

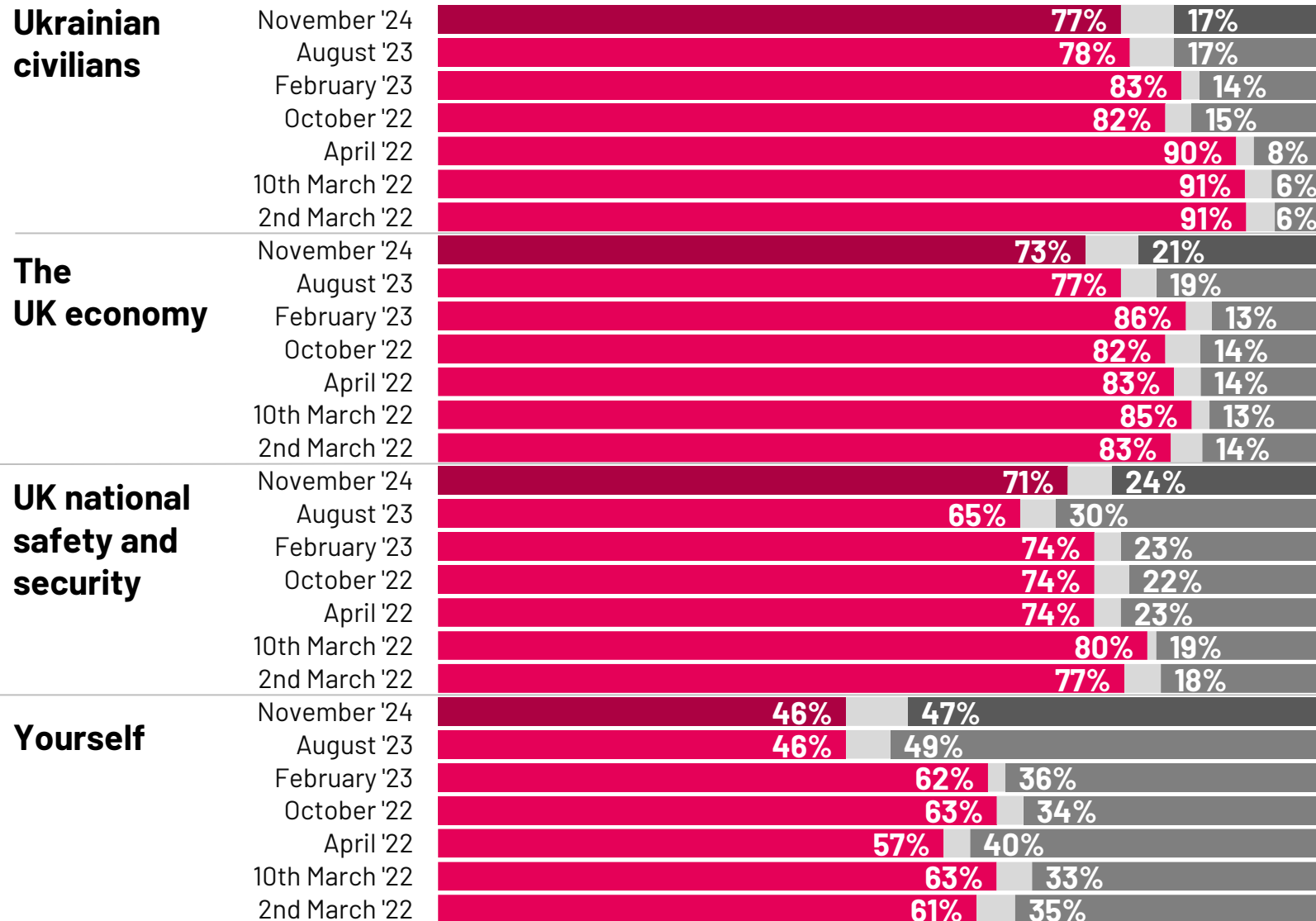

7 in 10 or more Britons are concerned about the impact of the Russian invasion of Ukraine, on Ukrainian civilians, the UK economy and UK national security

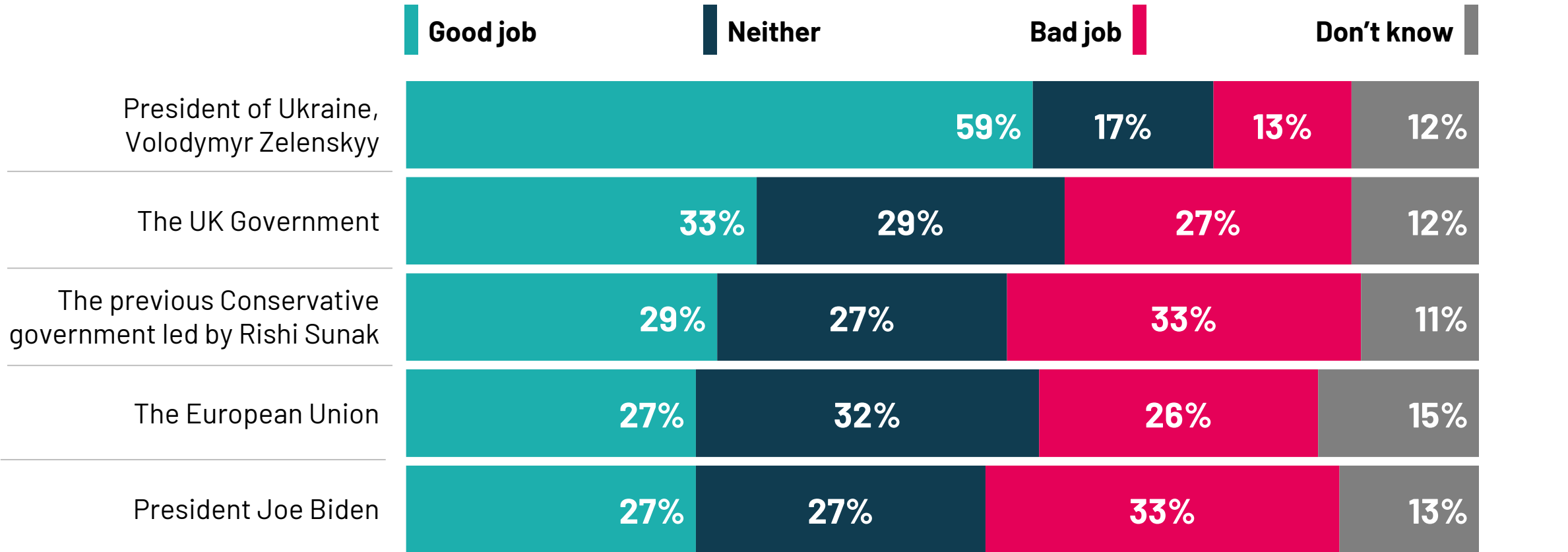
To what extent, if at all, would you say you are concerned about the impact of the Russian invasion of Ukraine on...

To what extent, if at all, do you think each of the following has done a good or bad job handling the Russian invasion of Ukraine?

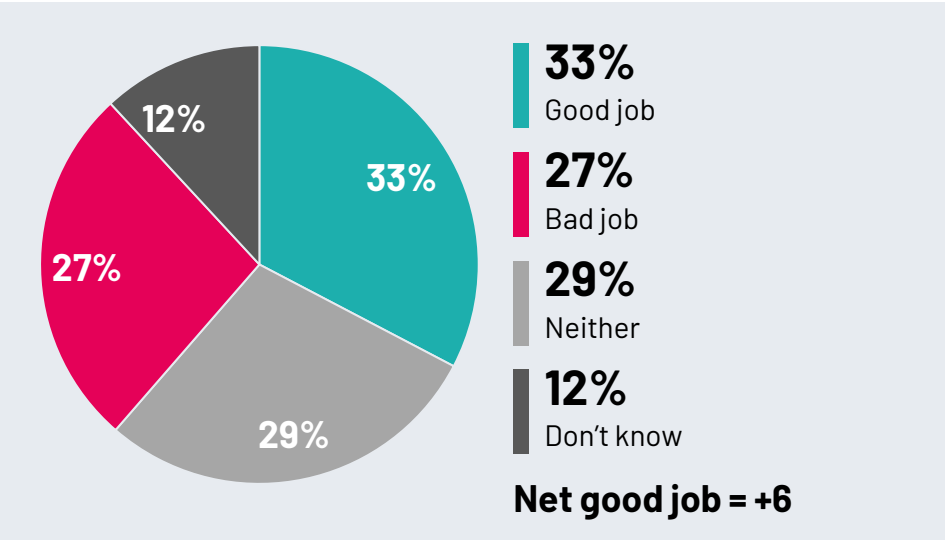

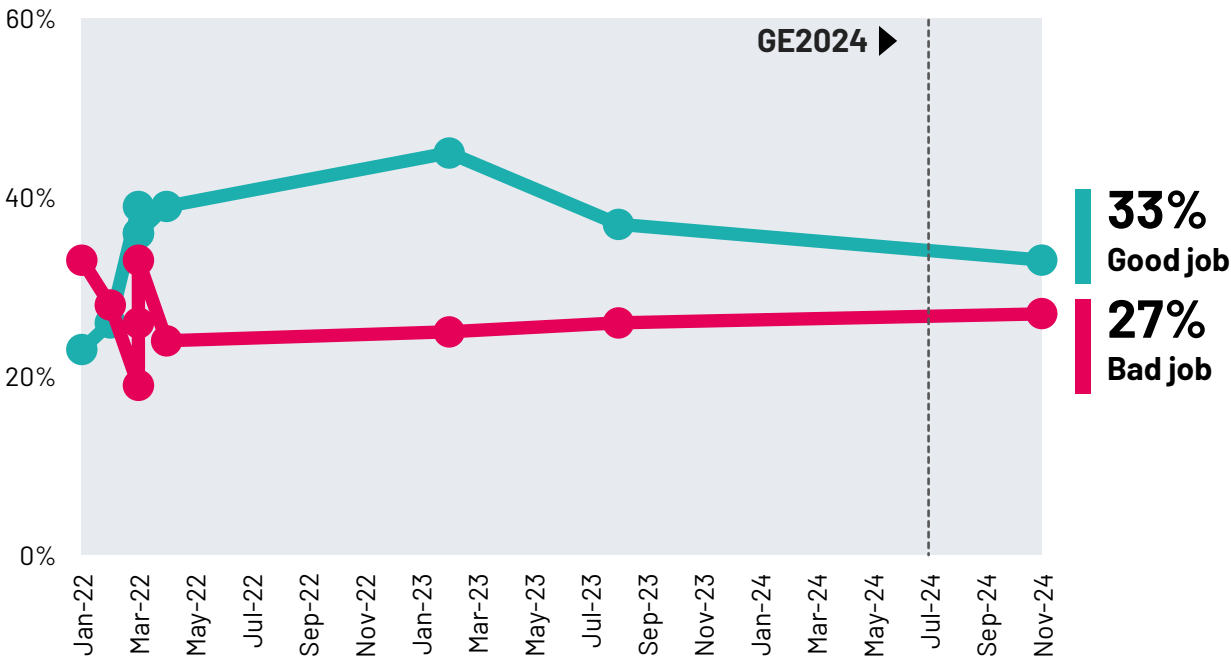

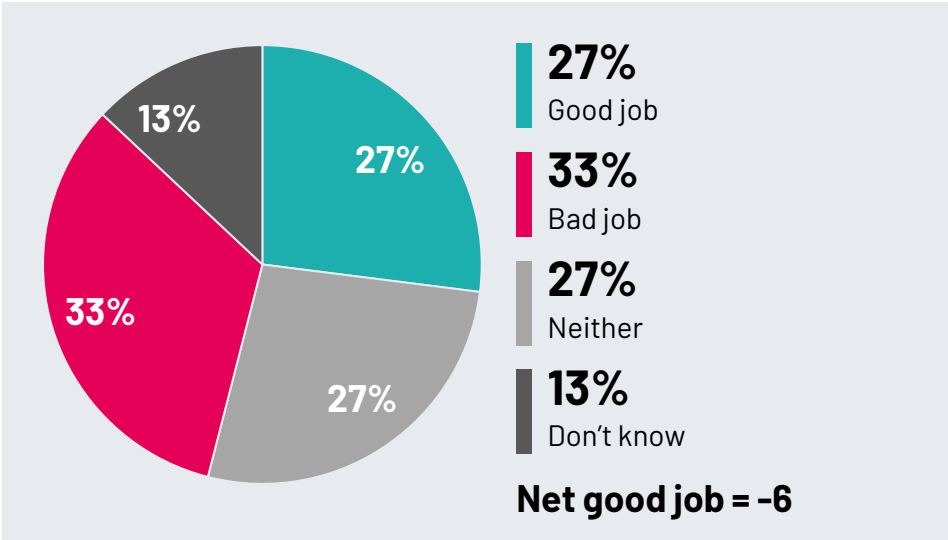

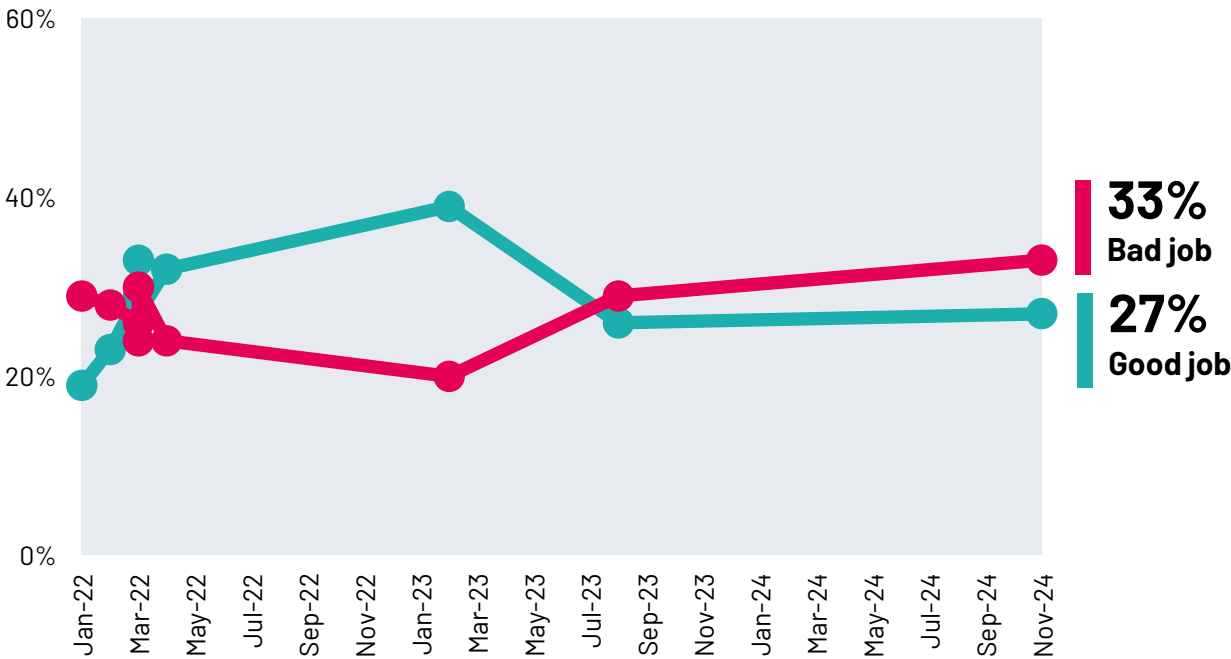

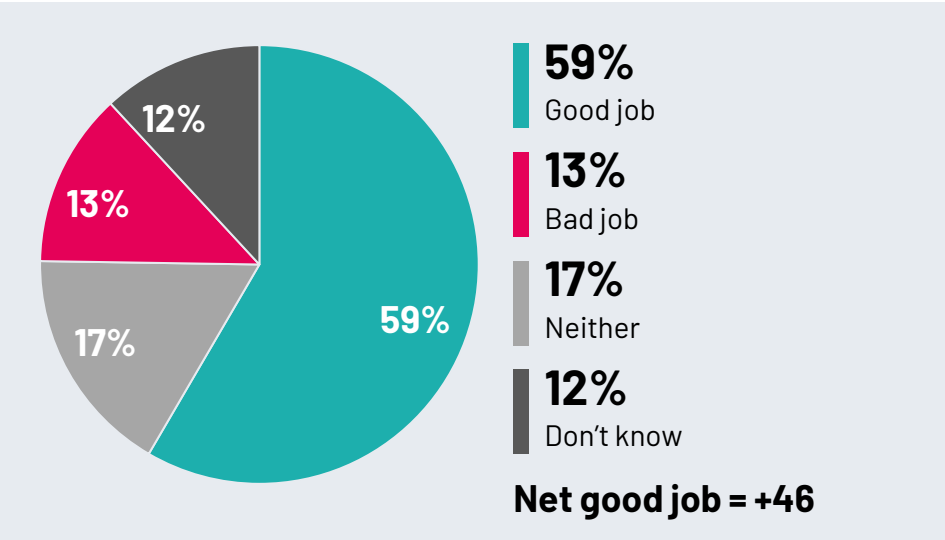

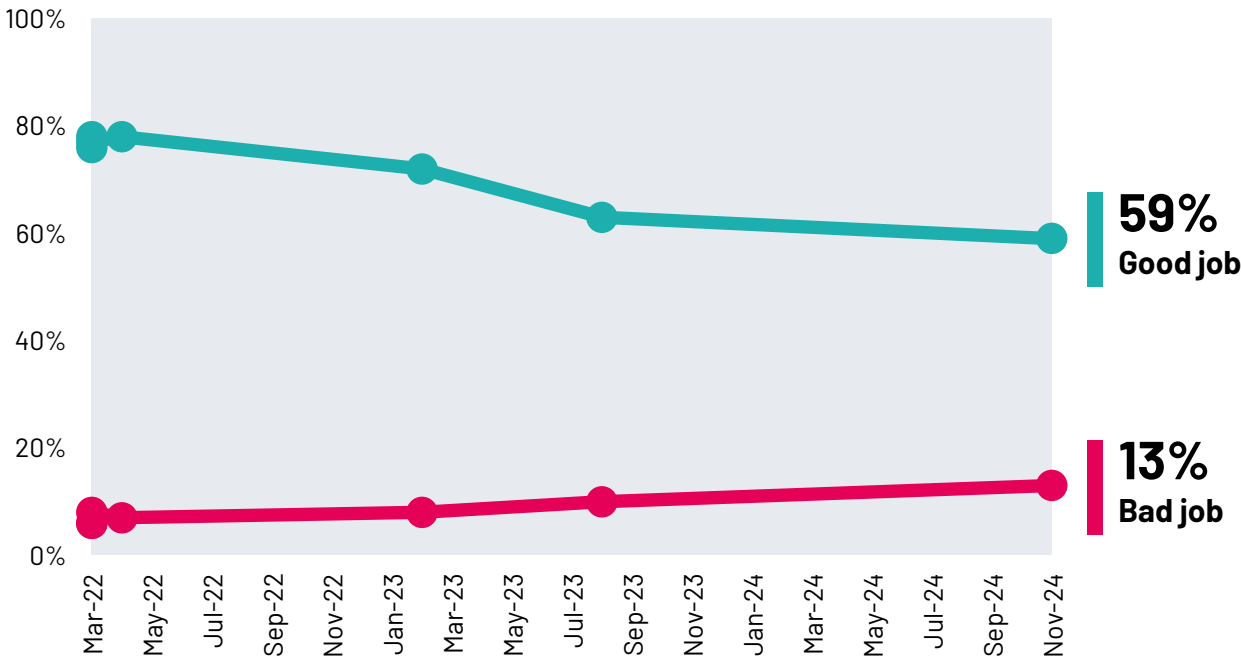
To what extent, if at all, do you think each of the following has done a good or bad job handling the Russian invasion of Ukraine?* Volodymyr Zelenskyy

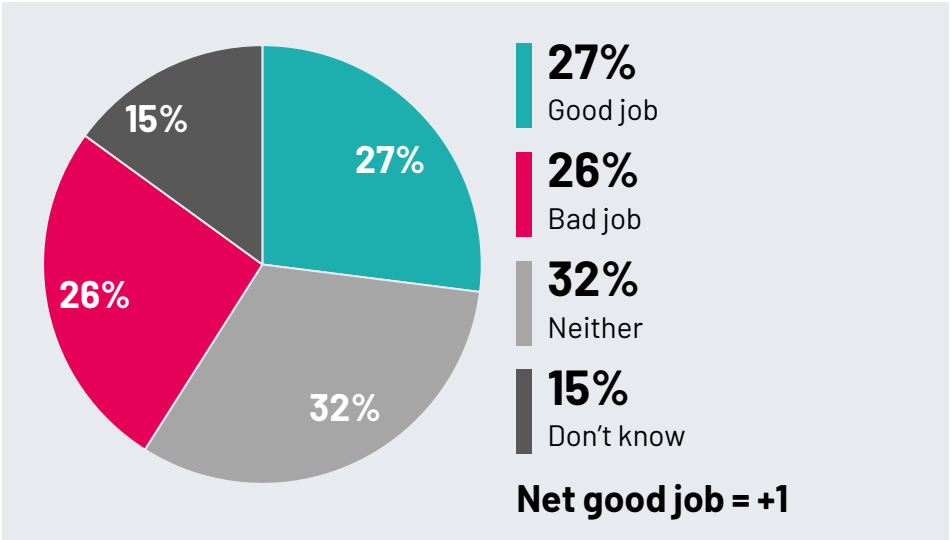

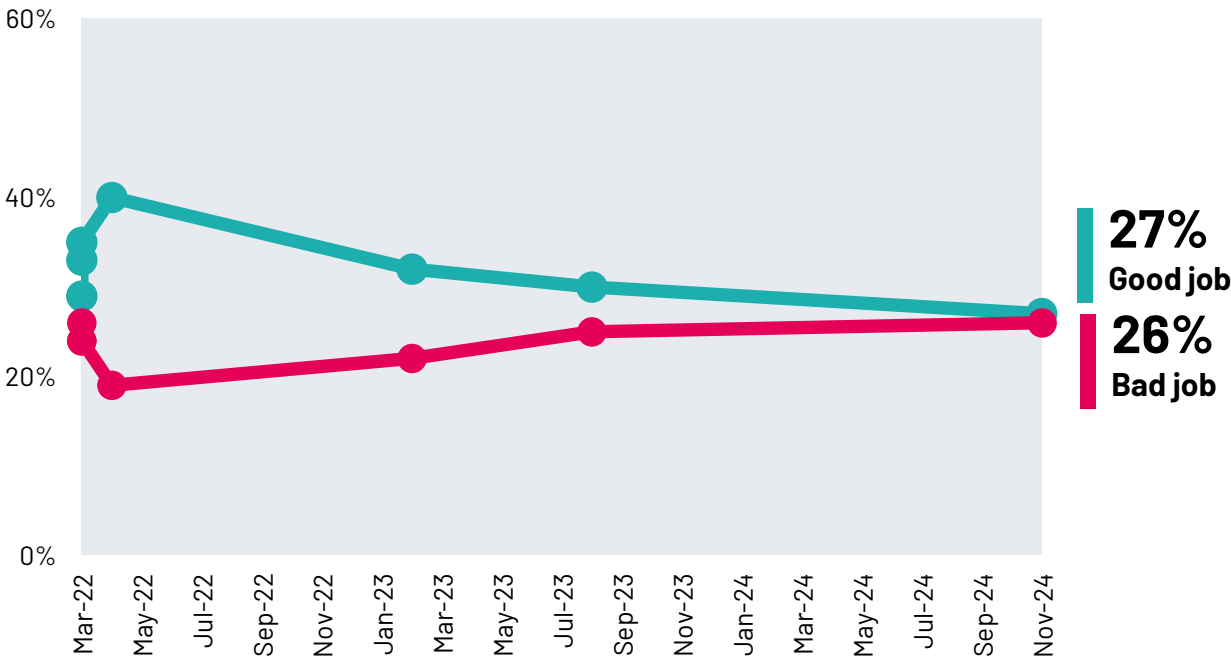

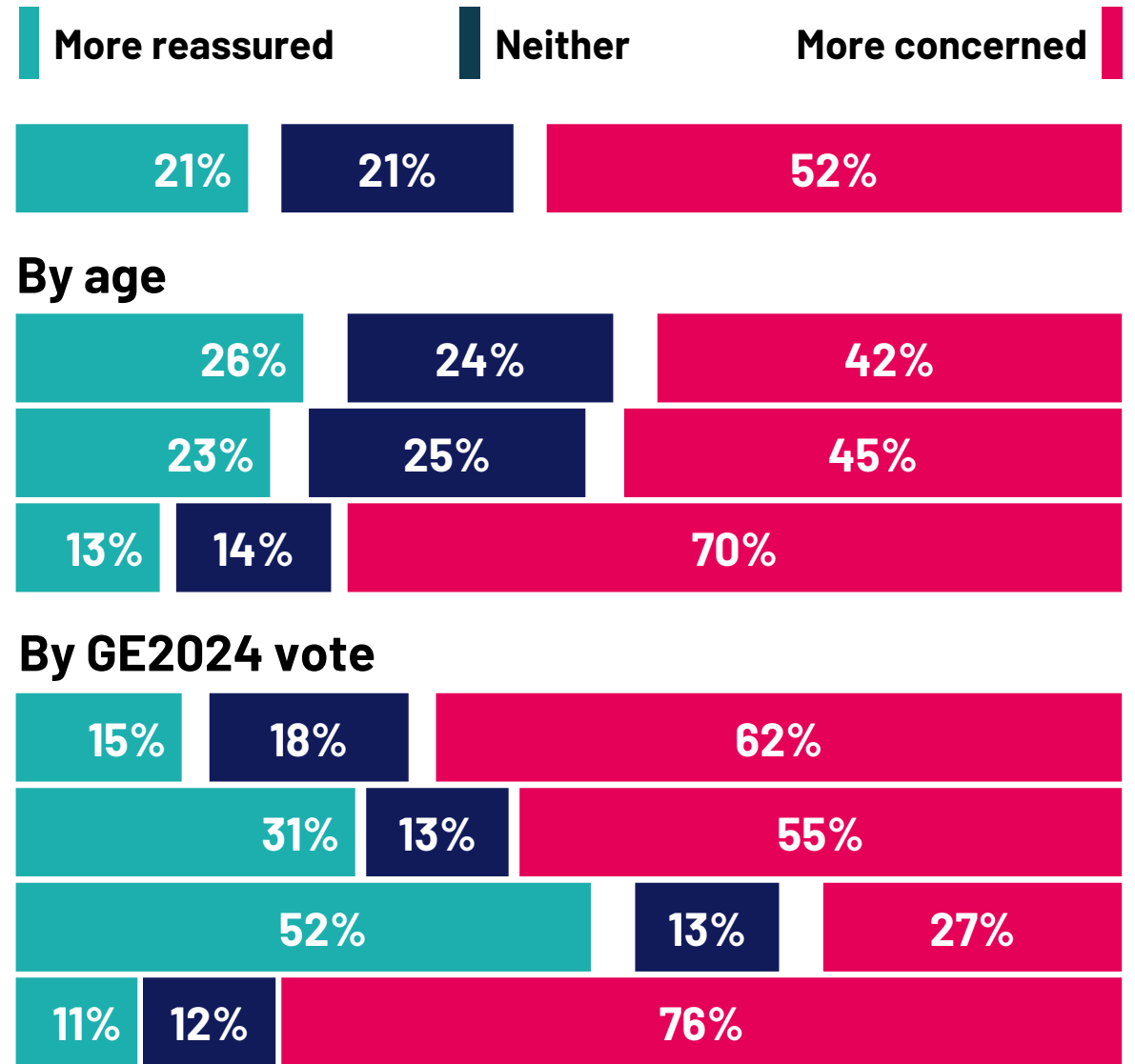

Half of Brits feel more concerned about the situation in Ukraine following Donald Trump's election as the next President of the United States

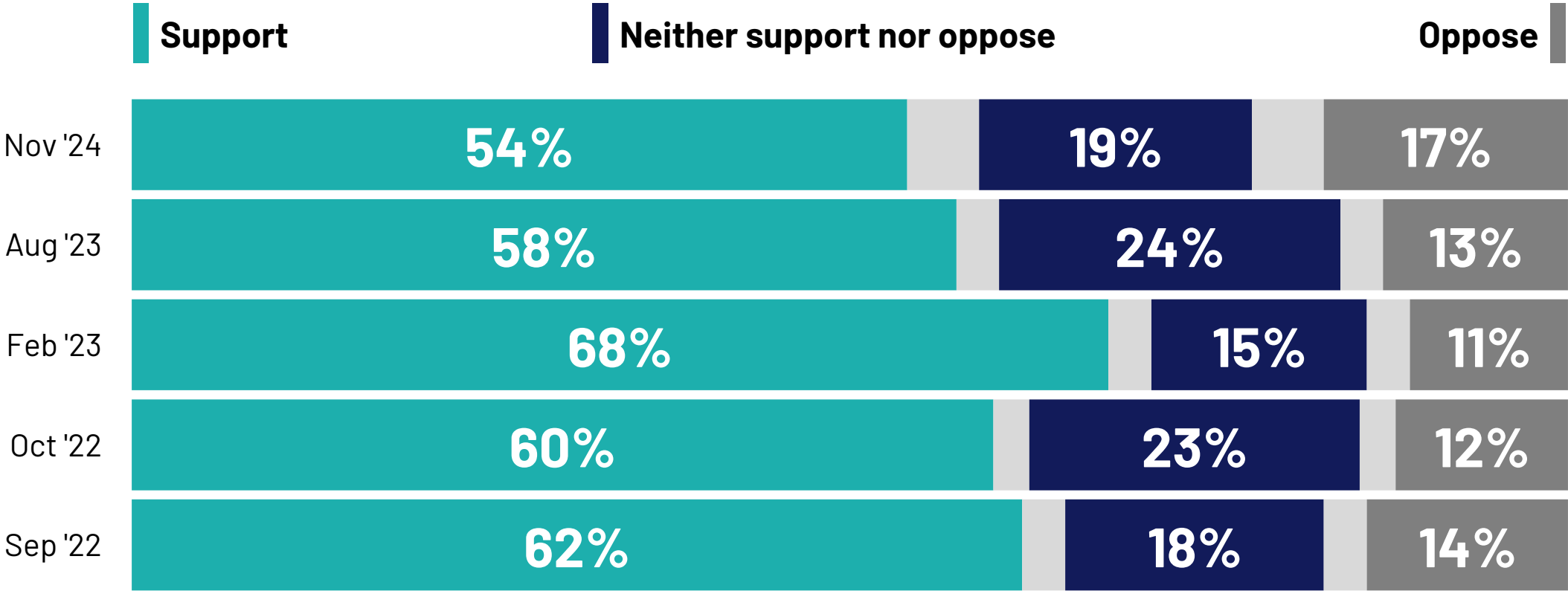
As you may know, Donald Trump has been elected as the next President of the United States of America. Does this make you more reassured or more concerned about the situation in Ukraine?

Just over half of the public support Britain's current role in the Ukraine conflict

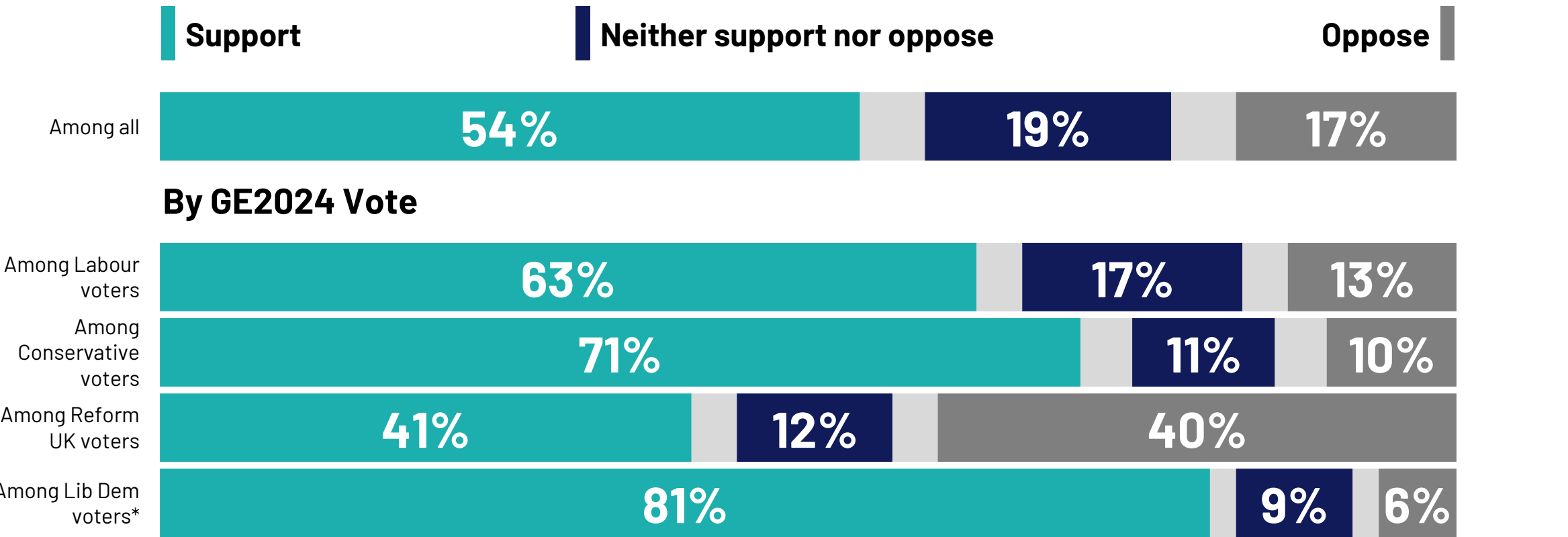

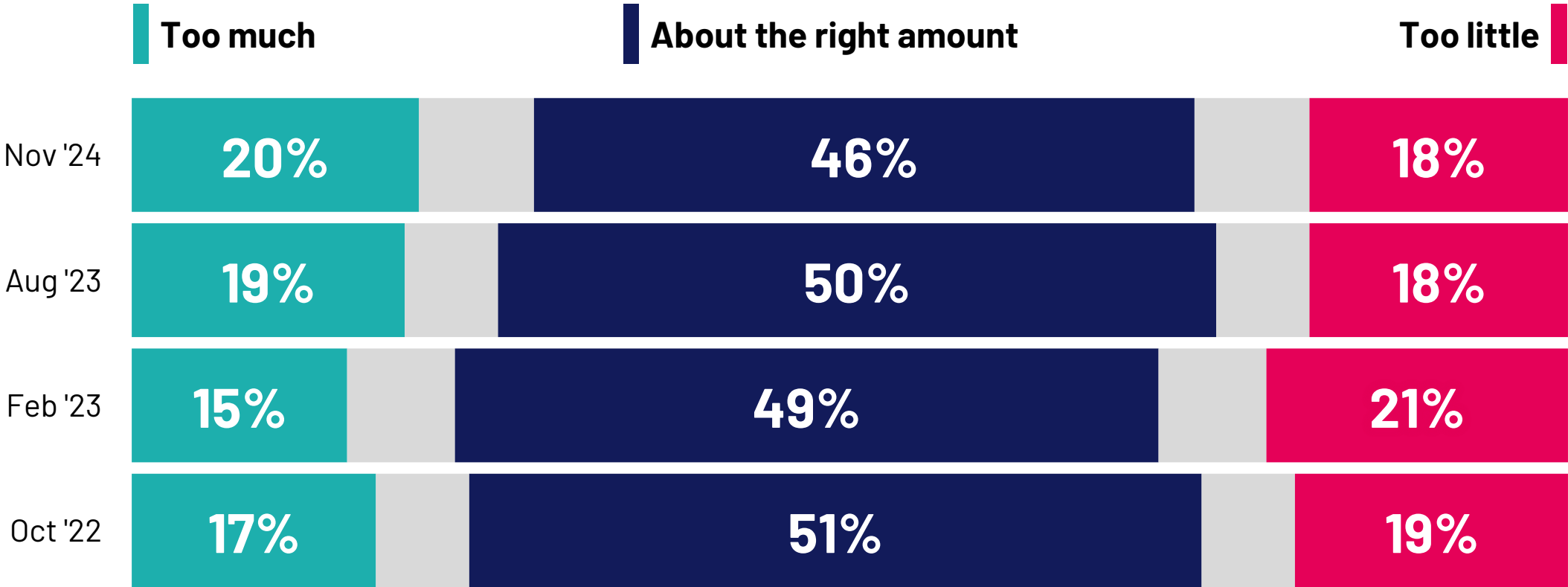

And taking everything into account, do you think the UK has provided too much, too little, or about the right amount of support to Ukraine?

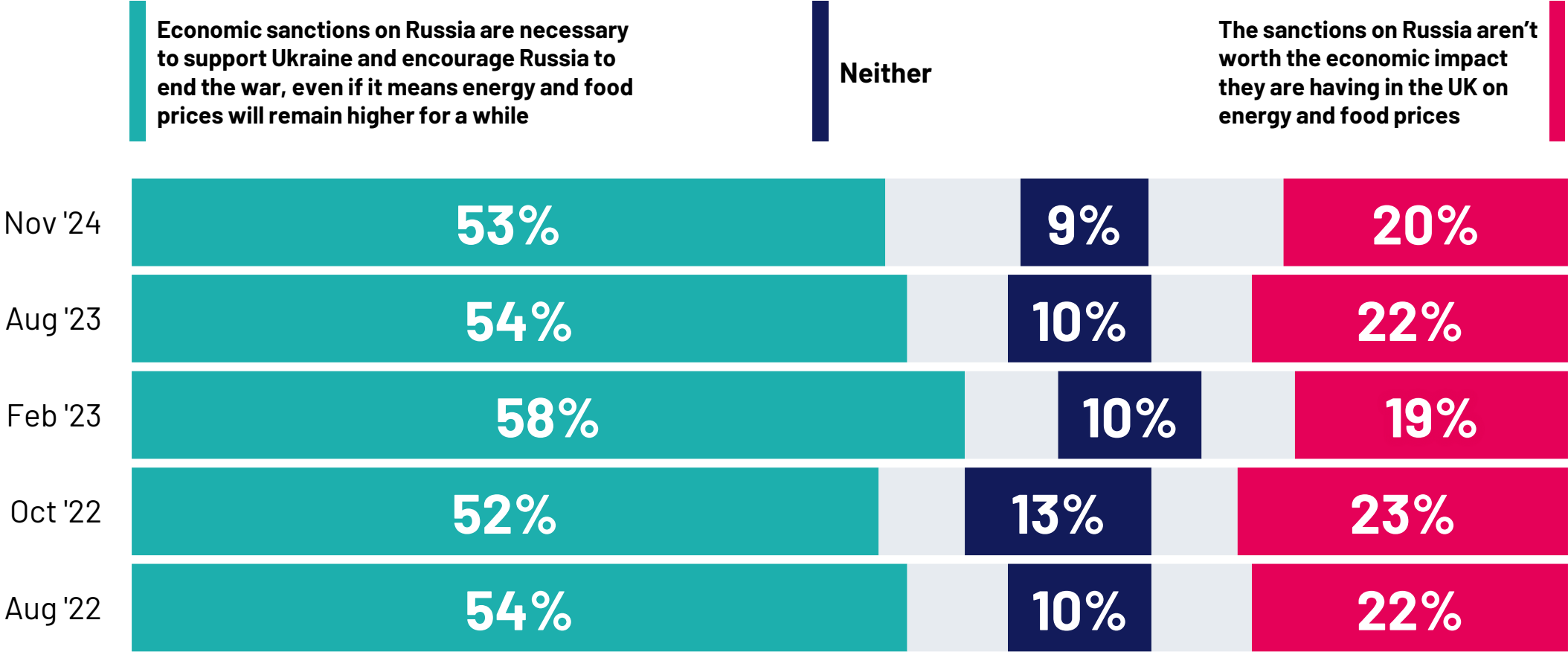

Half of Britons continue to think economic sanctions on Russia are necessary, even if it means energy and food prices remain higher

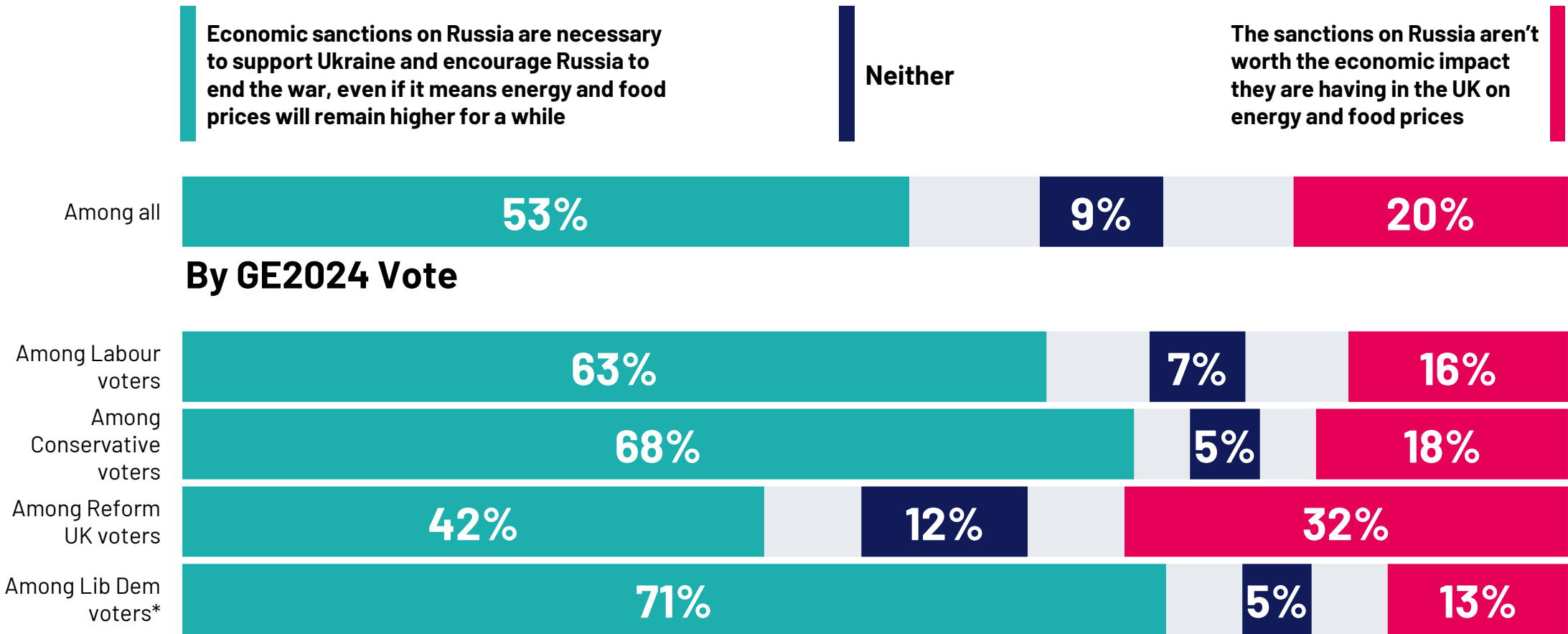
All in all, which of the following two opinions is closest to how you feel?
