In this case, the poll has a credibility interval of plus or minus the following percentage points



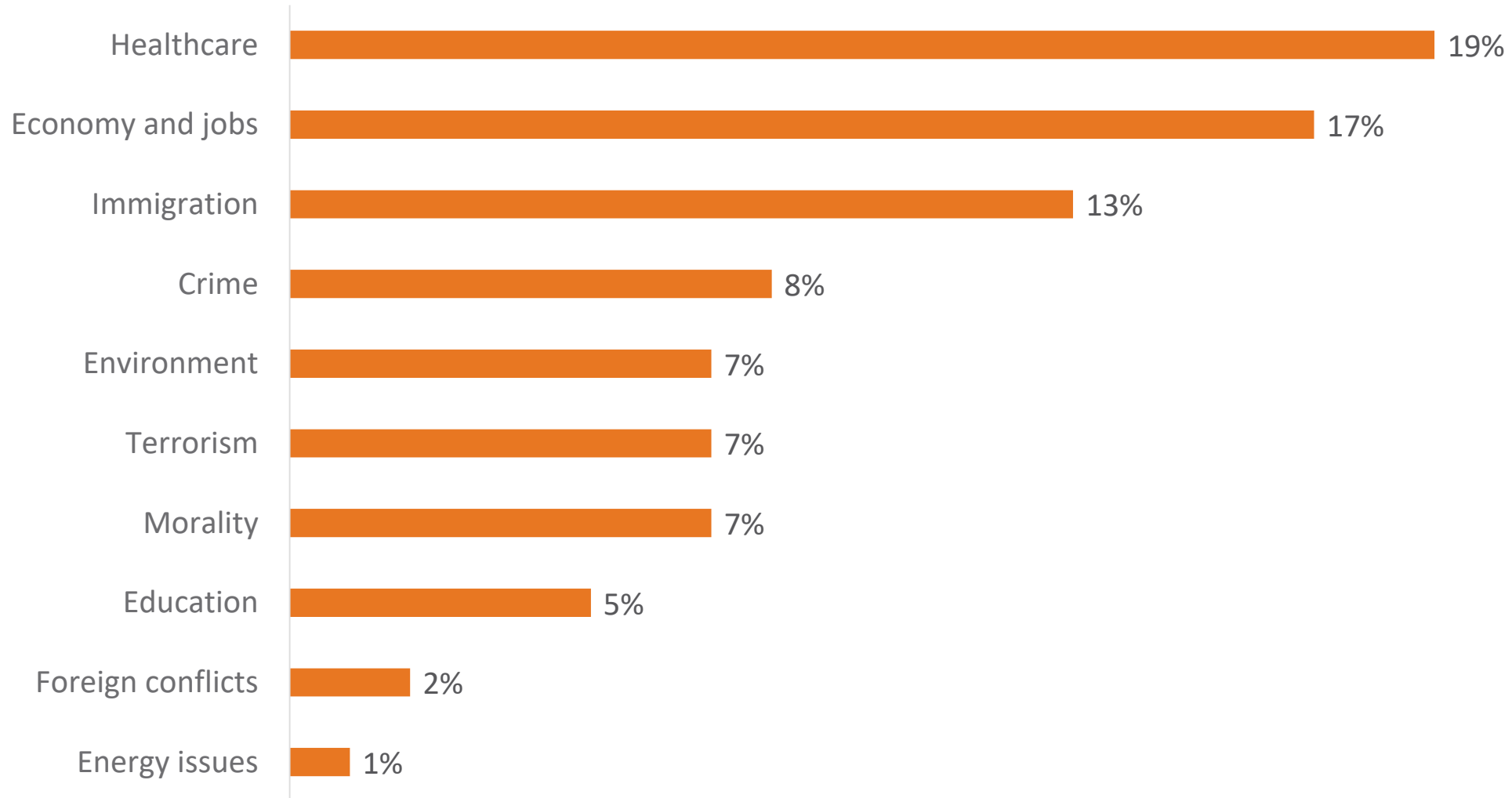

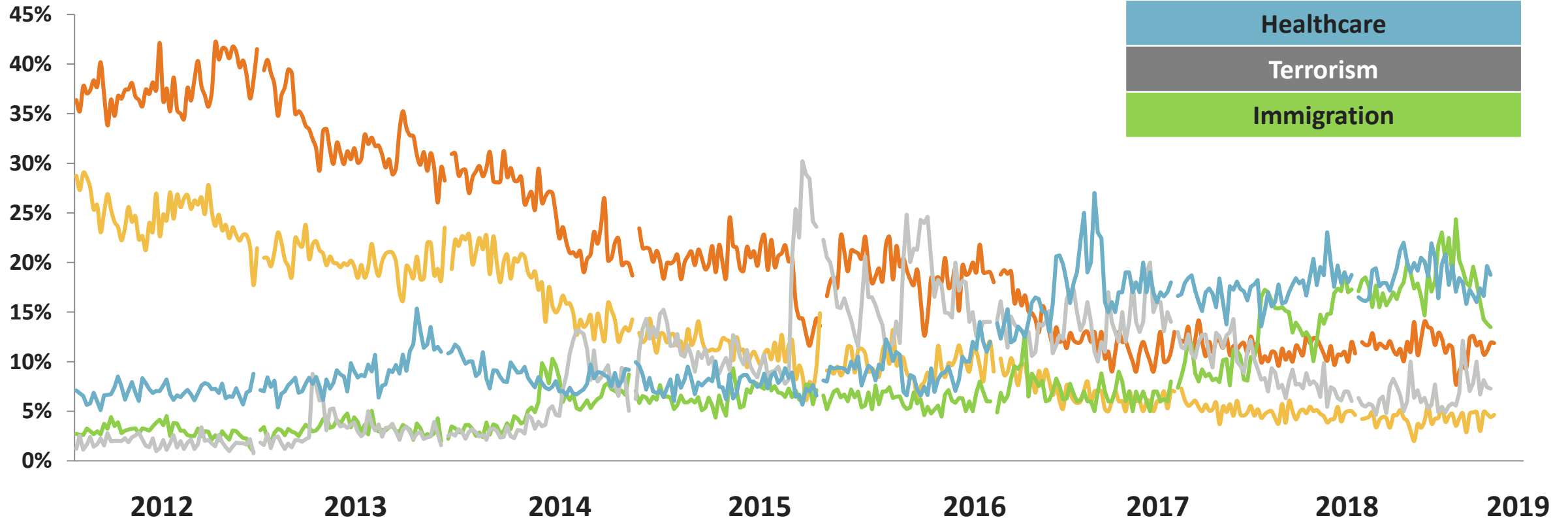

Most Important Problem Facing America

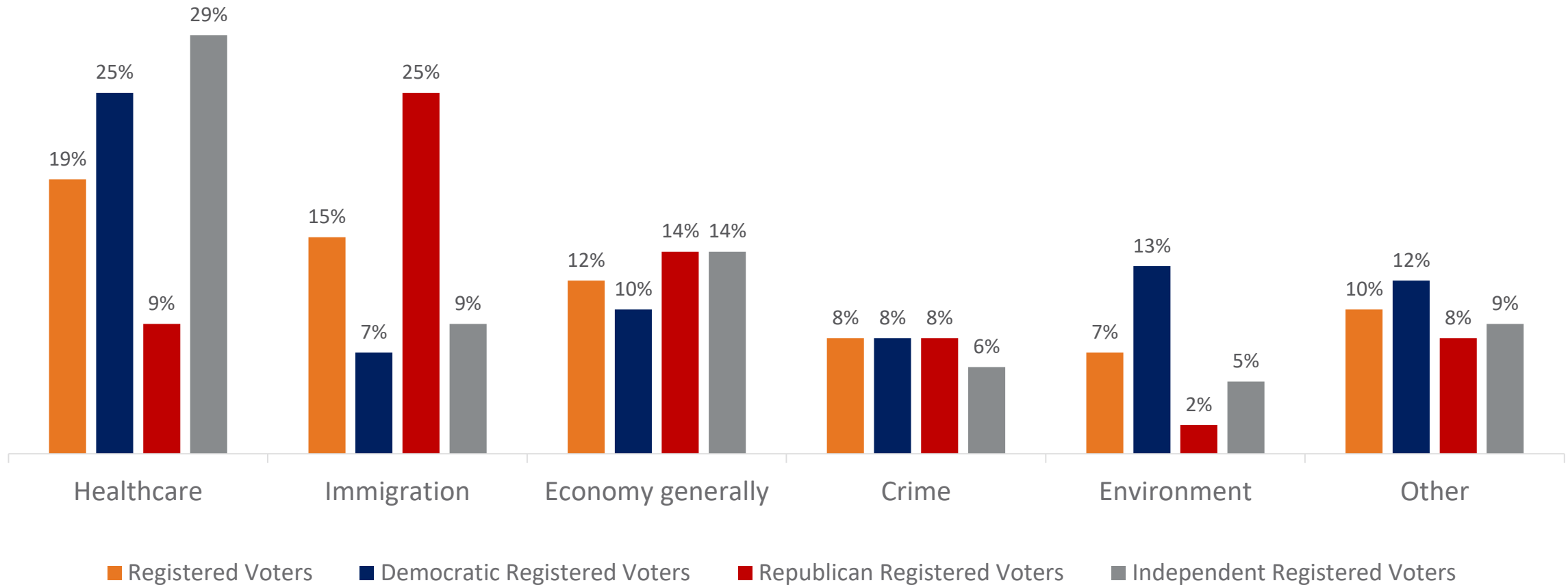
In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the U.S. today?

Parties are split on their top issues

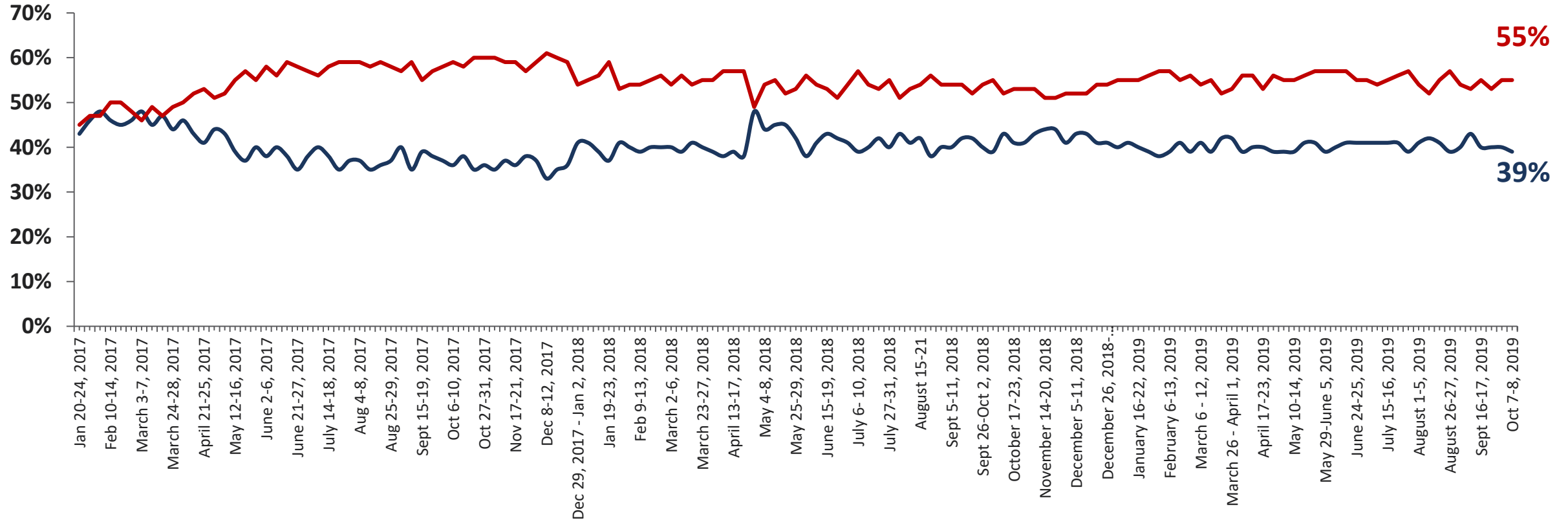
In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?

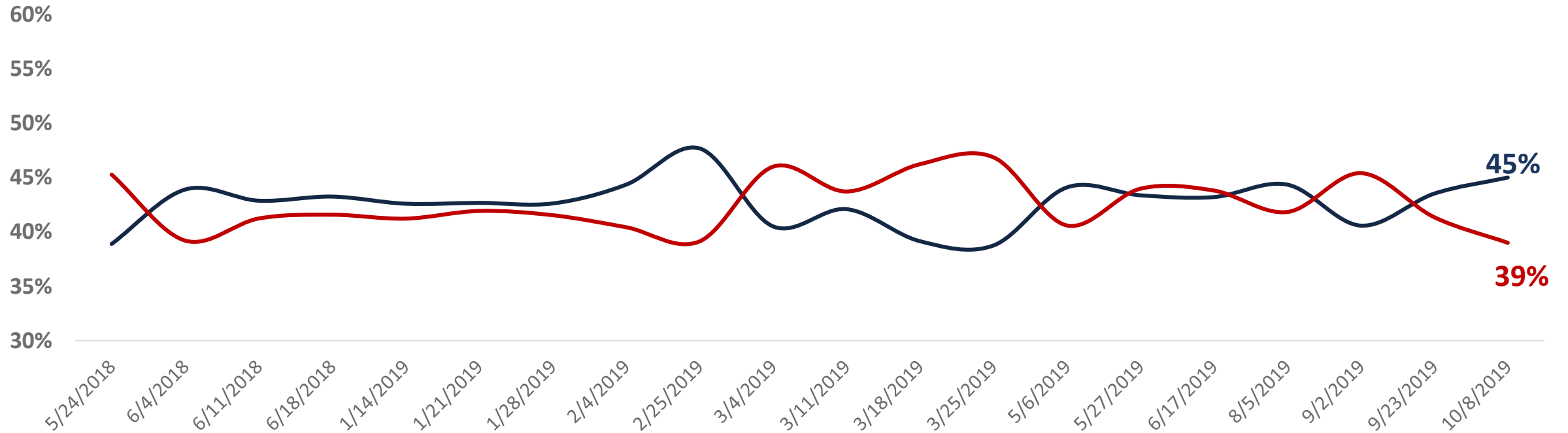

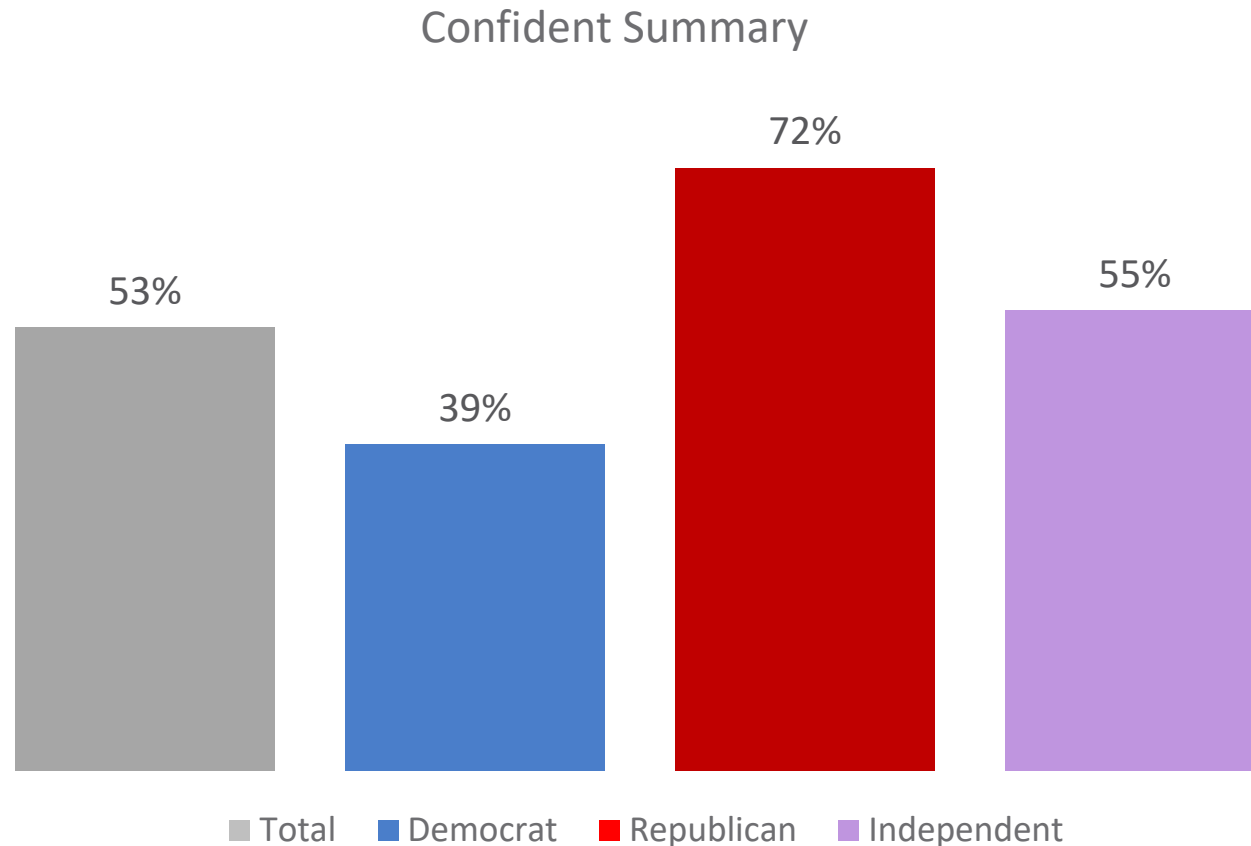

Only half of Americans trust 2020 elections will be open and fair

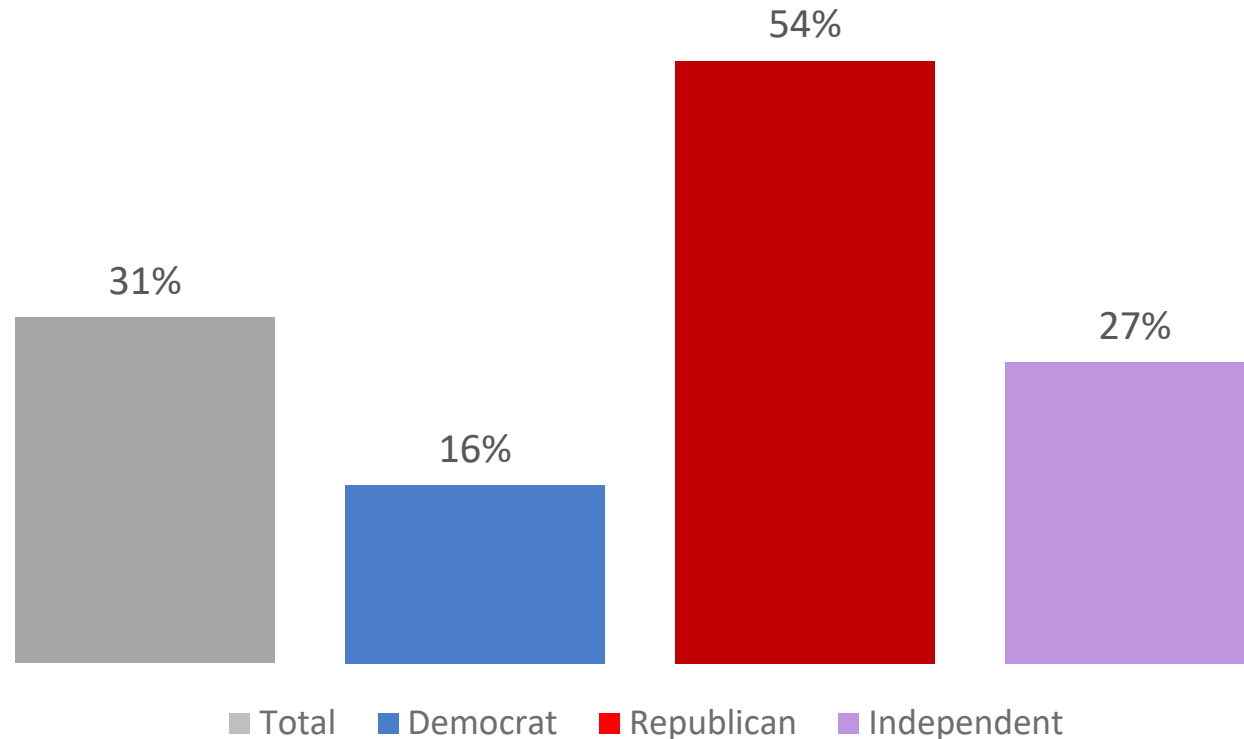
Thinking about the rules and processes in place for voting in US presidential elections, how much confidence do you have that the presidential election will be open and fair?

I am confident the government has done enough to protect elections from foreign interference

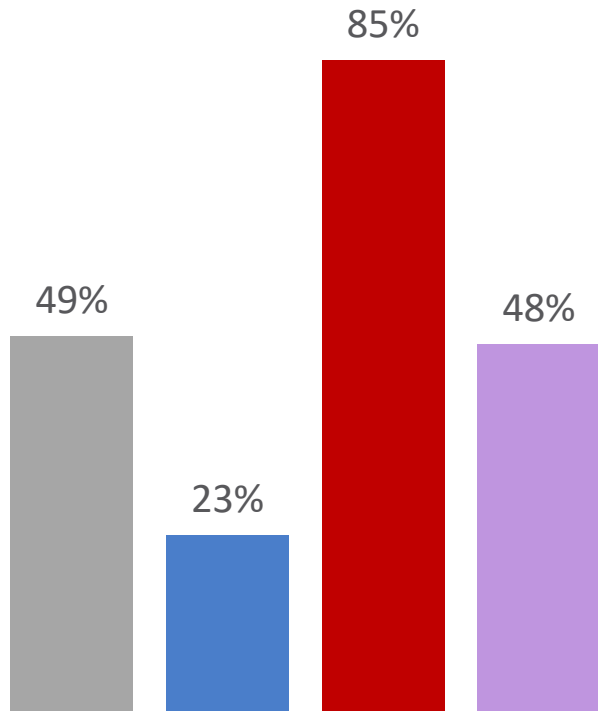

How committed would you say the Republican Party is to making sure elections in the United States are fair and accurate?

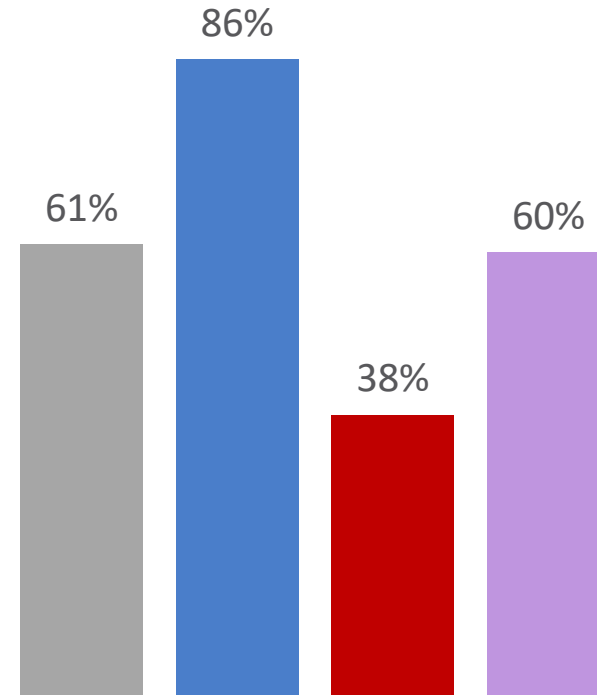

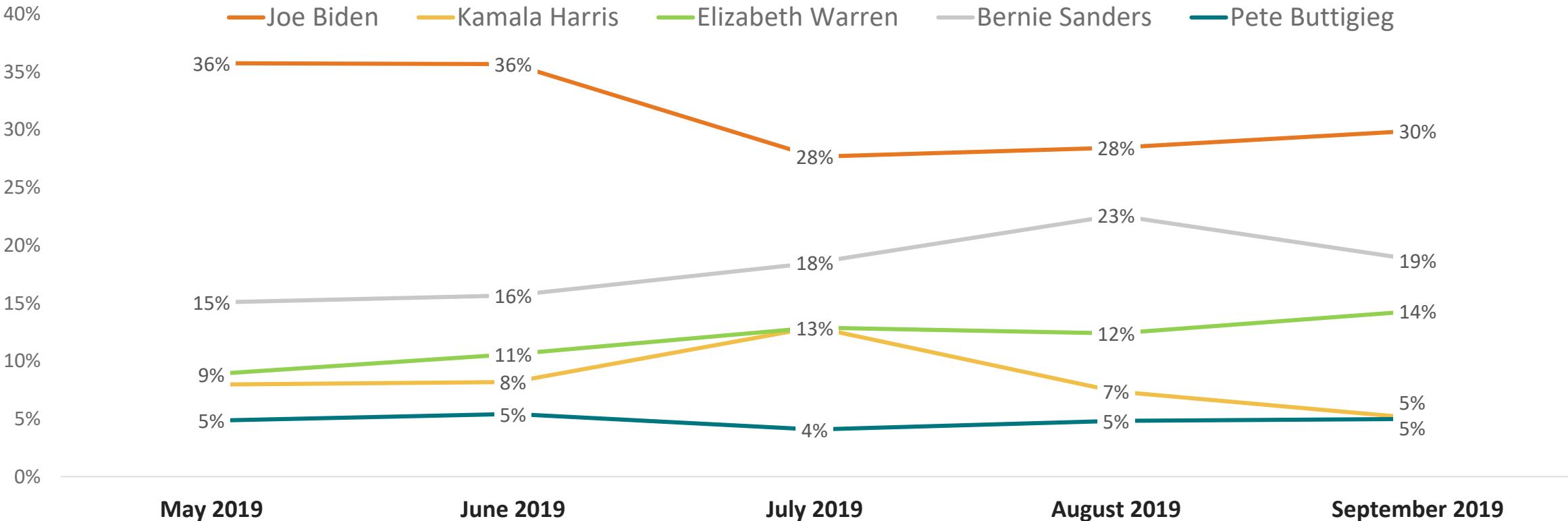

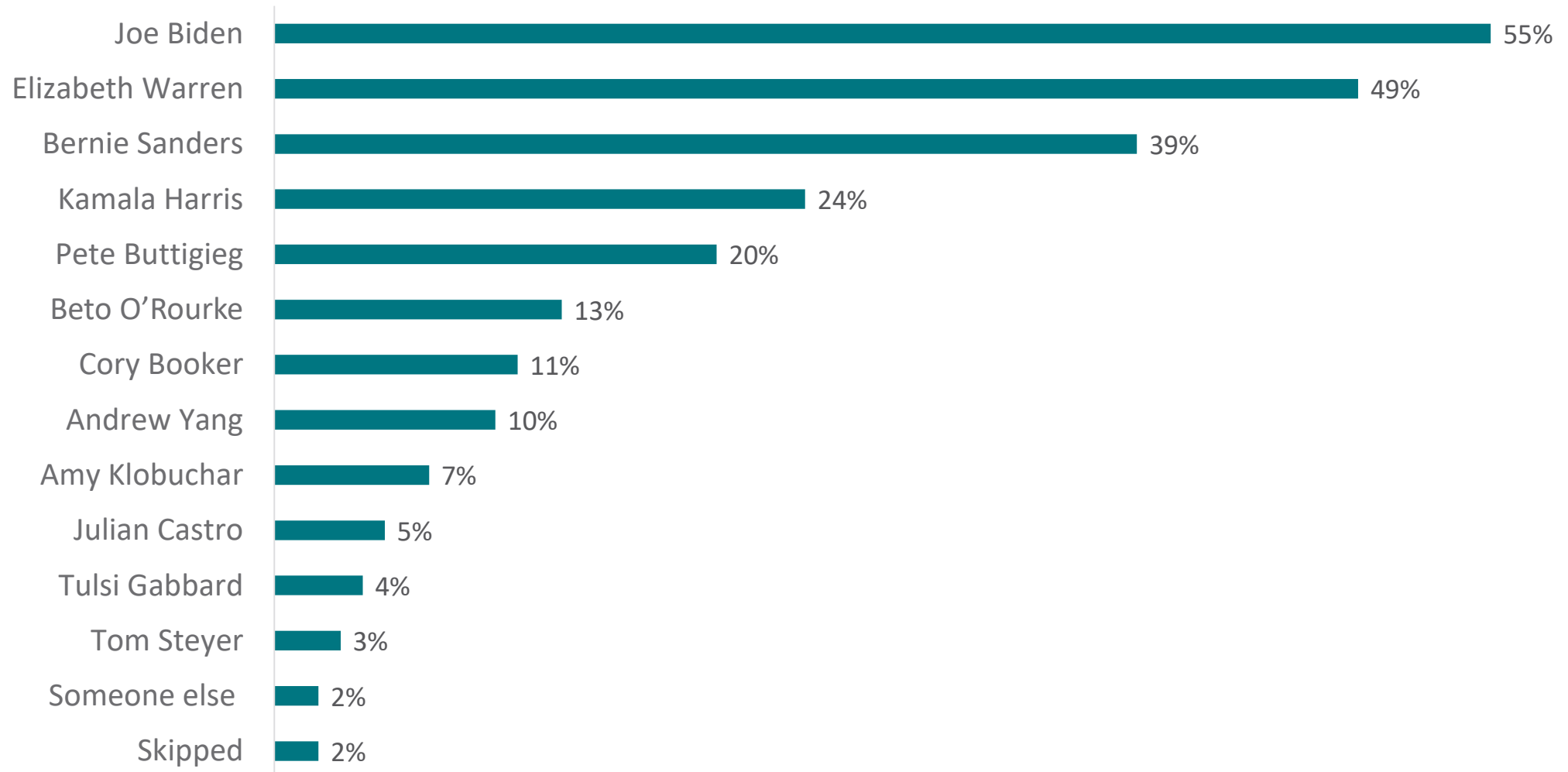
2020 Democratic Primary Horseshoe - Trend

If the 2020 Democratic presidential primary election were held today, and you had to choose from the list of candidates below, for whom would you vote?



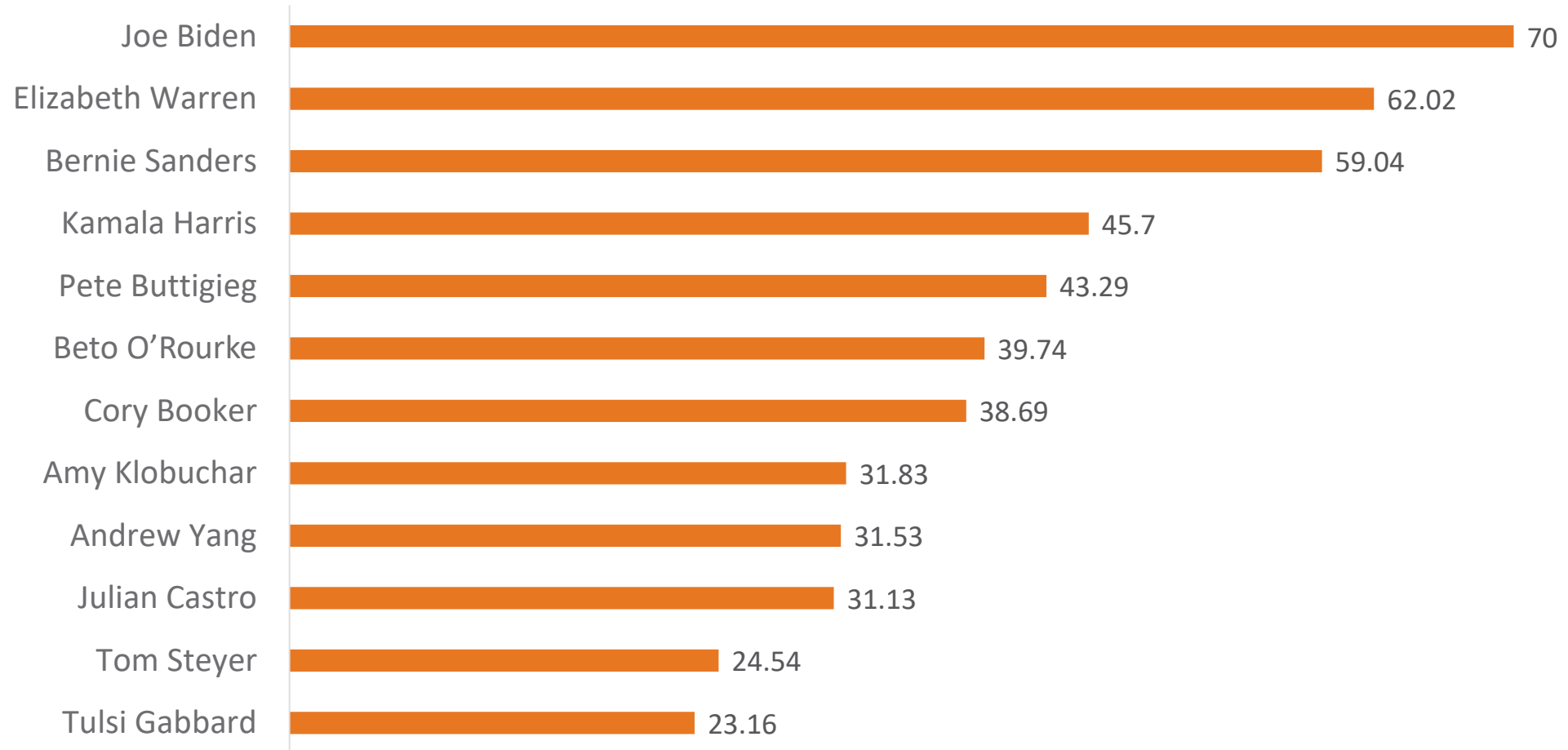
