


Britons are most likely to say they either trust family/ friends or no one when it comes to hearing views on political issues


Which of the following, if any, do you trust the most when hearing about their views on political issues? Please pick all that apply.





A third of Britons say they are not interested in hearing more about political issues from any of the listed groups


And from which of the following, if any, would you be most interested in hearing MORE about their views on political issues? Please pick all that apply.

Have you ever paid attention to a celebrity expressing their views in support of a political cause? If not please say so.






Over half who have heard a celebrity express their views on a political issues said that it had no impact on their views about that cause




Almost three in five Britons said that when they have seen a celebrity express views in support of a cause they are opposed to, it made them view the celebrity more negatively

I viewed them more negatively


