



One-quarter of the public (24%) report that they have an intolerance or allergy





Half of those with an allergy have been clinically diagnosed by a GP, doctor or healthcare professional


And how were you diagnosed with your allergies?





Two in five of those with an intolerance diagnosed themselves by researching the symptoms


And how were you diagnosed with your intolerances?






The most common symptom of allergies is a rash or skin problems

And, which of the following symptoms, if any, have you experienced because of your allergies?









The most common symptom of intolerances are gastrointestinal symptoms

And, which of the following symptoms, if any, have you experienced because of your intolerances?








People with allergies and/or intolerances are most likely to avoid buying food and drink from market stalls, takeaways or home delivery services

Do you avoid buying food or drink from any of the following because you are concerned they may contain undeclared ingredients you have an intolerance or allergy to?


