


Views on Wes Streeting's performance as Secretary of State

To what extent, if at all, do you think Wes Streeting has been doing a good or bad job in his role as the Secretary of State for Health and Social Care?






Awareness of the 10 Year Health Plan

Views of the plan's likely impact on patients and NHS staff






