In this case, the poll has a credibility interval of plus or minus the following percentage points



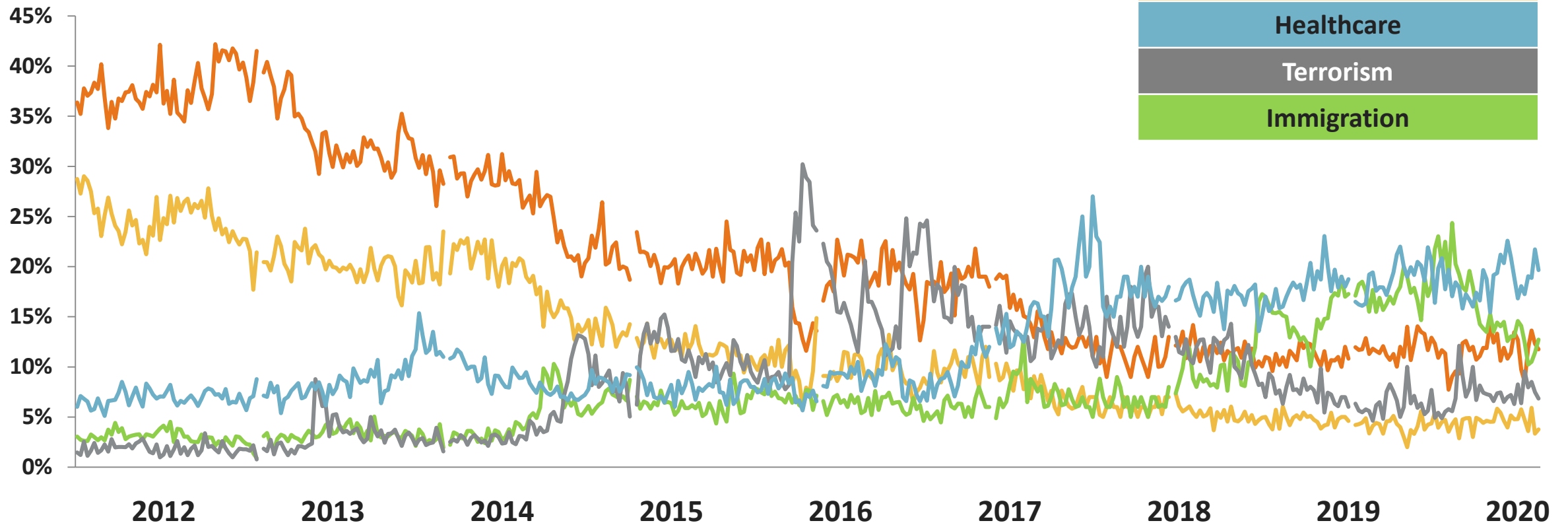

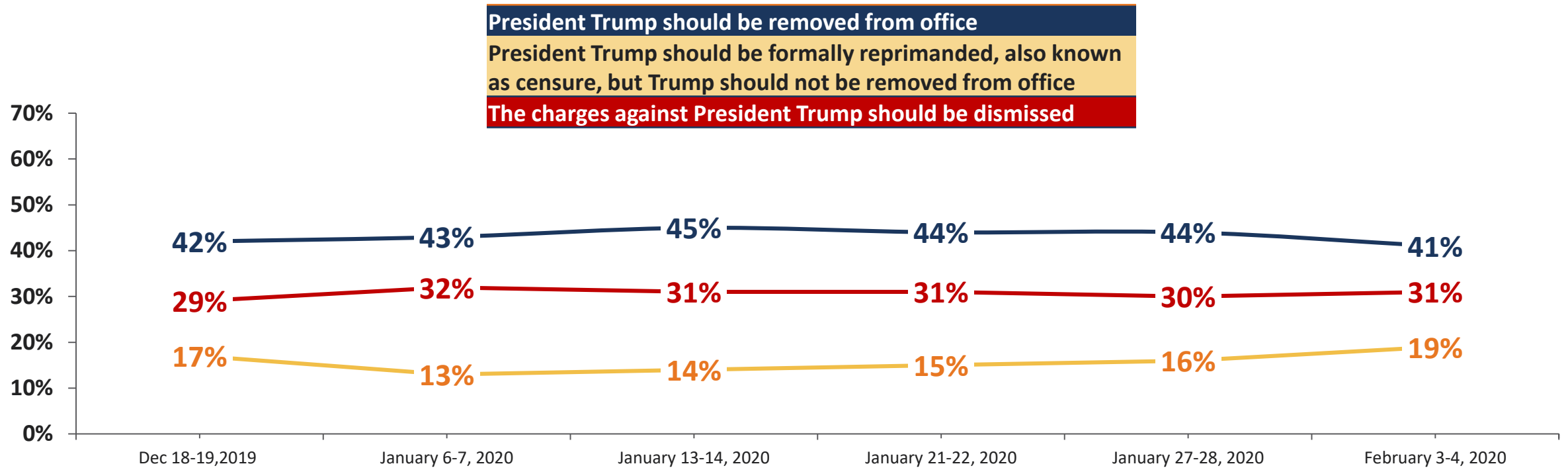

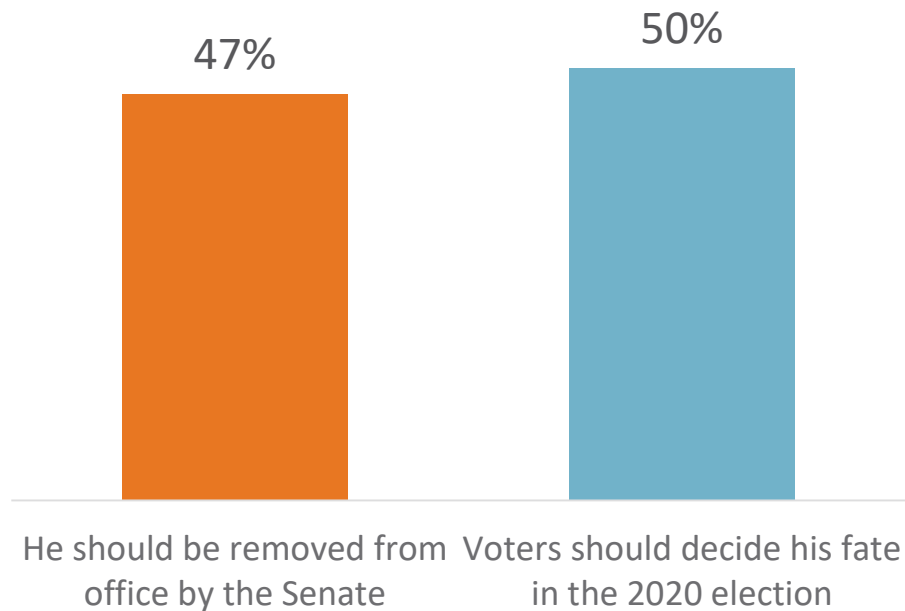

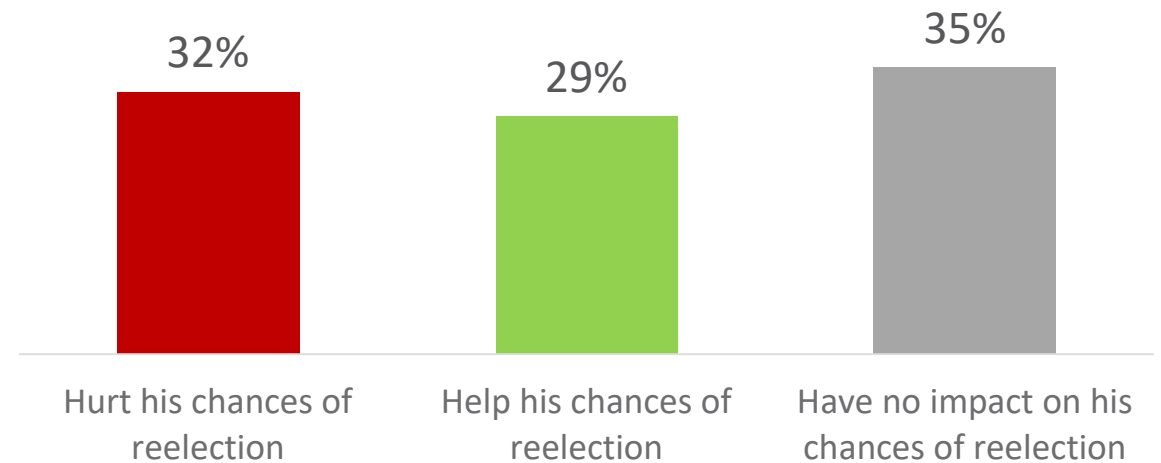

At the end of the impeachment process, what do you think should happen to President Trump?



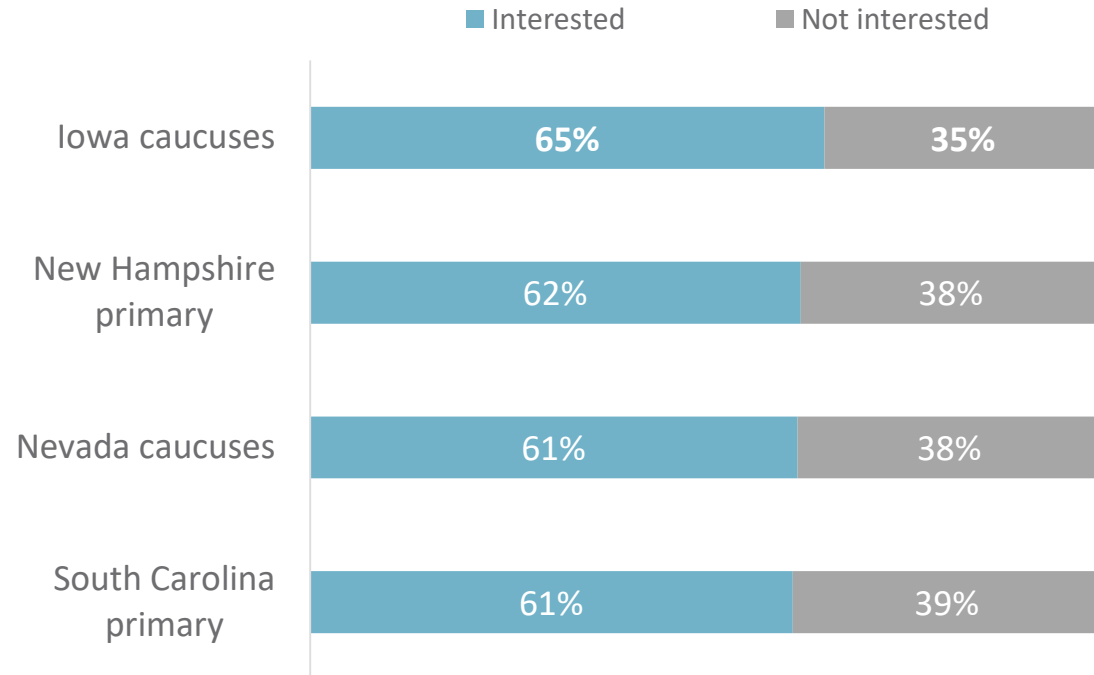

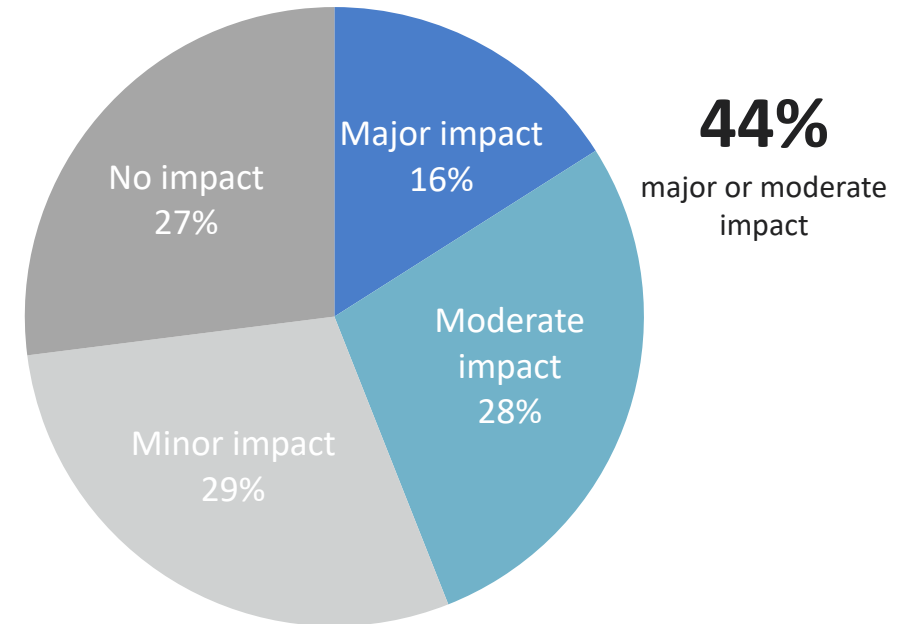
# IOWA CAUCUS AND THE DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY

How interested are you in the elections and caucuses being held in these states?



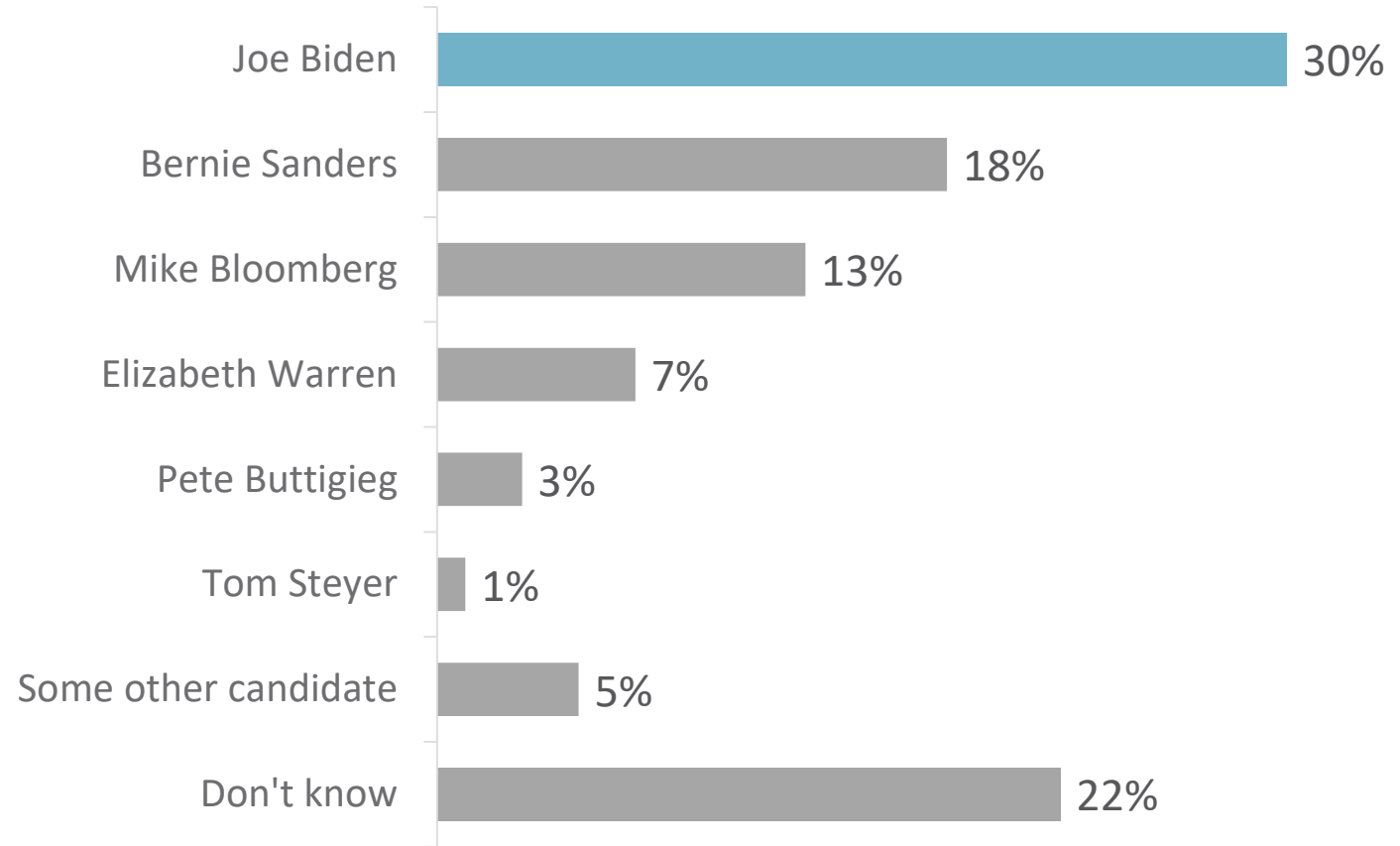

# Joe Biden is seen as most likely to beat President Trump, a key issue for Democratic primary voters.

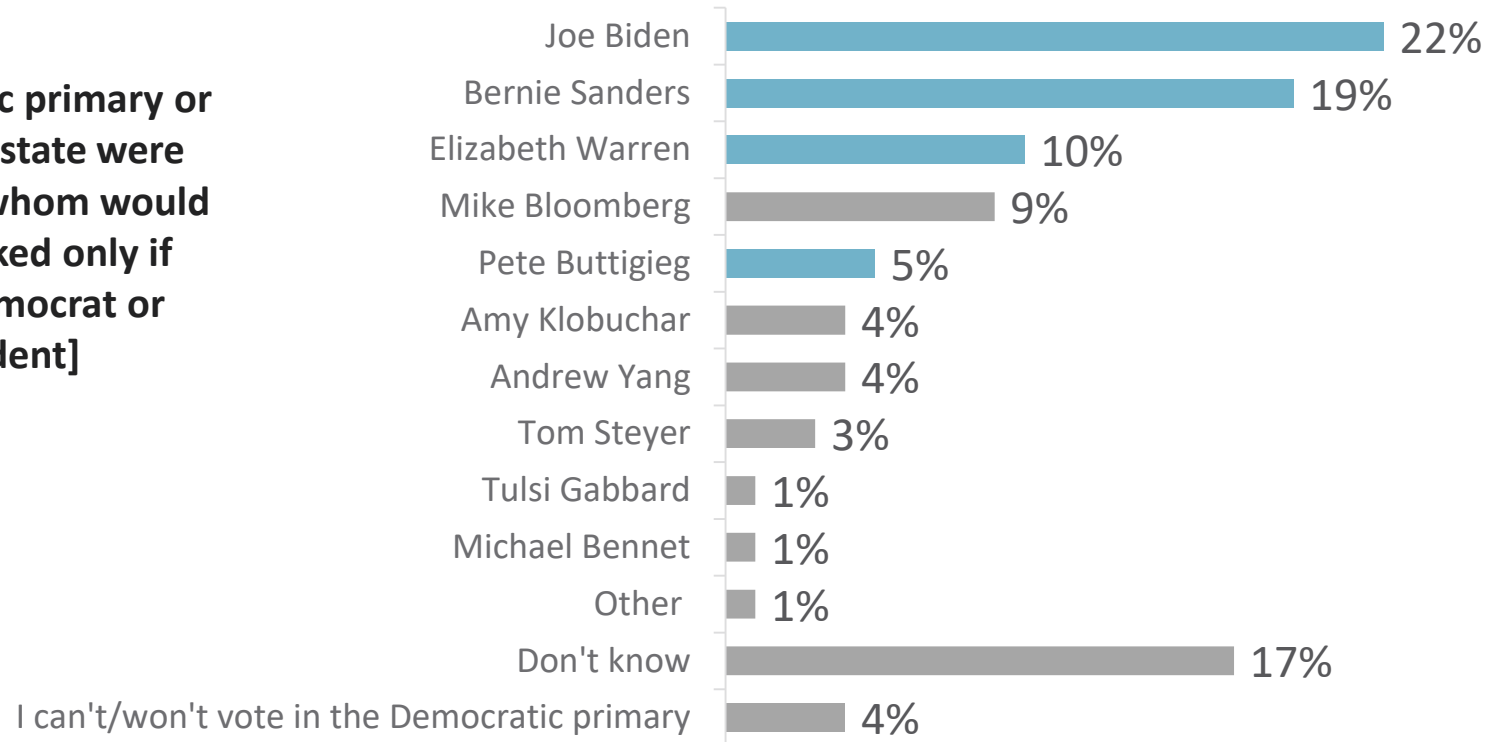
