





If the 2020 presidential election were held today, would you vote for Donald Trump or Joe Biden? Order of candidates is randomly rotated in question text










Most Important Issue in Voting




Biden Leads Trump in Pennsylvania among Likely Voters




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


Biden's Debate Performance Stronger than Trump's

Percentage of Americans ranking _____ as one of the three most important issues facing the US today



Views of Candidates Stable Heading into Last Week of Campaign


Percentage of Americans with a favorable opinion of...



How concerned are you that you or someone you know will be infected with COVID-19?








Millions of Americans have Already Voted, Primarily by Mail

Which of the following best describes how you will vote or have voted in this year's presidential election, to be held on November 3rd? (Of those who say they have voted already)







Percentage of Americans who...









Plan to celebrate at home with immediate family or people they live with


