
















































For the first time, Britons are split on whether Keir Starmer or Nigel Farage would make a better Prime Minister


Which of the following, if either, do you think would make a better Prime Minister?





Keir Starmer continues to lead Kemi Badenoch in terms of who would make a better Prime Minister


Which of the following, if either, do you think would make a better Prime Minister?


Which of the following, if either, do you think would make a better Prime Minister?
