

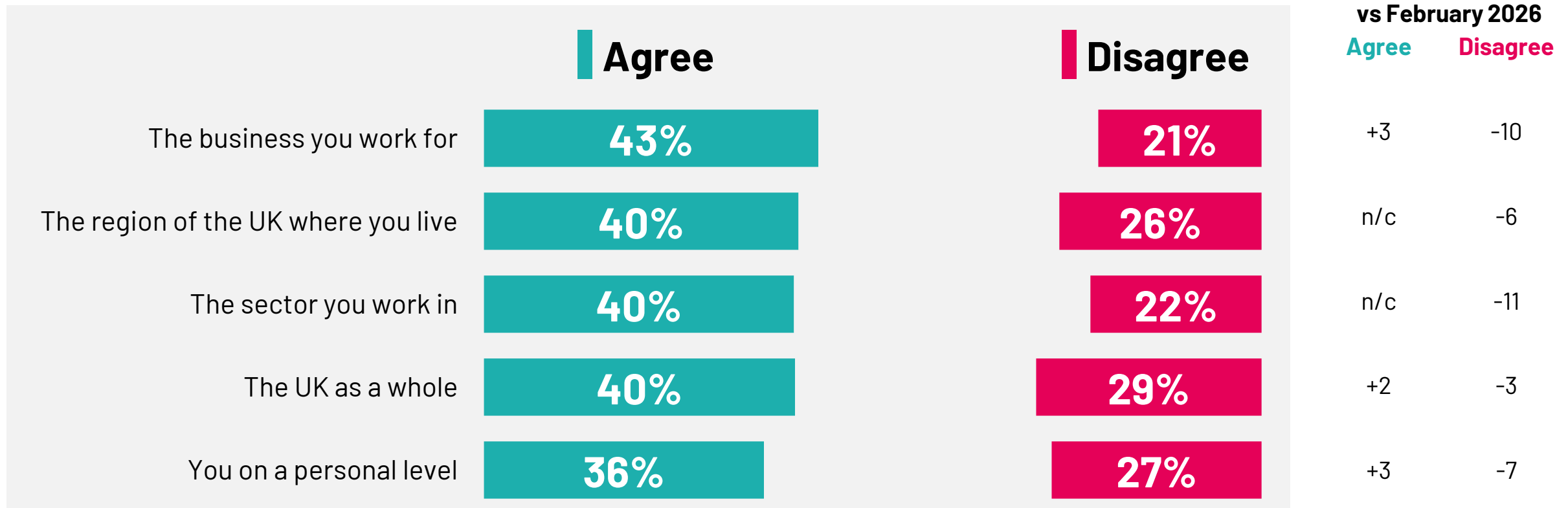

Two in five businesses say the government's economic policies will benefit them, their sectors, region and the UK as a whole

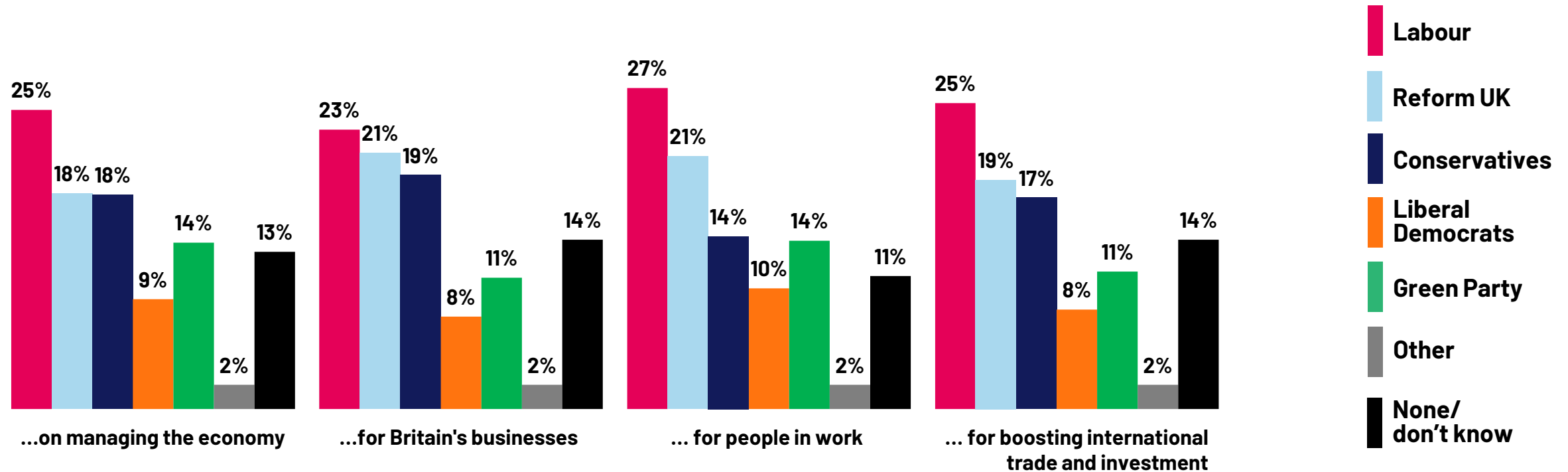
To what extent do you agree or disagree that the government has economic policies that will benefit...?

One in four businesses say Labour has the best policies for managing the economy, British businesses, people in work and boosting trade and investment

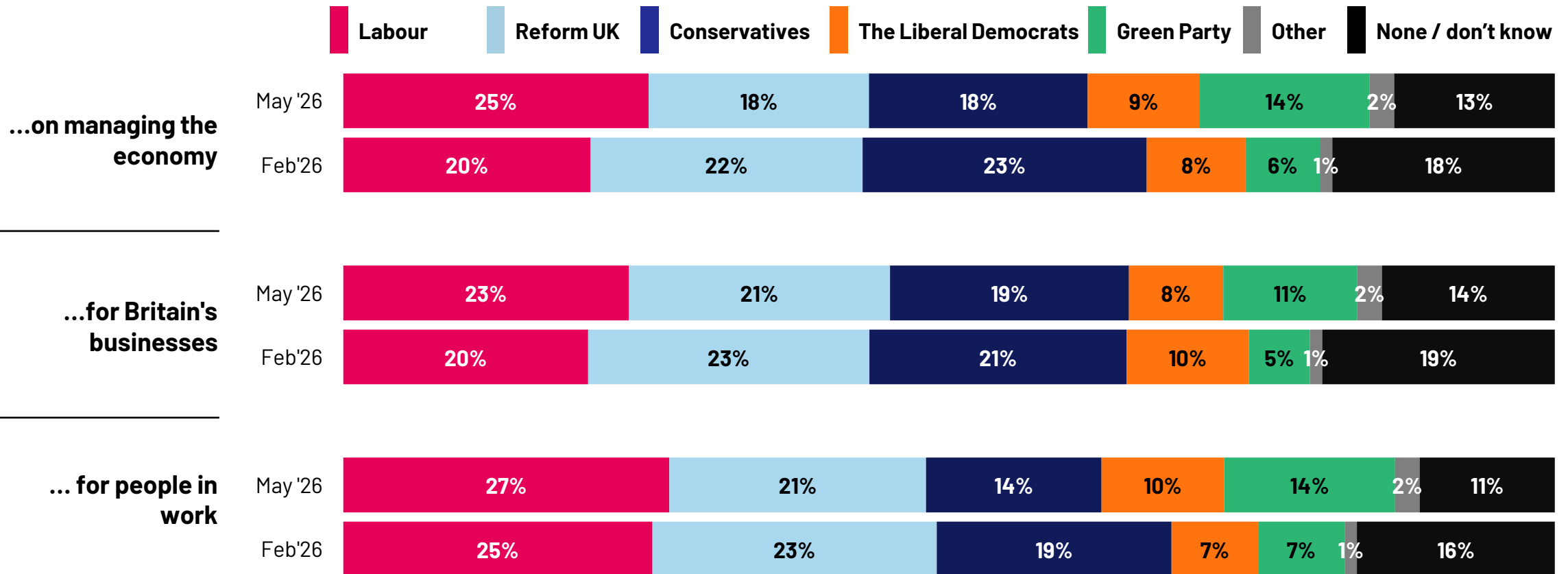
Which party, if any, do you think has the best policies ... ?

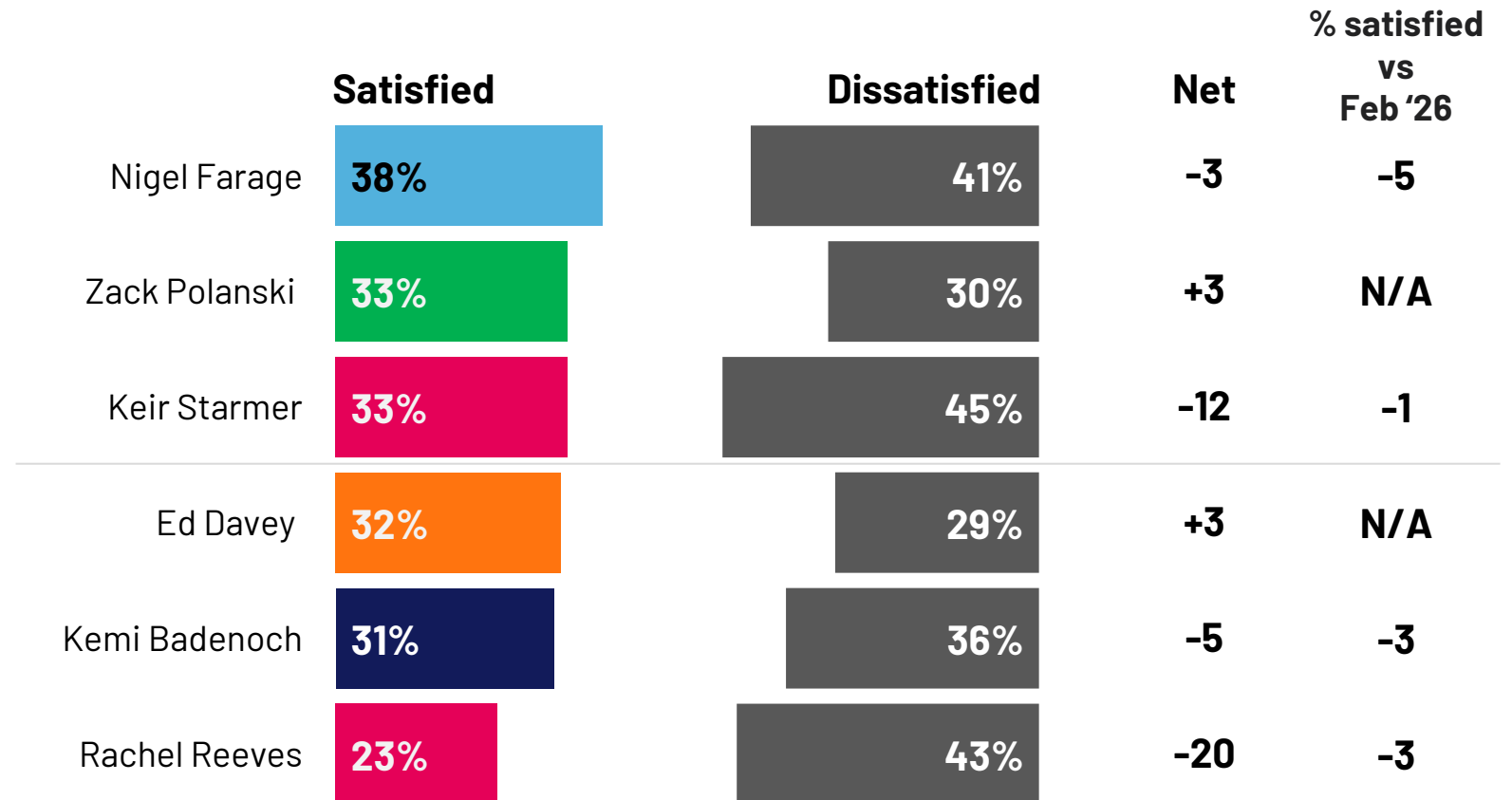

How satisfied or unsatisfied are you with the way each of the following are doing their job?

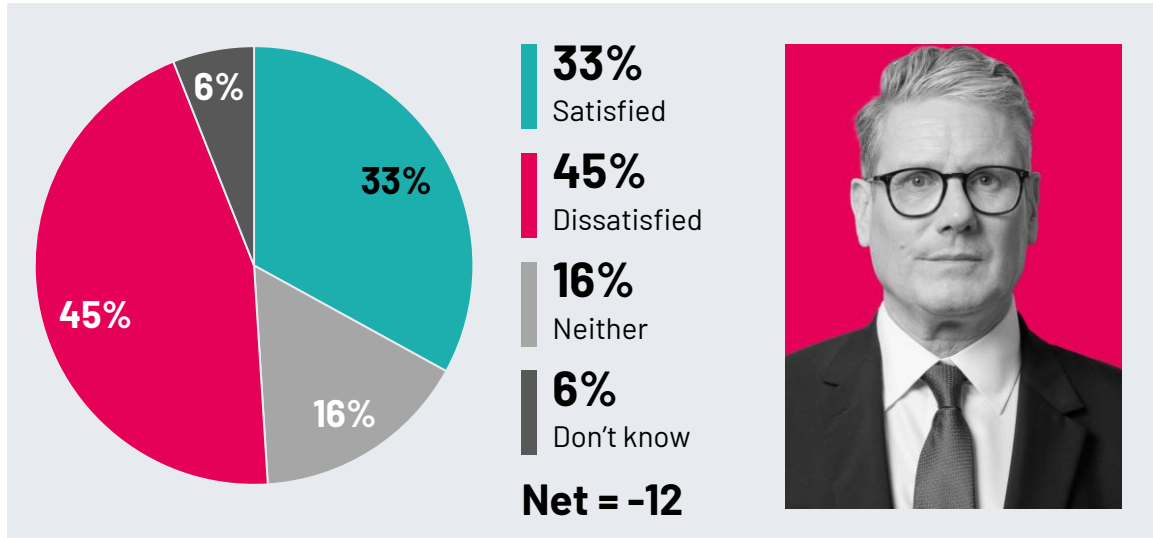

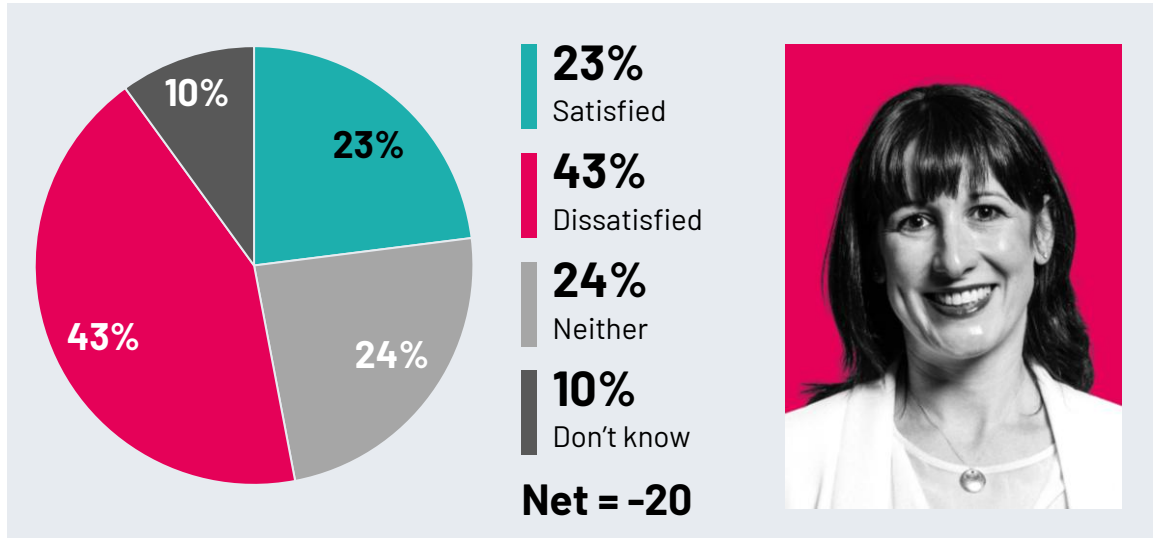

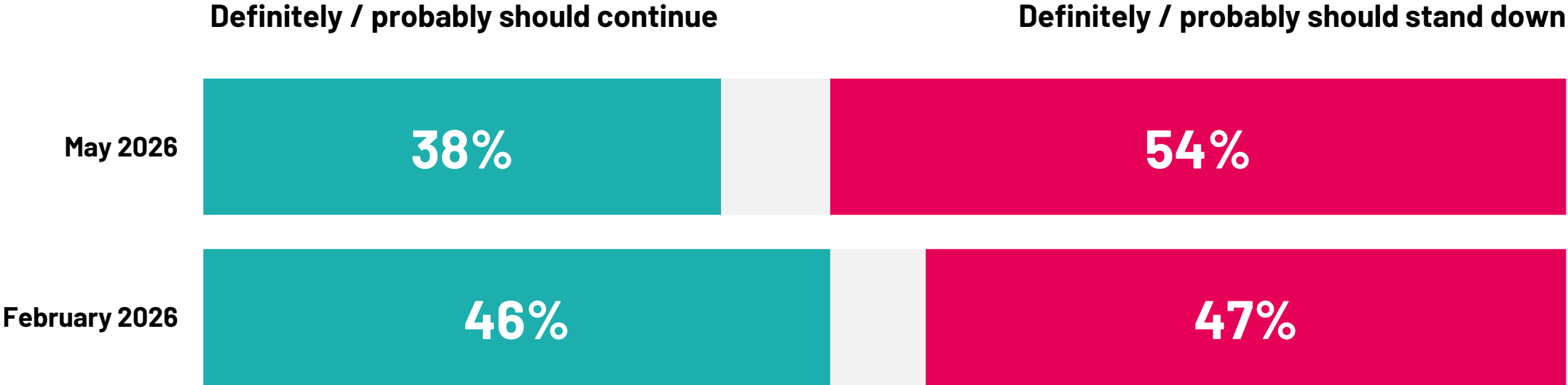

To what extent do you think Keir Starmer should continue as Prime Minister and Leader of the Labour party, or should he stand down and let someone else takeover?

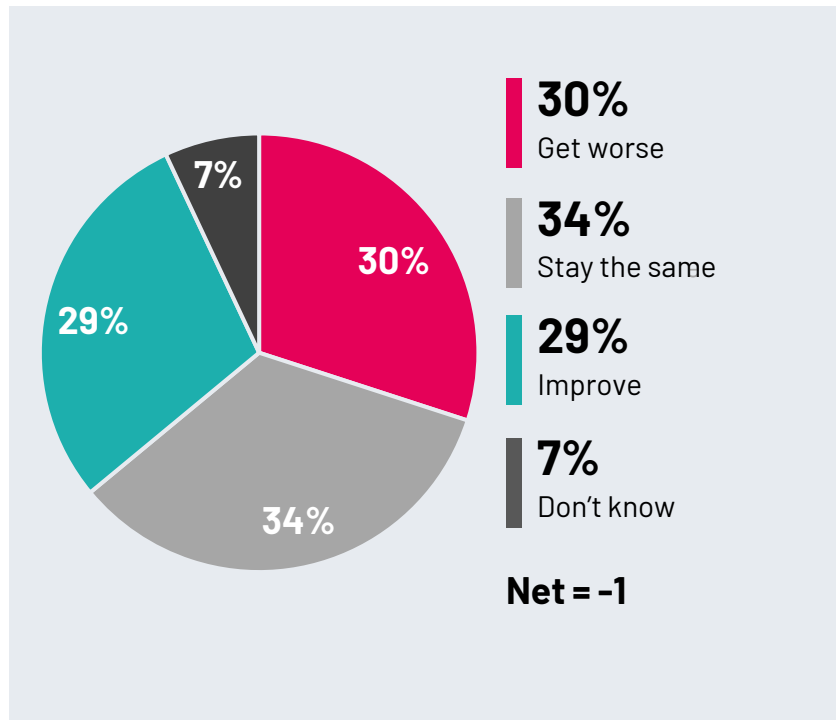

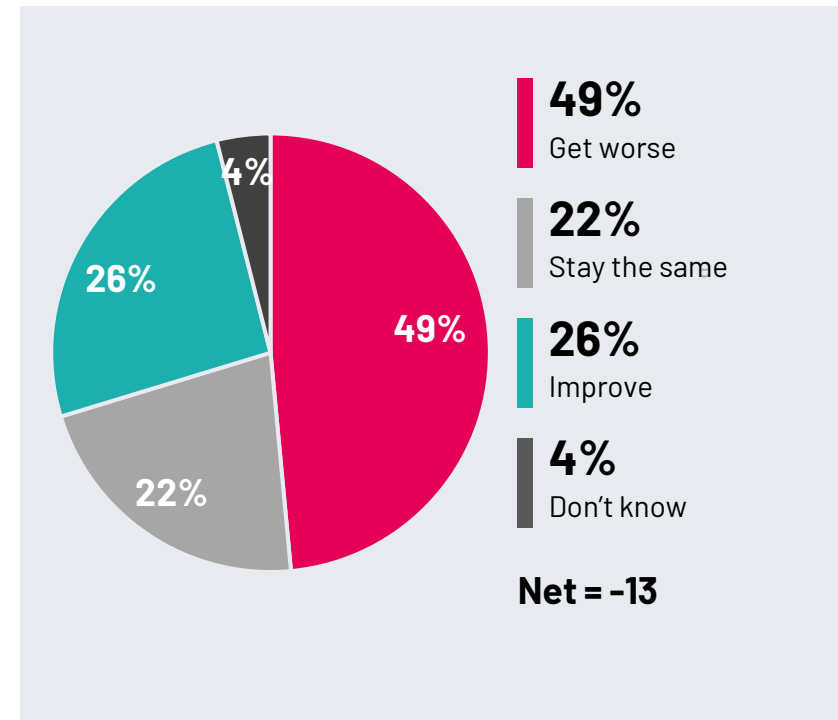


Three in ten businesses think their financial condition will get worse over the next 12 months

Do you think that the general **financial condition of your business** will improve, stay the same, or get worse over the next 12 months?



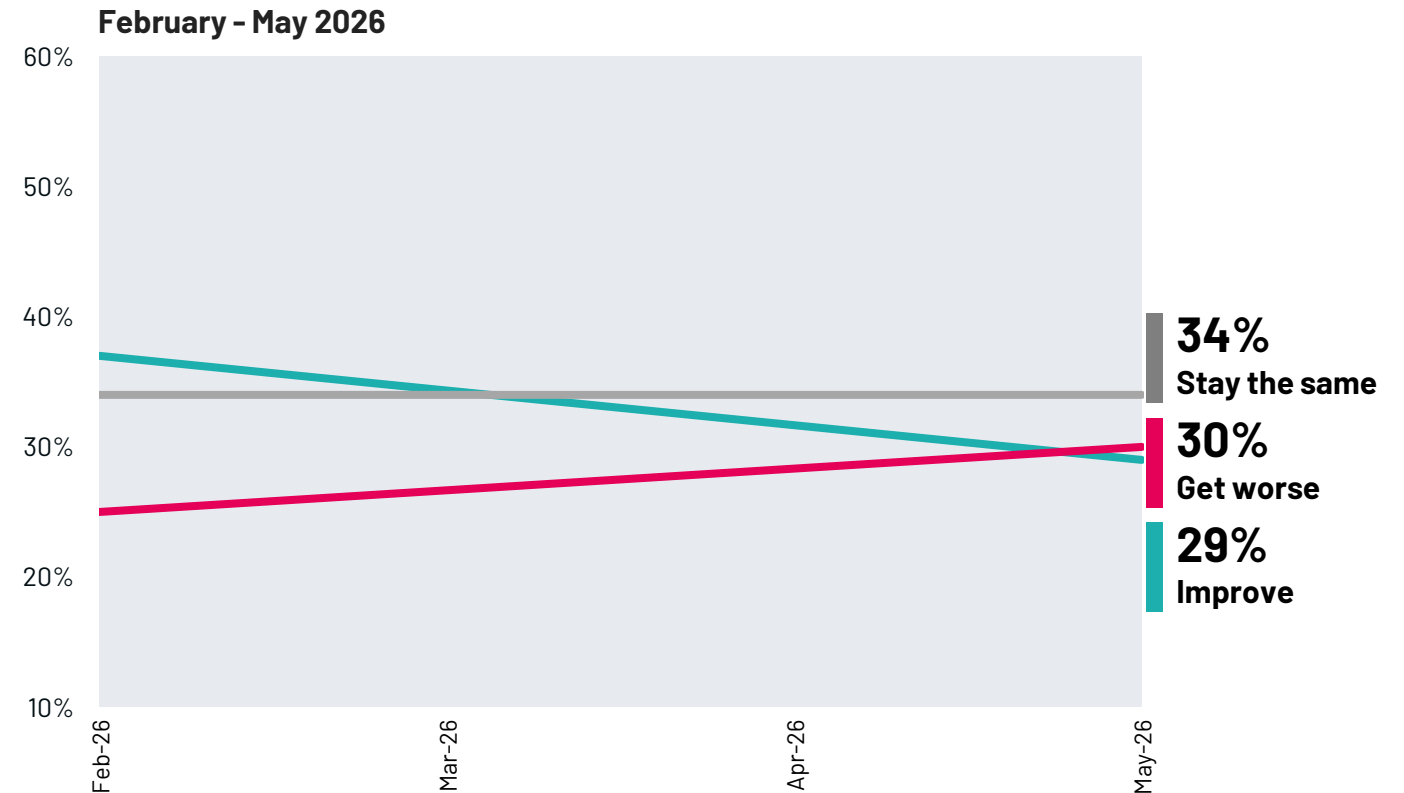
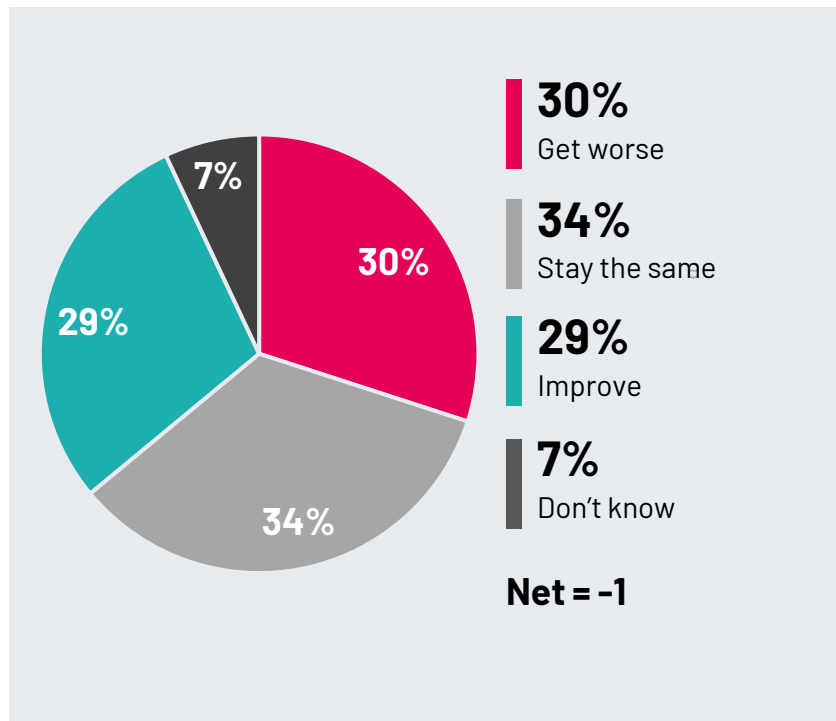
Do you think that the general **economic condition of the country** will improve, stay the same, or get worse over the next 12 months?

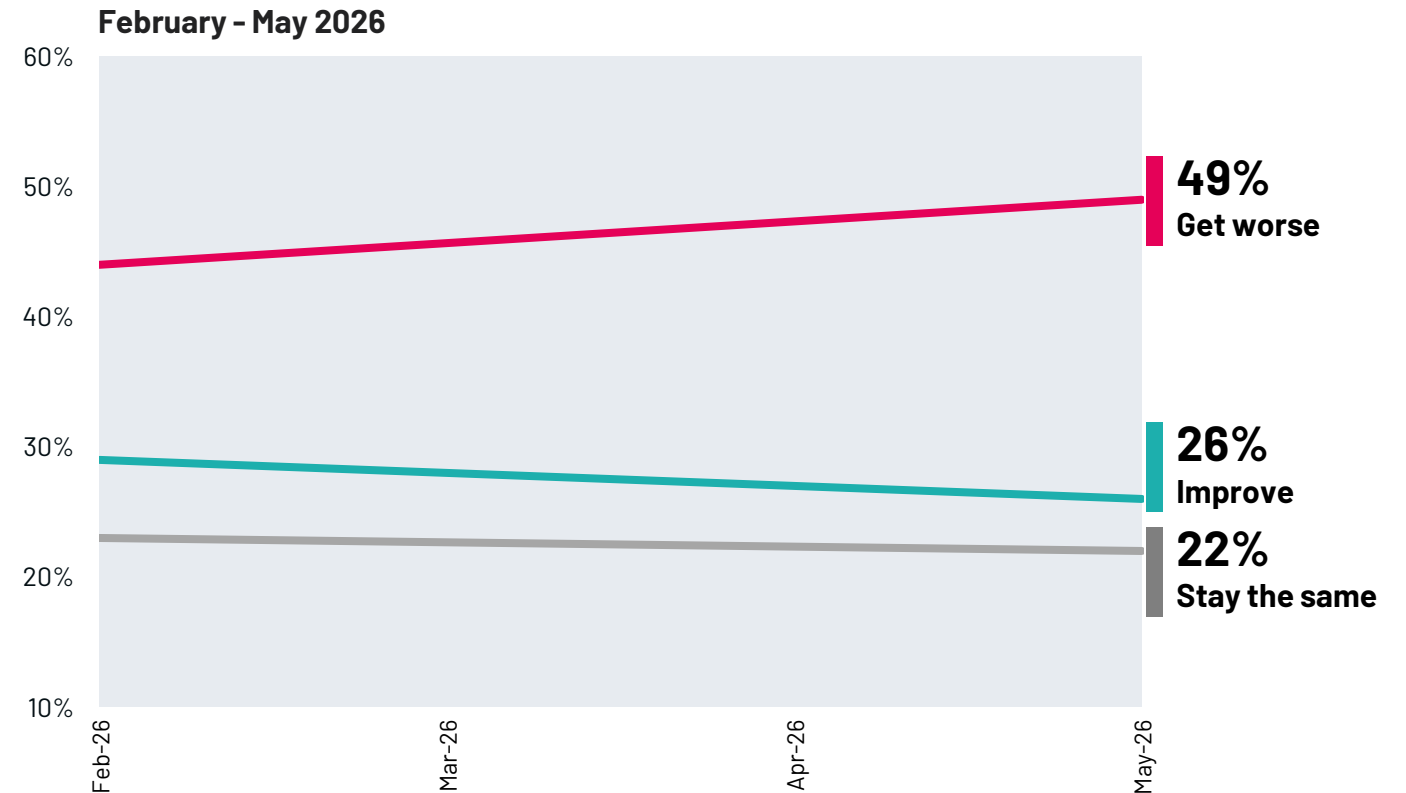
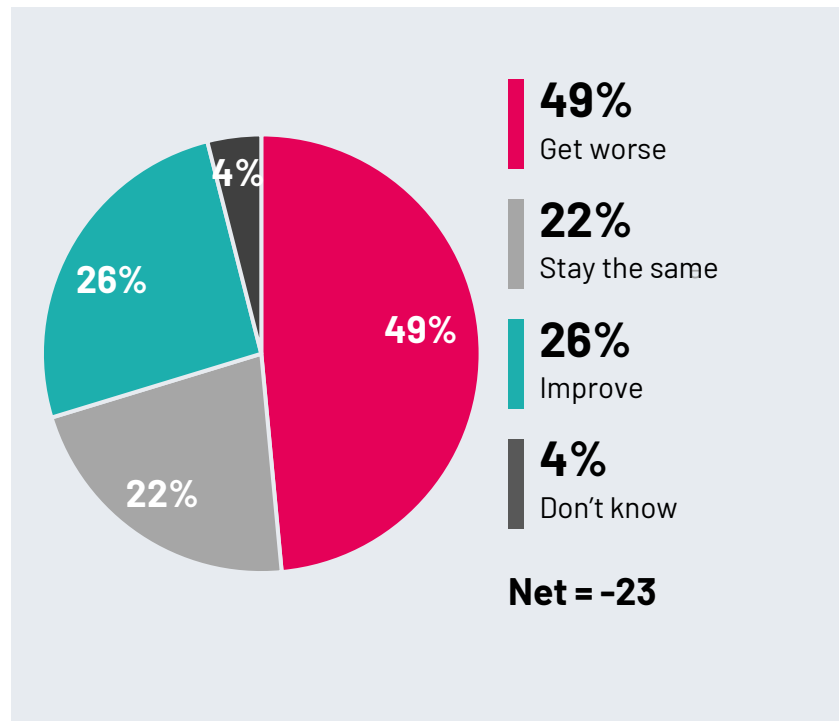
Do you think that the general **financial condition of your business** will improve, stay the same, or get worse over the next 12 months?

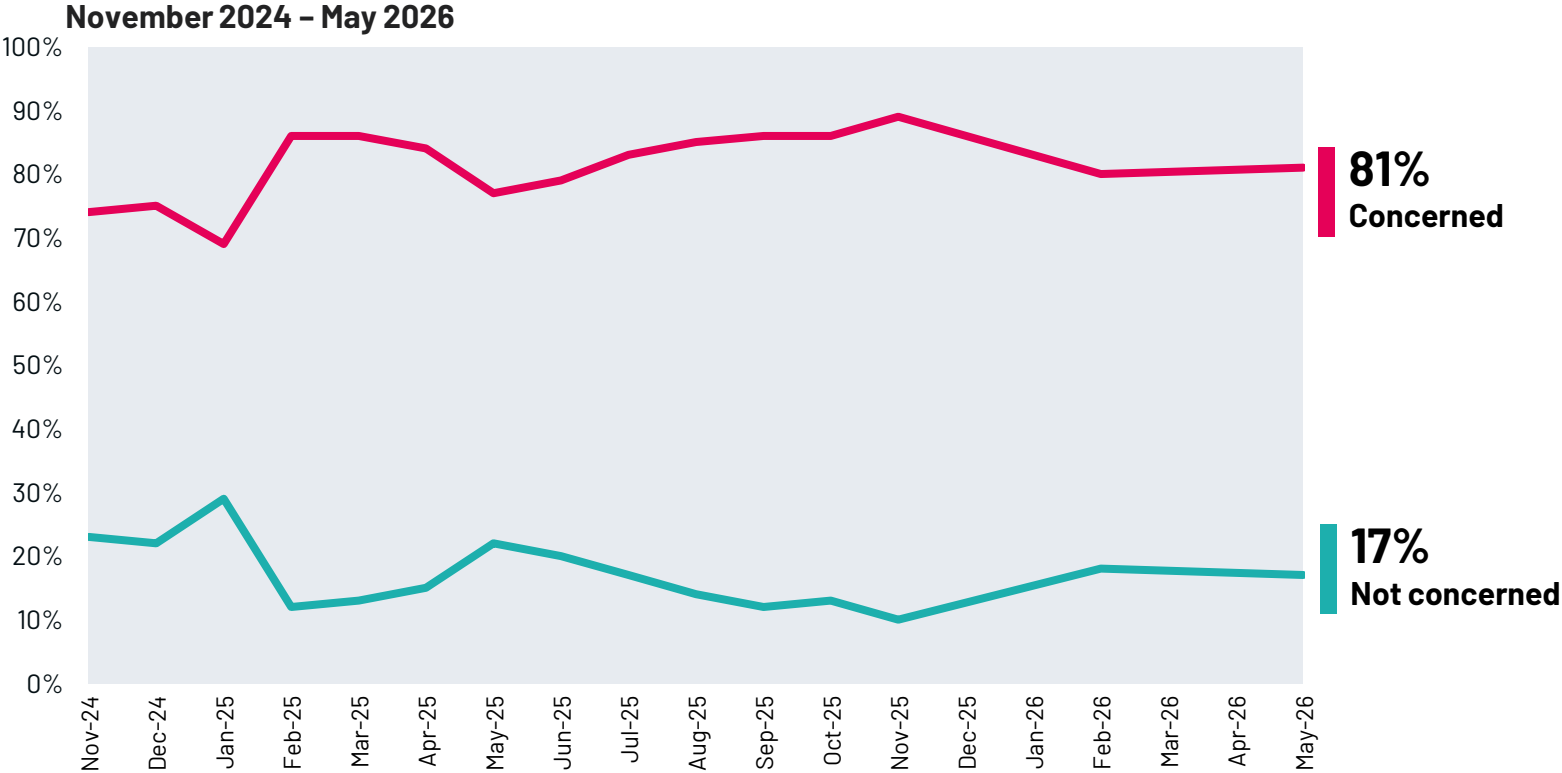
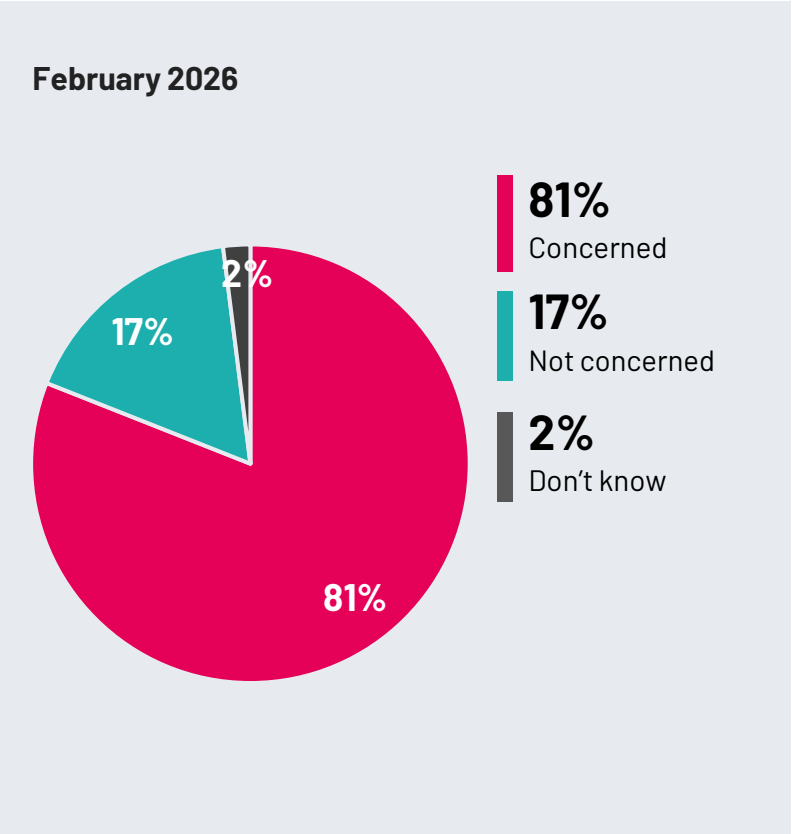

How concerned are you about the economic outlook over the next 6 months?

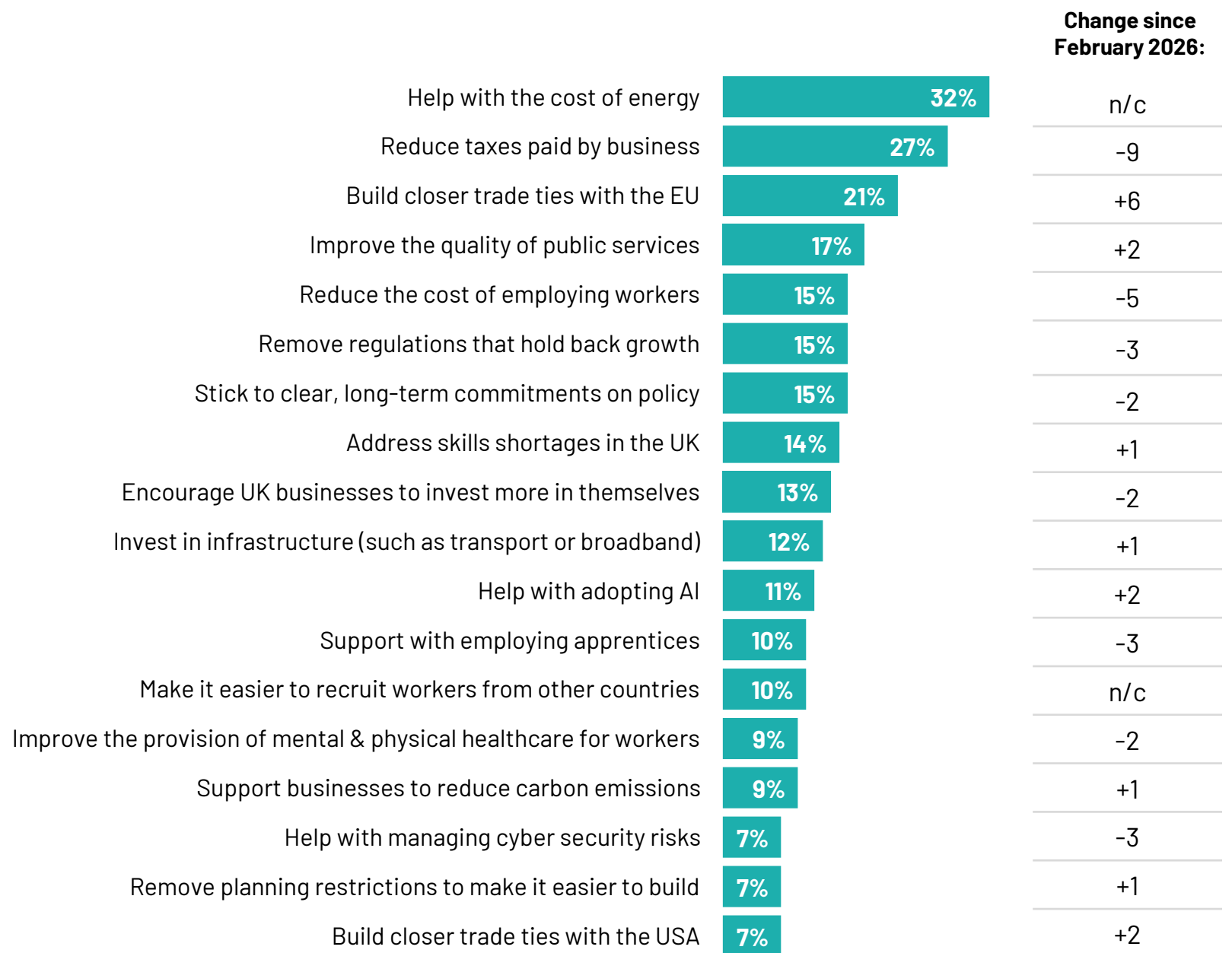

Help with the cost of energy, reductions to business tax and a closer relationship with the EU are the top priorities for businesses

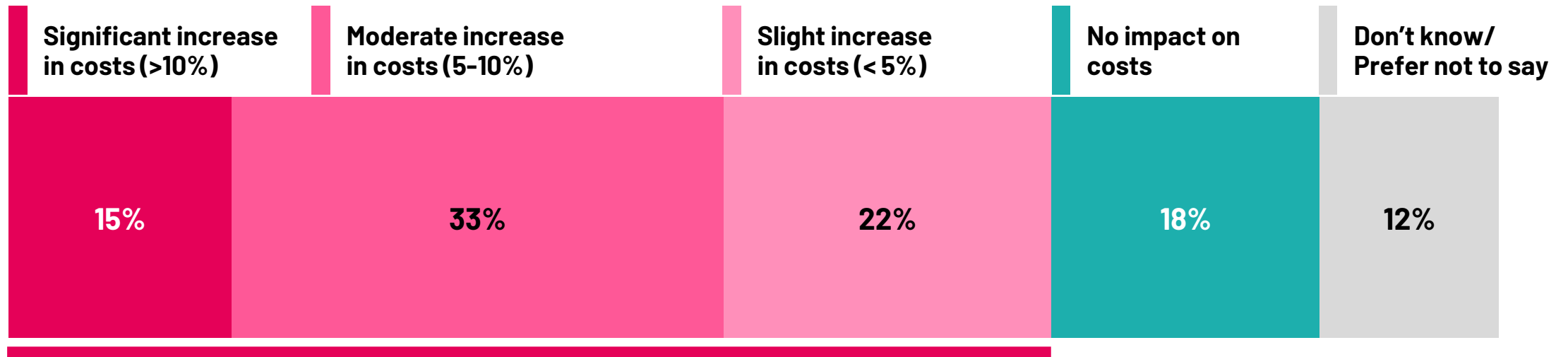

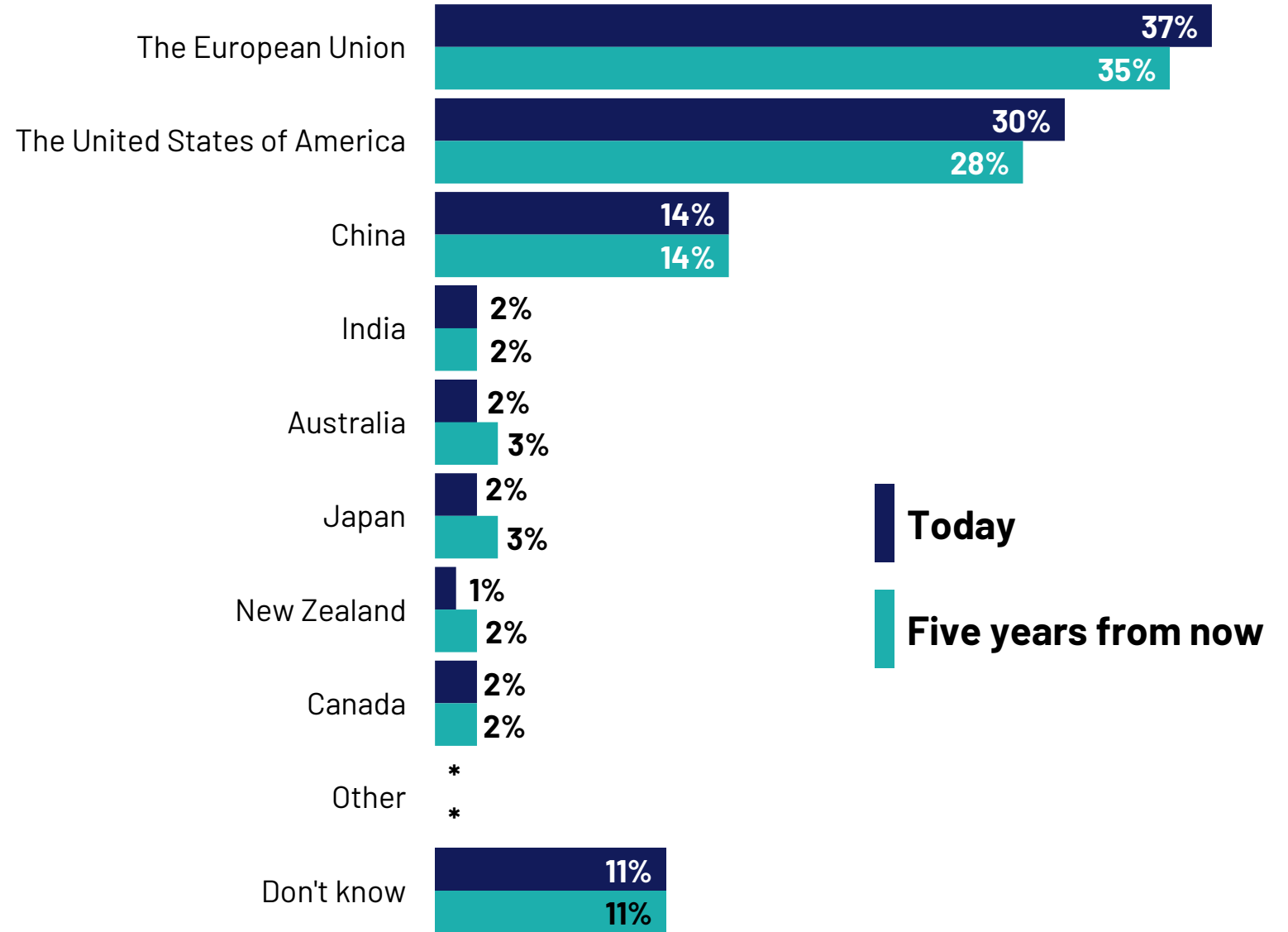
To what extent do you agree or disagree that there is currently a special relationship between the United States and Britain?

Over a third of business say the EU is today and will five years from now be Britain's most important trade partner

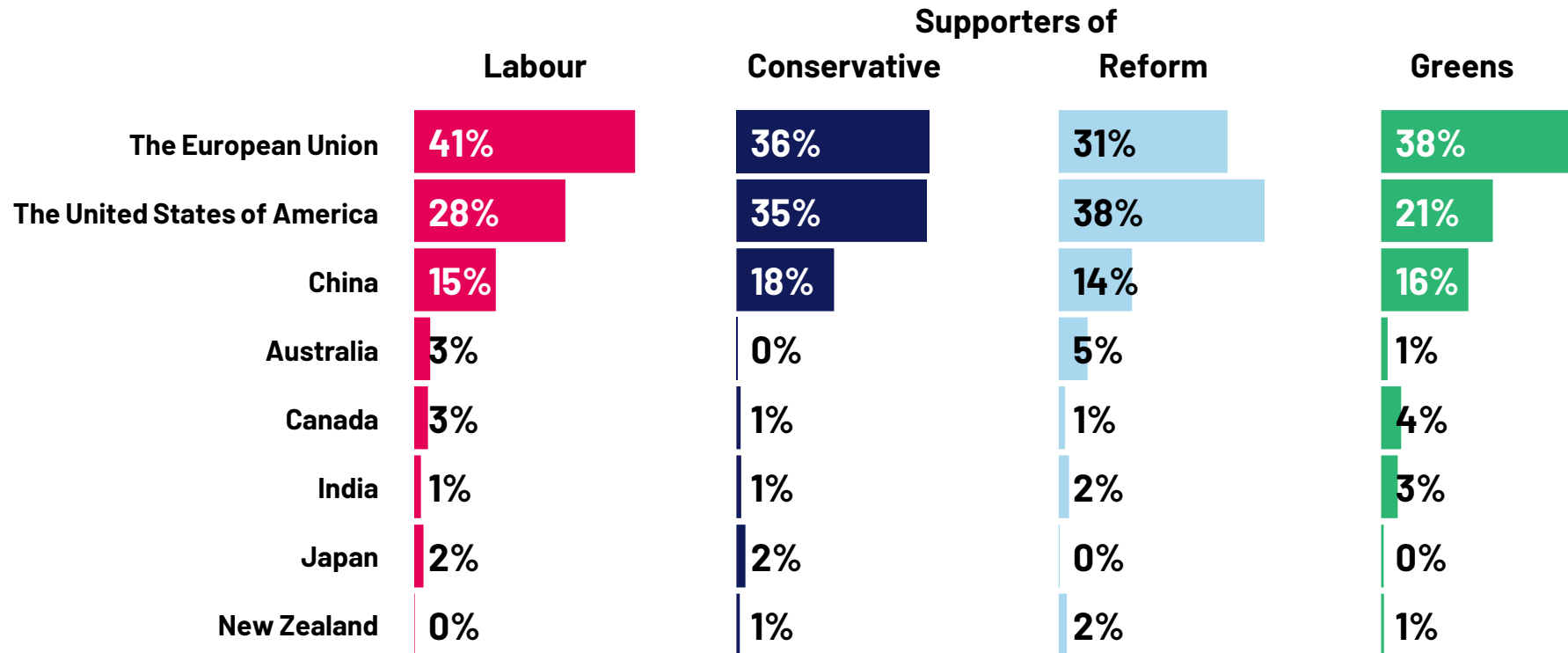
Which of the following, if any, do you consider to be Britain's most important trade partner...?
