

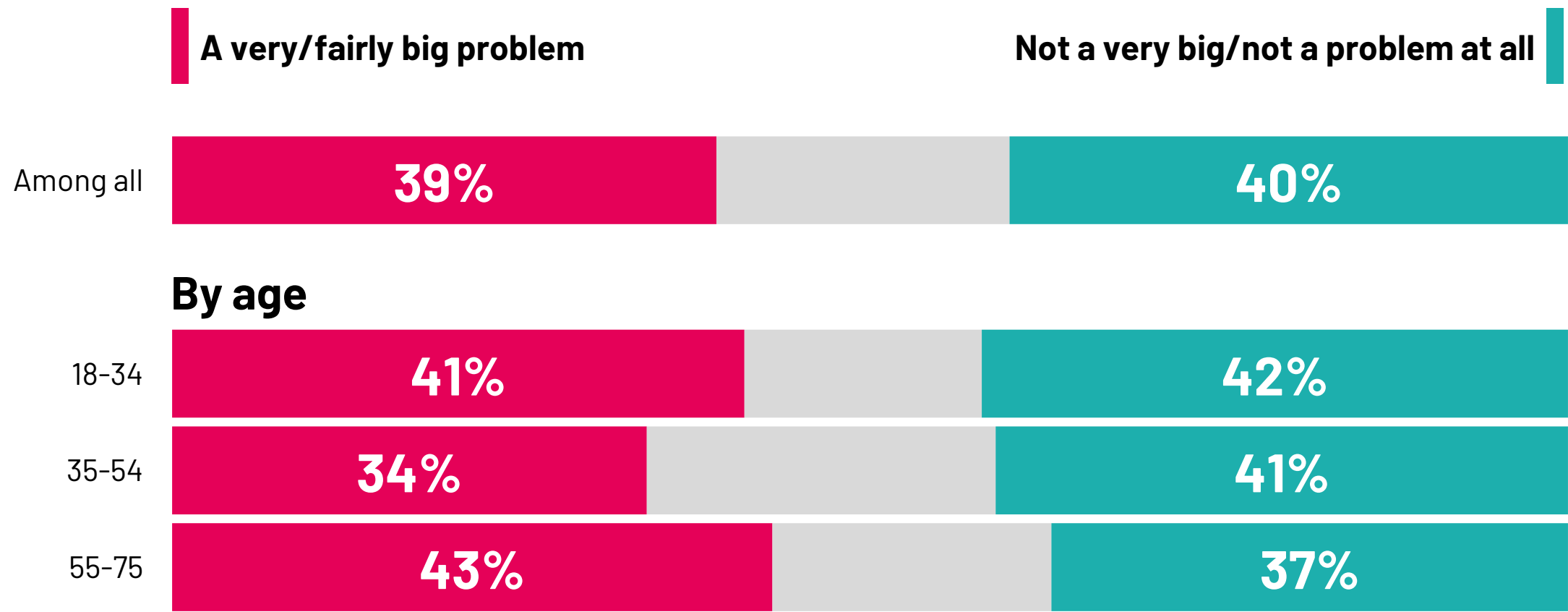

# The public are divided as to whether antisemitism is a problem in the UK, with 2 in 5 each thinking it is and isn't

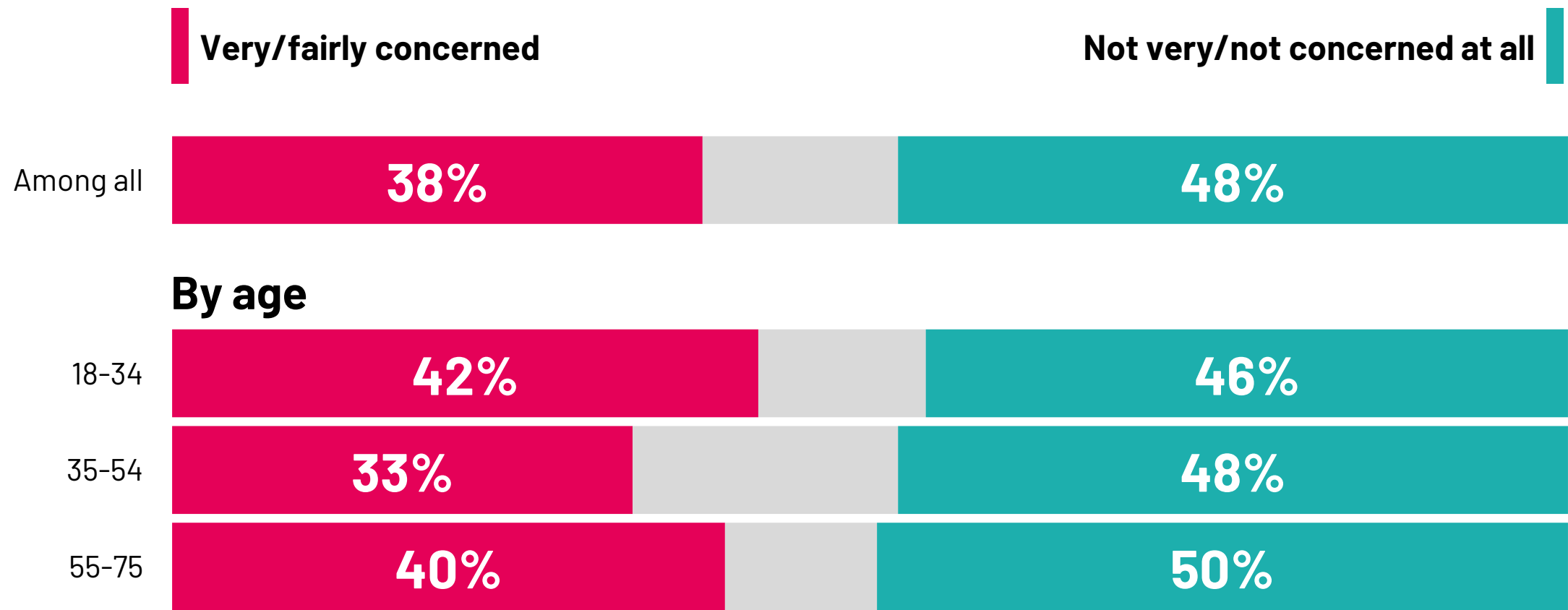
How much of a problem, if at all, do you think antisemitism (defined as anti-Jewish racism) is in the UK?

# 4 in 10 worry about antisemitism in the UK – but half aren’t very concerned

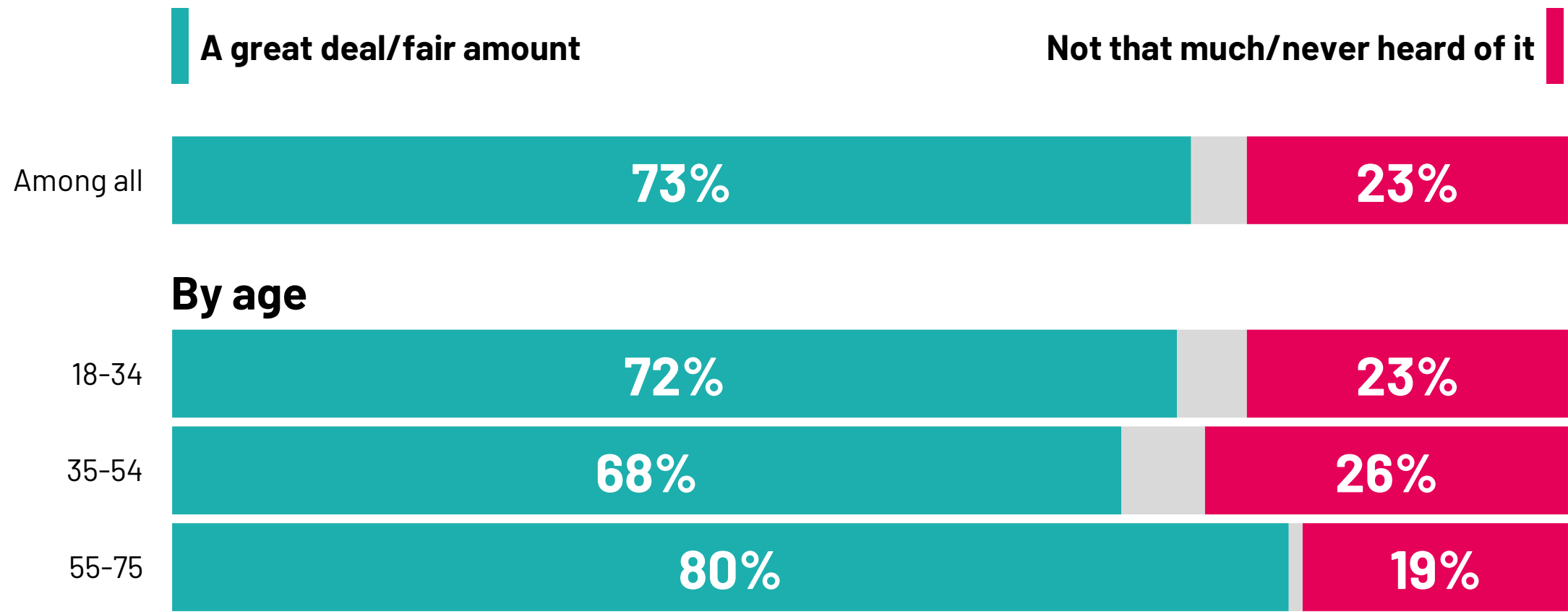
How concerned, if at all, are you about antisemitism in the UK?

# The majority of Britons consider themselves to know at least a fair amount about the Holocaust

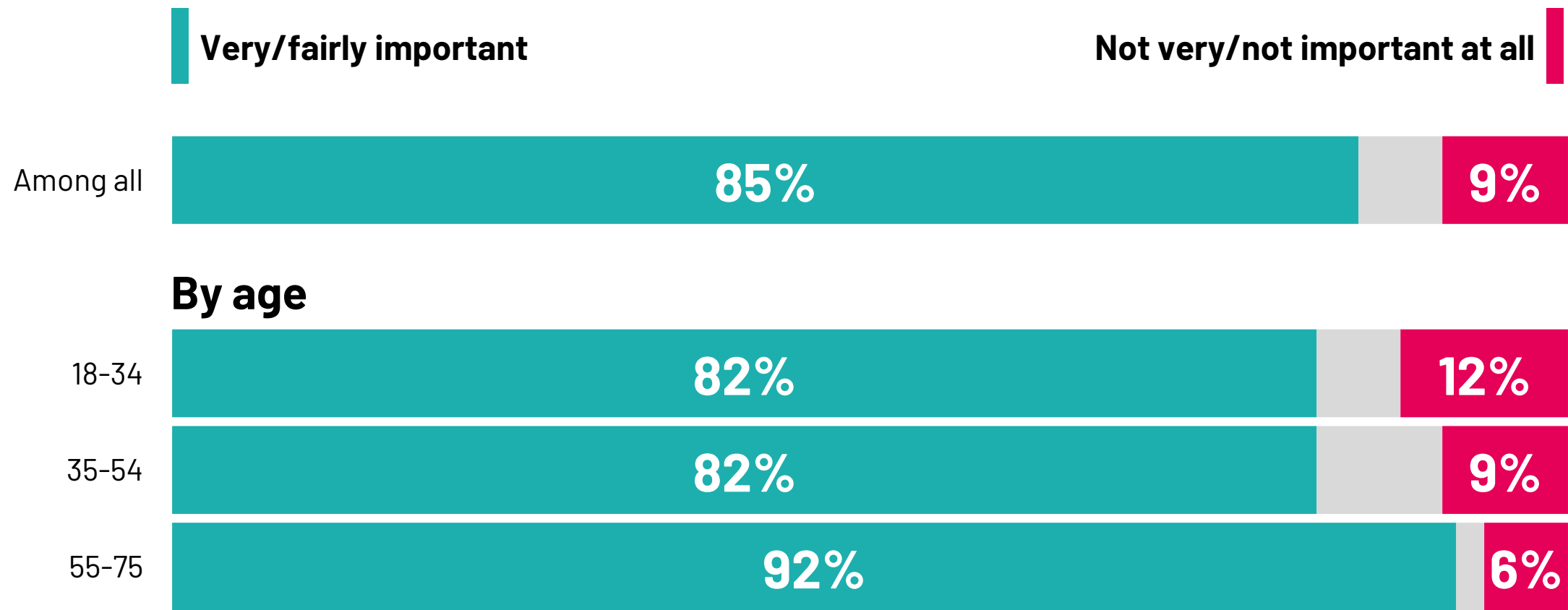
How much, if anything, do you know about the Holocaust?

# More than 4 in 5 think it's important that the Holocaust is discussed in the present day

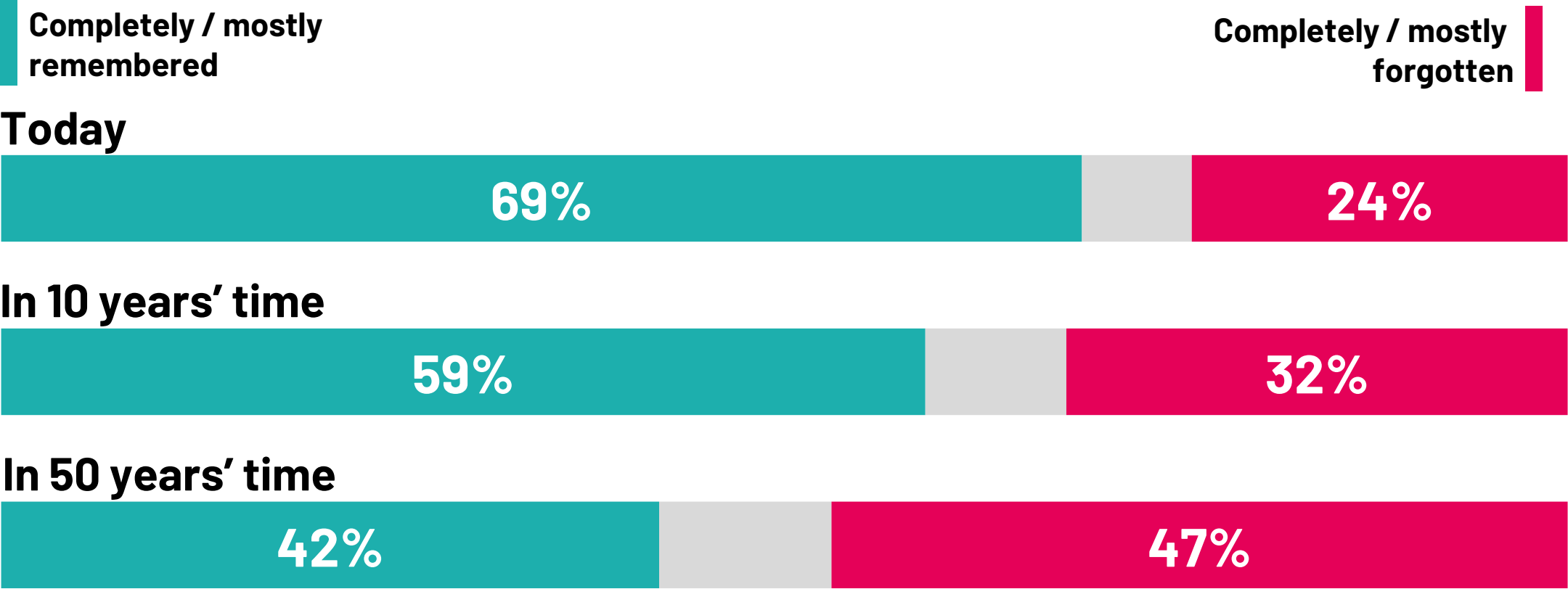
How important, if at all, do you think it is that the Holocaust is discussed in the present day?

# While 7 in 10 think the lessons of the Holocaust are largely remembered today, nearly half think they will be forgotten in 50 years' time

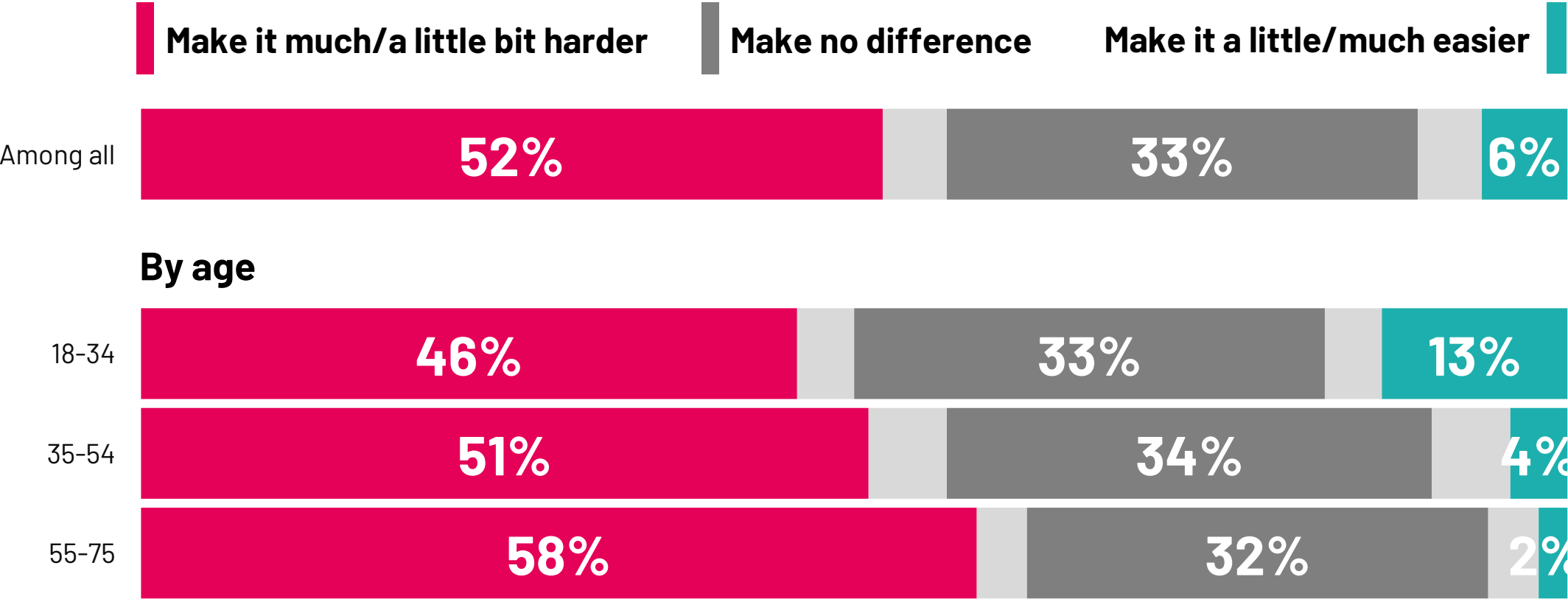
To what extent, if at all, do you think that the lessons of the Holocaust have / will be forgotten...?

# Half of Britons think the passing of Holocaust survivors will make it harder to educate young people in the future about the Holocaust

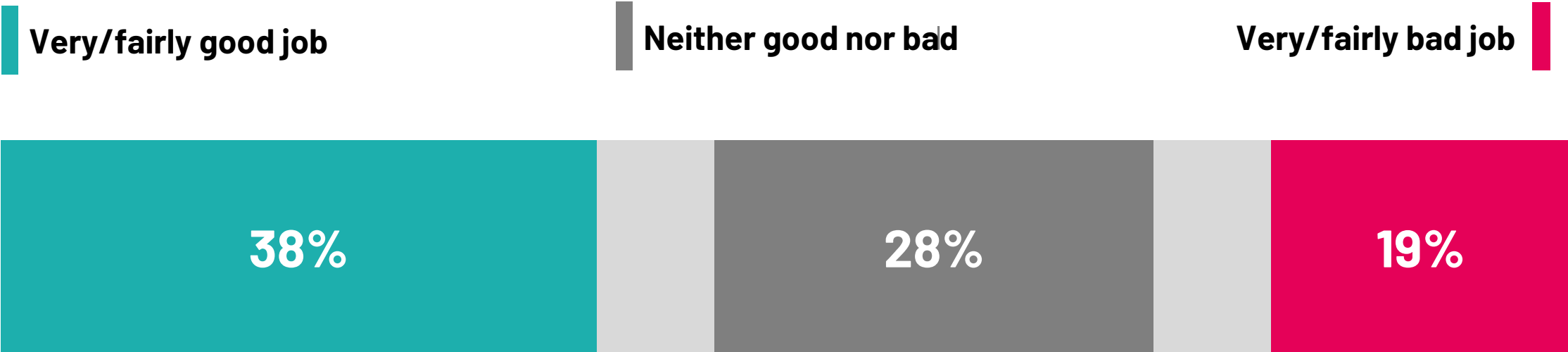
A time will come when there are no remaining survivors of the Holocaust. What impact, if any, do you think this will have on our ability to educate young people in the future about the Holocaust?
