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


In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?





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

In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?






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### **Donald Trump's Weekly Approval**






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

At the end of the impeachment process, what do you think should happen to President Trump?





# Americans are more likely now than in May 2019 to see Iran as an imminent threat and foresee war within the next few years.


On a scale of 1 to 5, with one being no threat and 5 being an imminent threat, how much of a threat do the following countries or organizations pose to the United States- Iran?

How likely, if at all, do you believe it is that United States will go to war with the following countries within the next few years- Iran?




