


Two in five Britons think it is likely that the UK will receive 'nul points' at the 2025 Eurovision Song Contest


As you may know, the Eurovision Song Contest will take place on the 17th May in Switzerland. How likely or unlikely, if either, do you think each of the following are to happen?






What 3 to 4 words come to mind when thinking about Switzerland?


