- Fieldwork was carried out between 28th January and 5th March 2006 among adults aged 16+
- Quotas set on gender, age and work status
- Data have been weighted by gender, age, work status and area using census data
- An asterisk (*) denotes a finding of less than 0.5% but greater than zero
- Where figures do not add up to 100% this is due to computer rounding, the exclusion of don't know or refused categories or multiple responses
- Where appropriate, 2003 results have been included from previous waves, conducted between the 21st July and 19th August 2001 among 1,028 adults aged 15+
