



# Three in ten are familiar with the Government's Plan for Change, and one in four with its five missions – large majorities don't know much if anything about either.




### Britons are split on whether they think Labour is governing the country in a way that feels similar or different to previous Conservative Governments

To what extent would you say the way in which the Labour party are governing the country feels similar or different to previous Conservative Governments?





In your opinion, do you think the current Labour government led by Keir Starmer is doing a good job or a bad job, if either, at delivering in the following areas?























### Mission 1: Kickstart economic growth: half think Labour is doing a bad job – continuing a deteriorating trend




### Mission 2: Make Britain a clean energy superpower: 4 in 10 Britons think Labour is doing a bad job – little change since April

In your opinion, do you think the current Labour government led by Keir Starmer is doing a good job or a bad job, if either, at delivering in the following areas?





In your opinion, do you think the current Labour government led by Keir Starmer is doing a good job or a bad job, if either, at delivering in the following areas?





In your opinion, do you think the current Labour government led by Keir Starmer is doing a good job or a bad job, if either, at delivering in the following areas?





Which of the following political parties, if any, do you think would do the best job achieving each of the following?






# Building an NHS fit for the future continues to be the main priority for the public, from Labour's five missions
