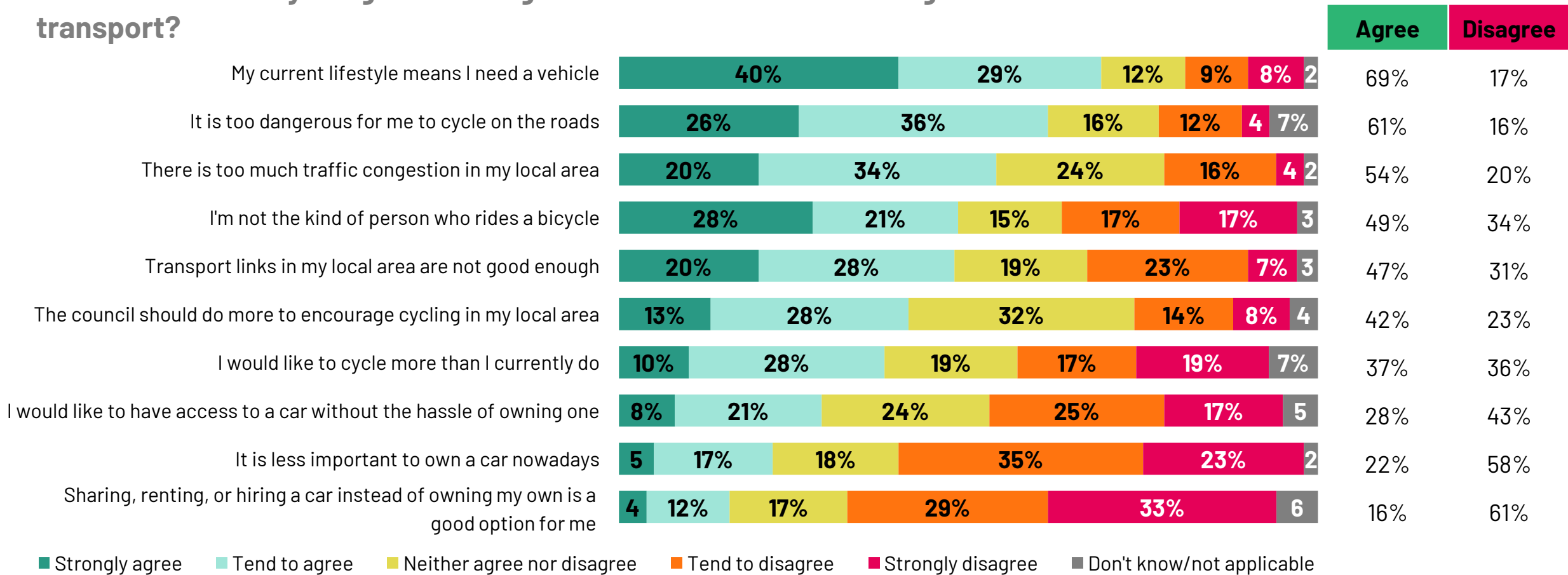

To what extent do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements about transport?



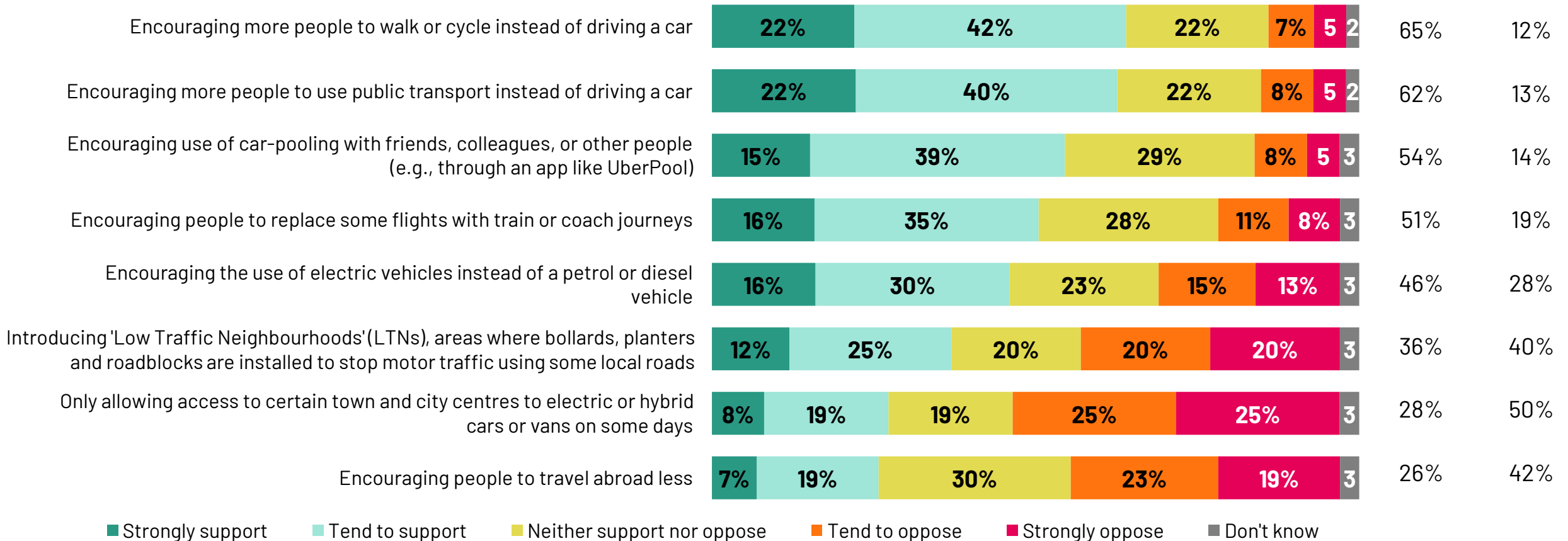

Support **Oppose**

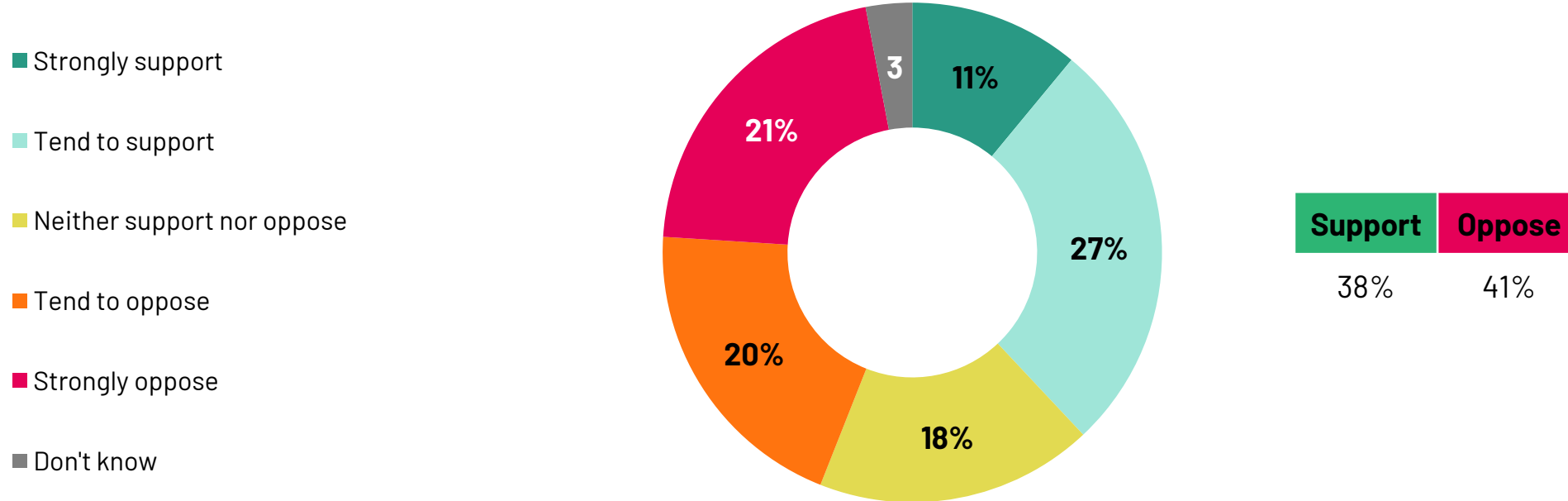

Support for, and opposition to, road user charging

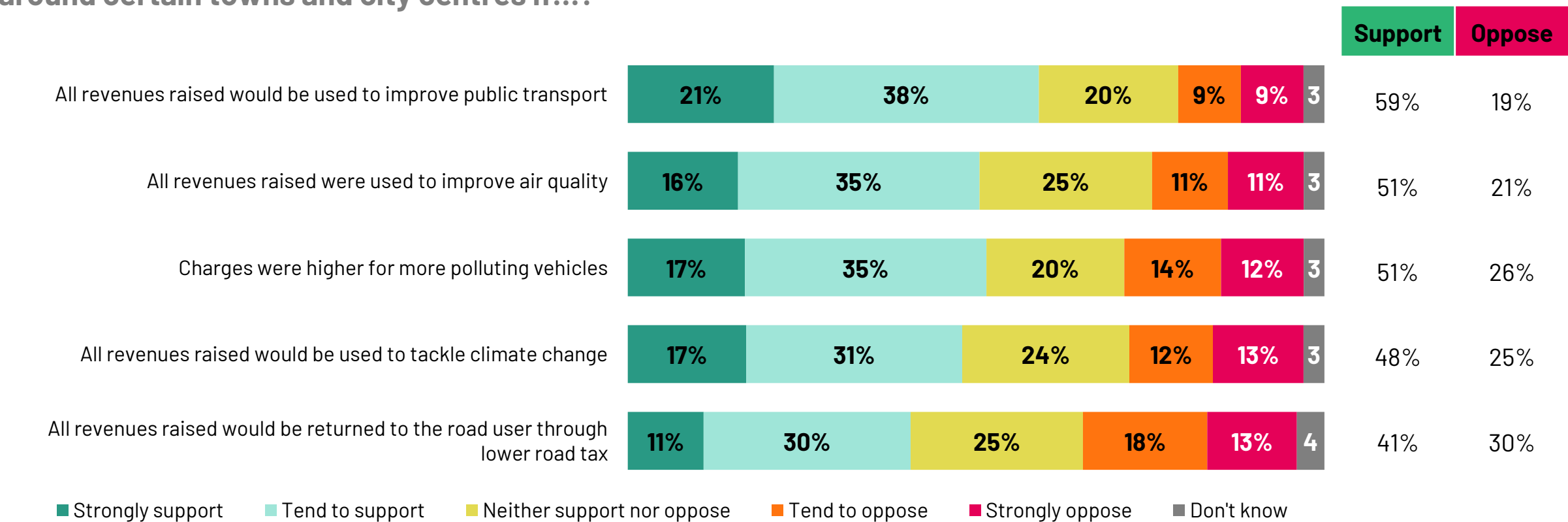
