

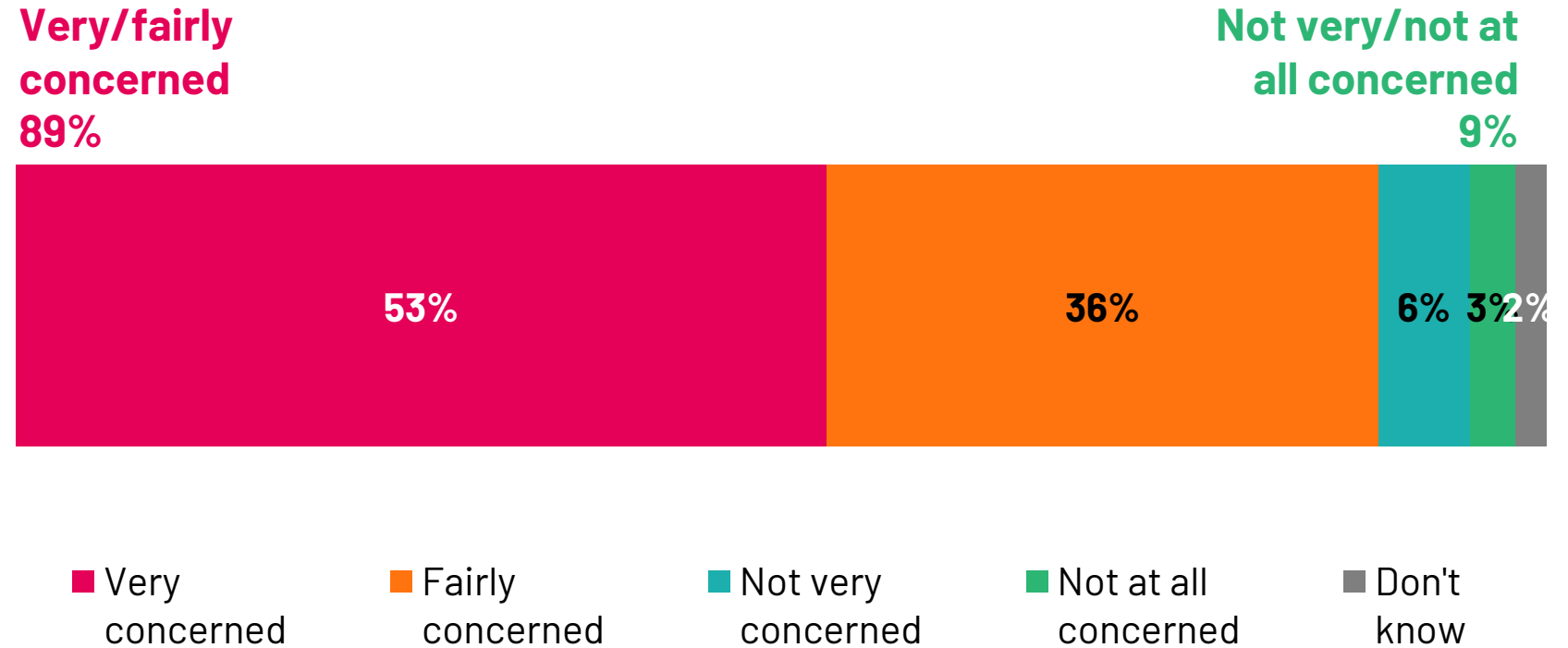

Q. How concerned are you, if at all, about the pressure that NHS services are under at the moment?

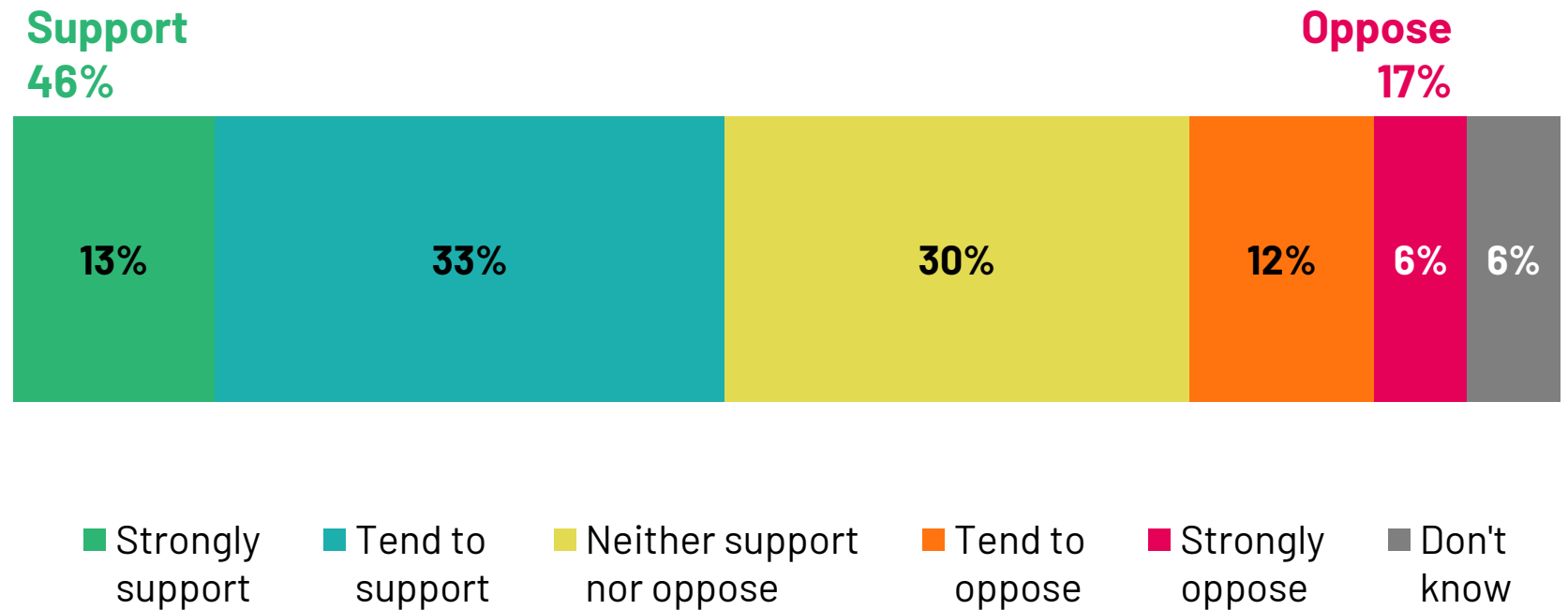

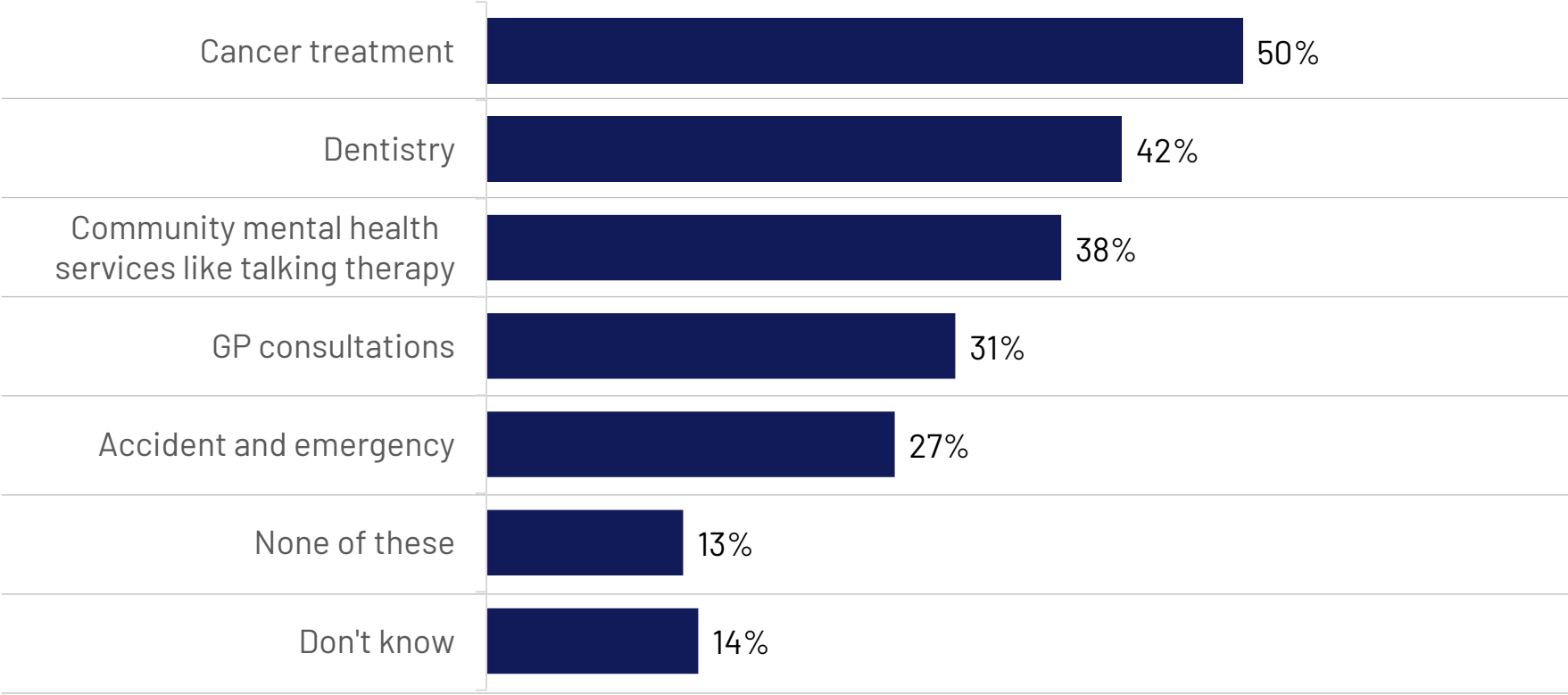

Q. Which of the following types of health services, if any, would you support the NHS using private companies to provide?

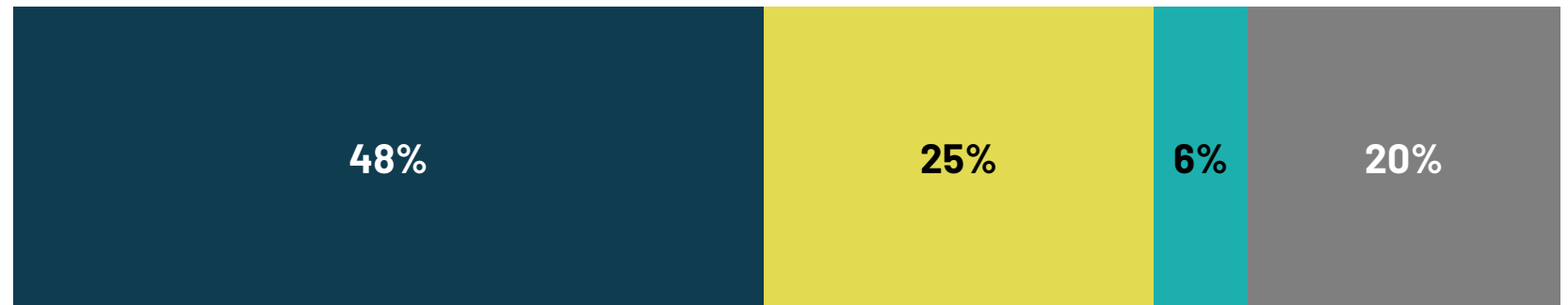
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Whether and how NHS use of private companies has changed in last 5 years
