

Beyond the prospect of endings, there is anticipation of beginnings — from reconstruction efforts to renewed diplomatic momentum










EXPECTATIONS FOR THE ECONOMY IN 2026



Economically, most expect the global economy to strengthen in 2026, though nearly half also anticipate a major stock market crash














This duality extends into views on AI, which is widely recognized for its potential to create new opportunities while simultaneously posing risks to the existing employment landscape







Beyond jobs, concerns extend to Al's broader societal impacts, including difficulty telling real content from fake and greater risks to personal data privacy






In response, expectations are rising for governments to impose stricter regulation on technology companies






When it comes to the 2026 World Cup, expectations point to unprecedented outcome, with 2 in 3 anticipating a first-time champion



Sample and methodology

Sample size

3,500 respondents

Sample criteria

General public: age (18+), national representation

Methodology

The survey was conducted via Ipsos online panel, computer aided telephone interviews and computer aided personal interviews

Geographical coverage

Conducted in MENA with a nationwide coverage across: Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Saudi Arabia and UAE
