



Seven in ten Britons say they have seen or heard a great deal/ fair amount about the current government's plans to change the way the benefits system works in the Uk

Base: 1,080 Online British adults aged 18-75 , including (334) 18-34-year-olds, (401) 35-








Two thirds of British adults are not confident that Labour have the right plans to change the way the benefits system works in the UK



Almost half of Britons think the government should priortise making sure everyone who needs health related benefits gets them, even if it means spending on health benefits remains high






How much confidence, if any, do you have that the UK Government is running the country...?





Just a quarter of British adults think it is likely that Keir Starmer will win the next General Election


How likely or unlikely do you think it is that Keir Starmer will...
