


Who would do a good or bad job as Prime Minister?


To what extent, if at all, do you think each of the following would do a good job or bad job as Prime Minister? If you do not know who the person is, then please say

Which of the following, if either, do you think would make a better Prime Minister?



Which of the following, if either, do you think would make a better Prime Minister?
















When given a list of Conservative politicians, the public are most likely to say none of them / don't know in terms of who would do the best job as leader of the **Conservatives**








If Kemi Badenoch was to no longer be leader of the Conservative party the public are most likely to say none of them / don't know on who they would prefer to be the next **Conservative leader**




