

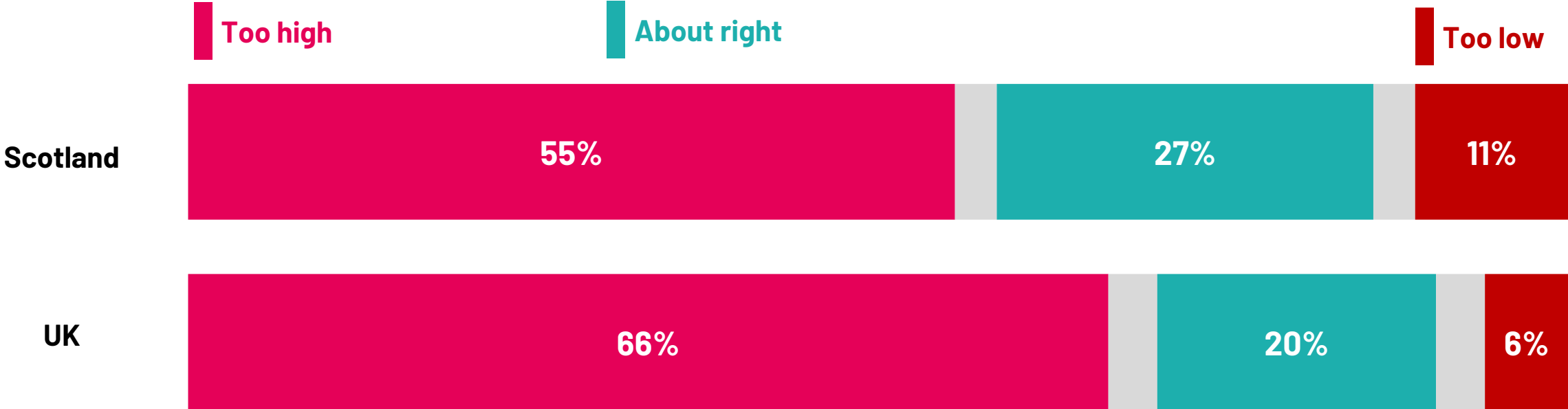

Do you think the total number of people coming into [Scotland / the UK] is too high, too low or about right?



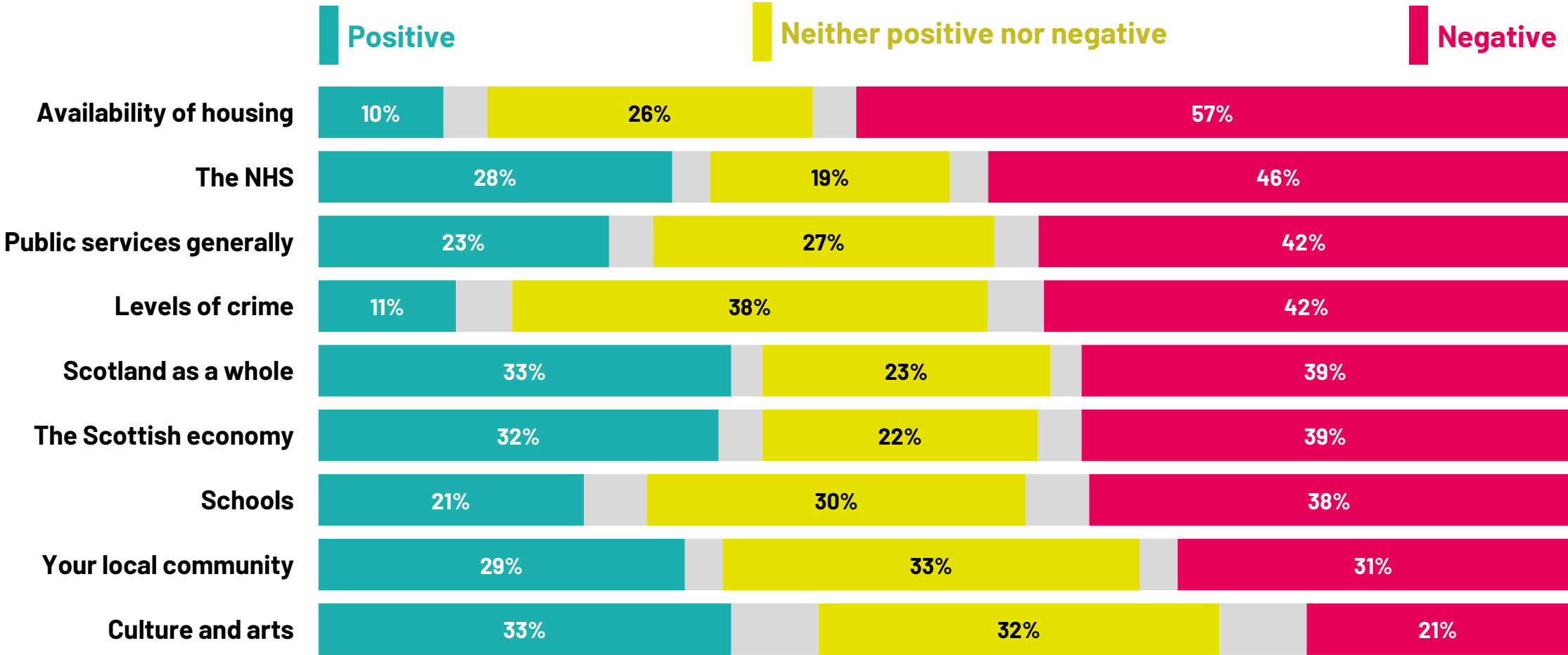

METHODS

- Ipsos interviewed a representative quota sample of 1,027 online adults aged 16+ in Scotland.
- Interviews took place online between 6th to 16th March 2026.
- Data has been weighted to the known offline population proportions.
- Where results do not sum to 100%, this may be due to computer rounding, multiple responses, or the exclusion of “don’t know” categories.
- All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error.
