


Direction of the country: trend

Generally speaking, do you think things in Scotland are heading in the right direction or wrong direction?












Favourability towards Scottish politicians





Favourability towards UK politicians






Favourability towards Donald Trump and Elon Musk







Keir Starmer: Favourability trend











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

Do you think that the general economic condition of [the UK /Scotland] will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?







Confidence in Government plans for the economy


How confident, if at all, are you that [the Labour Party / the SNP] has a good long-term economic plan for [the UK / Scotland]?

METHODS

- Ipsos interviewed a representative quota sample of 1,025 adults aged 16+ in Scotland.
- Interviews took place online between 21st and 26th February 2025.
- Data has been weighted to the known offline population proportions.
- Where results do not sum to 100%, this may be due to computer rounding, multiple responses, or the exclusion of "don't know" categories.
- All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error.
