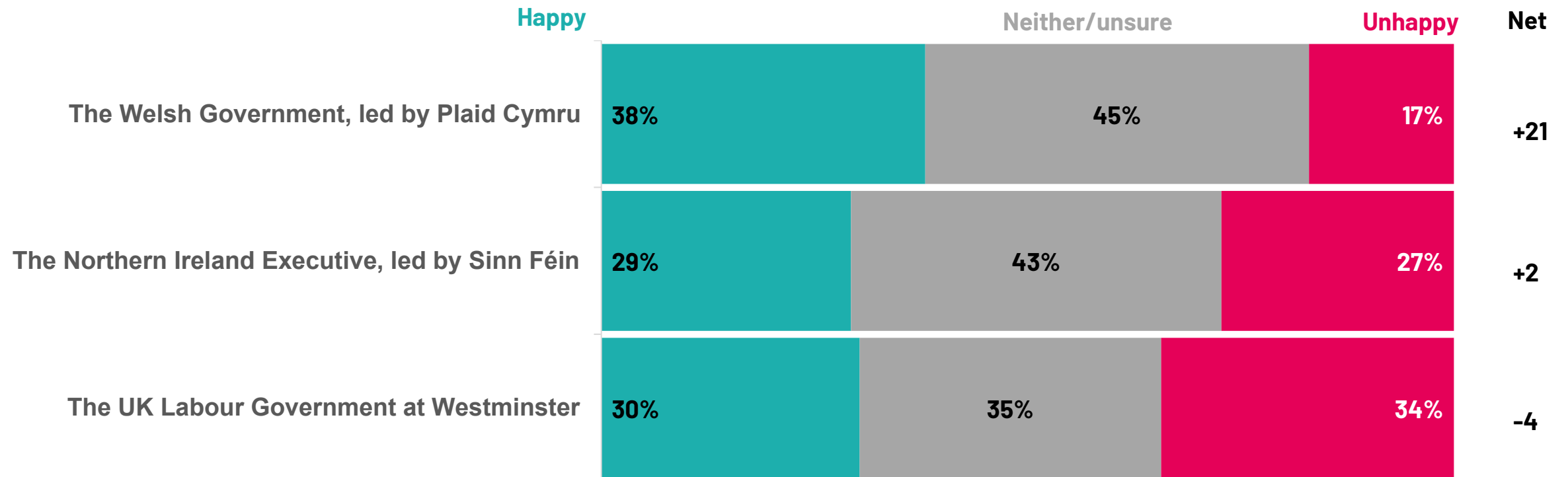

Views on Scottish Government collaboration with devolved governments

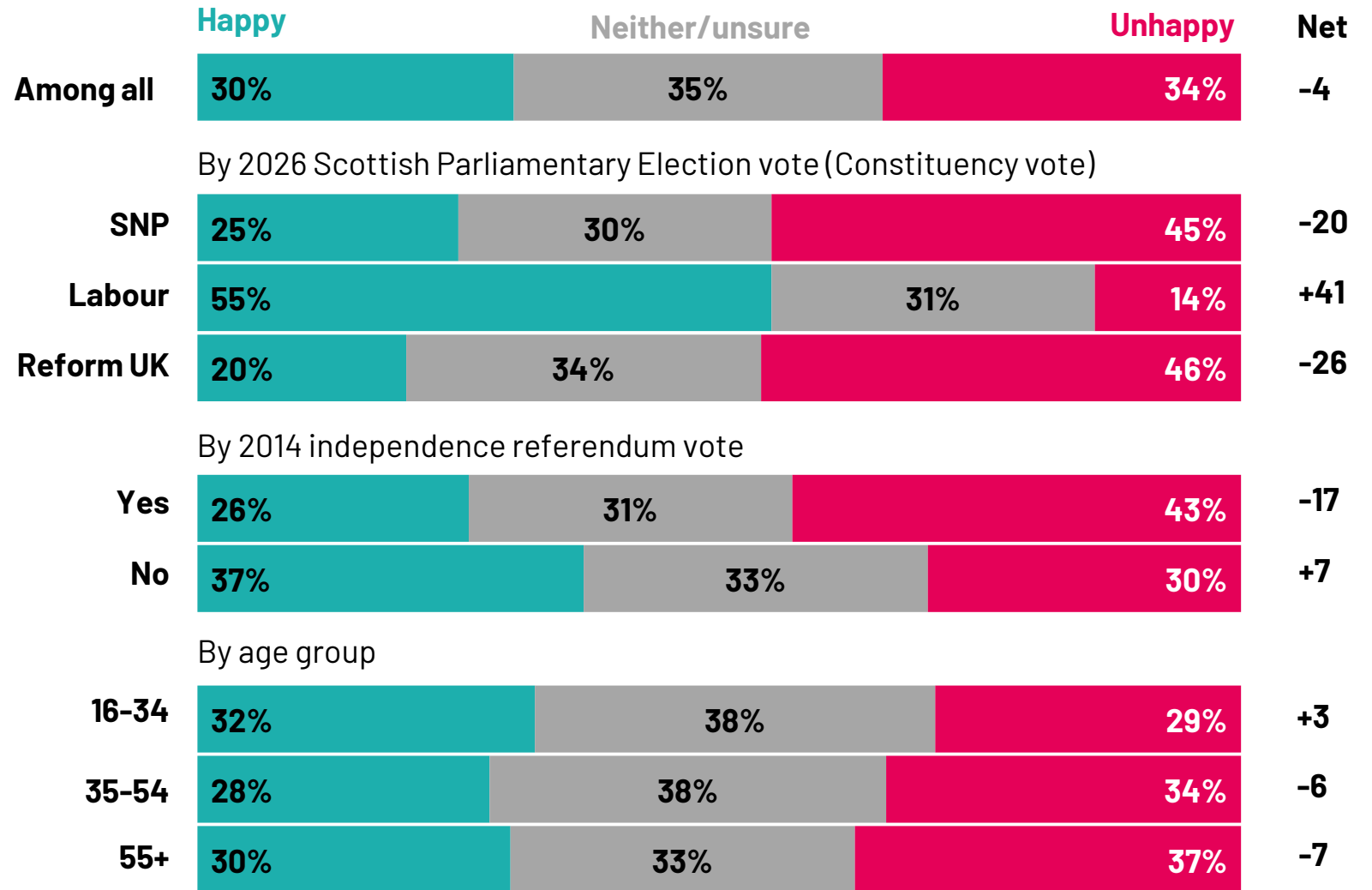

Views on Scottish Government collaboration with the UK Labour Government at Westminster

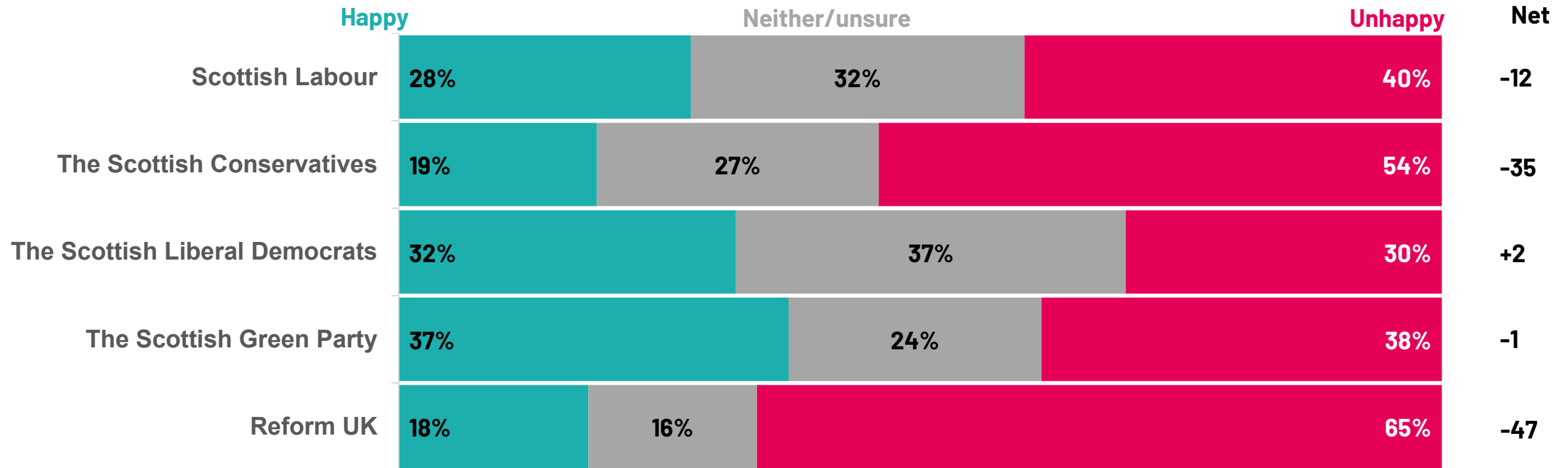

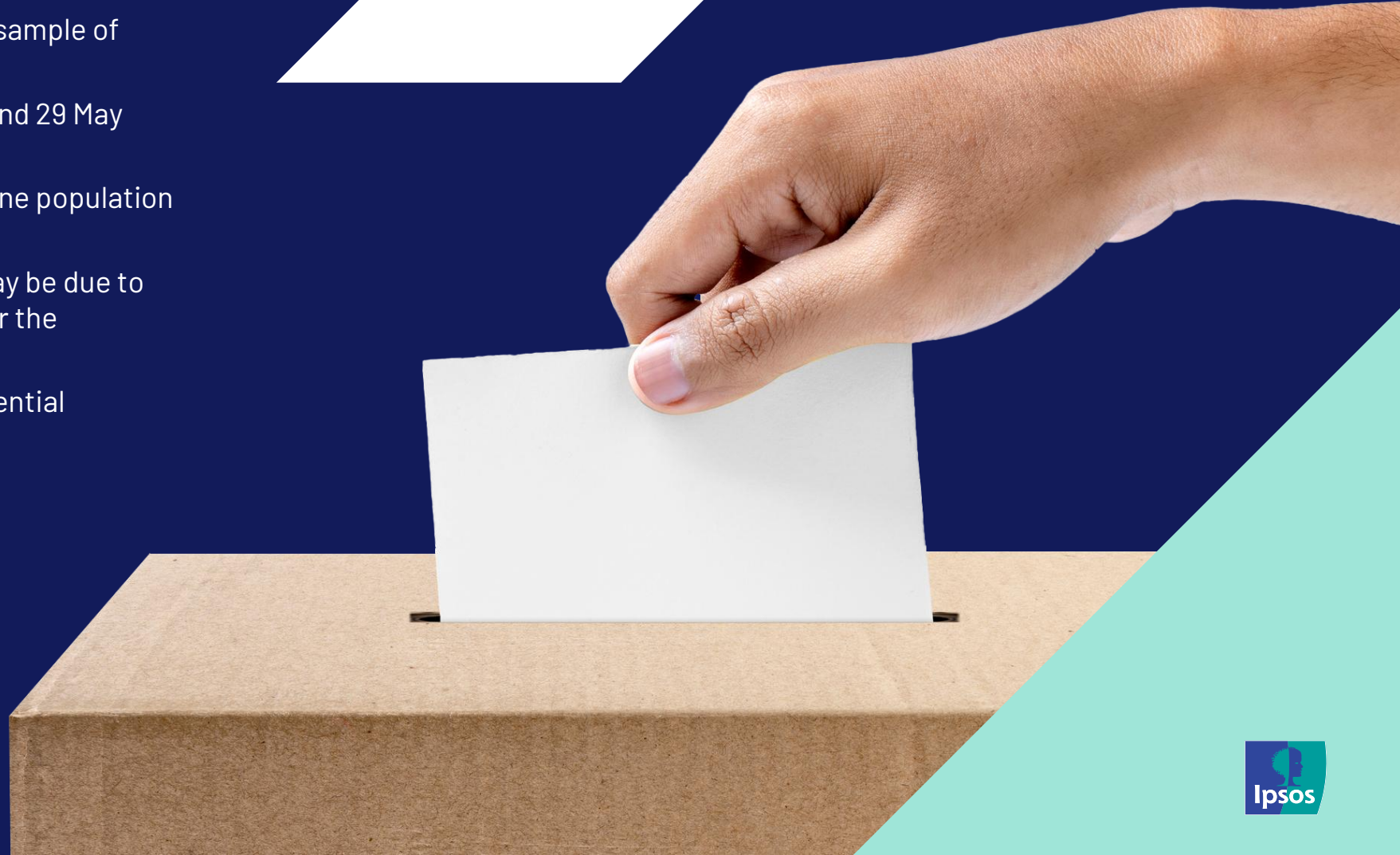

METHODS

- Ipsos interviewed a representative quota sample of 1,028 adults aged 16+ in Scotland.
- Interviews took place online between 22 and 29 May 2026.
- Data has been weighted to the known offline population proportions.
- Where results do not sum to 100%, this may be due to computer rounding, multiple responses, or the exclusion of “don’t know” categories.
- All polls are subject to a wide range of potential sources of error.
