



## Public Views Coronavirus as a health AND economic crisis


In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the U.S. today?






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#### **Coronavirus' Impact on Professional & Commercial Dealings**

% Yes March 13–16 March 20–23 March 27–30 April 3-6 April 10-13





% Large risk + Moderate risk






## **Swing State Perceptions**

If the 2020 presidential election were held today, would you vote for Donald Trump or Joe Biden?






