










Nearly Half of Americans Have Established a "Bubble"; Mask Usage Outside the Home at All-time High

Percentage of Americans that have established a "bubble" of people that they can interact with


A **bubble** is a group of people outside of one's household that is all following the same rules about minimizing the risk of catching COVID-19





Percentage of Americans who wear masks when leaving home










Americans Looking for Strong Federal Management of COVID














Trump's Handling of Protests Met with Low Overall Approval
