


Around 7 in 10 say they have used NHS resources responsibly due to concerns around the state of the NHS

Have you done any of the following in the last year, specifically because of concern about the state of the NHS?



And how likely or unlikely are you to do each of the following in the future, specifically because of concern about the state of the NHS?










Around two thirds agree with Wes Streeting's statement that the NHS is broken

To what extent do you agree or disagree with Mr Streeting's statement, 'the NHS is broken'



Around half say that they are more worried about the problems facing the NHS, and that Labour won't be able to fix them, due to Wes Streeting's statement
