

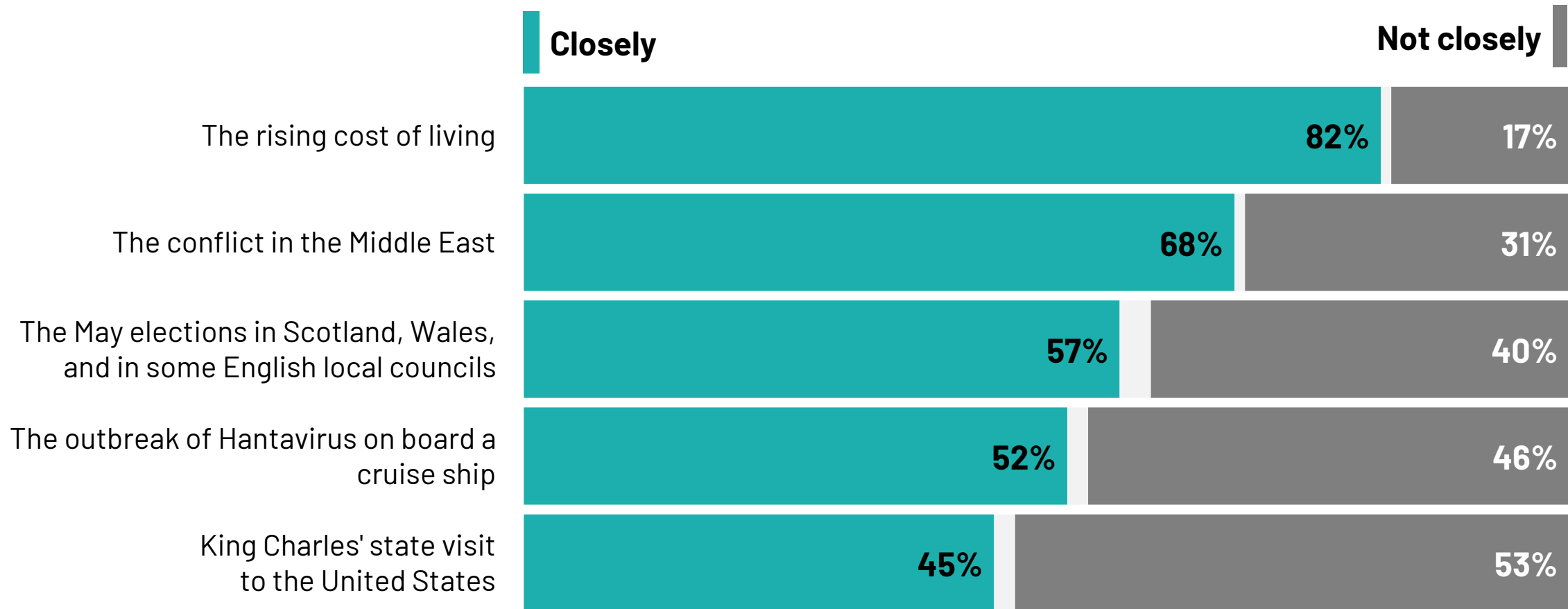

How closely, if at all, have you been following stories about...?



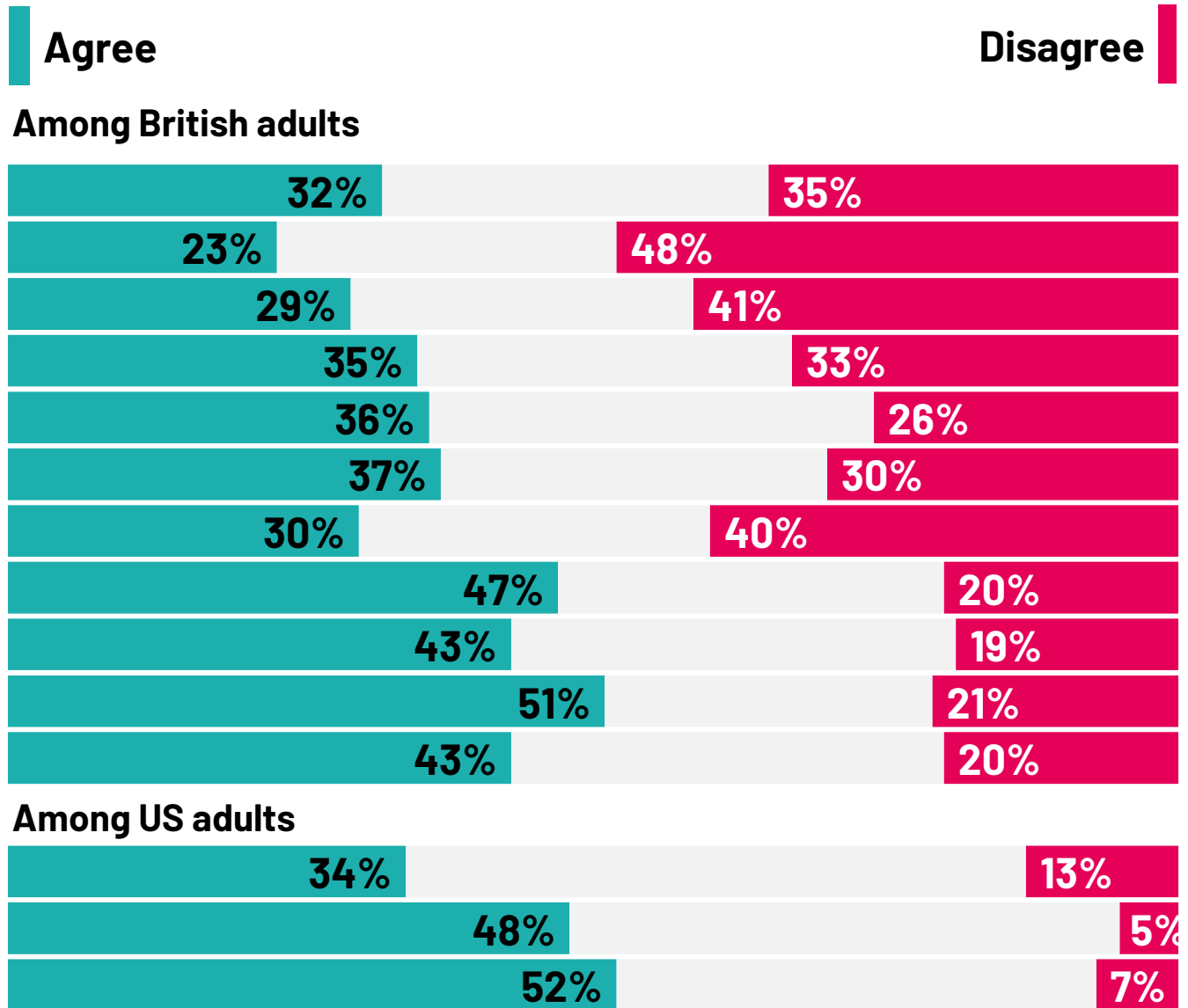

To what extent do you agree or disagree that there is currently a special relationship between the United States and Britain?

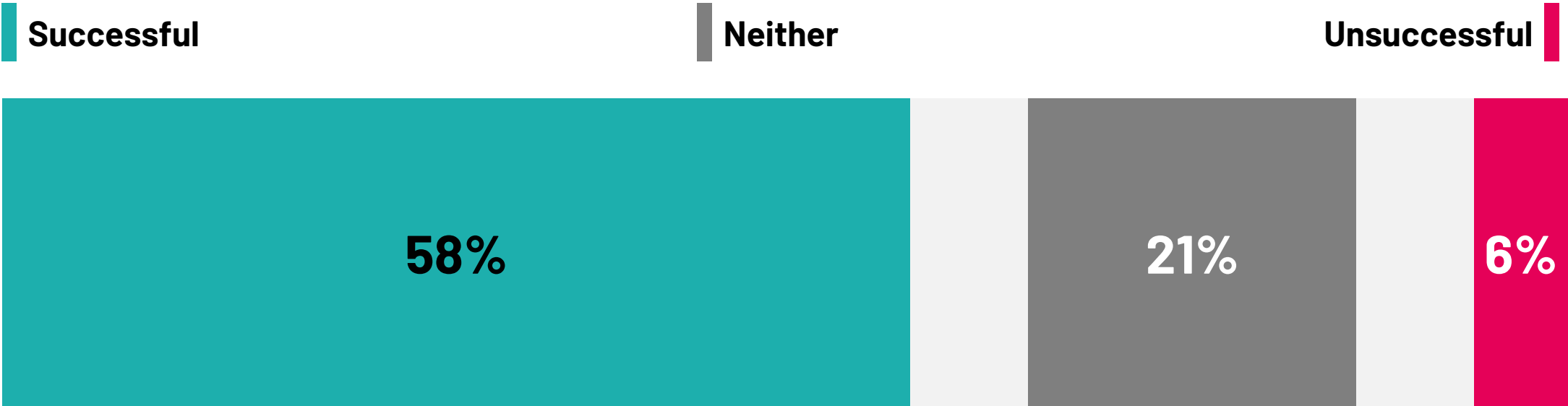

Over half of Britons think that King Charles III's state visit to the US was successful

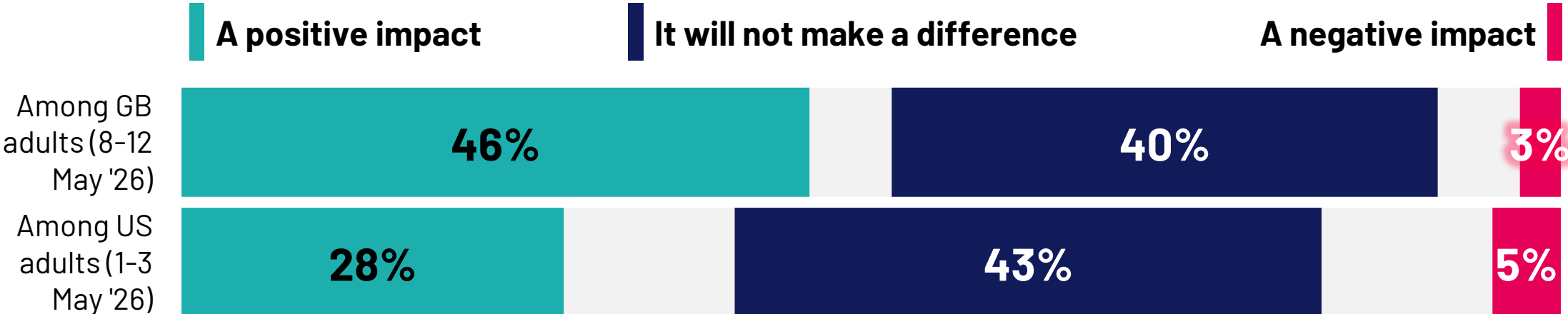
