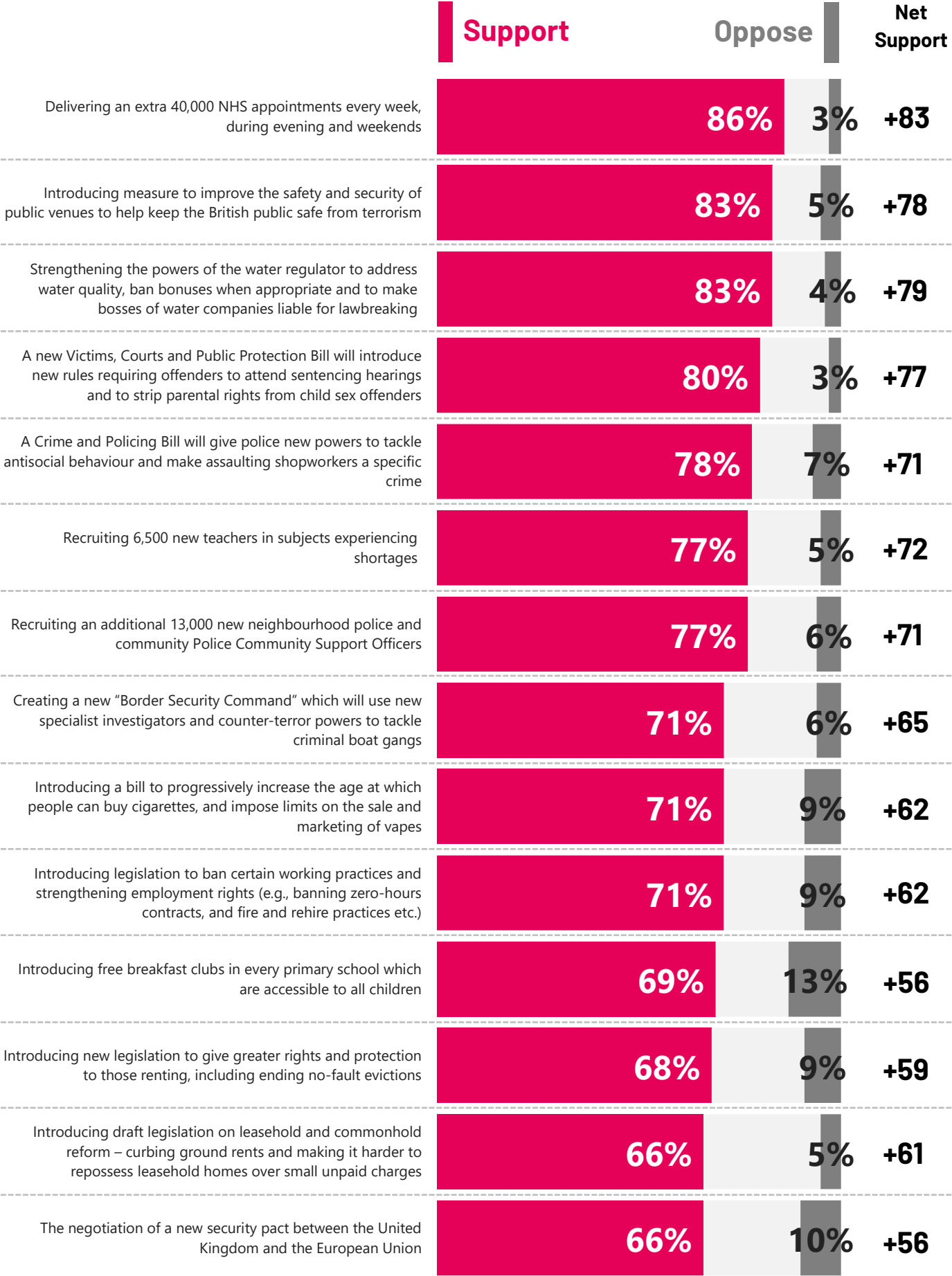


# What do the public think of the policies in the King’s Speech and Labour Party’s manifesto?

From what you’ve seen or heard, to what extent, if either, do you support or oppose the following policies?



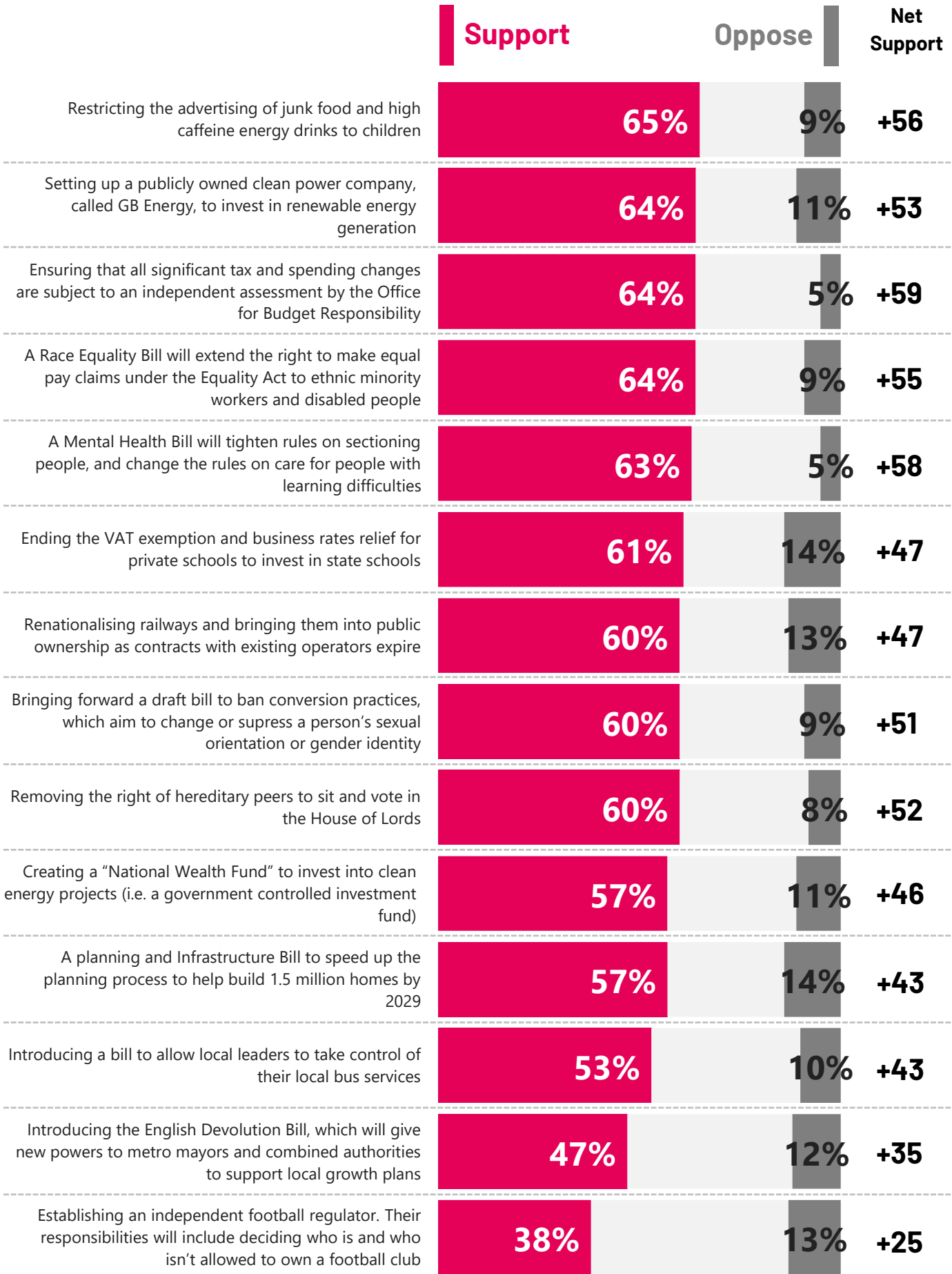
