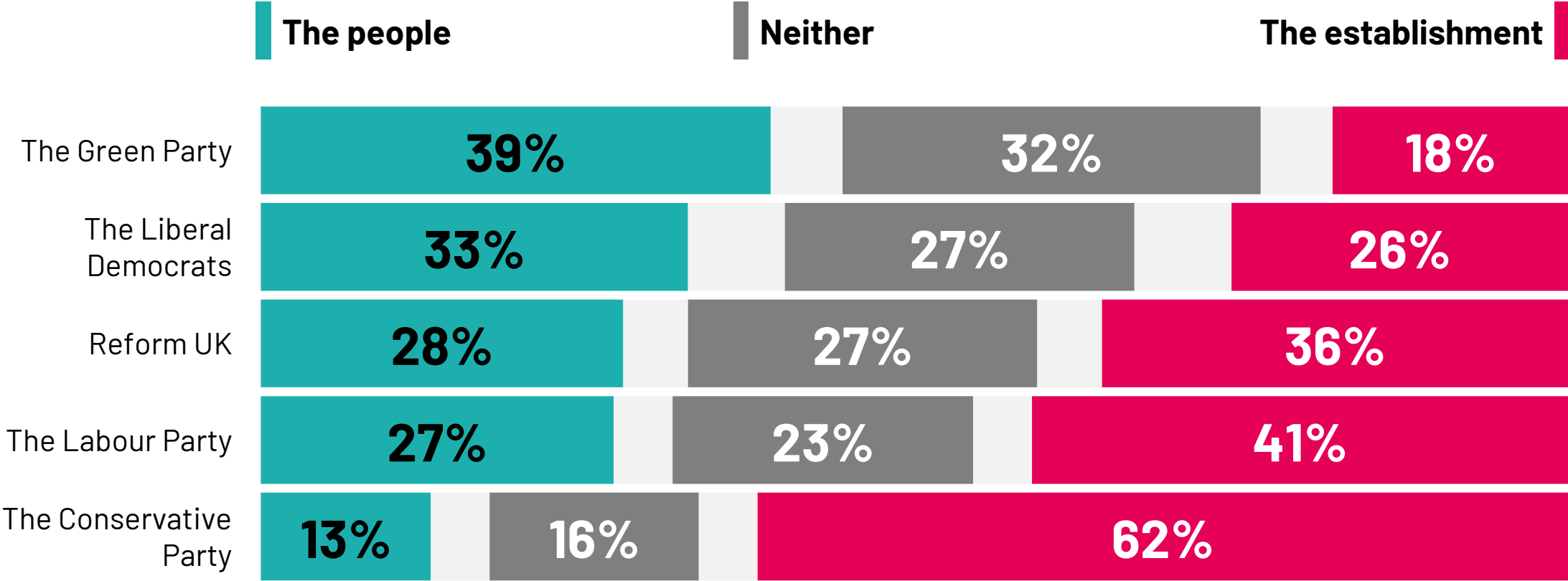

Do you think the following political parties are more on the side of the people or more on the side of the establishment?



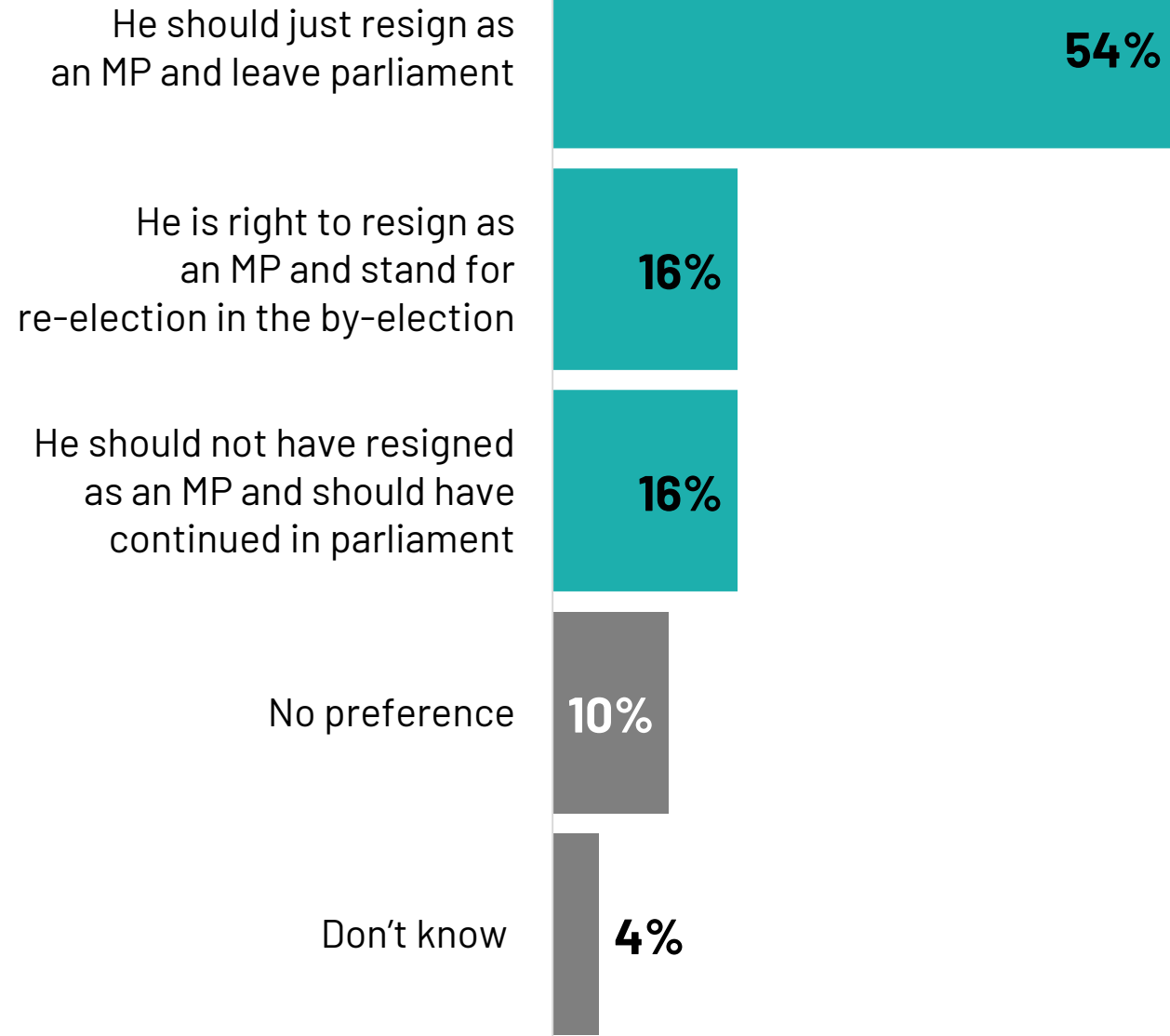

Half of Britons think Nigel Farage should resign as an MP and leave parliament

As you may be aware, Nigel Farage has resigned as an MP for Clacton and indicated he will stand as a candidate in the resulting by-election. Mr Farage is currently under investigation by Parliament's standards commissioner for not declaring a £5m gift he received before his election to parliament and he is facing further questions about not disclosing other financial support he has received. Mr Farage has said he has done nothing wrong and that "the people of Clacton should be the judges of my actions"

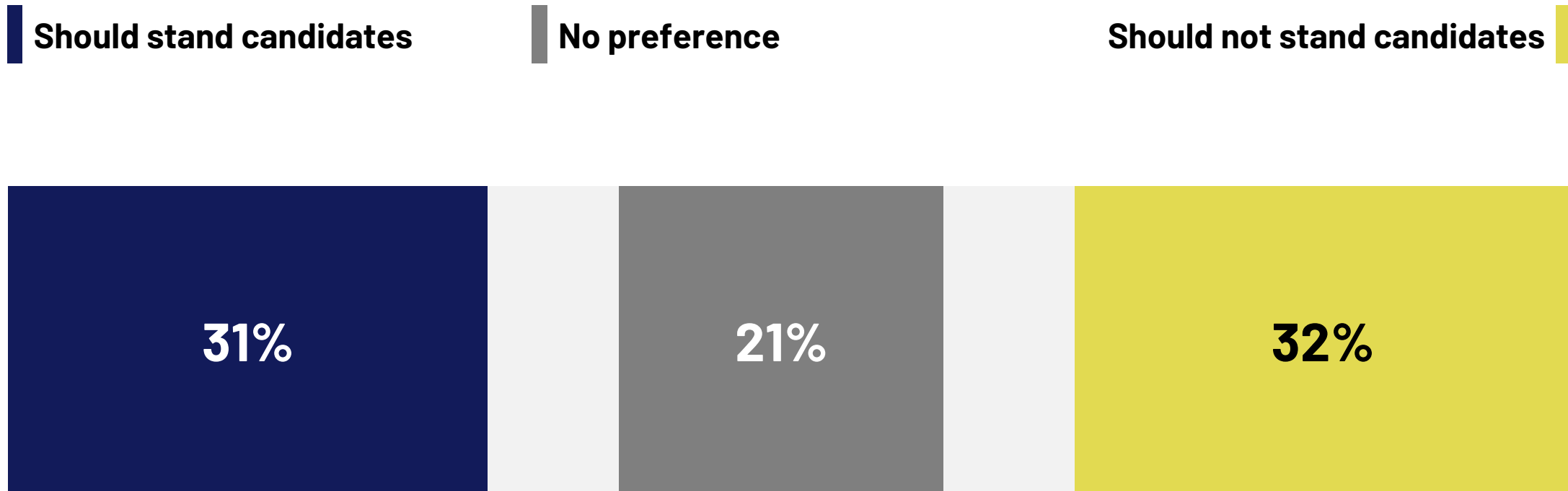
Which of the following best describes what you think Nigel Farage should have done?

Britons are divided on whether the other main political parties should or should not stand candidates in the Clacton by-election

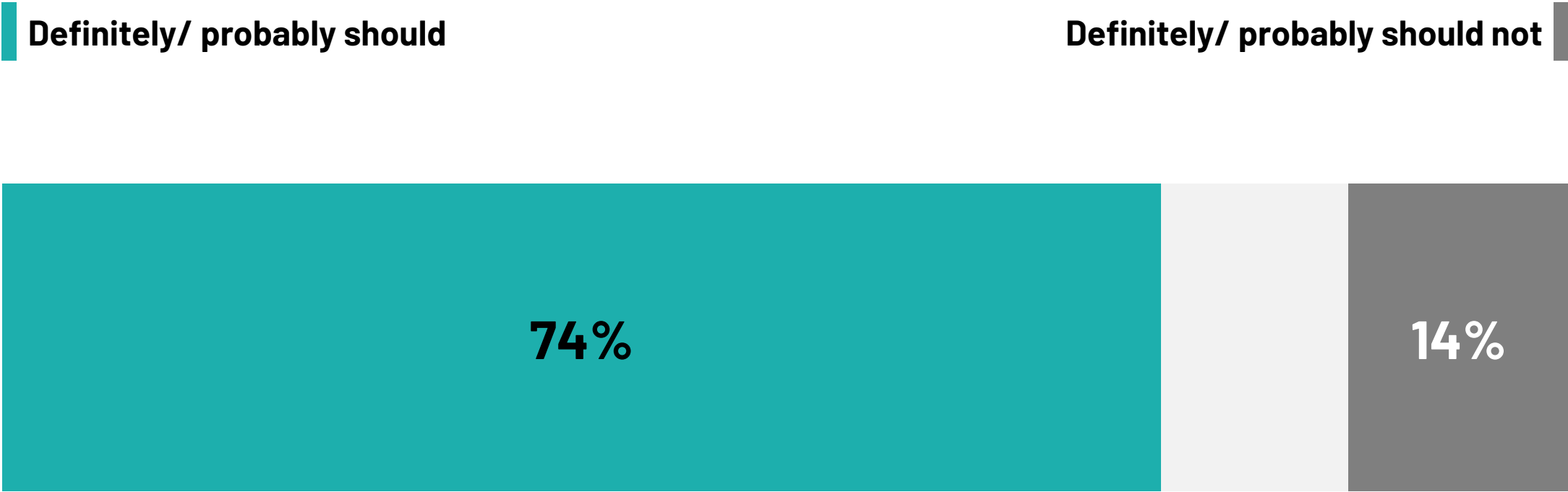

Three quarters of Britons think the parliamentary standards commissioner should be investigating whether Nigel Farage broke parliamentary rules

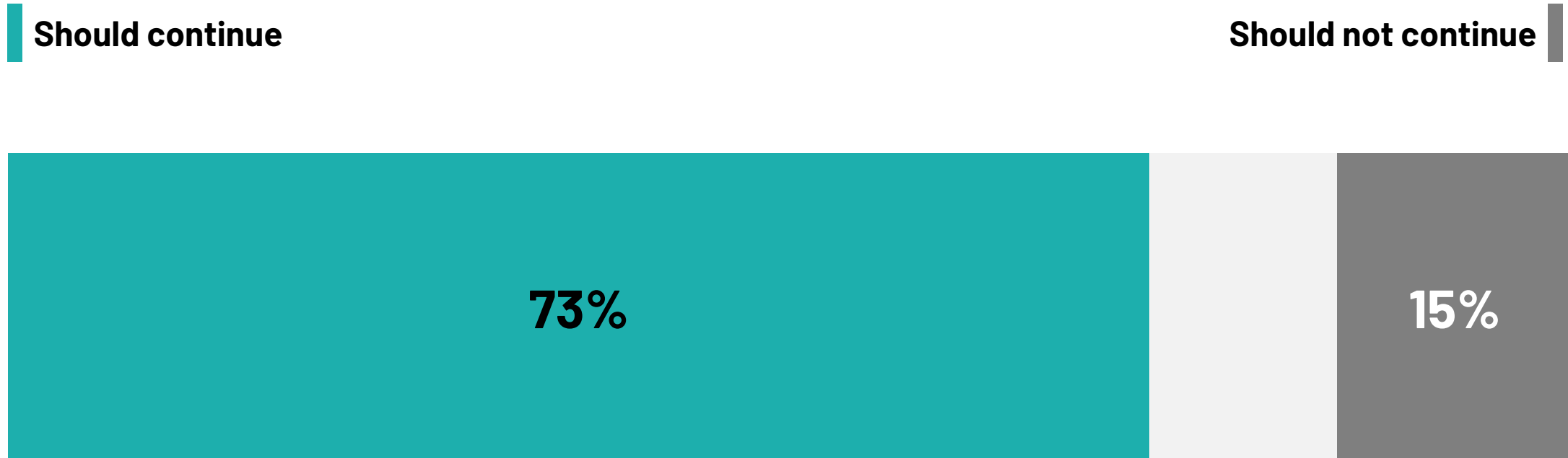

Three quarters of Britons think the parliamentary standards commissioners should still continue to investigate Nigel Farage even if he wins the up-coming by-election

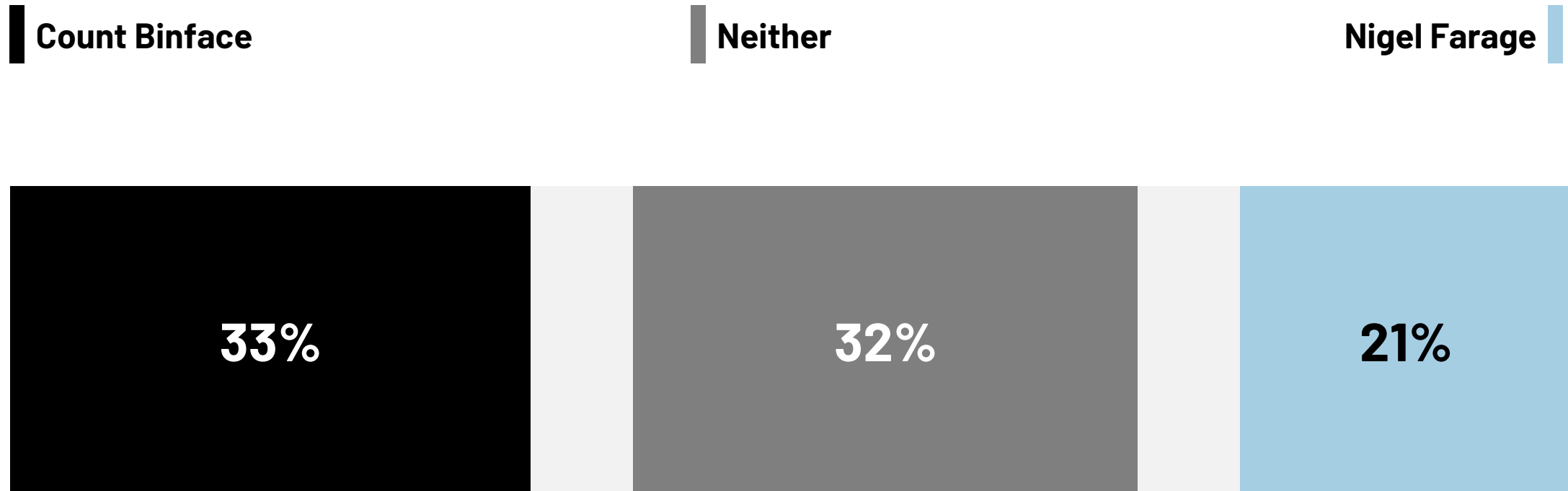
If Nigel Farage wins the upcoming by-election in Clacton, do you think the parliamentary standards commissioner investigation should continue or not?

A third of Britons would prefer for Count Binface to win the Clacton by-election

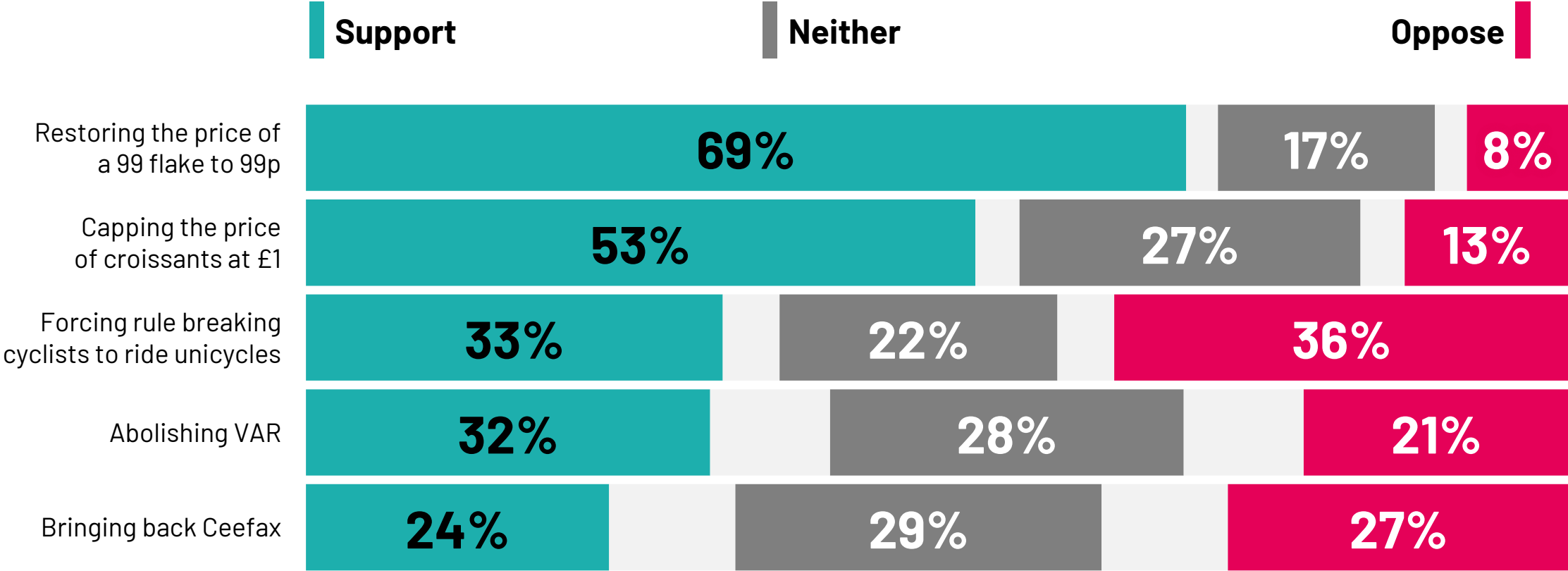
Which of the following, if either, would you prefer to win the by-election in Clacton
