


8 in 10 Britons are aware of the 2025 Women's Euros (after two qualifying rounds) – slightly higher than after the first qualifying round in the 2022 tournament


Prior to this survey, how would you best describe your awareness of the 2025 UEFA Women's European Championship football tournament?

Around three in ten British adults, and around six in ten football fans are following the Women's Euros closely


How closely, if at all, have you followed the 2025 UEFA Women's European Championship football tournament, held in Switzerland?

Over the past two years, which England football team, if any do you believe has...?. **Among English football fans**




