



Voting Intention: June 2024

How do you intend to vote in the General Election? Will you vote...?








Base: 1,014 British adults 18+, 31 May – 4 June 2024; Headline Voting Intention: all 9/10 certain to vote, always/usually/it depends vote in General Elections = 566. Margin of error is displayed at +/- 4% All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error. On the basis of the historical record of the polls at recent general elections, there is a 9 in 10 chance that the true value of a party's support lies within 4 points of the estimates provided by this poll, and a 2 in 3 chance that they lie within 2 points. This is especially important to keep in mind when calculating party lead figures.

How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?




How would you vote if there were an election tomorrow?




Who might you vote for instead?

If you do change your mind about voting for this party, which party would you vote for instead?





Important Not important















Satisfaction with leaders and the Government: June 2024




Are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the way Rishi Sunak is doing his job as Prime Minister?







How satisfied or dissatisfied are you with the way ... is doing his/her job as Prime Minister?













Number of months after becoming opposition leader









Do you think that the general economic condition of the country will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?


























