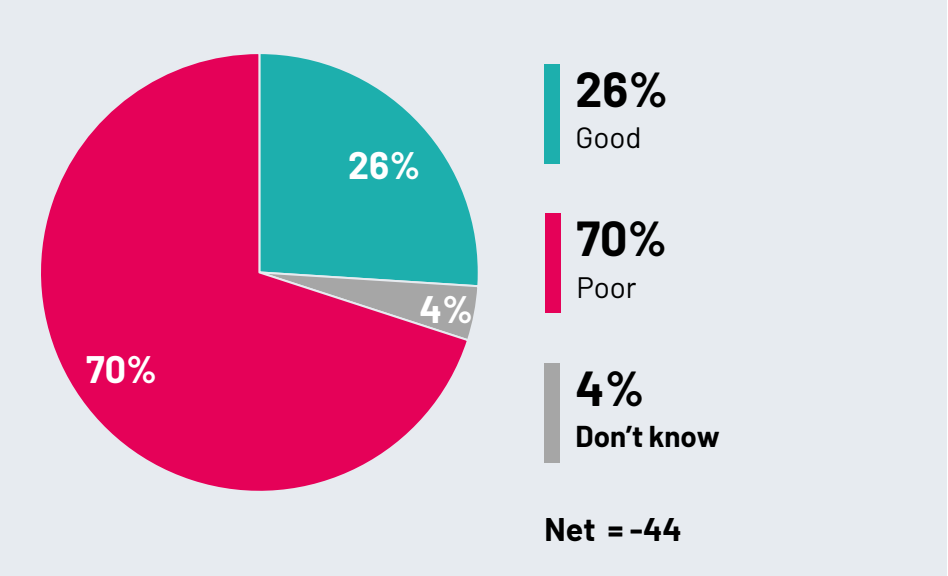

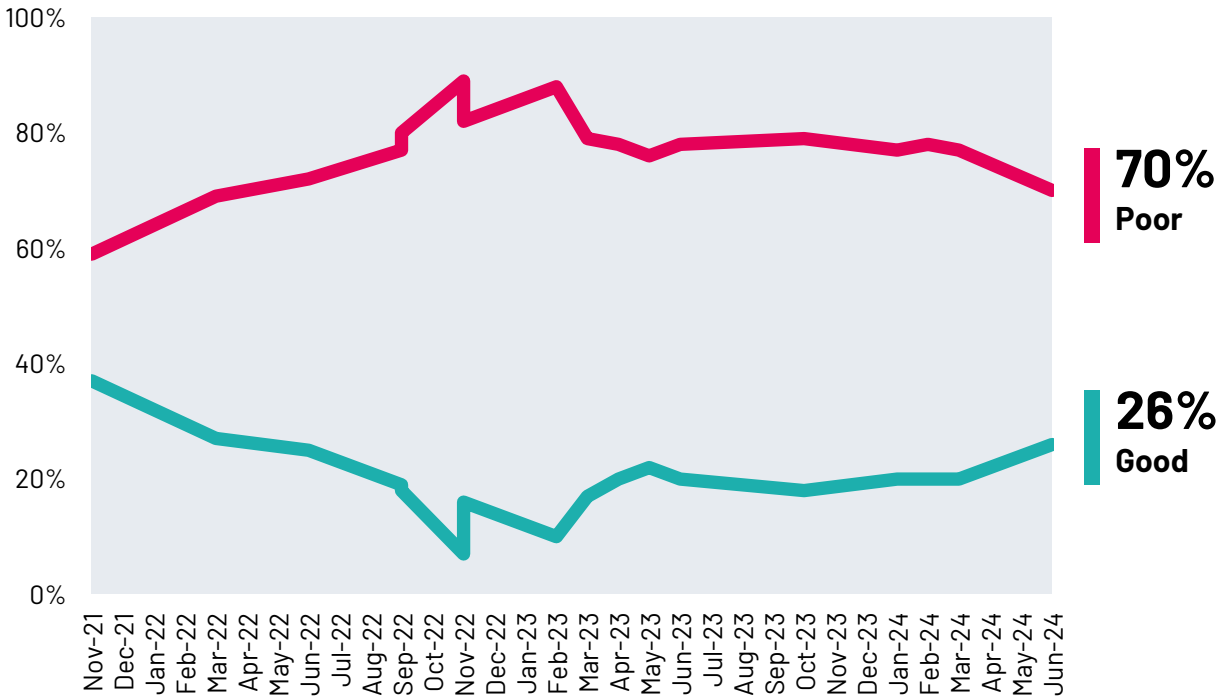
How would you describe the current state of the British economy? Would you say it is...?

November 2021 – June 2024



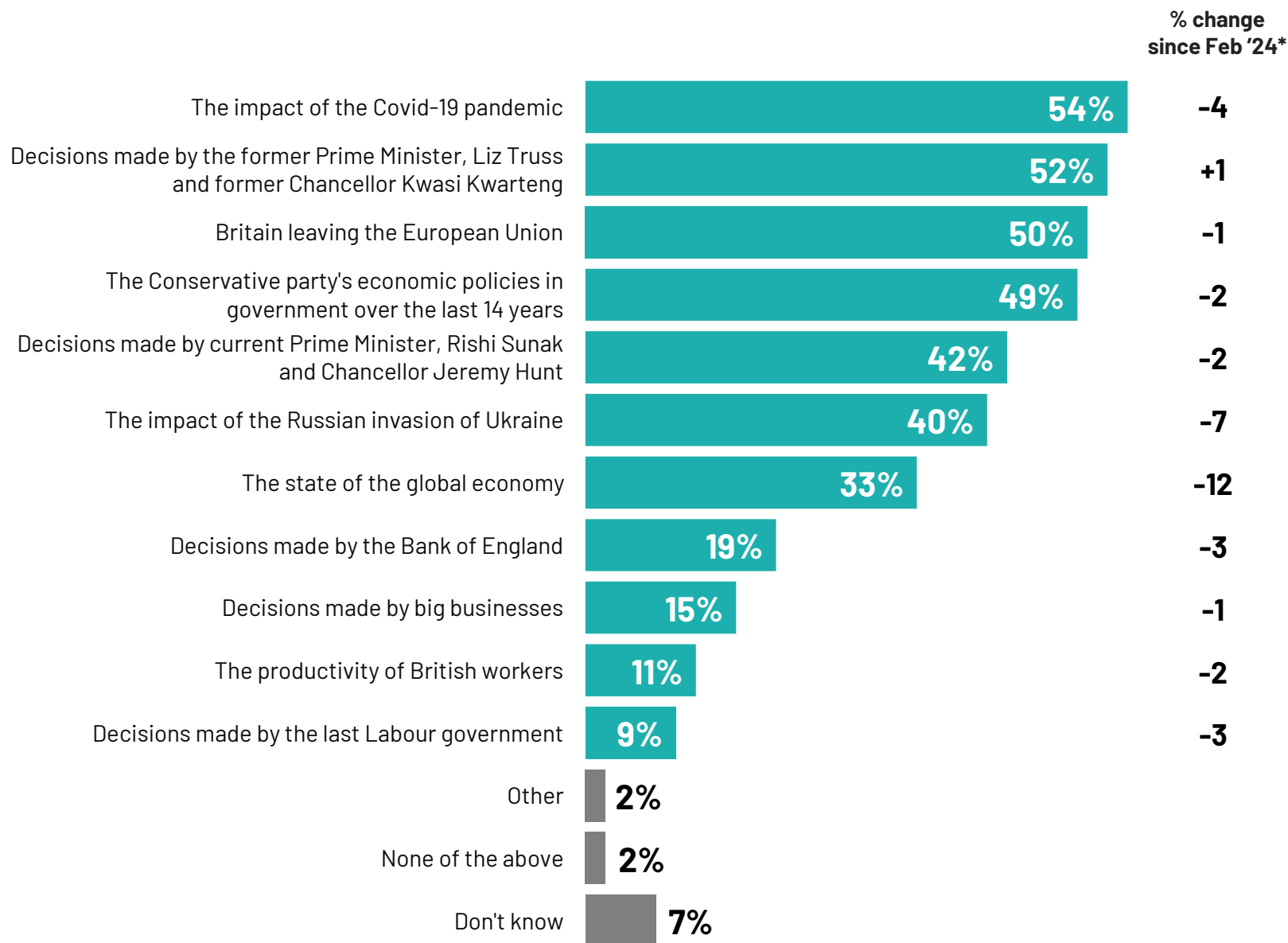
# Those who think the economy is in a poor state are most likely to blame the Covid-19 pandemic and decisions made by Liz Truss and Kwasi Kwarteng

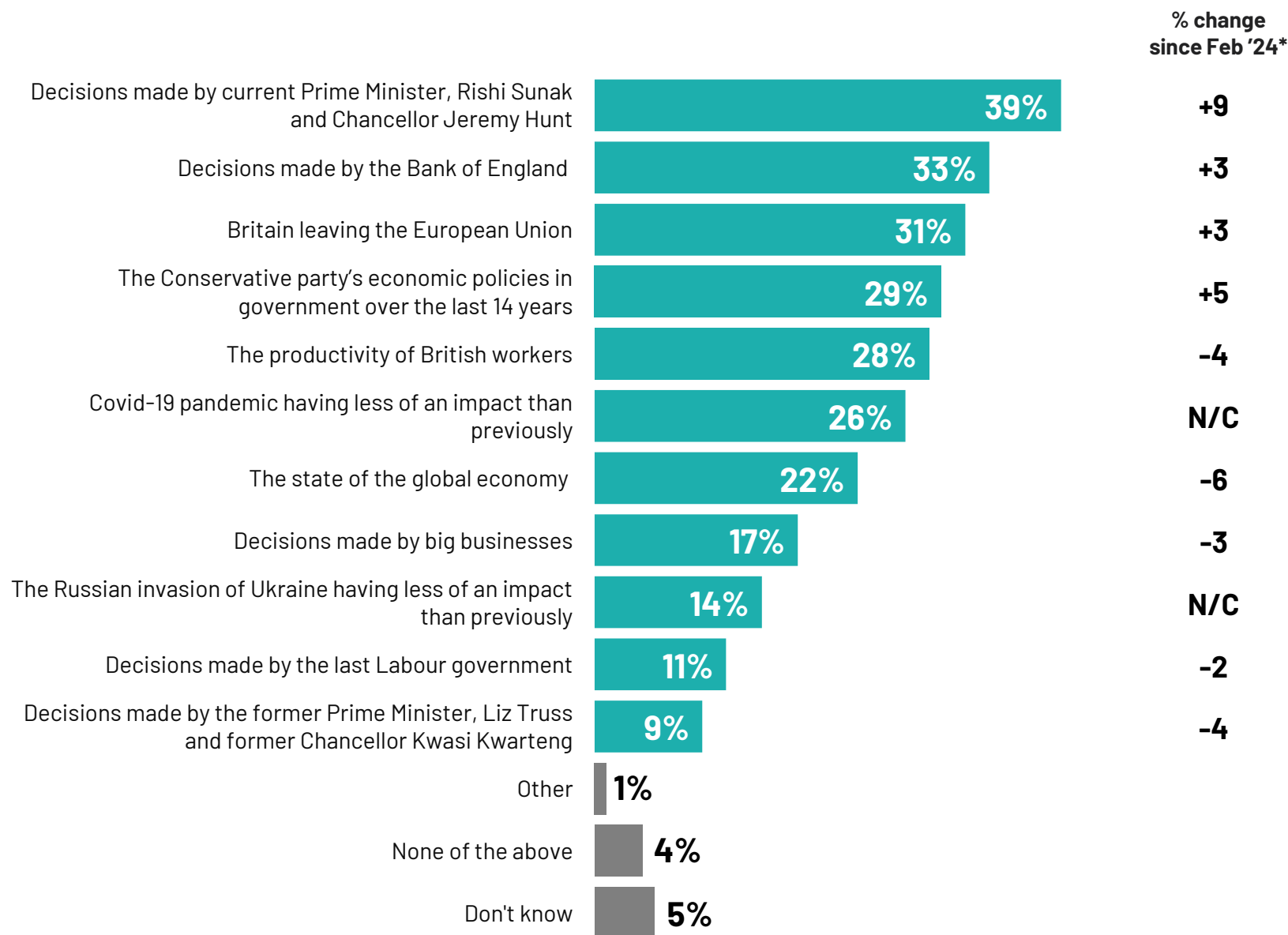
# Two fifths of those who think the economy is in a good state think it is due to decisions made by Rishi Sunak and Jeremy Hunt
