


Around half of Britons believe pensioners, farmers, small businesses, working people and people like them are treated worse than they should be by the British government.

Based on what you've seen or heard, how well or badly do you think each of the following groups are treated by the British government?





Based on what you've seen or heard, how well or badly do you think each of the following groups are treated by the media?





Based on what you've seen or heard, how well or badly do you think each of the following groups are treated by the British public?






More than half of the public would support Farmers if they decided to strike, in line with support shown for Nurses and Ambulance workers.














