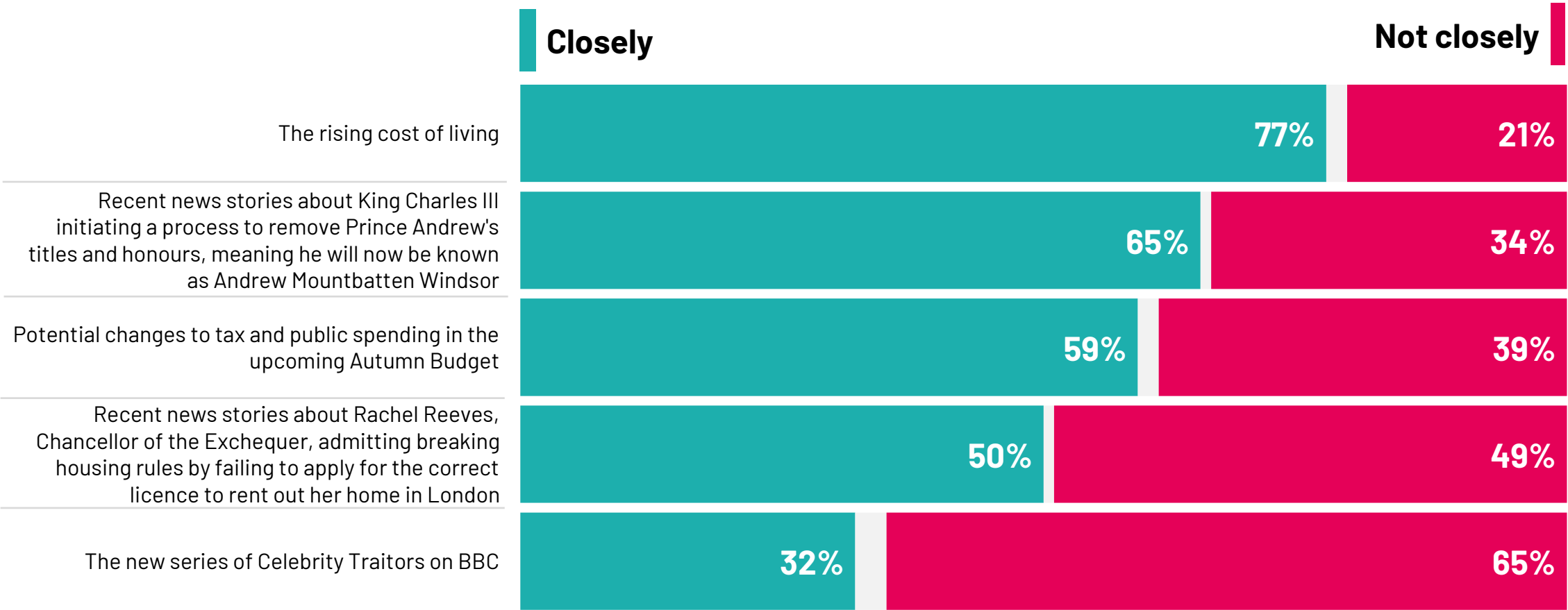

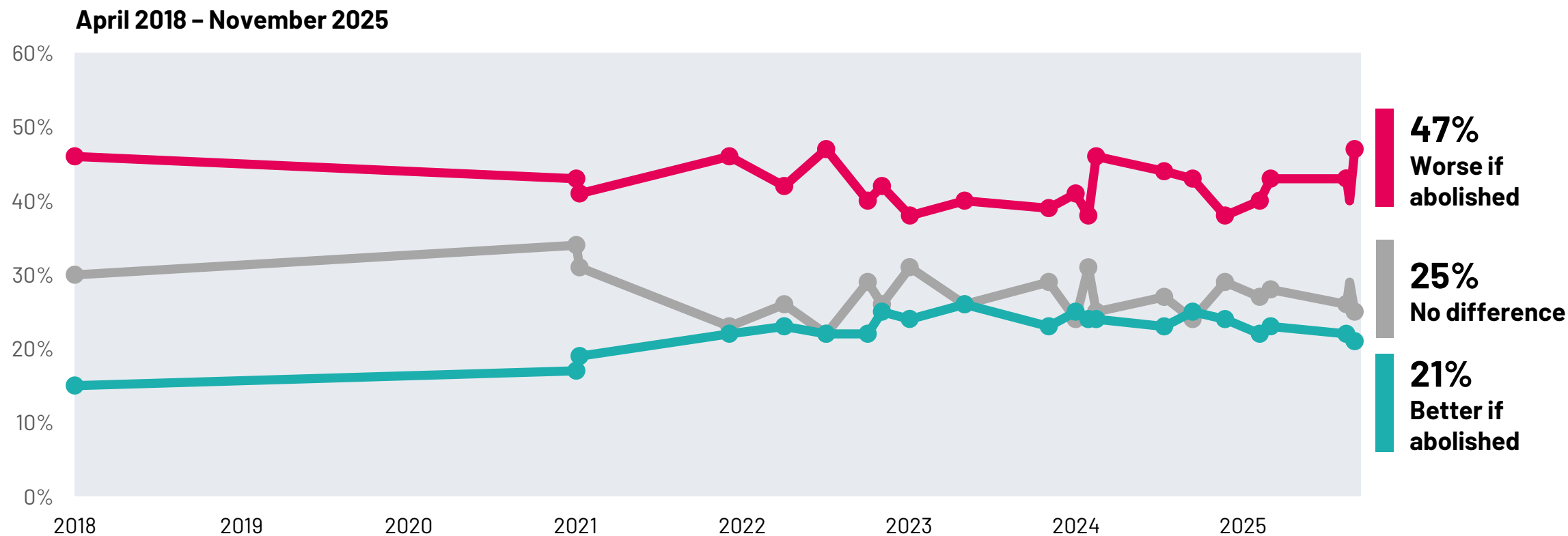

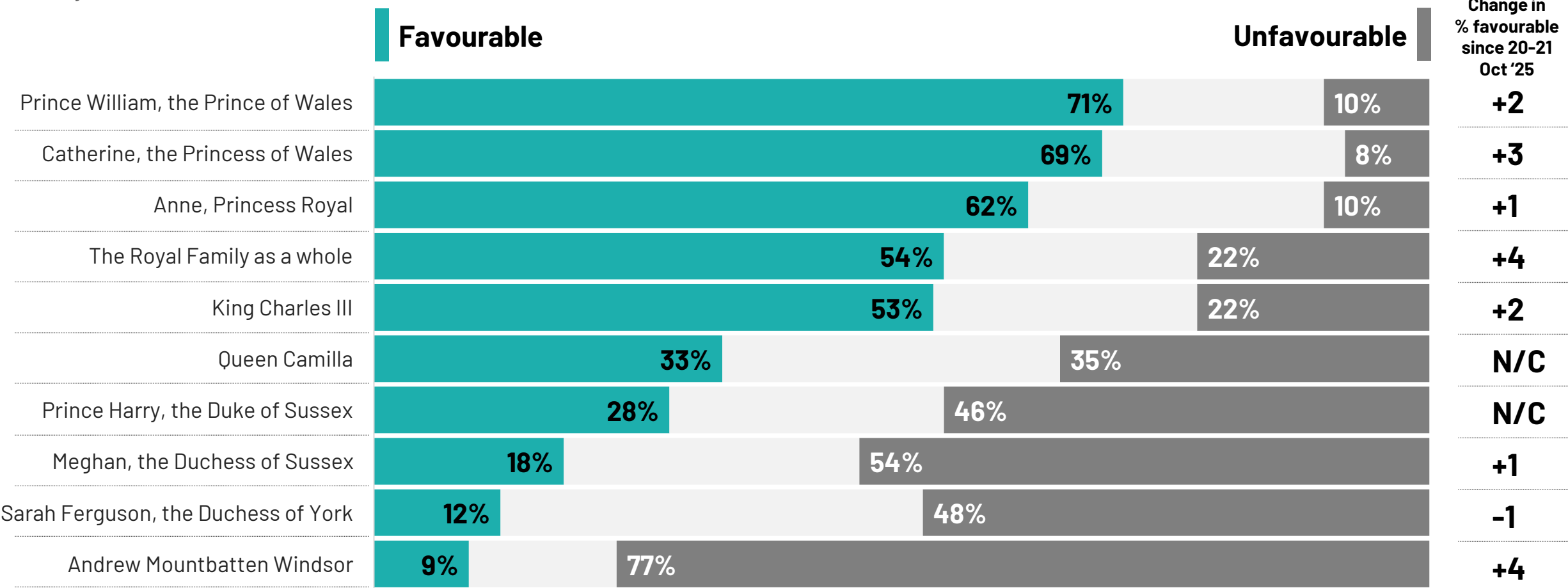

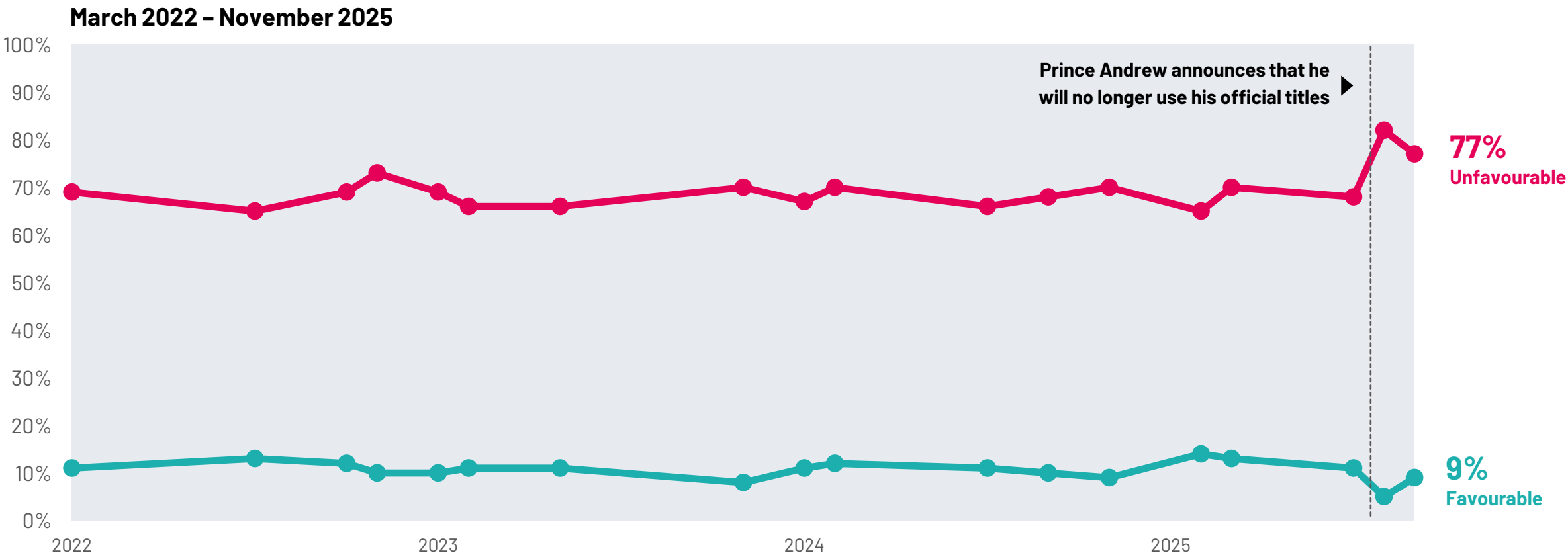
How favourable or unfavourable are your opinions and impressions of each of the following members of the British Royal family?

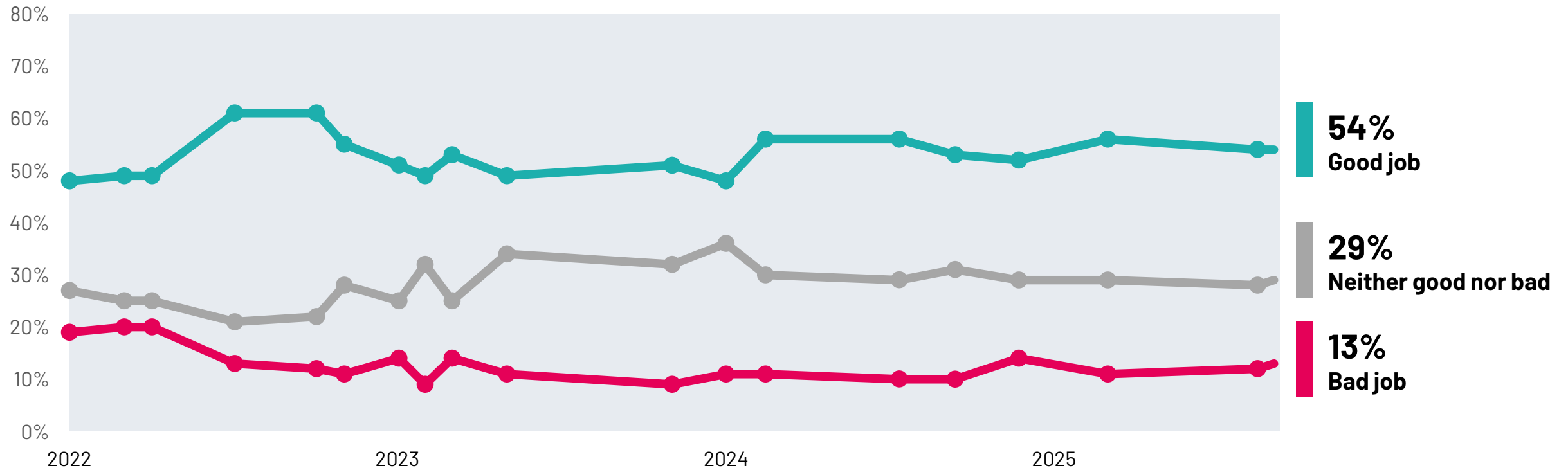

To what extent, if at all, do you think King Charles III is doing a good job or bad job as King?

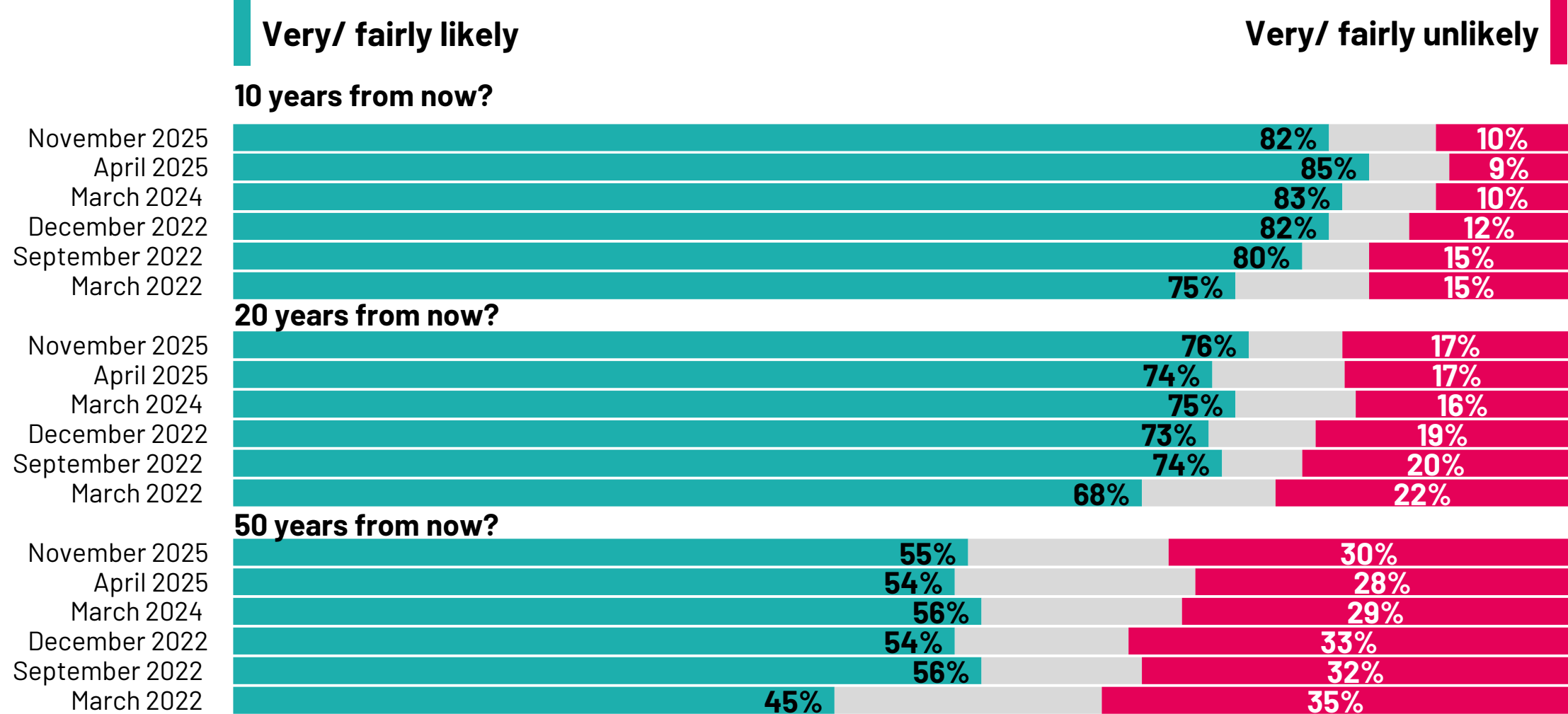

Looking to the future, how likely or unlikely do you think it is that Britain will have a monarchy...?

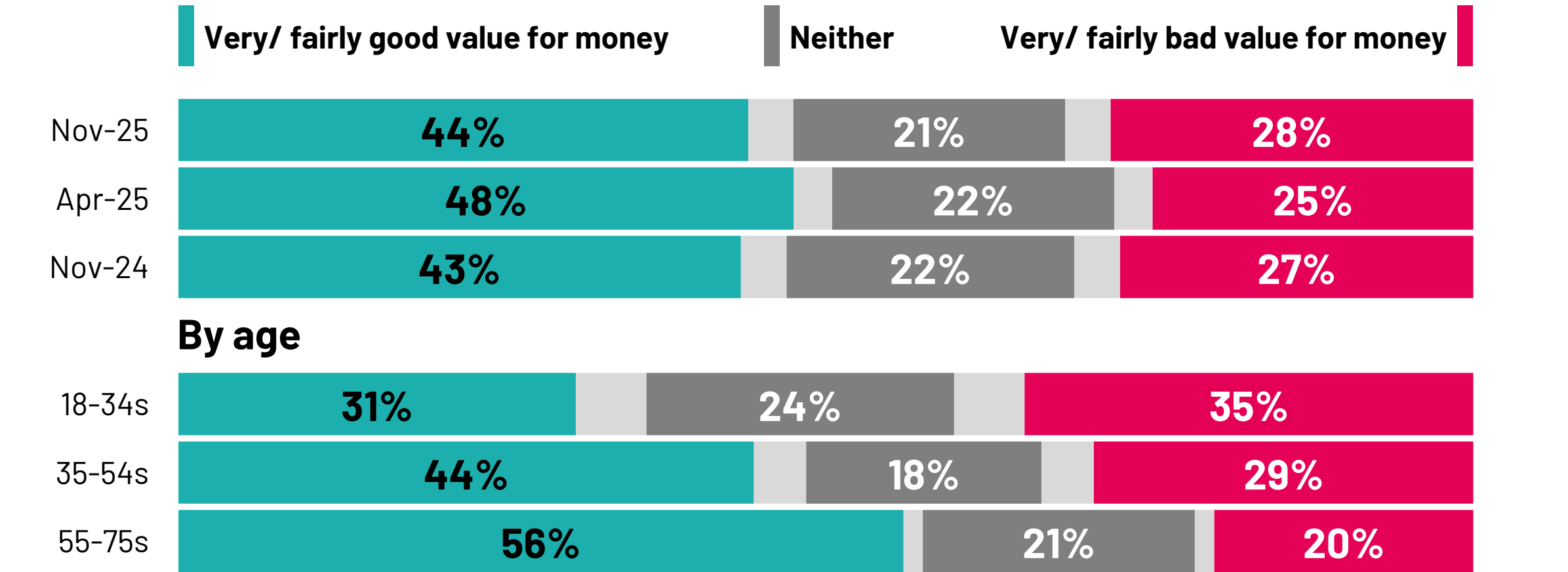

From what you know, to what extent, if at all, do you think the Royal Family are good or bad value for money for the UK taxpayer?

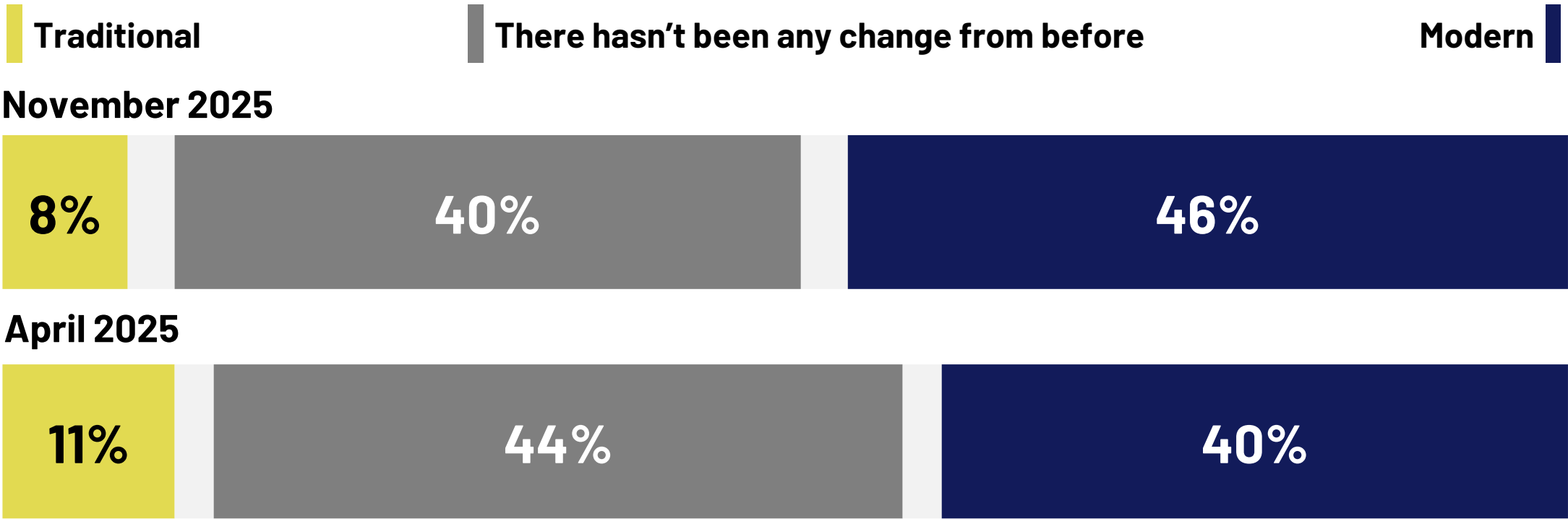

# Almost half of Britons think the Royal Family has become more modern since King Charles III became King

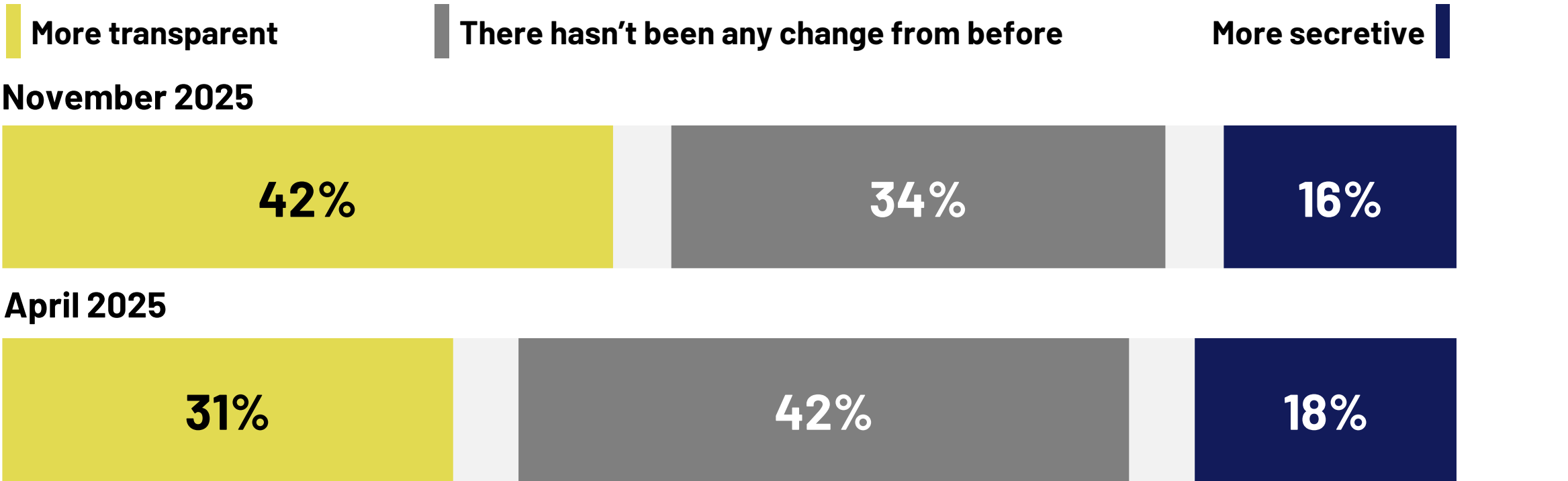
Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more traditional or more modern, or has there not been any change from before?

# Around two in five Britons think the Royal Family have become more transparent since Charles III became King – up from April 2025

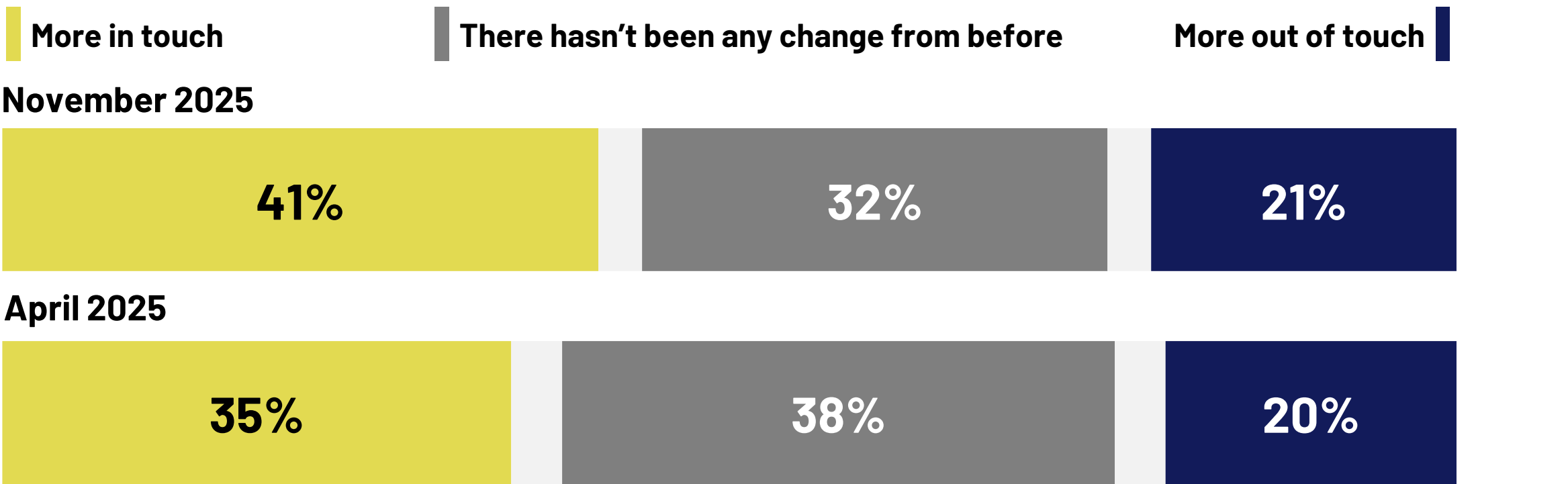
Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more transparent or more secretive with the public, or has there not been any change from before?

# Two in five Britons think that the Royal Family has become more in touch since Charles III became King

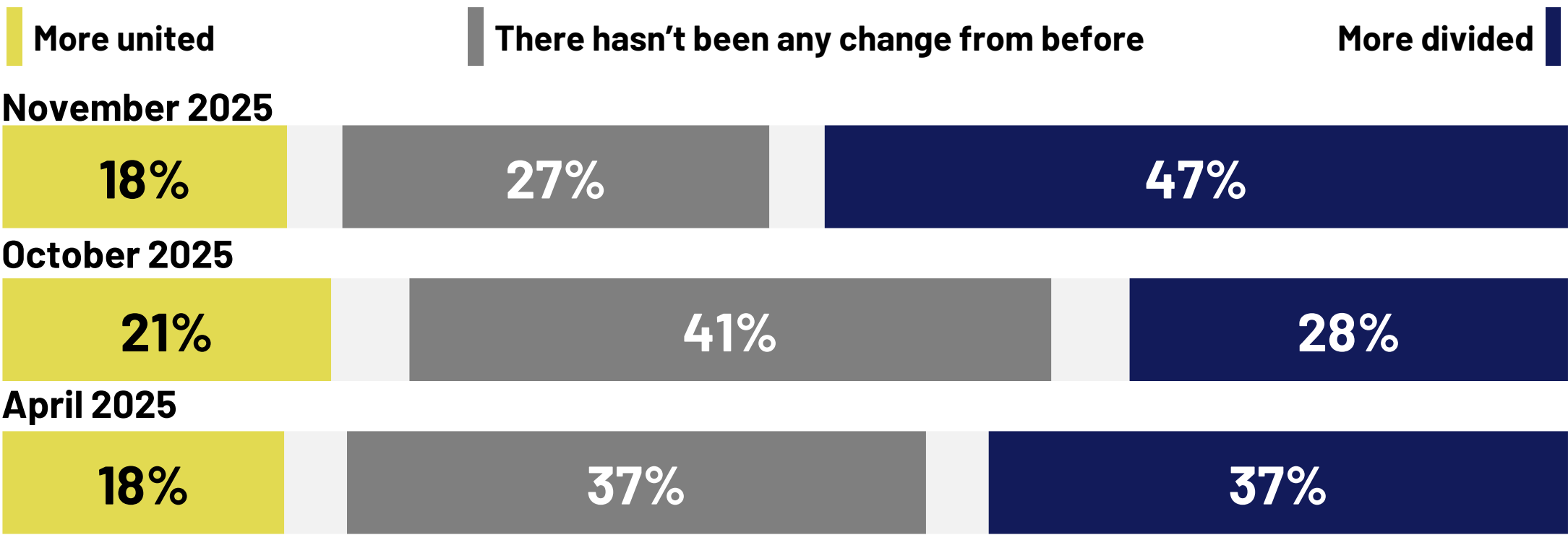
Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more in touch or more out of touch with the public, or has there not been any change from before?

# Almost half of Britons think the Royal Family has become more divided since Charles III became King. This is up considerably from last month.

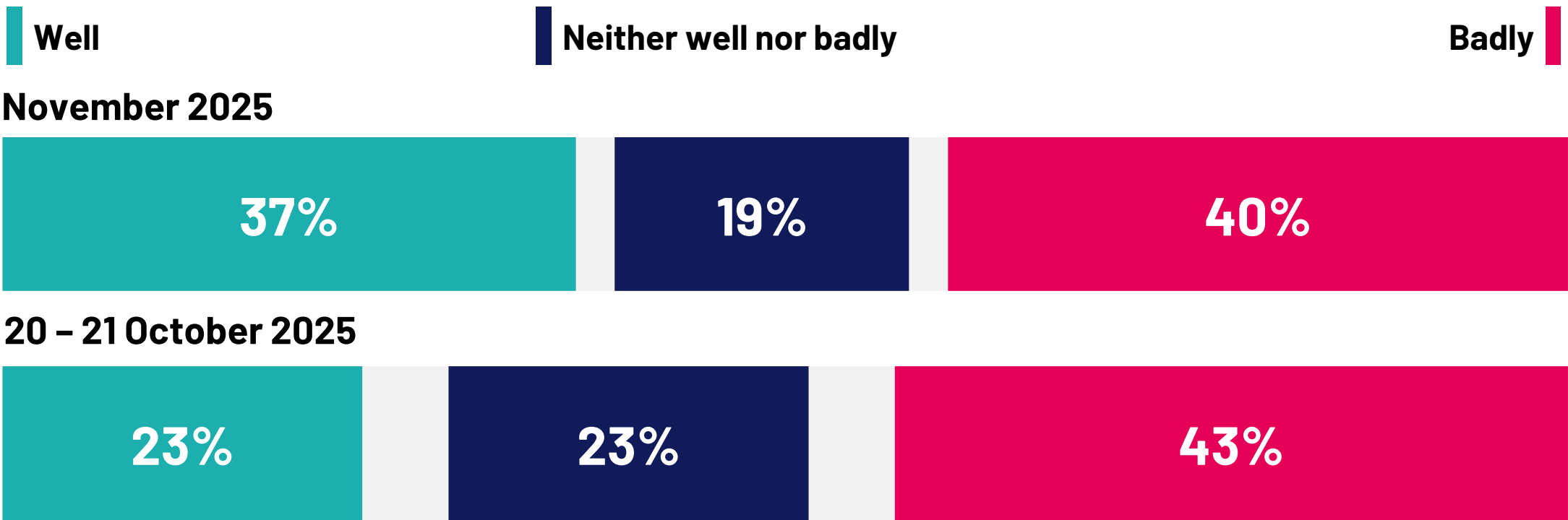
Thinking about since Charles III became King, would you say the Royal Family has become more united or more divided, or has there not been any change from before?

# Britons are split on whether the Royal Family have handled the situation with Prince Andrew well or badly. But the percentage thinking they have handled it well is up compared to last month

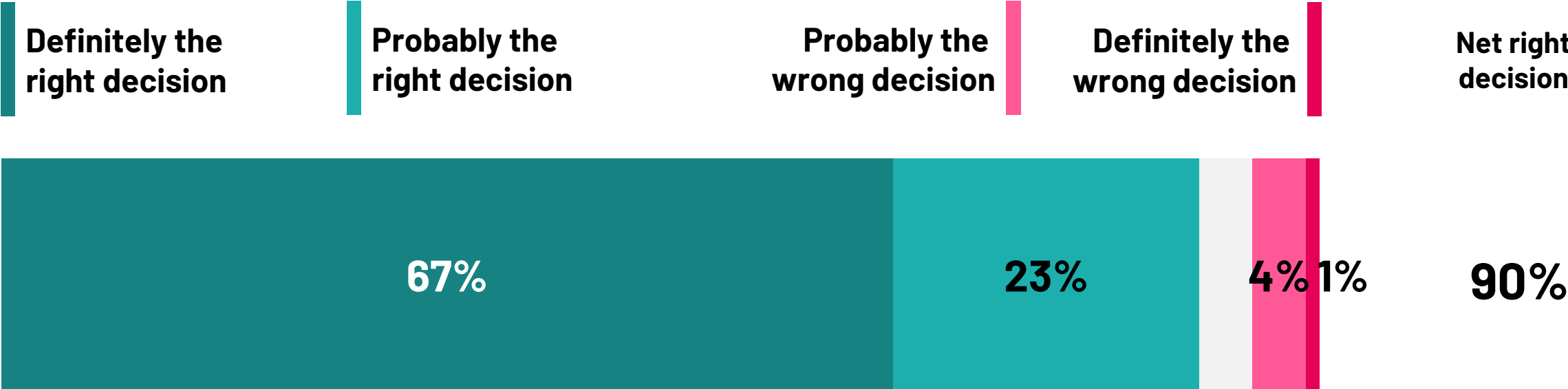
Overall, how well or badly, if either, do you think the Royal Family have handled the situation with Prince Andrew since allegations were first made against him?

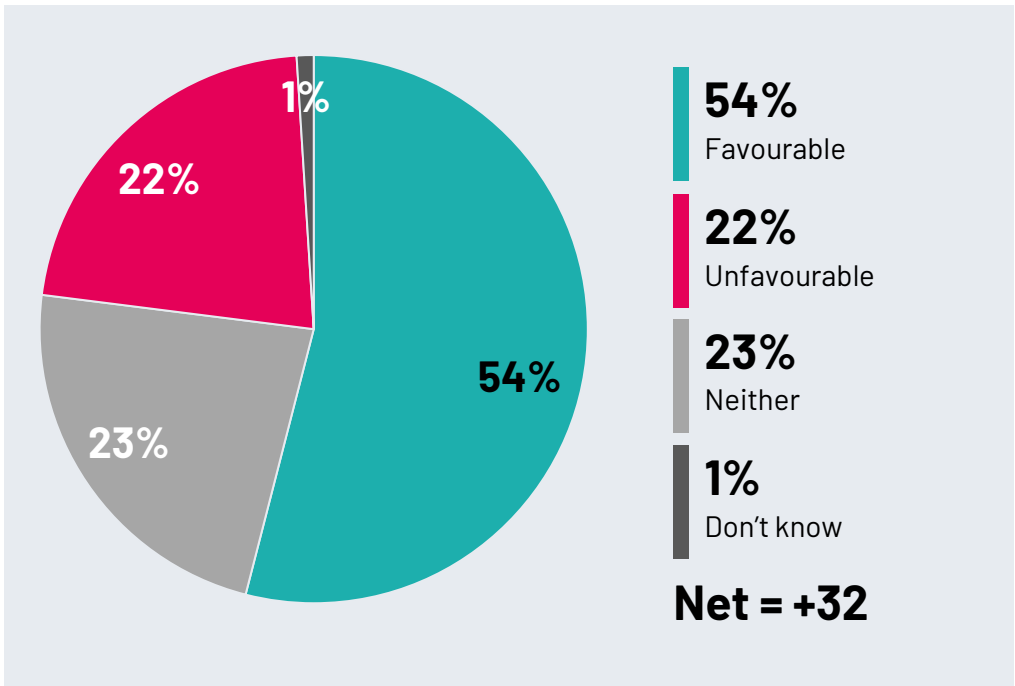

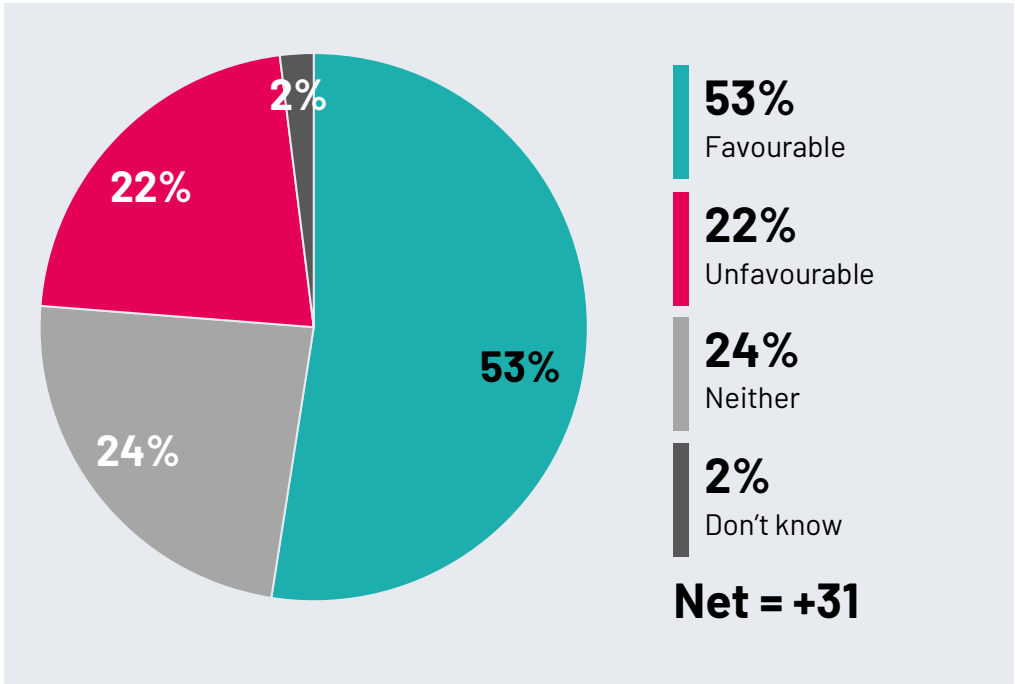

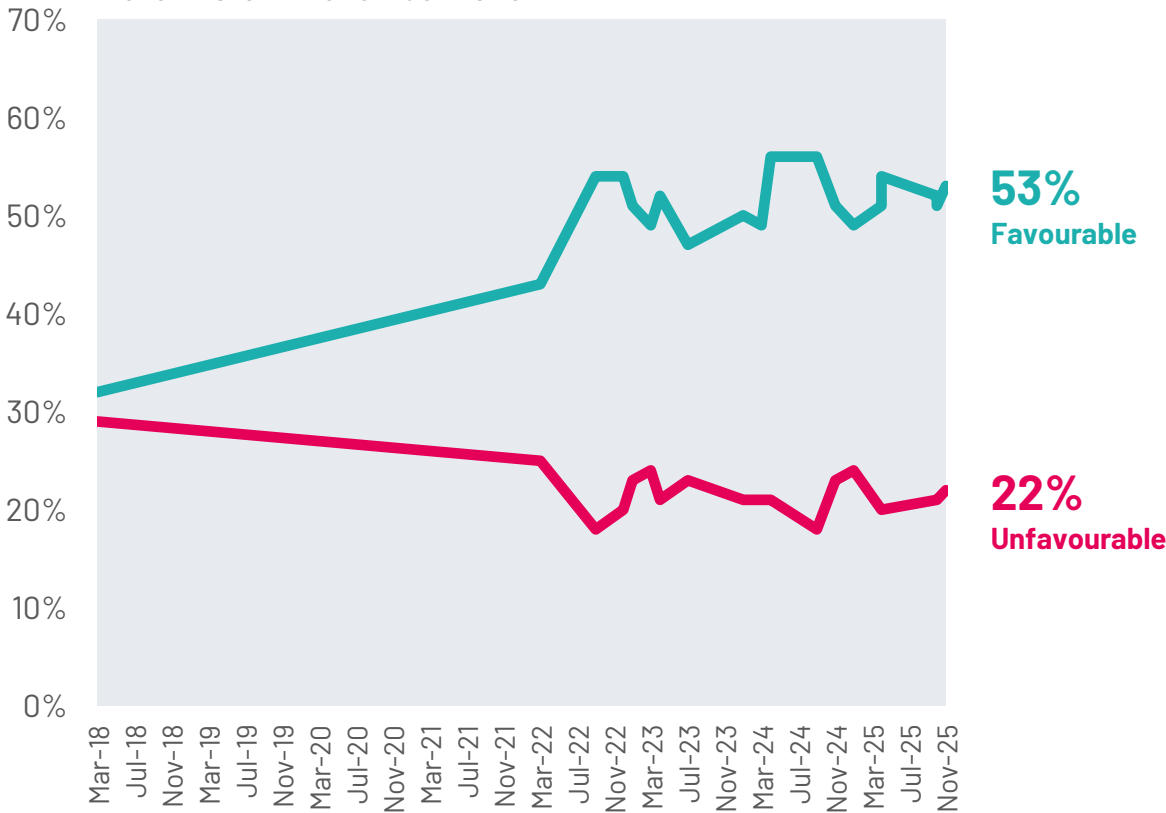

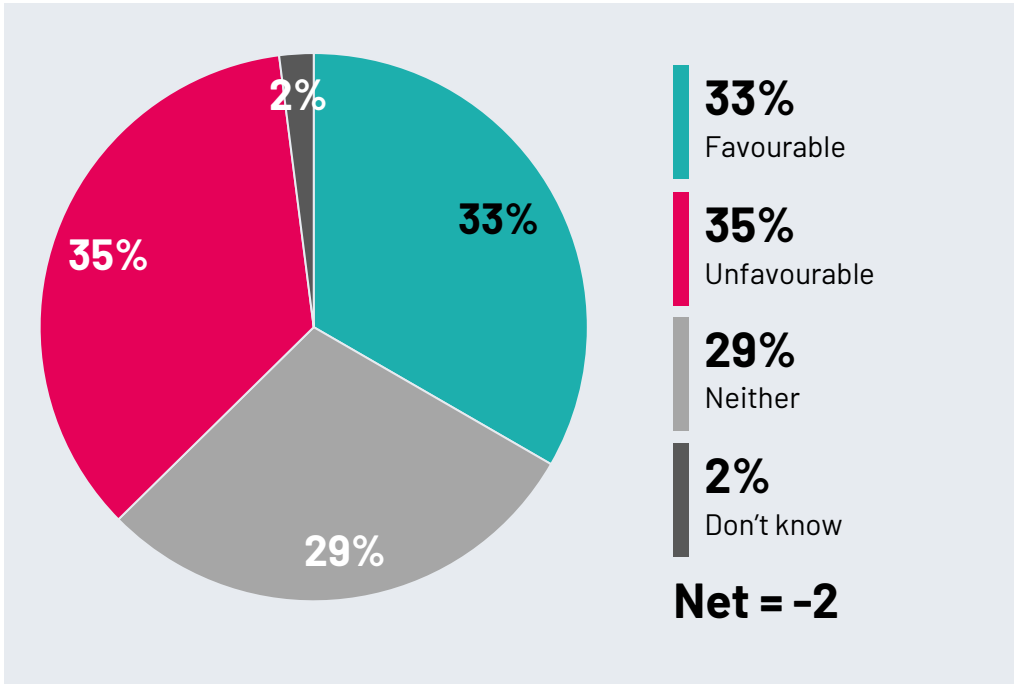

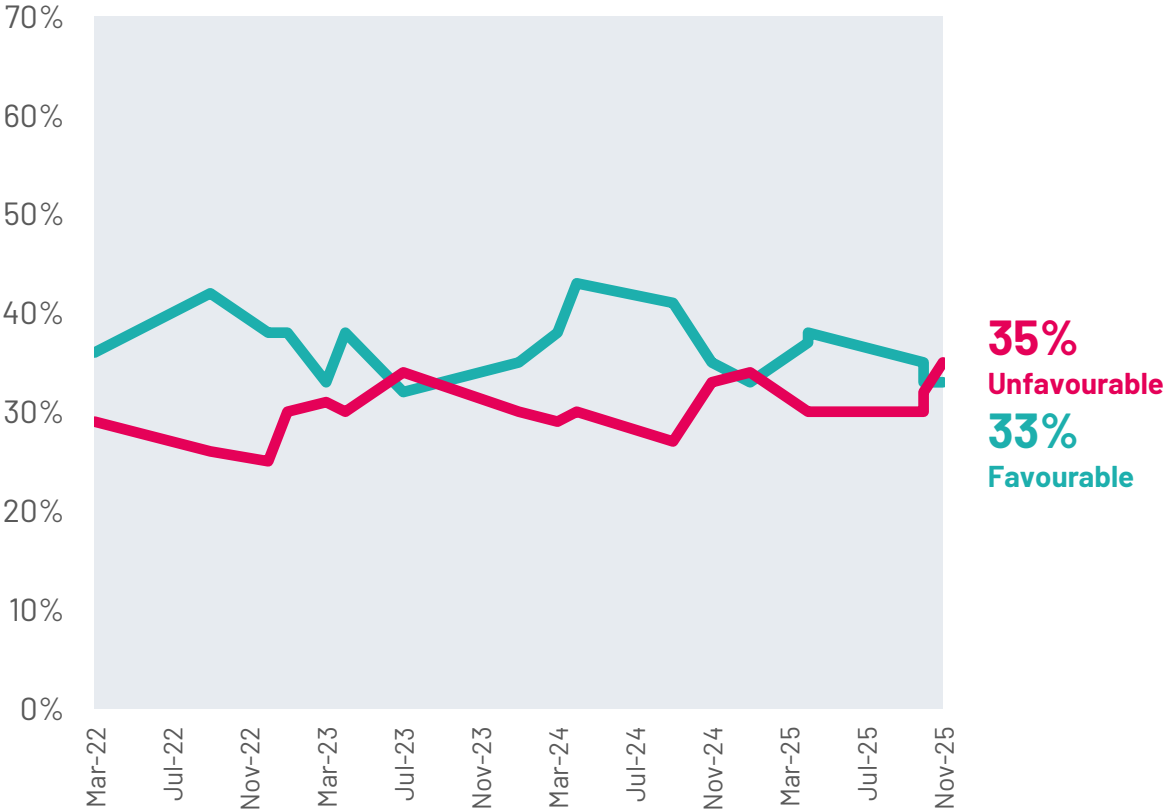
How favourable or unfavourable are your opinions and impressions of each of the following members of the British Royal family?

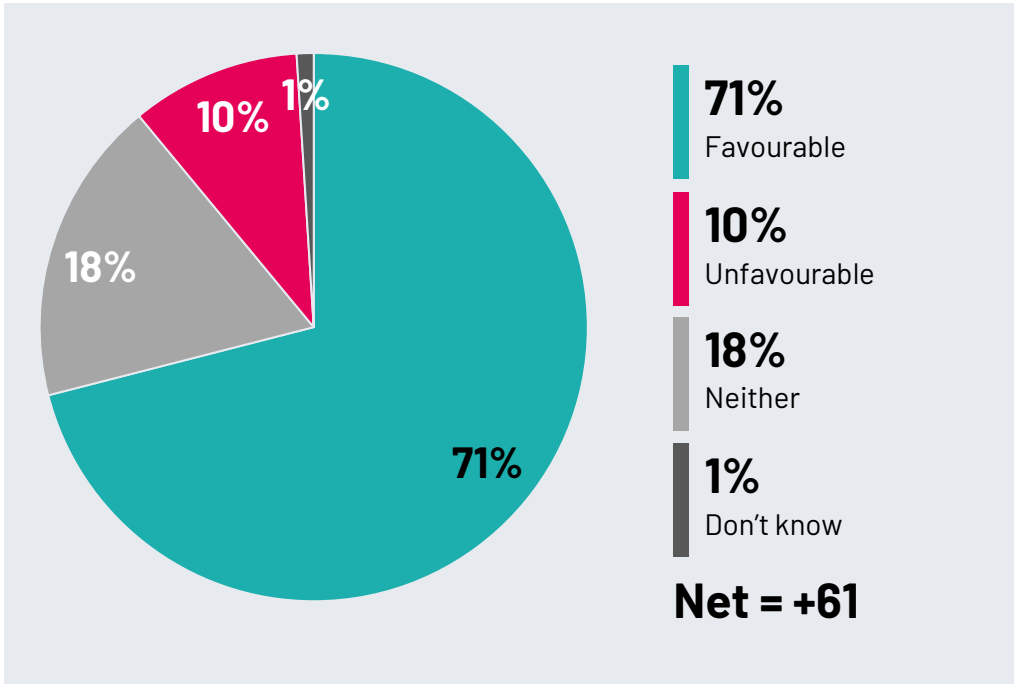

# Prince William, the Prince of Wales: Favourability

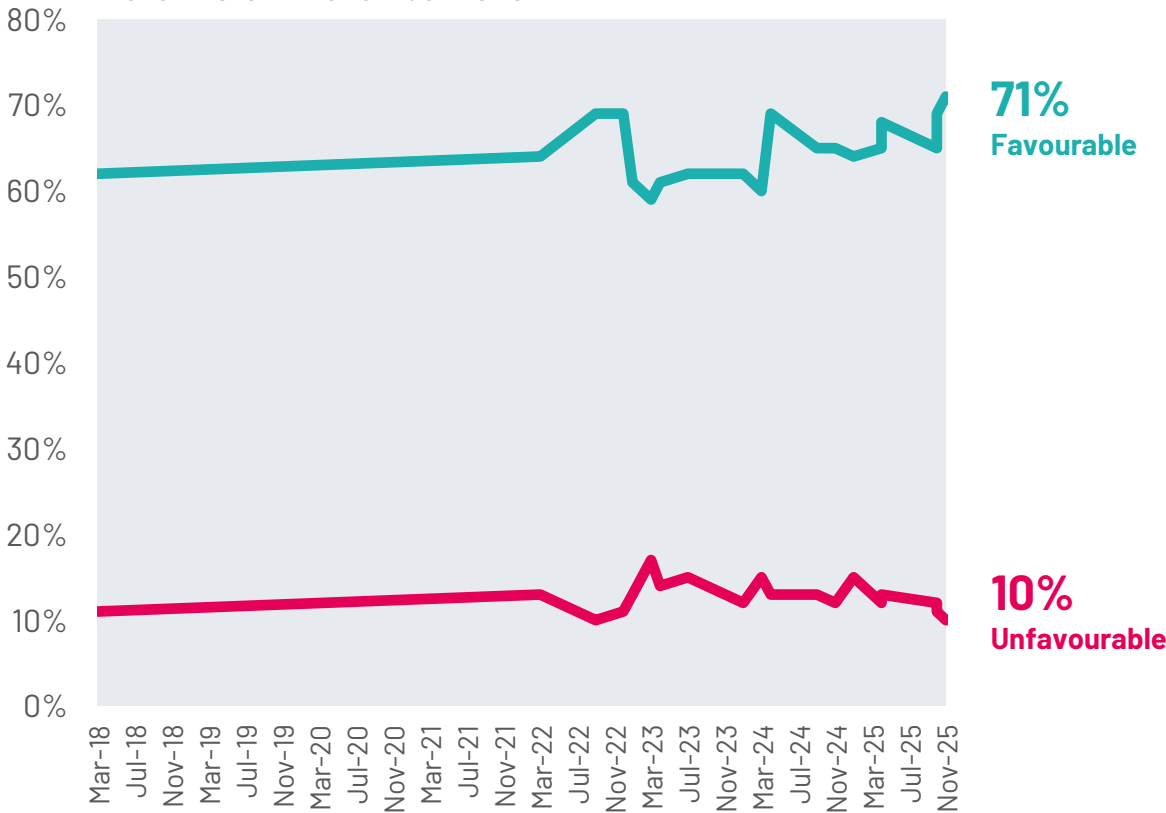
How favourable or unfavourable are your opinions and impressions of each of the following members of the British Royal family?

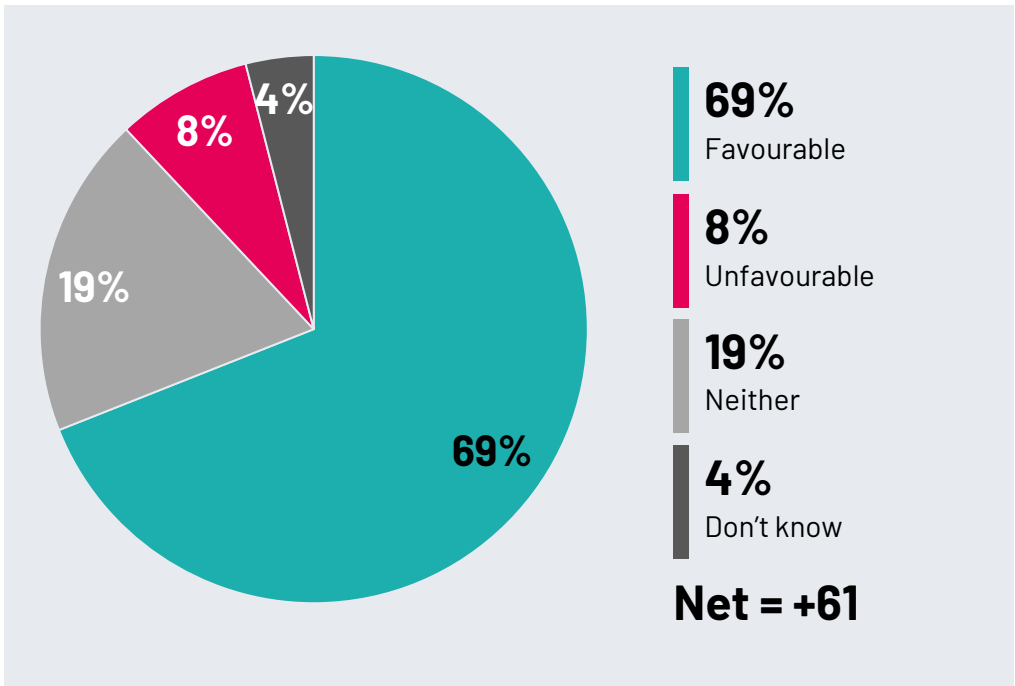

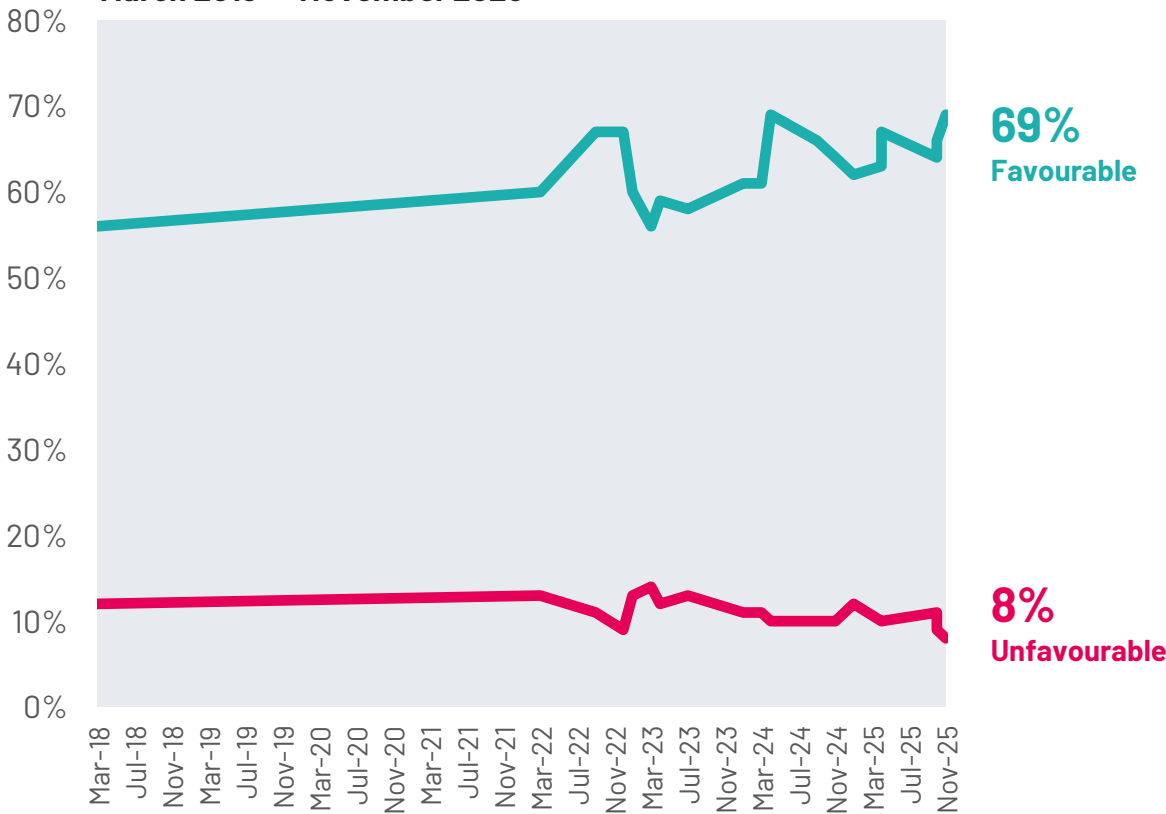
How favourable or unfavourable are your opinions and impressions of each of the following members of the British Royal family?

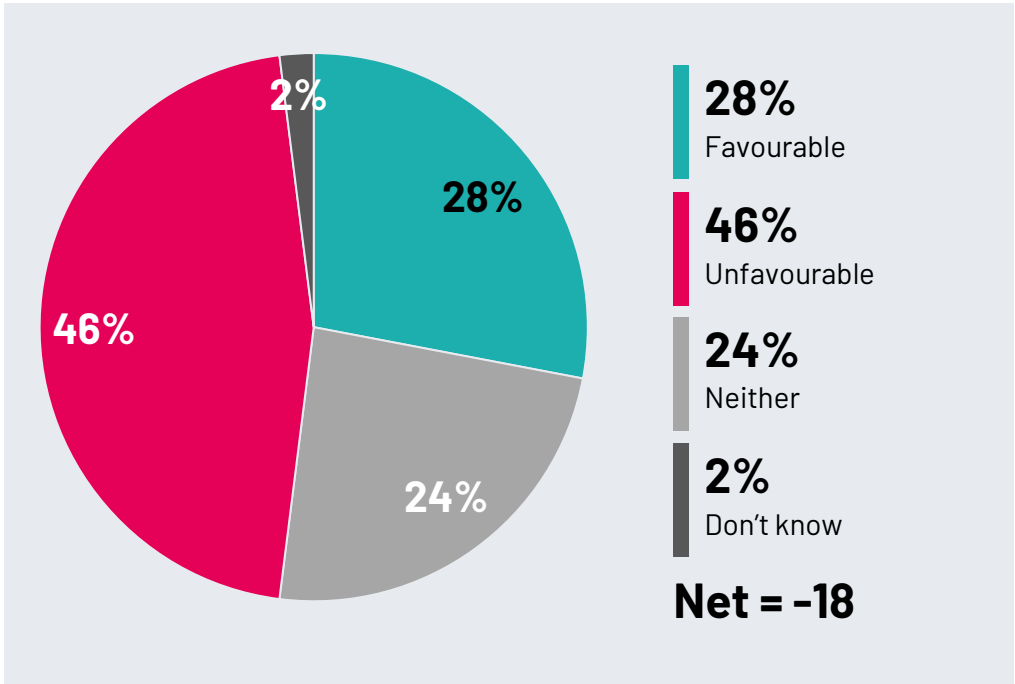

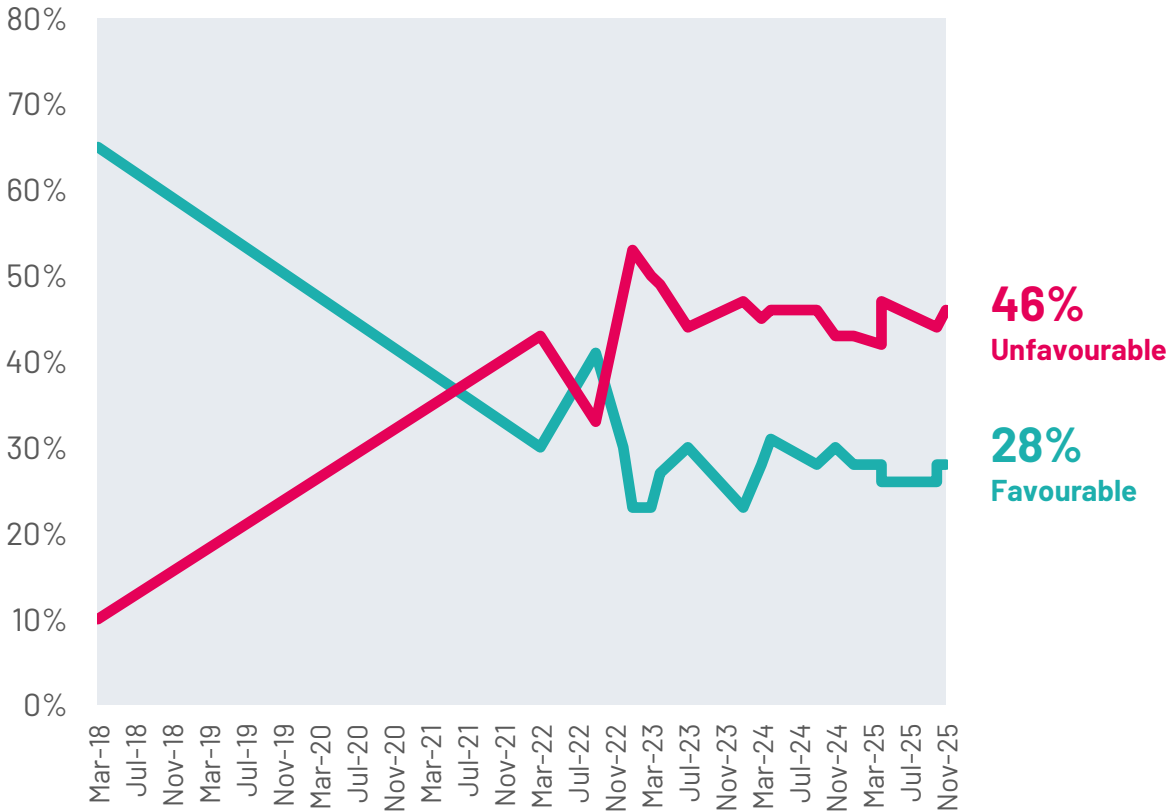
How favourable or unfavourable are your opinions and impressions of each of the following members of the British Royal family?

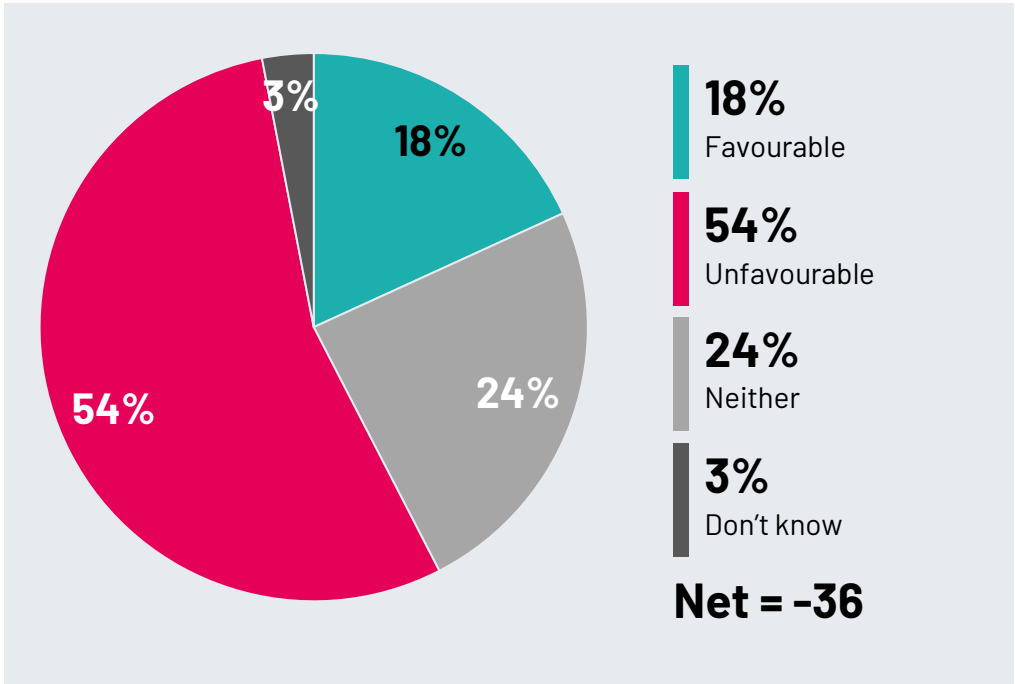
