

This study had no external sponsors or partners. It was initiated and run by Ipsos with the intention to share our understanding about the world we live in and how citizens around the globe think & feel about their world.








~8 in 10 Pakistanis have experienced smog over the last month, while in Lahore & Multan almost everyone experienced it.



Q: Over the past month, how often have you experienced smog where you live?


Breakdown of those who experienced at-least once in a month




Q: To what extent has smog affected or not affected any of the following

### Punjab is worst hit by smog in provinces; Lahore & Rawalpindi affected most



# BELIEFS AND PERCEPTIONS





For Pakistanis vehicle emissions (70%), industrial smoke (63%) and waste burning (37%) are top three reasons for smog followed by brick kilns (31%) and crop remains' burning (30%), while  $\sim$ 1 in 5 believe it as wrath of Allah.

Pakistanis see lack of public cooperation (44%) and enforcement of rules (37%) as major barriers in combating smog and air pollution, highlights the lack of fulfilment of responsibilities by citizens.



Q: What are the main reasons why this problem is not being resolved?




## ACTIONS AND BEHAVIORS






# ~8 out of 10 Pakistanis agree that they themselves need to play their part in combating smog with varying conditionalities.



Q. To what extent do you agree with the following statements:



Males, the elderly, and highly educated Pakistanis are more willing to cooperate in the fight against smog, indicating that those who are more informed about smog's origins are also more likely to take responsibility in addressing it



Awareness, Perception and a whet extent do you agree with the following statements:

48% Pakistanis are personally ready to switch to walking, public transport (31%), bicycles (29%) and new/hybrid electric vehicles to reduce smog.




48% Walking to small distances instead of using a vehicle




Q: Which of the above actions are you personally willing to take?


To what extent would you cooperate or not cooperate with the government, give you a notice to get your vehicle repaired from a workshop and get a certificate issued?

To what extent are you willing or not willing to get your vehicle tested in a certified workshop annually before the motor vehicle tax renewal is done annually?






