Do you think that the UK’s decision to leave the European Union was the right or wrong decision for the United Kingdom?





Half of Britons think that Brexit has been more of a failure than success


Overall, taking everything into account, do you think that Brexit has been more of a success, more of a failure, or neither?

Half who think Brexit has been a failure say Boris Johnson has contributed most to this


