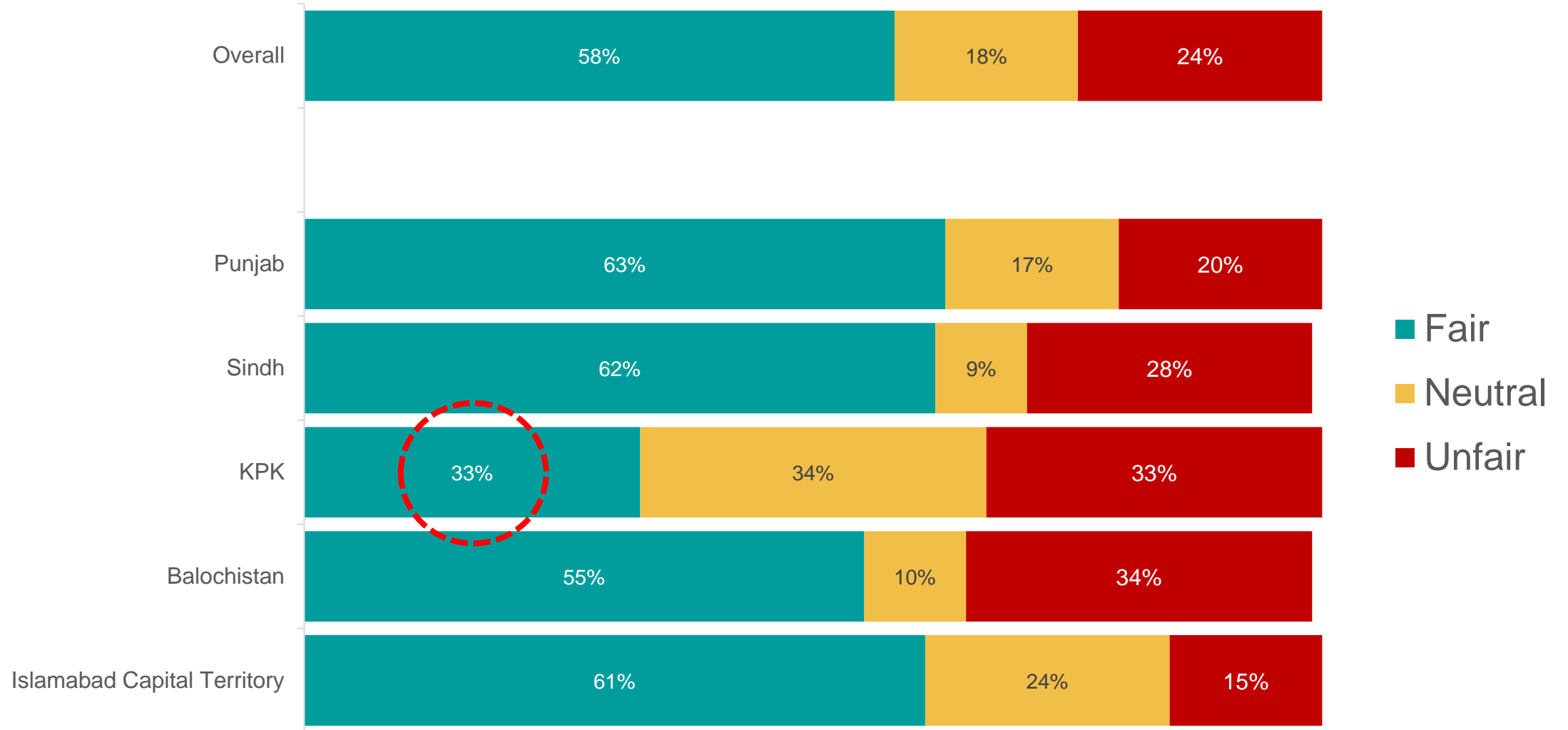


Polling Day Processes: 3 in 5 Pakistanis believe that the polling day processes were fair & transparent. Positivity is higher among rural population.

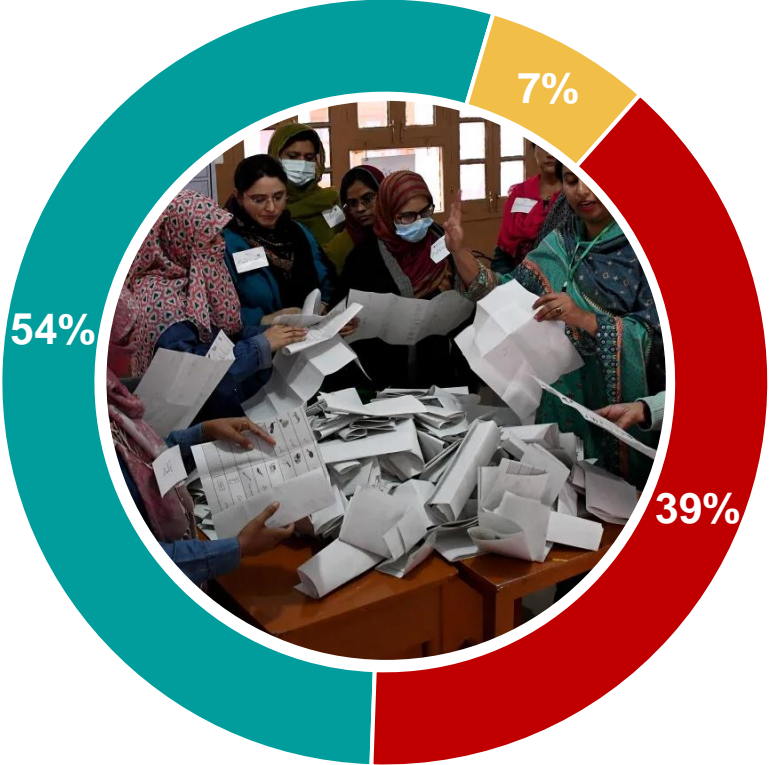


■ Fair and Transparent. ■ Not sure. ■ Unfair and Not Transparent

Polling Day Processes: Except for KPK, Majority of people in all other provinces think election day processes were fair & transparent



Overall Perception of Rigging in Elections: There's a divide on whether the elections were rigged or not, 54% Pakistanis think elections were overall transparent, while 39% think these were rigged.

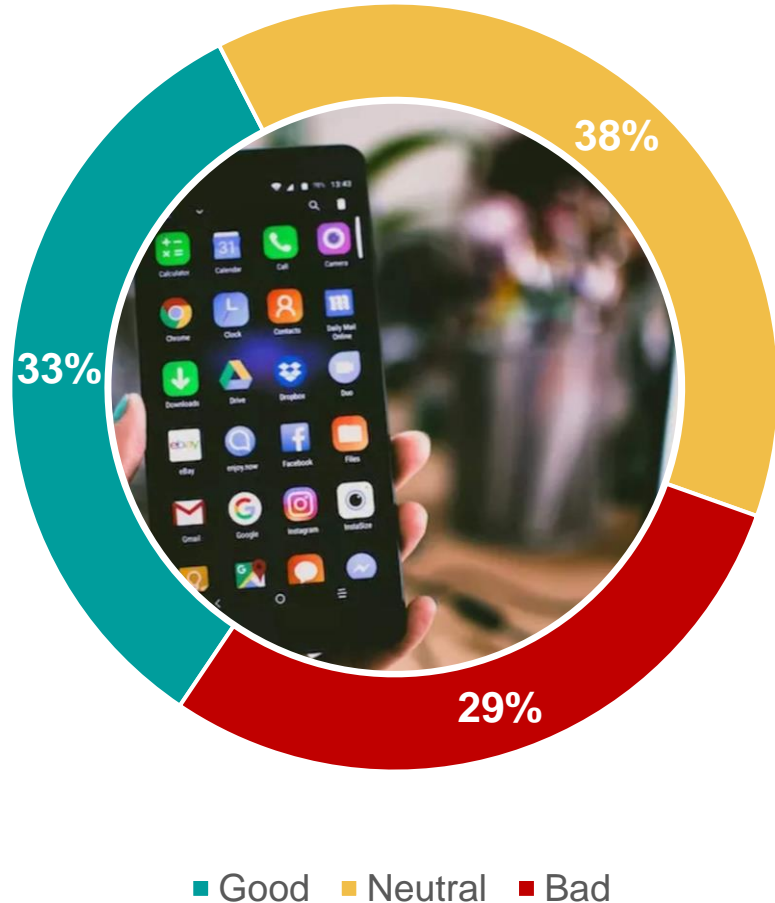


■ Transparent ■ Neutral ■ Rigged

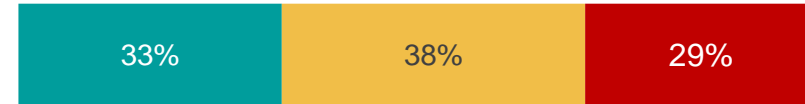
Overall Perception of Rigging in Elections: Highest perception of rigging is in KP, followed by Islamabad. Least in Sindh

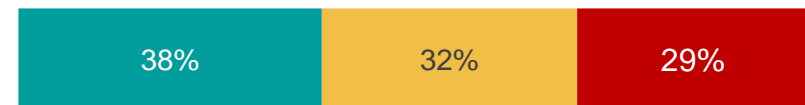

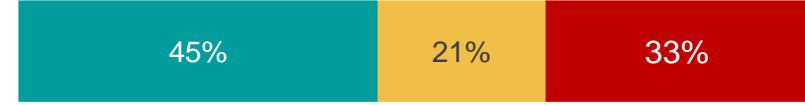

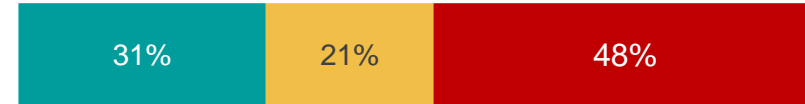
