

On balance, do you think it would be better or worse for Britain in the future if the Monarchy was abolished, or do you think it would make no difference?









Two in five Britons think that too much money was spent on the Coronation of King Charles



Britons are more likely to say that they would want the coronation of the next monarch to be smaller in scale compared to King Charles III's



Britons are more likely to think that King Charles III's style as monarch is different to Queen Elizabeth II's – 55–75s are most likely to think it is different


To what extent, if either, would you describe King Charles III's style as monarch as similar or different to Queen Elizabeth II's style as monarch?





Britons are split between whether there hasn't been any change, or whether the Royal Family has become more modern, since Charles III became King. 55-75s are most likely to say it has become more modern


Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more traditional or more modern, or has there not been any change from before?





Two in five Britons think that there hasn't been any change from Queen Elizabeth II reign in terms of whether the Royal Family is more transparent or more secretive


Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more transparent or more secretive with the public, or has there not been any change from before?





Britons are split between whether the Royal Family has not changed or whether they are more in touch with the public, since Charles III became King


Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more in touch or more out of touch with the public, or has there not been any change from before?


Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more united or more divided, or has there not been any change from before?





Almost half of Britons do not think there has been any change in terms of how outspoken the Royal Family has become since Charles III became King


Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more outspoken or less outspoken on political issues, or has there not been any change from before?





The Royal Family as a whole: Favourability







How favourable or unfavourable are your opinions and impressions of each of the following members of the British Royal family?





Queen Camilla: Favourability








Prince William, the Prince of Wales: Favourability






Catherine, the Princess of Wales: Favourability

How favourable or unfavourable are your opinions and impressions of each of the following members of the British Royal family?










Prince Harry, the Duke of Sussex: Favourability




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




Meghan, The Duchess of Sussex: Favourability
