



How worried, if at all, are you personally about being a victim of crime?






Not all areas of the country experience the same levels of crime. What happens in your local area may, or may not, reflect the national picture. What do you think has happened to crime over the past 12 months?






What do you think has happened to the following types of crime and anti-social behaviour in your local area over the past 12 months?






To what extent, if at all, do you trust the police in this country to do each of the following?




Compared with 12 months ago, would you say you now see a uniformed police presence on foot in the area where you live more often, less often, or about as often?






To what extent are you confident or not confident in the ability of each of the following to tackle violence against women and girls in Britain today?






To what extent, if at all, do you think each of the following are effective at preventing people who have previously committed offenses from offending in the future?






In general, do you think prison sentences are too short, too long, or the right length?
