


Around 7 in 10 Britons say that the availability of dental care on the NHS has decreased over the last five years


Would you say that the availability of dental care on the NHS has increased, decreased, or stayed the same over the last five years?



Half of Britons are not confident that they could afford routine treatment with a private dentist


How confident, if at all, are you that you could afford the cost of...






Around half of Britons have made an appointment with an NHS dentist in the last two years

Have you tried to make an appointment with an NHS dentist in the last two years?



You said that you have had an appointment or treatment with an NHS dentist. Which of the following, if any, have you personally experienced in the last two years?


