


How would you describe the current state of the British economy? Would you say it is...?




Three in five Britons who say the British economy is in a poor state blame decisions made by Keir Starmer and Rachel Reeves






Almost half of Britons who think the economy is in a good state say that decisions made by the Bank of England have contributed most

Which of the following, if any, would you say have contributed MOST to the British economy currently being in a GOOD state? Please pick as many as apply.




Around three quarters of Britons think it is likely that Labour will increase taxes that they personally pay over the next year

How likely, if at all, do you think the Labour party will be to do each of the following over the next year?



Three in five Britons think it likely that if the Conservatives were in government, they would increase taxes and decrease spending on public services


How likely, if at all, do you think the Conservative party would be to do each of the following if they were in government?





If Reform UK were in Government, half of Britons think it is likely that they would increase taxes and decrease spending on public services


How likely, if at all, do you think Reform UK would be to do each of the following if they were in government?





Labour's lead on which party has the best policies has either been cut or lost altogether across several key issues since the 2024 General Election campaign



Best party on key policy issues



A majority of Britons still say they are concerned about the impact of the cost of living


To what extent, if at all, would you say you are concerned about the cost of living over the next six months for each of the following?






Household spend over the next 6 months – long term trends 2022-25






