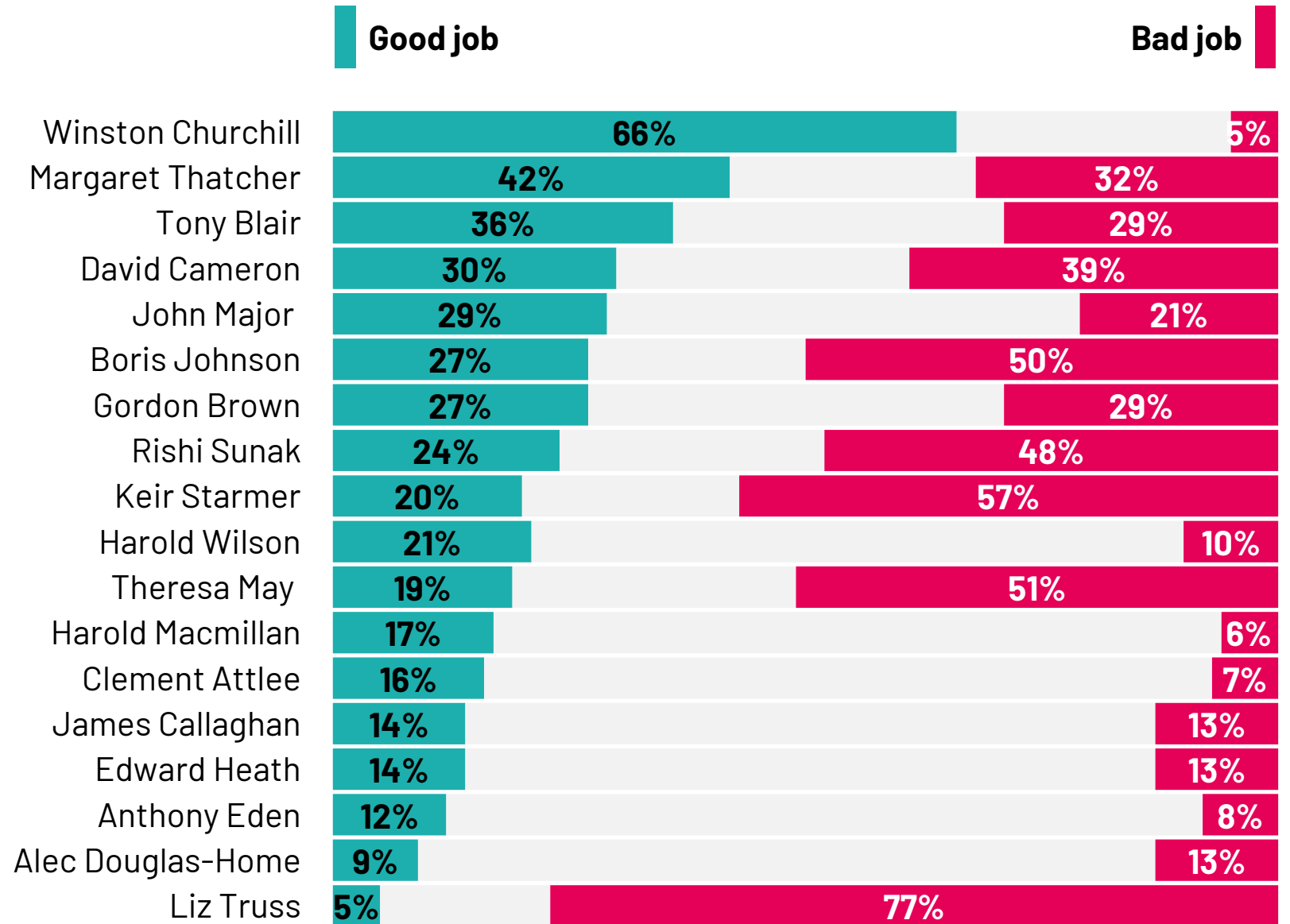

Britons are split on whether Britain is ungovernable

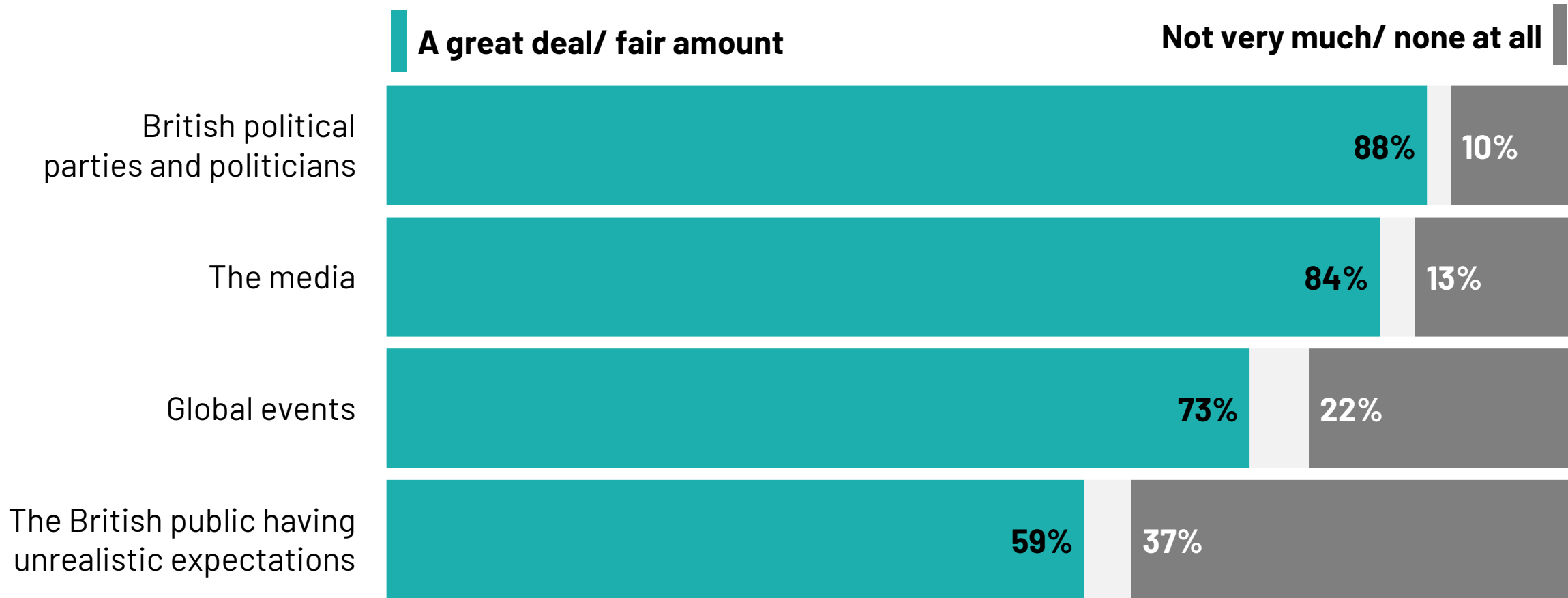
To what extent, if at all, do you think the following statement is true or false? "It doesn't matter which party or leader is in power, Britain today is ungovernable"

A majority of Britons think British political parties and politicians have a great deal/fair amount of responsibility for Britain being ungovernable

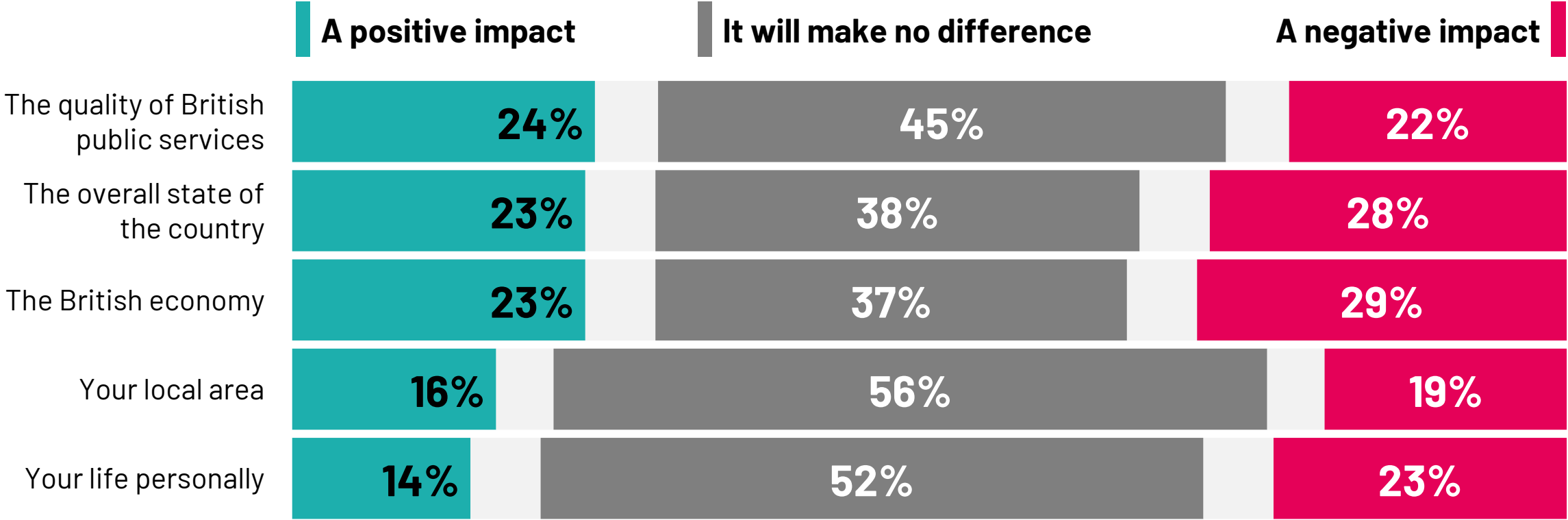
You said that you think Britain is ungovernable today, no matter which party or leader is in power. How much responsibility, if at all, do you each of the following have for making Britain ungovernable?

Britons are most likely to think that a new Prime Minister will make no difference to various parts of society

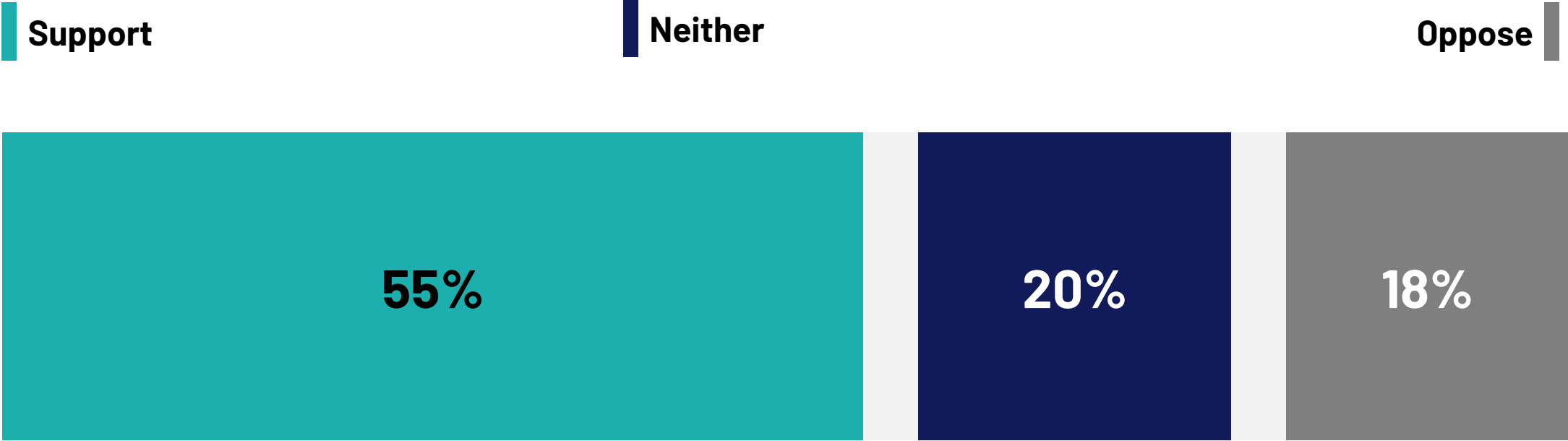
