




How happy are Indians today?

There continues to be an improvement in the trend in this quarter, though at 69%, it is still below the mark seen in the same month last year (75%).








Overall Happiness by GENDER

Both younger age groups (18-30 y.o & 31-45y.o) show good while the older age group declines once again.





Both the groups show correction and the higher education group though recovered, is still lower than last year levels.






Overall Happiness by TOWN CLASS








How happy are Indians on PERSONAL dimensions of life?

In the recent waves, *Personal aspects* & *Health* mostly displayed a steadily positive outlook throughout the one aspect that was **most adversely affected was the Economic stability/Financial condition** aspect. This aspect finally continues to show recovery in the recent wave and so does health.





Social aspects show some correction, especially on the Neighbours aspect, though levels are still lower than previous year.





Happiness with the political dimensions continue to hold steady in the present wave.





And work and job related dimensions also show an uptick in the present wave.







About Ipsos India happiness monitor

The Ipsos India Happiness monitor is a monthly survey that runs on **Ipsos IndiaBus**.

It captures how happy Indians are on a **10-point Happiness scale**, on the following parameters:

- Overall Happiness
- Personal parameters Family, Health & Personal Finances
- Social parameters Friend Circle, Neighbours
- Employment related Work & Colleagues (among those employed)
- Political parameters Situation of the country and Situation of the World



About Ipsos IndiaBus

Ipsos IndiaBus, conducted by **Ipsos India**, is a monthly pan India omnibus that carries multiple client surveys. It uses a structured questionnaire on diverse topics administered among 2200+ adult individuals of both genders

from SEC A, B and C households across all four zones. The survey is conducted in metros, Tier 1, Tier 2 and Tier 3 towns, providing a more robust and representative view of urban Indians.





Survey design & methodology

Methodology:

The respondents were polled face to face and online. A city-level quota is maintained for each demographic segments to ensure the waves are identical and free of additional sampling error. The data is weighted by demographics and city-class population to arrive at national average.

Frequency:

The data collection is done in every month and the results are calculated on two-months rolling sample.

Instrument used:

A structured questionnaire to gauge overall happiness and happiness with respect to other diverse aspects listed earlier, captured on a 10-point scale ranging from very unhappy (1) to very happy (10)

Question administered:

O. Considering all aspects of your life, how happy do you feel today? Please reply with this 10-point scale where 10 means very happy and 1 means very unhappy. How happy are you with your _____? (10 pt scale; 10: Very happy 1: Very unhappy)
