

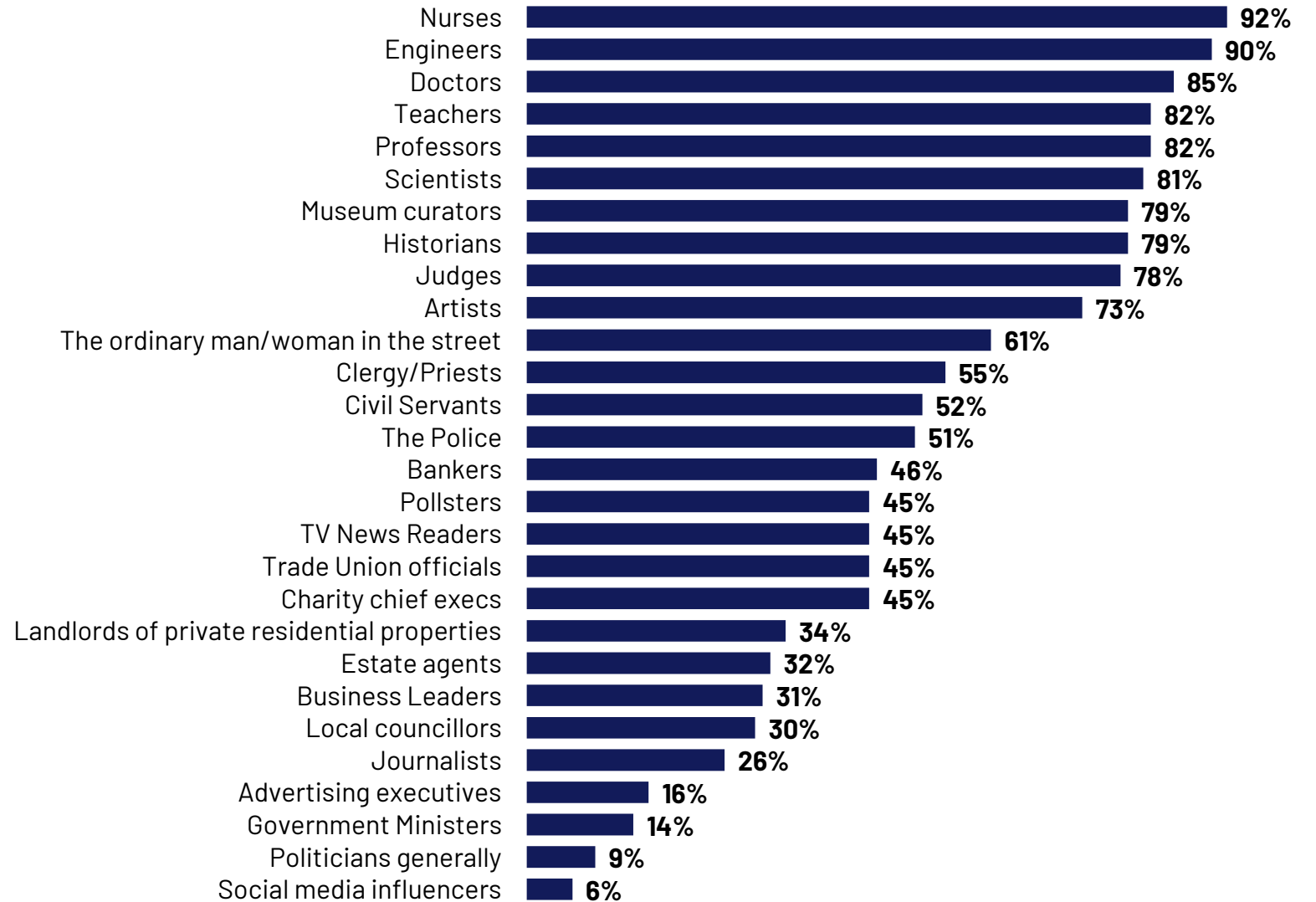

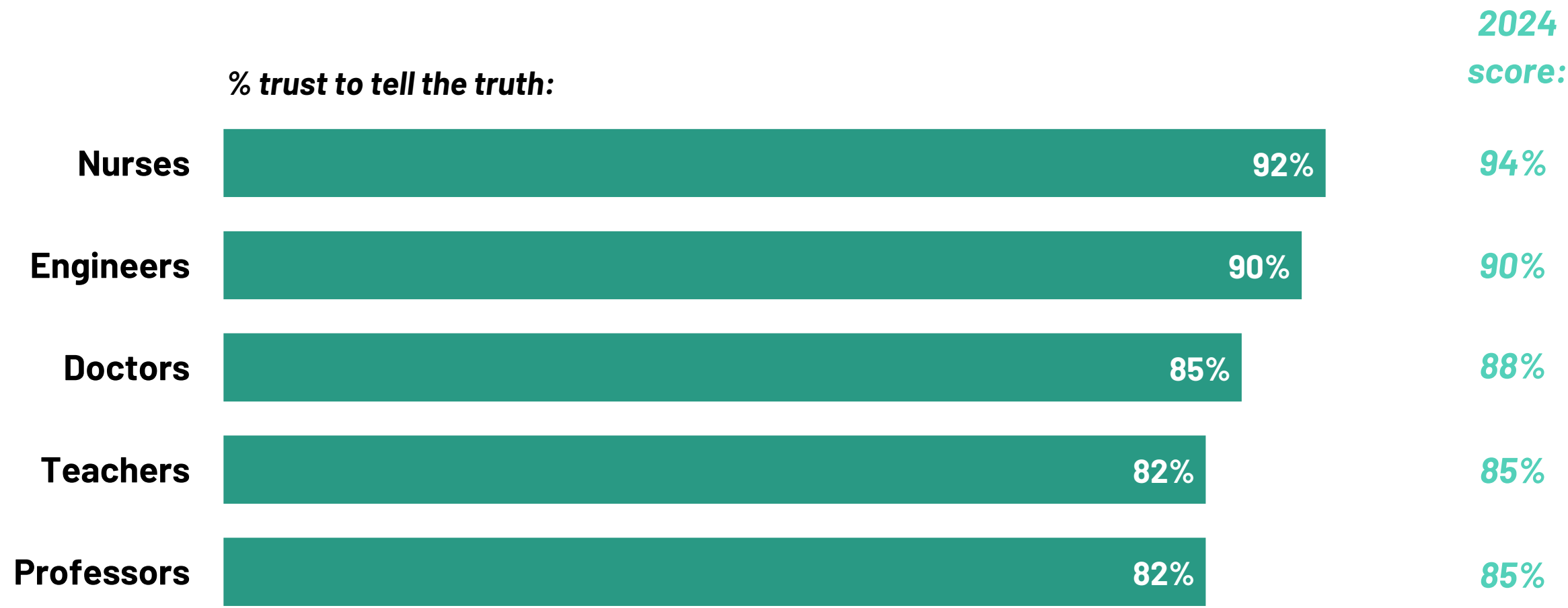

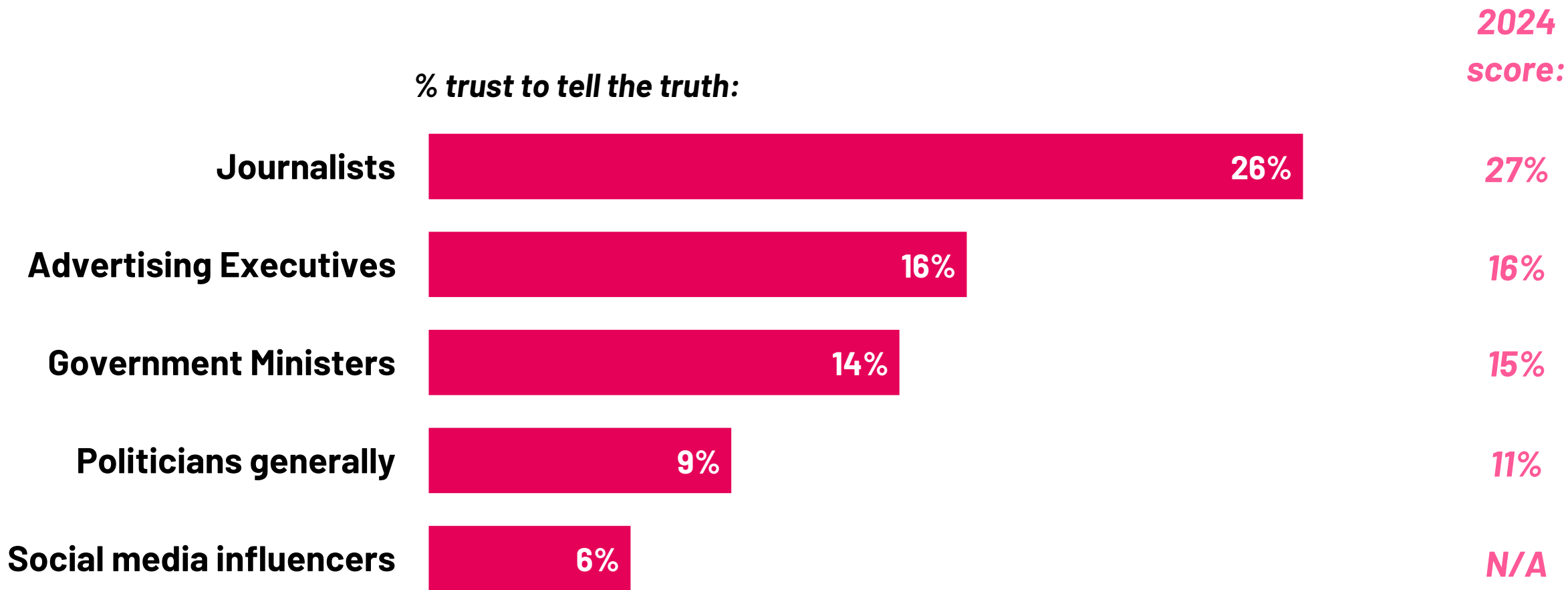
# The five most trusted professions, 2025

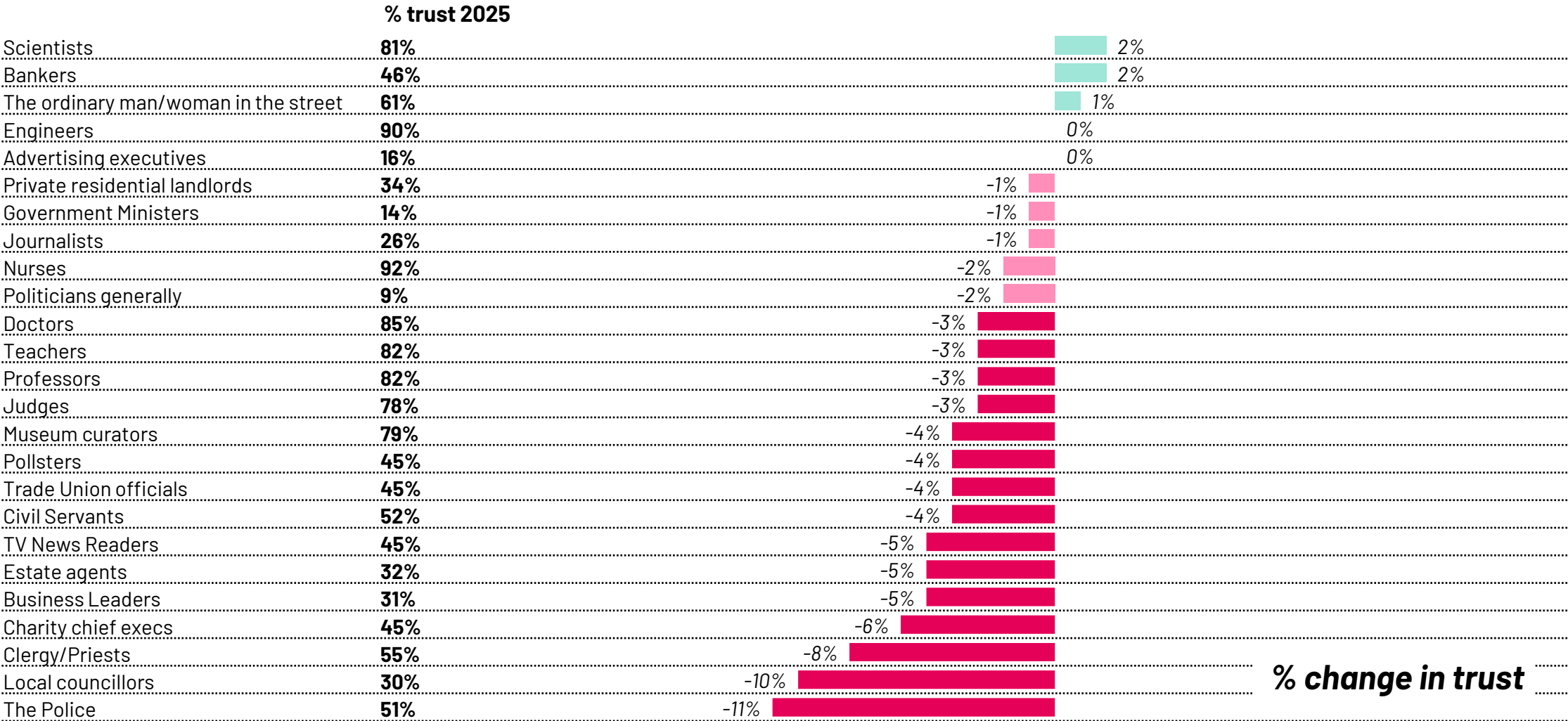
# The five least trusted professions, 2024

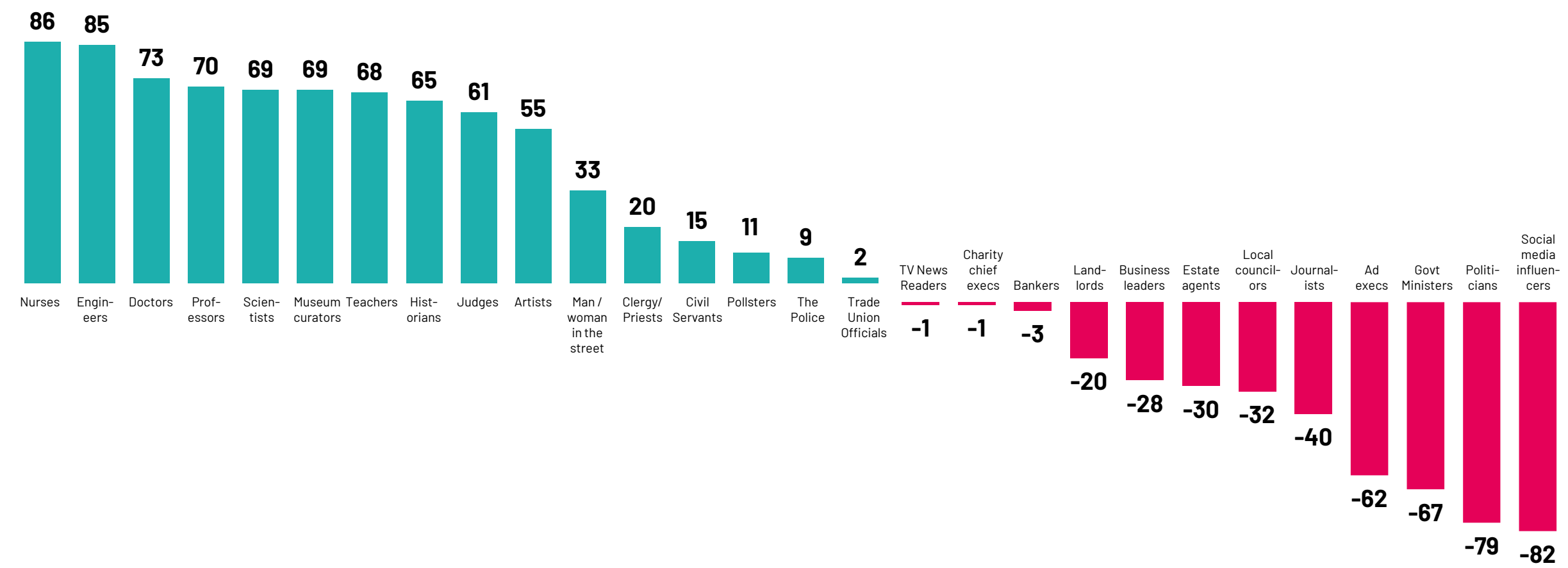

Net trust = % trust to tell the truth - % do not trust to tell the truth



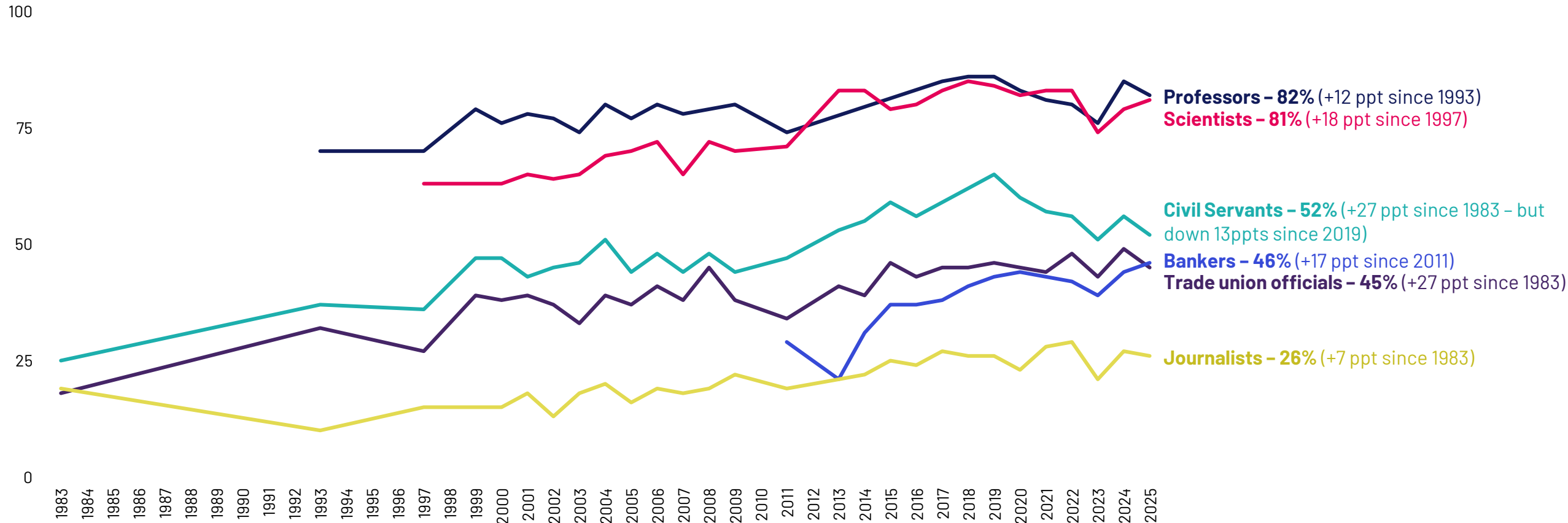

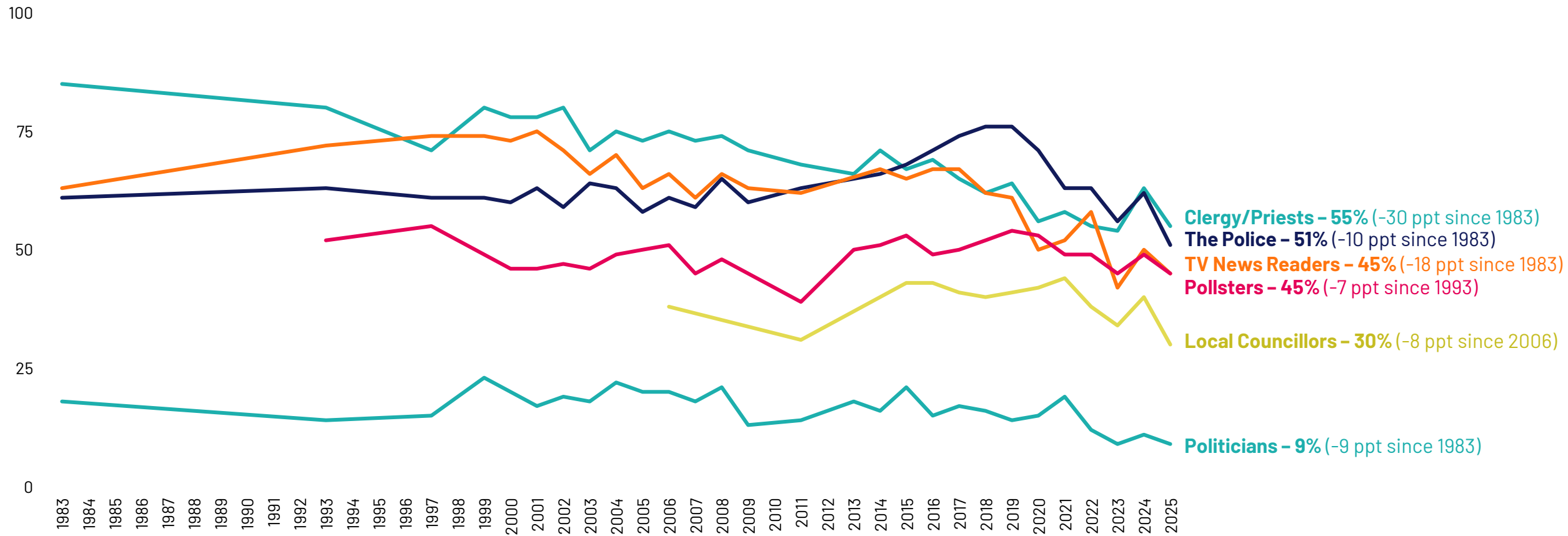

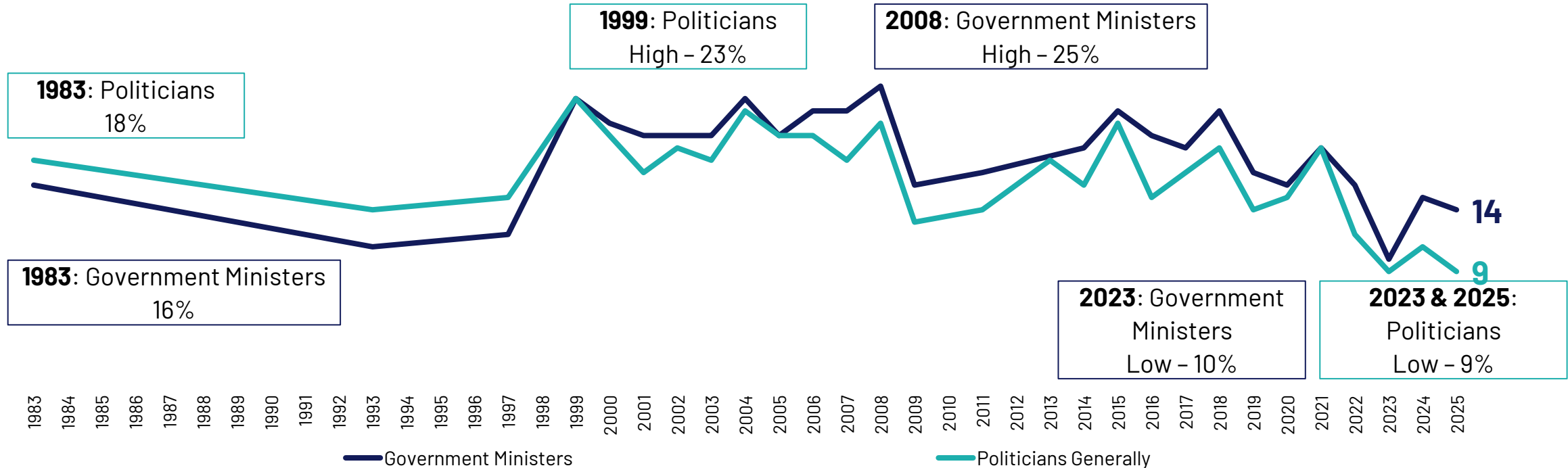

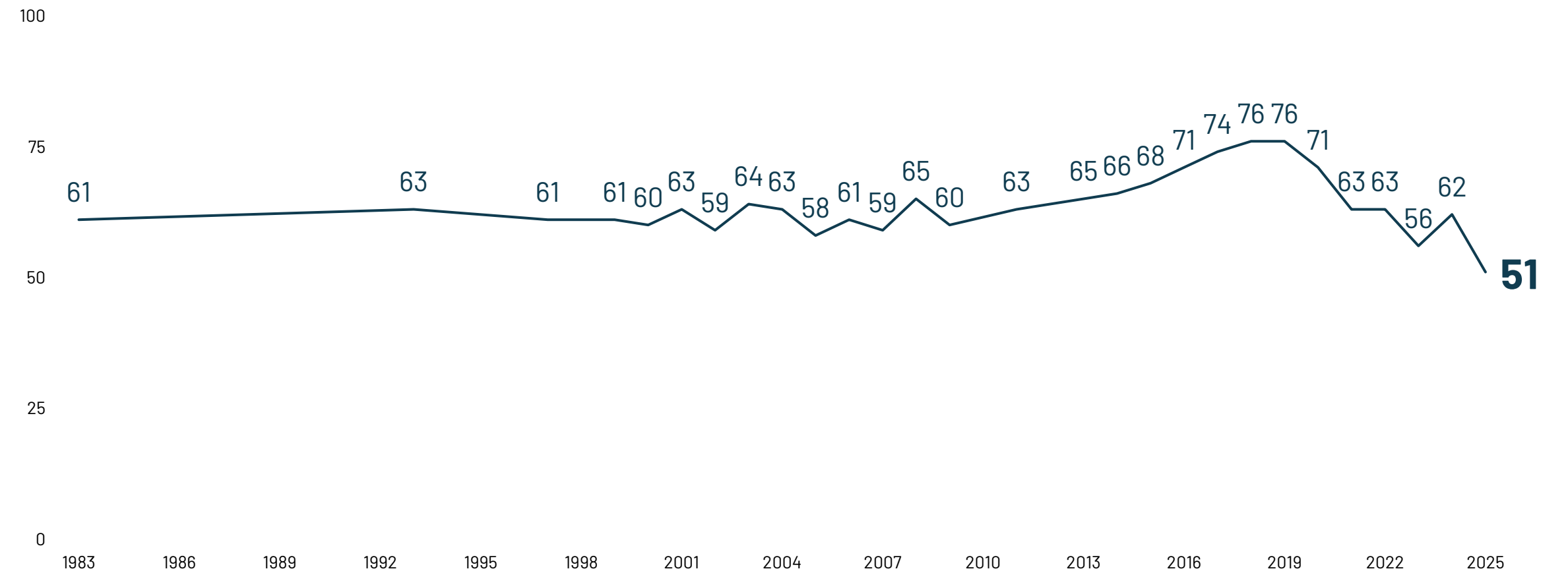

% trust to tell the truth:

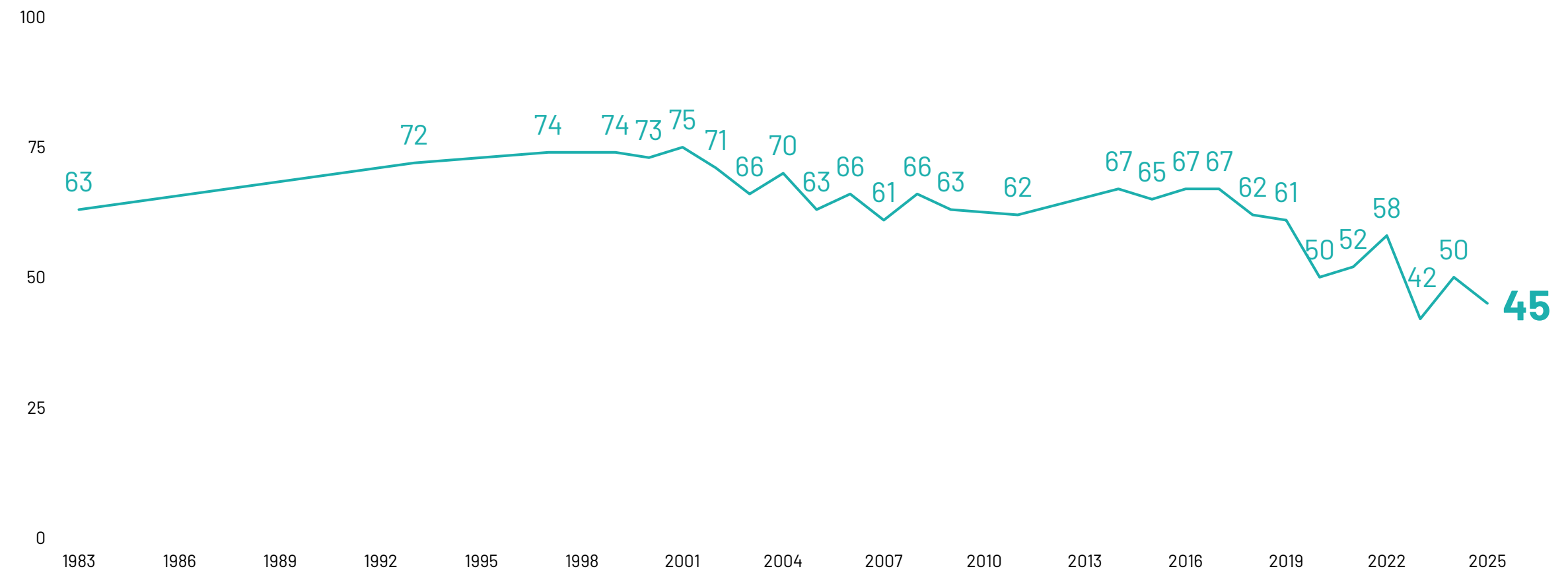

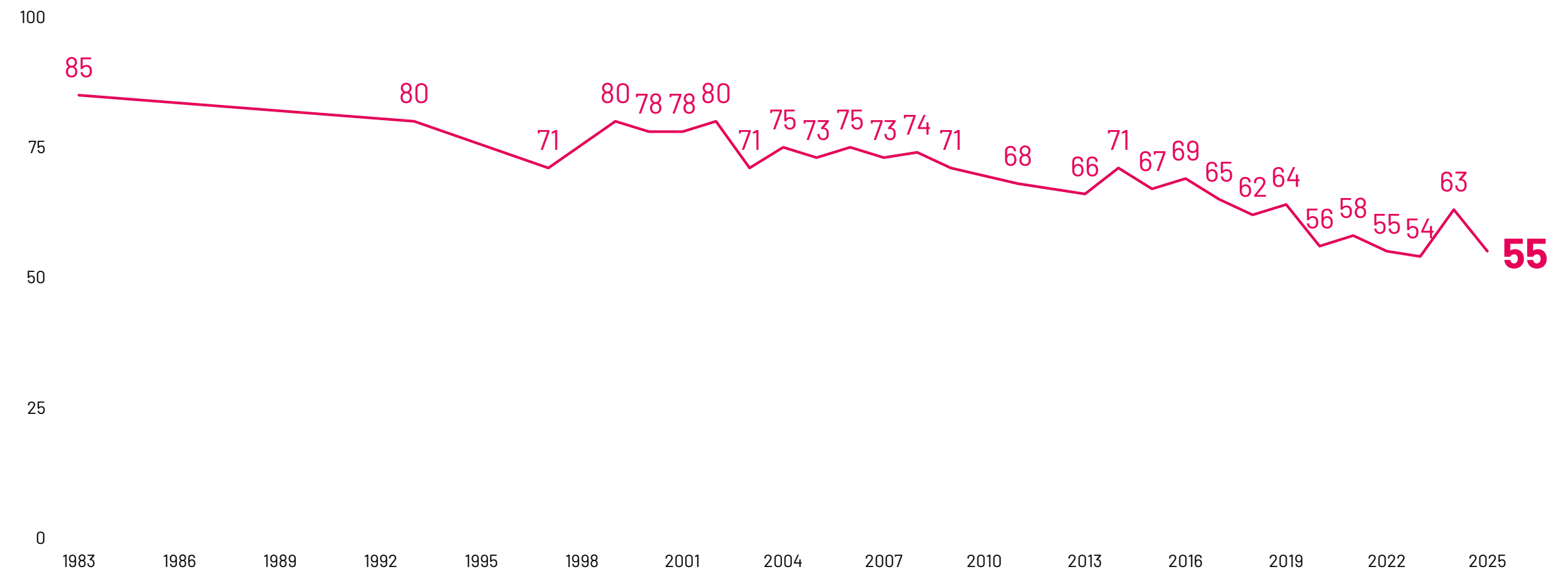

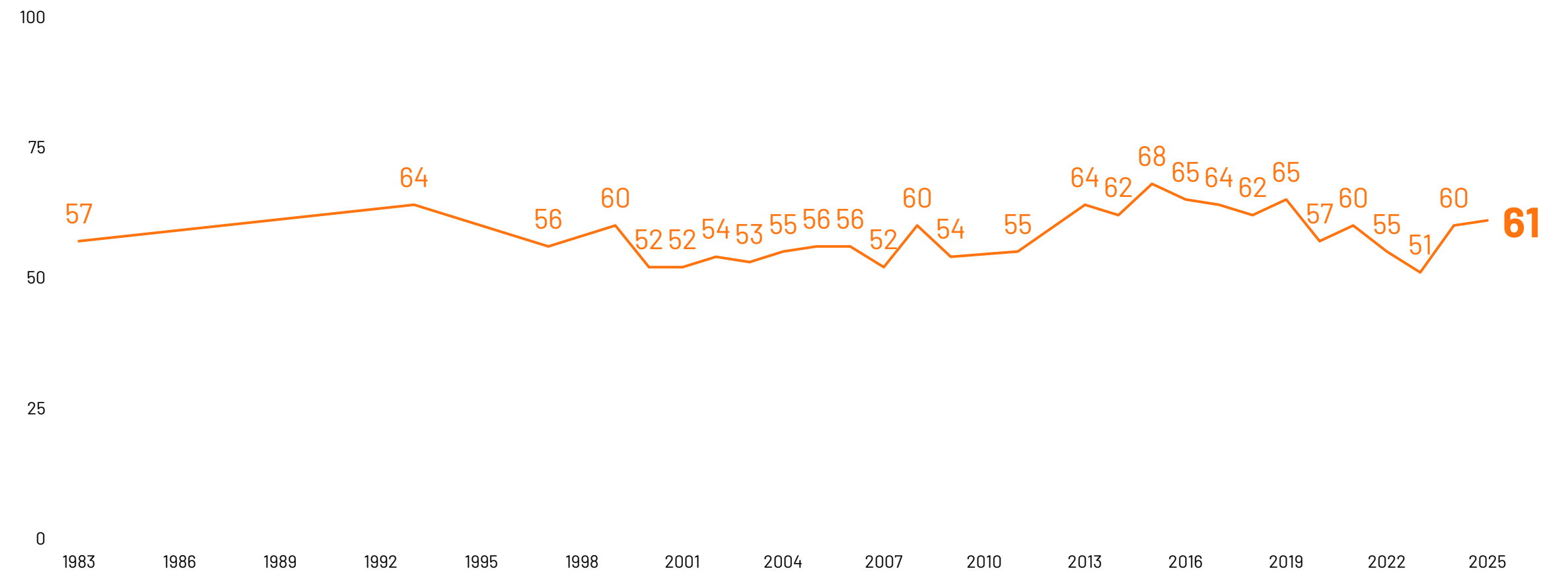

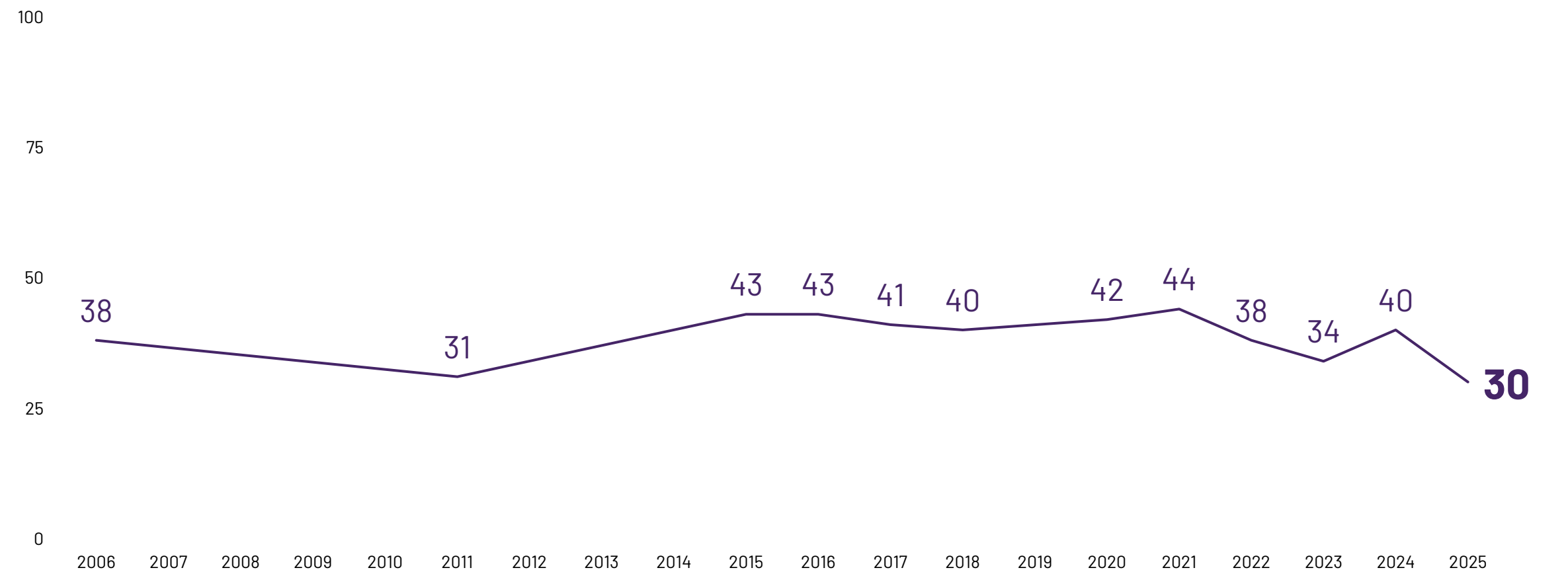

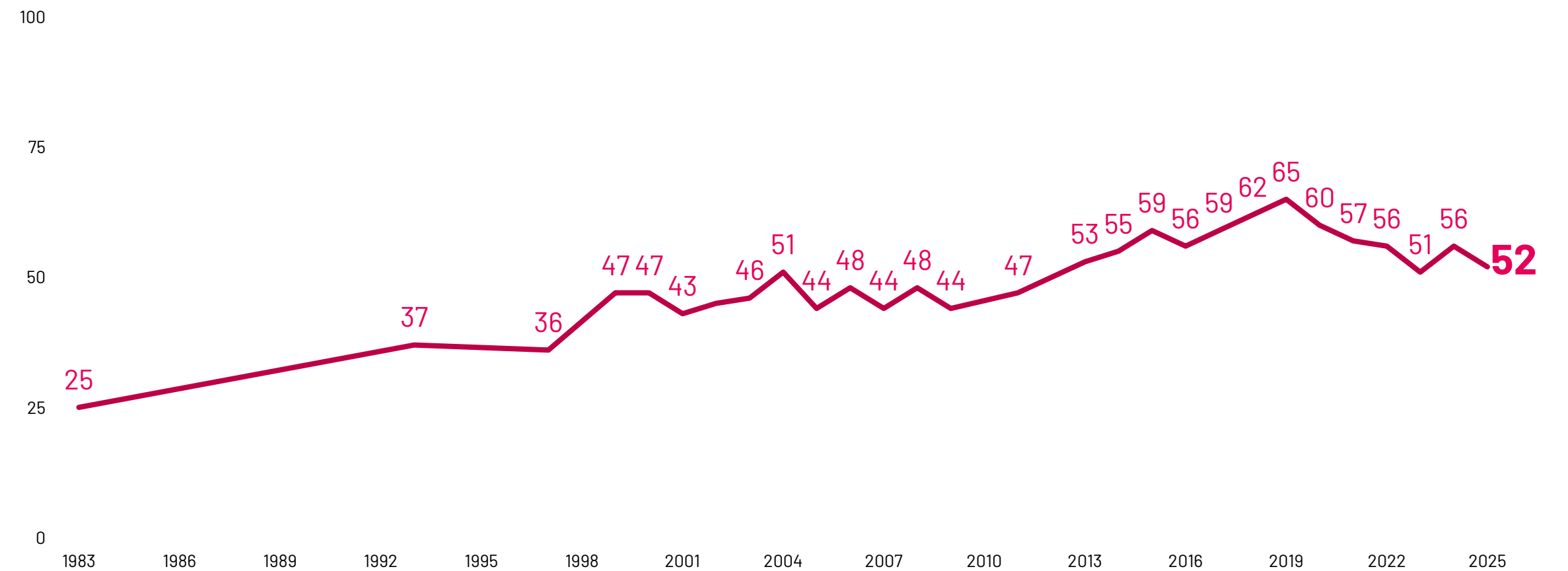

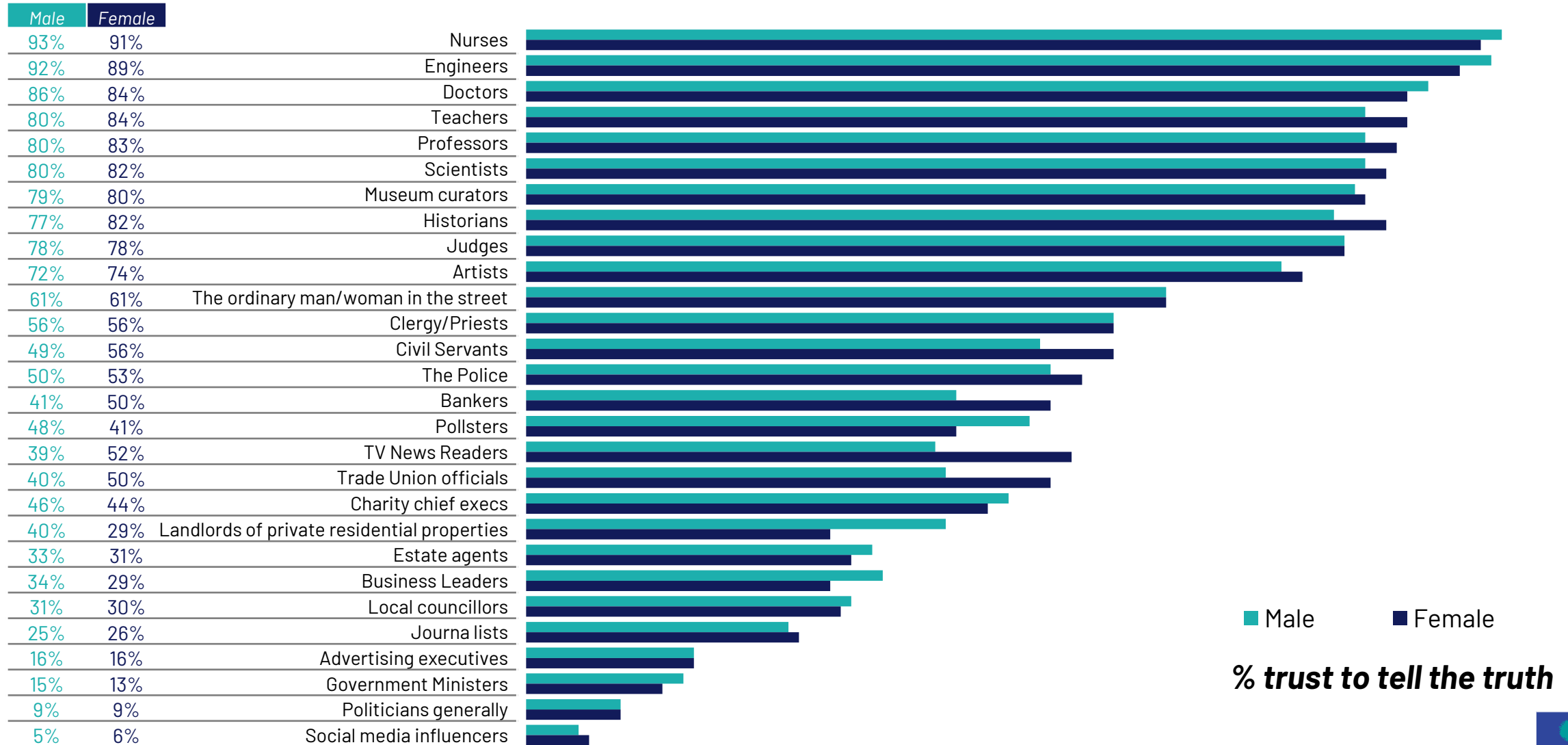

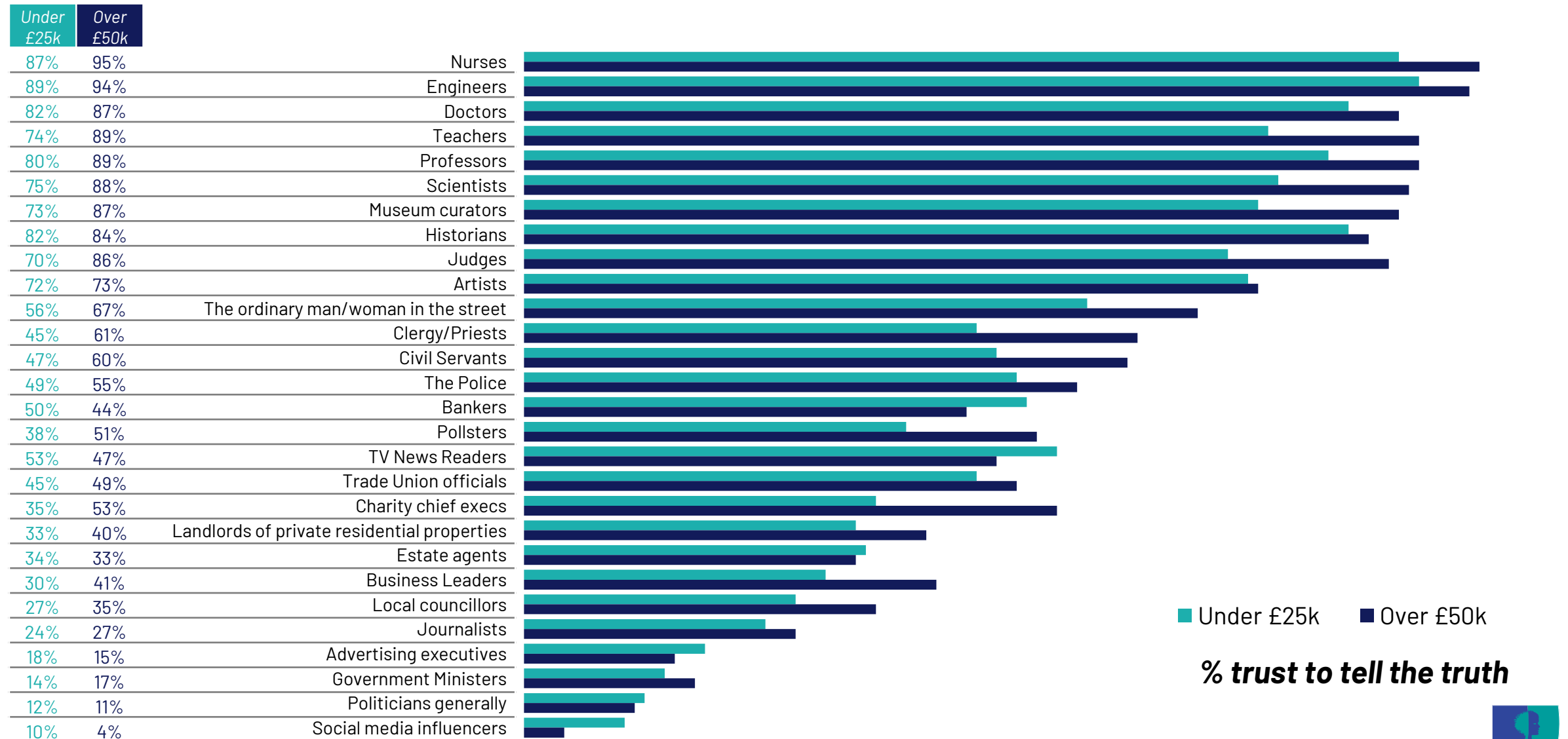

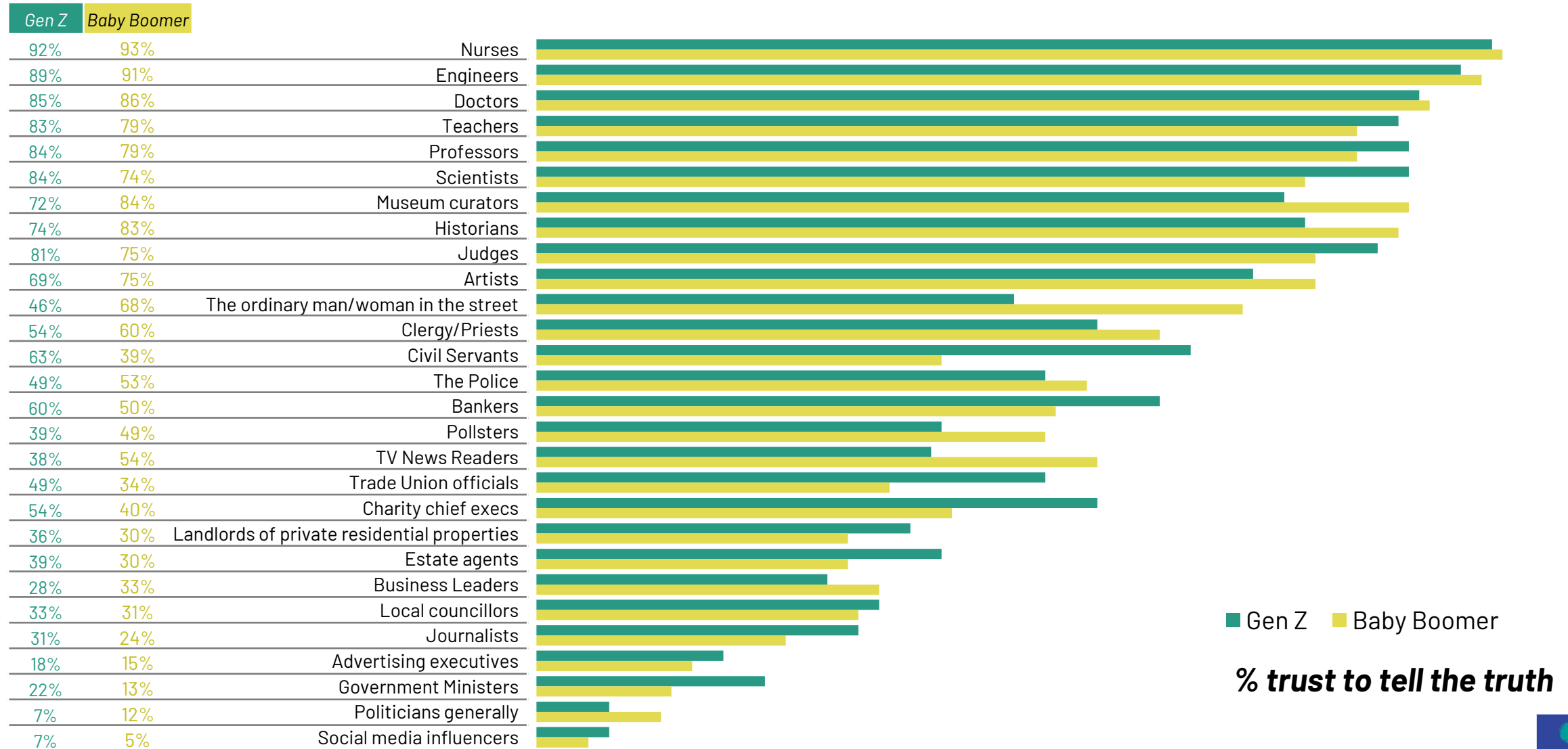
# Trust in professions by household income

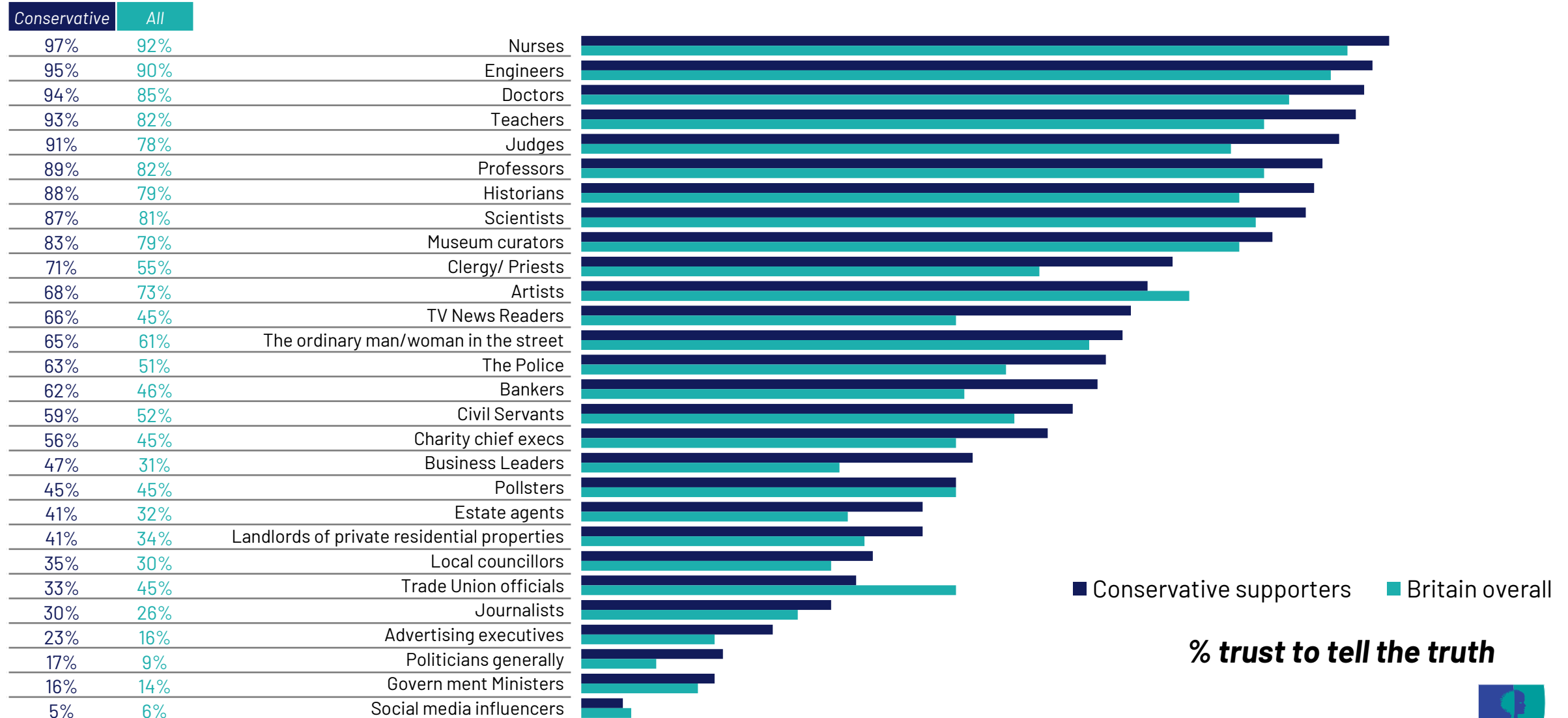
# Trust in professions by party preference - Labour

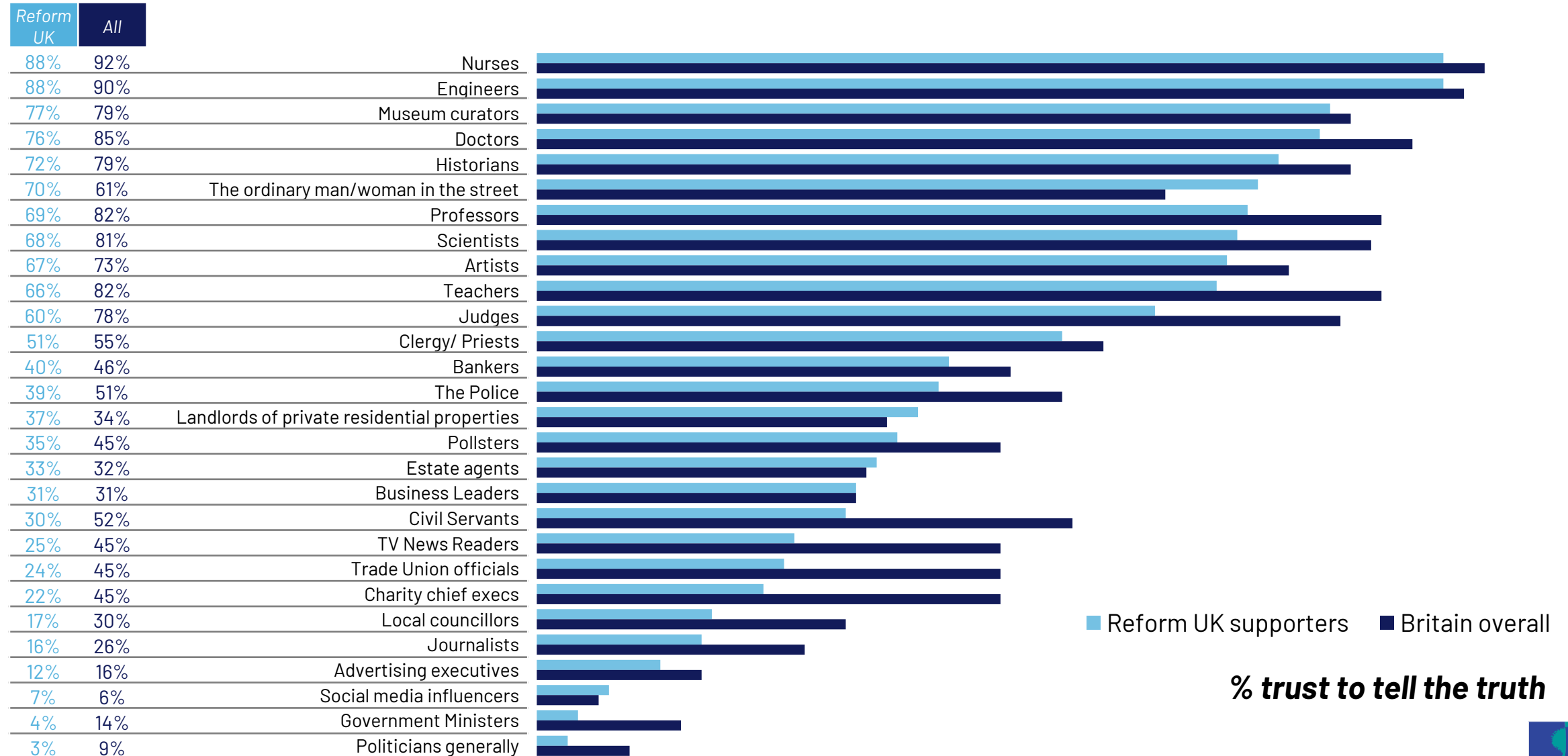

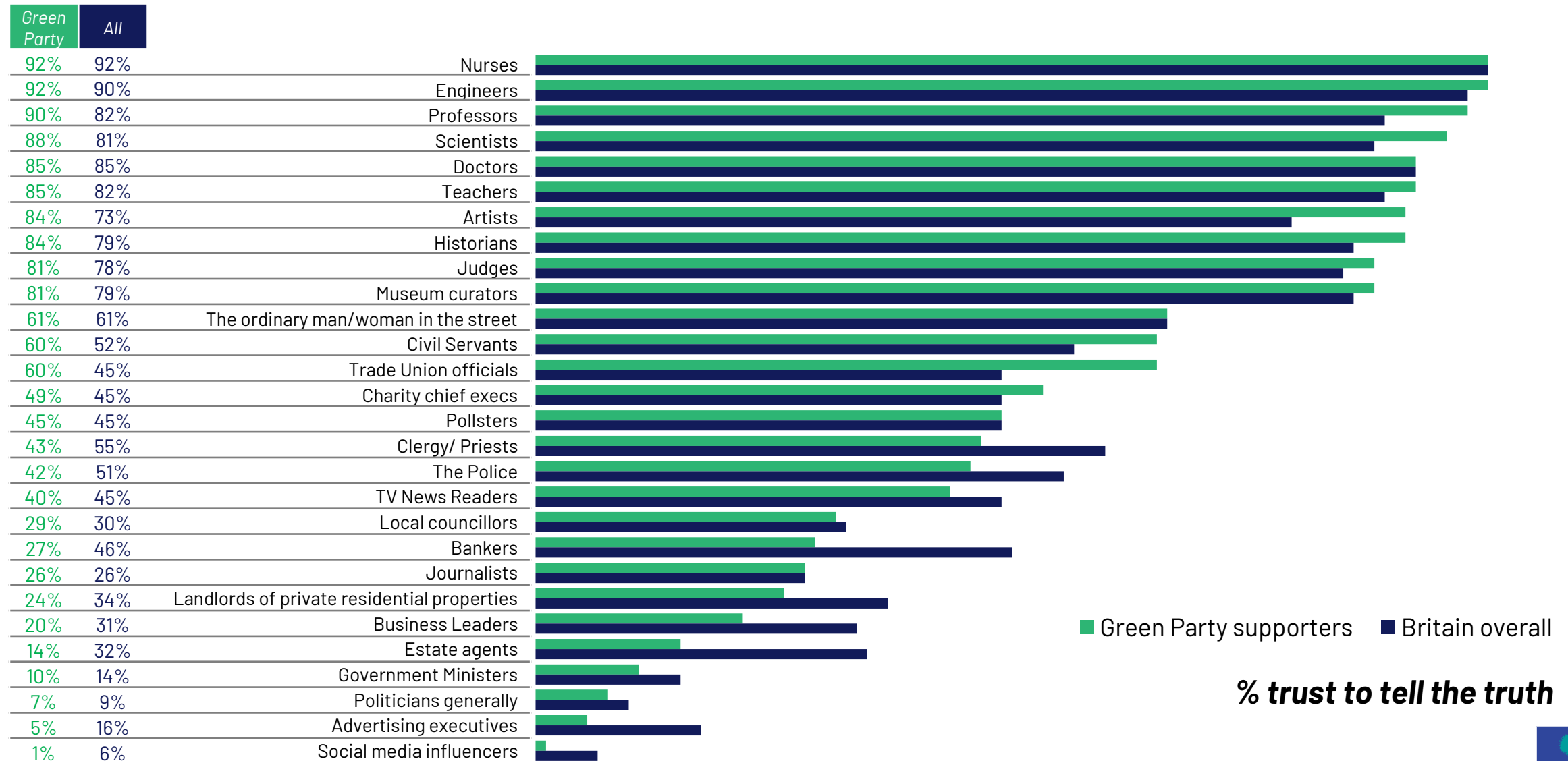

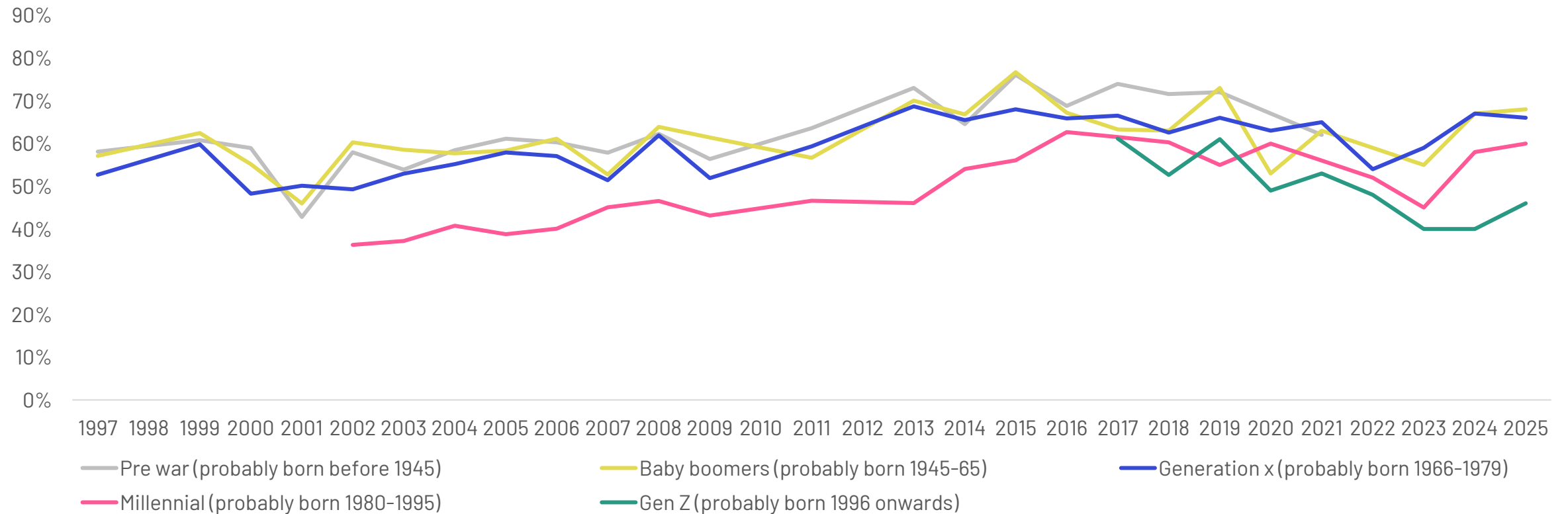

# TECHNICAL NOTE

This year's Veracity Index has been conducted using a telephone survey. Prior to 2020 (except for 2013) the index has used a face-to-face data collection methodology.

Mode effects should be kept in mind when comparing the results with previous years' data, especially when differences are close to the margin of error.

This year's survey was carried out over the telephone, with 1,022 British adults aged 16+ between 5 and 11 November 2025.

Data are weighted to the population profile. Where percentages do not sum to 100 this may be due to computer rounding. All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error.
